THIS WEEK:

The University of Iowa men's tennis team will head south when they square-off against Texas Tech in Lubbock, Texas, at the McLeod Tennis Center at 1 p.m. (CT). Four of Iowa's next five matches will be contested away from Iowa City.

LAST WEEK:

- The Hawkeyes lost to Cornell on Sunday (L, 5-2).
- Nikita Snezhko and Joe Tyler extended their doubles win streak to three winning on court three against the Big Red.
- In singles, Oliver Okonkwo and Will Davies won their matches on courts four and five, respectively.

SEASON RECAP:

- The Hawkeyes (8-2) are off to their best start in the Ross Wilson era.
- Iowa has won the doubles point in eight of the ten matches. The Hawkeyes boast two doubles tandems that are off to hot starts, Will Davies/Oliver Okonkwo (8-2) and Kareem Allaf/Jonas Larsen (7-3).

TEXAS TECH BREAKDOWN:

- The Red Raiders are coached by Brett Masi. He is in his fourth season with the program, boasting a record of 60-32 (.652).
- Texas Tech is 8-5 overall dropping its last two matches on the road at Arizona (L, 4-3) and Alabama (L. 4-1).
- The Hawkeyes are 1-2 all-time against the Red Raiders. lowa lost last year's match against Texas Tech, 4-2, in La Jolla, California.
- Texas Tech boasts the eighth ranked doubles tandem in the country, Bjorn Thomson and Parker Wynn.
- Tommy Mylnikov is ranked No. 114 and Wynn is also ranked No. 115 in singles.

HAWKEYE NOTABLES:

- Kareem Allaf won 11 matches during competition, including seven in a row to capture the ITA Central Regional championship. He became the third Hawkeye to accomplish the feat in school history.
- Will Davies and Oliver Okonkwo are a combined 32-7 in singles and doubles competition through ten matches.
- Larsen's 54 career doubles wins that puts him tied for 11th in program history.
- With one more singles win, Allaf will crack the Top-15 in program history for the Hawkeyes.
- lowa has competed against five teams who made the NCAA Tournament a year ago, including beating three former-conference champions.
