

#### **LEADING OFF**

**HAWKEYES** 

- lowa started the season with a 9-1 record, the best start for the program since 1940 when the Hawkeyes started 10-0-1. The team won seven-straight during the start, the longest streak since winning 12-straight in 2007.
- UI head coach Rick Heller is a single win shy of No. 700 for his career. He is 39th in the NCAA in winningest active coaches with 699 victories in 26-plus seasons.
- The Hawkeyes are 7-0 in the state of Florida this season, going 4-0 at the first Snowbird Classic before finishing 3-0 at the Stetson Invitational. Iowa scored 60 runs in the seven contests.
- Three Hawkeyes -- Tyler Peyton, Dan Potempa and Nick Day -- bring eight-game hitting streaks into the Snowbird Classic. All three hit streaks are career-longs.
- Junior Jake Mangler has reached base safely in all 13 games this season. The second baseman has hits in 11-of-13 games.
- lowa leads the Big Ten and ranks 13th nationally in scoring, averaging 7.8 runs per game. The Hawkeyes also rank in the top-21 in the country in steals (17th, 28) and batting average (21st, .305).
- The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in nine categories and rank second in three more. Iowa is the only team currently with more than 100 runs scored this season (102) and are leading the conference in hits (144), RBIs (86), doubles (26), and home runs (7).
- lowa has four batters in the top-11 in the league in batting average with junior Jake Yacinich pacing the B1G with a .417 clip.

Rick Heller was named the 20th head coach in University of Iowa baseball history on July 12, 2013. Heller joined the Hawkeyes after serving as head coach at Indiana State the last four seasons.

Heller, a native of Eldon, Iowa, has been head coach at three institutions -- Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99) -- leading all three schools to NCAA postseason play. He led Indiana State to its first outright Missouri Valley Conference title in 2012. He led Northern Iowa to the 2001 MVC title and into the NCAA Tournament, the first regional appearance for the Panthers since becoming a Division I program in 1981. In 26-plus seasons as a head coach, Heller holds a career mark of 699-572-4.

Heller led the Sycamores to their first outright Missouri Valley Conference championship in school history and back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1995 during the record-setting 2012 season. Indiana State finished 41-19, including a 14-7 record in conference play to claim the regular season crown and earn an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament. The 41 wins were the most for the program since 1991.

During his tenure at Northern lowa, Heller's teams won 270 games, including the 2001 Missouri Valley Conference championship and NCAA Regional Berth. While building the Panthers into an annual contender, Heller coached three MVC Most Valuable Players, one MVC Pitcher of the Year and helped put 22 players in professional baseball.

While at UNI, Heller's teams broke a total of 57 team or individual records, including setting team records for hits, runs batted in, doubles and extra base hits during the 2001 season. Heller led the Panthers to four MVC tournaments, winning the championship in 2001. All-American Ryan Brunner claimed the league MVP award and All-American Nic Ungs was named Pitcher of the Year.

The Panthers recorded back-to-back 30-plus win seasons in 2001 and 2002 for the first time in school history and set the school single-season record with 35 wins in 2001. Before taking over the Northern lowa program prior to the 2000 season, Heller spent 12 years as a head coach at Upper lowa University, a Division III institution. While at Upper lowa, Heller recorded a 291-194-3 overall record and was named the lowa Conference Coach of the Year four times.

#### SCOUTING GEORGETOWN

- The Hoyas have won three-straight contests to improve to 6-7 overall this season. Georgetown has been in Port Charlotte since March 8 competing at the Snowbird Classic.
- Georgetown is hitting .254 as a team, and the Hoyas boast three .300 hitters in their every day lineup. Steve Anderson paces the team with a .346 average with nine RBIs and eight runs scored. He also has a team-best .462 slugging percentage.
- The Hoyas have a 5.15 team ERA, allowing 82 runs (67) earned in 13 games. Max Allen has a pair of wins and a 9.82 ERA in four appearances.

## **SCOUTING SAINT JOSEPH'S**

- The Hawks have won 4-of-6 games to even their record at 5-5 this season. Saint Joseph's went 2-1 last weekend, falling 8-2 to Villanova before defeating Niagara (8-0) and Temple (11-3).
- St. Joseph's is hitting .258 as a team with 17 extra base hits (16 doubles, one home run). The Hawks have three everyday players hitting above .300 with Brian O'Keefe leading the team with a .439 average. O'Keefe has eight RBIs and eight runs. Tom Cunningham has a team-best 10 RBIs and St. Joe's lone home run.

• The Hawks have a 5.36 team ERA, allowing 64

runs (53 earned) over 89 innings. Jordan Carter is 2-1 in three starts with a 4.41 ERA. He has 14 strikeouts in 16 1/3 innings. Daniel Thorpe is 1-0 with a 1.89 ERA in three starts with 17 punch outs in 19 innings.

#### **SCOUTING OTTERBEIN UNIVERSITY**

- Otterbein is an NCAA Division II institution located in Westerville, Ohio. The Cardinals compete in the Ohio Athletic Conference.
- Otterbein brings a 2-1 record into the Snowbird Classic after winning 2-of-3 games against Elmhurst in Xenia, Ohio.
- The Cardinals are hitting .347 as a team with 14 extra base hits (nine doubles, three triples, two home runs). Otterbein scored 30 runs in the three victories. Nine players are hitting .300 or better with David Lemly pacing the team with a .636 average with seven hits in 11 at-bats, including two triples.
- Otterbein struggled on the mound, surrendering 30 runs (28) earned over 26 innings. The Cardinals have a 9.69 team ERA and are allowing opposing hitters to post a .351 batting average. Sophomore right-hander Adam Collier is expected to start against lowa. He is 0-1 with a 21.00 ERA in one start, allowing seven runs on 10 hits over three innings.

#### **THE SERIES**

- The Hawkeyes are 2-1 all-time against Georgetown, which includes a 7-2 victory last season at the Snowbird Classic.
- Iowa has never faced Saint Joseph's or Otterbein University.

#### **HELLER 1 WIN FROM 700**

First-year head coach Rick Heller is a single victory shy of reaching 700 in his 26-plus year coaching career. Heller is 39th among winningest active head coaches in the NCAA.

#### **SUNSHINE STATE SUCCESS**

The Hawkeyes are a perfect 7-0 in the Sunshine State, posting a 4-0 record at the Snowbird Classic on Feb. 21-23 before going 3-0 at the Stetson Invitational on Feb. 28-March 2. Iowa has posted a .329 average and scored 60 runs in seven games in Florida. Six Hawkeyes are hitting at least .345, and Iowa's hurlers have a 3.29 team ERA with 45 strikeouts to 17 walks over 63 innings.

#### **QUICK HITTERS**

• The Hawkeyes have had at least 10 hits in 8-of-13 contests this season. lowa had a string





of five-straight games with double-digit hit totals, including a season-high 17 hits Feb. 22 against Ball State.

- Junior Nick Day is hitting .489 (15-of-32) with six runs and five RBIs during his careerbest eight-game hitting streak. Day has four multi-hit games, including three three-hit games during the stretch.
- Junior Jake Yacinich hit .429 with four runs scored in lowa's three-game series at Kansas State. Yacinich is leading the Big Ten with a .417 batting average. Four lowa players rank among the top-11 in the league in the category.
- Iowa leads the Big Ten and ranks 13th in the NCAA in scoring at 7.8 runs per game. The Hawkeyes lead the conference in nine offensive categories and are second in three more.
- The Hawkeyes are hitting .300 as a team with runners in scoring position. Six lowa players have a .300 average or better and three are above .400 (Trevor Kenyon, .400; Jake Mangler, .421; Tyler Peyton, .500).
- Juniors Dan Potempa and Tyler Peyton have hit safely in eight-straight contests. Potempa had a career-high three hits in the series finale at Kansas State. Peyton has a team-best .440 average to go along with a .560 slugging and .517 on-base percentage.
- Junior Jake Mangler has reached base safely in all 13 games this season, collecting hits in each of the first 10 contests. The second baseman became the fourth Hawkeye to hit a home run when he connected on a solo shot in the series finale at Kansas State. He was 2-for-4 with three RBIs and two runs in the game.

#### **STRONG STARTS**

- The Hawkeye starters have four quality starts in 13 games this season (Tyler Peyton 2, Calvin Mathews 1, Andrew Hedrick 1).
- Friday night starter Calvin Mathews is 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA over his past three starts. He went a career-long 7 1/3 innings, scattering five hits and allowing an unearned run Feb. 28 in a 5-1 victory over Stetson. Mathews had a career-high eight strikeouts at Austin Peay in his first start of the season.
- Junior Andrew Hedrick is 1-1 with a 2.38 ERA in a pair of starts this season. The southpaw pitching 6 2/3 scoreless innings in a 2-0 win over St. Bonaventure, scattering four hits and striking out a career-high seven batters. Hedrick was moved into the starting rotation as lowa's No. 2 starter March 8 at Kansas State.

#### **DAY DOES IT**

After starting the season hitless in his first 10 at-bats, junior Nick Day has hit .469 (15-of-32) over the last eight contests. The Solon, lowa, native is in the midst of a career-best eight-game hitting streak, which includes four multi-hit games.

#### **MORE POP**

Junior Eric Toole put on 10 pounds in the offseason to improve his gap power. The move is paying off as the outfielder has five extra base hits in 13 games this spring. Toole entered the 2014 season with seven extra base hits in his Hawkeye career.

#### TERROR ON THE BASE PATHS

Junior Jake Yacinich has nearly as many steals in 2014 as he had in his first two seasons as a Hawkeye. The Des Moines, lowa, native has a Big Ten-leading 10 steals in 11 chances -- a total that is eighth-best nationally. Yacinich had 13 steals in 16 chances coming into the 2014 season.

#### **TWO-WAY TYLER**

Sophomore Tyler Peyton is thriving as a twoway player for the Hawkeyes. The Grimes, lowa, is the team's starting first baseman when he's not on the mound. Peyton has a team-high .440 batting average, collecting 11 hits in 25 at-bats. As a position player, Peyton has three-straight games with two hits, and as lowa's Sunday starter, the right-hander is 2-0 with a 4.32 ERA over 25 innings.

#### **POWER SURGE**

After hitting two home runs the entire 2013 season, lowa has a Big Ten-leading seven home runs in 13 games this season. The Hawkeyes hit three home runs in taking 2-of-3 games during its opening weekend at Austin Peay before following with three home runs in the perfect 4-0 weekend at the Snowbird Baseball Classic.

#### **BEST START IN 74 YEARS**

With its 9-1 record, lowa got off to its best start since the 1940 season. The Hawkeyes opened that season 10-0-1 before finishing 20-3-1. lowa received votes in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCB-WA) rankings that were released on March 3.

lowa won seven-straight games during the start for the first time since the 2007 season when it was victorious in 12-straight contests.

- lowa has scored 10 or more runs four times this season, including a season-high 16 in a victory over Ball State. The Hawkeyes hit the 10-run barrier three times the entire 2013 season.
- The Hawkeyes have three of the top-seven run scorers -- Jake Yacinich (3rd, 14), Blake Hickman (t4th, 13) and Taylor Zeutenhorst (t7th, 12) -- in the Bia Ten.
- lowa scored 11 and 15 runs in consecutive victories at Austin Peay on the opening weekend of the 2014 season. It was the first time scoring 10 or more runs in two-straight games since April 20 and April 23, 2011, putting 14 and 13 runs on the board in victories over Western Illinois and Michigan.
- Iowa scored 10 runs in the second inning alone of the second game of the Feb. 15 doubleheader at Austin Peay. The Hawkeyes last had a doubledigit inning on April 3, 2011, in a 19-7 victory over Michigan State.
- lowa has outscored its opponents 54-33 over the final four innings.

#### RUNNIN' WILD

Nine different Hawkeyes have swiped at least one base during the 2014 season. Iowa's 28 steals are leading the Big Ten and rank 17th nationally. Junior Jake Yacinich has a league-best 10 steals in 11 attempts, a total that is eighth in the country. Six different players have at least two steals.

The outfielder tied a career-high with four hits, going 4-of-6, which included a two-run home run in lowa's 16-6 win over Ball State. Zeutenhorst is lowa's first Player of the Week honoree since 2012.

#### **3 B1G PLAYERS TO WATCH**

Juniors -- Eric Toole, Sasha Kuebel and Jake Yacinich -- have been named to the Big Ten Watch List.

Toole paced the Hawkeyes with a .337 batting average, 59 hits and 32 runs scored in 2013. He also tied for fifth in the Big Ten with 22 steals. Yacinich batted .286 and tied for the team lead with 24 RBIs, and Kuebel won a pair of games and posted a 5.13 FRA.

Juniors Nick Hibbing, Jake Mangler, Eric Toole and Jake Yacinich have been elected by their teammates as team captains for the 2014 season.

#### **TOOLE EARNS PRESEASON HONOR**

Junior Eric Toole was named a preseason first-team all-conference selection by College Sports Madness. Toole was a second-team All-Big Ten selection in 2013 after leading the Hawkeyes in batting average (.337), runs (32), hits (59), total bases (67 and steals (22).

#### HICKMAN NAMED TO PG'S TOP-100 LIST

Sophomore Blake Hickman has been named to Perfect Game's top-100 list for the sophomore class. The catcher/right-handed pitcher is ranked No. 51 in the nation. He is 1-of-3 Big Ten players in the top-51 and six in the top-100.

#### A NEW ERA

The Rick Heller era began in July, 2013, when Heller was tabbed as the 20th coach in lowa baseball history. The Eldon, lowa, native has been head coach at three institutions -- Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009) and Upper Iowa (1987-99)

-- leading all three schools to NCAA postseason play.
Heller added Scott Brickman and Marty Sutherland to his staff as assistant coaches. Brickman, the pitching coach, spent the past four seasons as head coach at NCAA Division II Belmont Abbey University, while Sutherland, the hitting coach/recruiting coordinator, was an assistant high school coach and hitting/fielding instructor. The three were together on the coaching staff at Northern lowa in 2008 and 2009.

Heller also brought back a pair of UI baseball alums in Jim Magrane and Matt Wooldrick. Magrane will serve as the volunteer assistant coach, while Wooldrik will be the director of baseball operations.

#### **ROSTER BREAKDOWN**

- Of the 34-man roster, 22 are upperclassmen. The Hawkeyes roster features two true freshmen, 10 sophomores, 18 juniors, one redshirt junior and three seniors.
- The Hawkeyes have 17 native lowans -- the most of any state. Illinois is second with 12.

   11 of which are transfers.
