The University of Iowa men's swimming and diving team will host 20th-ranked Minnesota in a Big Ten Conference dual Friday at 5 p.m. (CT) at the Campus Recreation and Wellness Center Natatorium.

DIVING TO NCAA ZONE STANDARDS

Iowa got off to a strong start in its first springboard competition of the season, winning the 1-meter and 3-meter events against Michigan State on Oct. 16. Freshman Will Brenner dove to a win on the 1-meter with a NCAA Zone qualifying standard of 306.15, while junior Andrew Hull won the 3-meter with a NCAA Zone standard of 331.55. Iowa also got a NCAA standard from junior Brandis Heffner off the 1-meter, as he was the runner-up with a score of 301.73.

J. ALLEN IS ON FIRE

Senior Jackson Allen swam to six first place finishes against Michigan State on Oct. 16, including three relays and three individual victories. Allen's 50 free time of 20.32 was a collegiate best and is the top time on the Iowa team this season.

WAIT, HE'S A FRESHMAN?

Jack Smith has hit the ground (or water) running (or sprinting) for the Hawkeyes. The freshman from Stoke-On-Trent, England, posted five first place finishes in Iowa's dual victory over Michigan State. Smith is leading the Hawkeyes in the 100 free (45.34) and 200 free (1:41.82) this season, while also posting the third-fastest 50 free (20.79) time. Smith is also part of the top 400 free and 800 free relays.

HE CAN GO THE DISTANCE

Sophomore Chris Dawson is Iowa's top distance swimmer early in the season. The Colorado native has the top times in the 500 free (4:37.71) and 1,000 free (9:36.75). Dawson claimed an event victory in Iowa's dual win over Michigan State, taking home the top time in the 500 free in 4:38.72.

RETURNING NCAA QUALIFIERS

The Hawkeyes return Roman Trussov, Mike Nelson, Jerzy Twarowski and Addison Boschult from the NCAA Championships this season. Trussov placed 18th in the 200 medley relay (1:26.19), 19th in the 400-medley relay (3:10.03), 24th in the 100 breast (53.17), and 28th in the 200 breast (1:55.04). Nelson served as an alternate in the 100 and 200 breaststroke, Twarowski finished 18th in the 200-medley relay (1:26.19) and 19th in the 400-medley relay (3:10.03), and Boschult placed 10th at the NCAA Championships with a score of 386.50 and was second overall off the platform at NCAA Zone D Diving Championships (387.70).

TRUSSOV: 2-TIME NCAA QUALIFIER

Senior Roman Trussov returns for his senior season as a two-time NCAA qualifier (2013, 2015). The Kazakhstan native holds the school records in the 100 breast (52.85), 200 breast (1:54.57) and as part of the 200 (1:25.53) and 400 (3:08.56) medley relays. Trussov placed 24th overall in the 100 breast and 28th in the 200 breast at the 2015 NCAA Championships.



TOP FLYER RETURNS

Sophomore Jerzy Twarowski is back for his second season as a Hawkeye and his second season competing in the yards distances. Twarowski became the first Iowa butterfly swimmer to break the 47-second mark during his first collegiate season, posting a school-record time of 46.70. He also broke a 22-year old school record (Rafal Szukala) in the 200 fly, finishing with a time of 1:44.00.

A LONG WAYS FROM HOME

This year's team will feature five Hawkeyes from overseas. Jerzy Twarowski comes to the UI program from Krakow, Poland, Roman Trussov from Ust-Kamenogorsk, Kazakhstan, David Ernstsson from Stockholm, Sweden, Kenneth Mende from Chemnitz, Saxony, Germany, and Jack Smith from Stoke-On-Trent, England.

SEASON RECAP

The Hawkeyes, who finished eighth at the 2015 Big Ten Championships return their top performers in 10-of-14 swimming events, 3-of-3 diving events, and four top performers in relays. Among the returnees are 4-of-5 swimmers and diver who competed in the 2015 NCAA Championships.

RECORD BREAKING YEAR

The Hawkeyes broke nine school records in 2015-16. Individually, Grant Betulius (100 backstroke - 45.56) and (200 backstroke - 1:42.19), Roman Trussov (100 breaststroke - 52.85) and (200 breaststroke - 1:54.57), Jerry Twarowski (100 butterfly - 46.70) and (200 butterfly - 1:44.00) and Addison Boschult (platform diving 409.20) all broke school records in their respective events. 200 medley relay of Betulius, Trussov, Twarowski, and Halsmer with the time of 1:25.53 and 400 medley relay of Betulius, Trussov, Twarowski, and Halsmer with the time of 3:08.56).

CAMPUS RECREATION AND WELLNESS CENTER

Ground was broken for the Campus Recreation and Wellness Center in October 2007. The facility opened in August 2010 and is home for the Hawkeyes. It is located at the corner of Burlington and Madison streets and cost approximately \$69 million. The facility includes a 50-meter competition pool, a separate diving well, a leisure pool with lap lanes and 24,000 square feet of fitness space.

IOWA SWIMMING AND DIVING TRADITION

Iowa was one of the first schools in the nation to compete on a collegiate level and competed at the first NCAA Championship. From 1937 to 1960, Iowa placed in the NCAA top 10 18 times, crowning nine NCAA and 22 Big Ten champions.

ON THE HORIZON

The Hawkeyes return to the pool Nov. 6, heading to West Lafayette, Indiana, for a road dual at Purdue.
