#### **SCOUTING THE RAMS**

Rhode Island is a member of the Atlantic 10 conference and brings a 2-1 mark into this weekend's action. The Rams are led by 32nd year head coach Bob Schneck, associate head coach Steve Santonastaso, and assistant Caitlyn Welsh. The roster consists of three seniors, three juniors, three sophomores, and four freshmen. Franki Darnold paces the Rams with 34 kills, while Catie Steffen has a team-high 4.00 kills per set average. Callan Kinnan has a team-most 100 assists (11.11 per set), and Cate Seman has 33 digs for a team high 3.30 digs per set. Layne Self leads the squad in blocks with nine for a 1.29 block per set average. On the season Rhode Island is hitting .242 and averages 14.45 kills per set.

#### A LOOK AT THE EAGLES

Mid-American Conference member Eastern Michigan is an even 2-2 on the season heading into the weekend tournament. The Eagle roster consists of two seniors, three juniors, seven sophomores, and two freshmen. Head coach Kim Barrington is in her 18th season at the helm and is assisted by John Kessenich and Nicasio Paquiz, Jr. Paige Roback has a team high 59 kills (3.28 per set) followed by Stacey Perinar with 58 kills (3.22 per set). Corynne Smith paces the team with 83 digs (4.61 per set), Alyssa Davis has a team-most 134 assists (7.44 per set), and Kelsey Jones has a team high 22 blocks (1.22 per set). The team is hitting .179 on the season and averages 12.8 kills per set.

#### **CHECKING ON THE CRUSADERS**

Valpo Popcorn Classic host Valparaiso, a Horizon League member, brings a perfect 4-0 mark into tournament play. The Crusaders are led by 14th year head coach Karen Avery and her assistant Craig Cromwell. The roster is made up of five seniors, three juniors, two sophomores, and seven freshmen. Sarah Dooms has a team high 31 kills (3.10 per set), while Kelsey Berrington leads the squad in assists with 72 (5.14 per set) and service aces with seven (0.50 per set). Morganne Langoria paces the team in digs with 38 (3.17 per set), and Kelsey Victor and Ellen Vanden Berg have a team-most 11 blocks (0.92 per set) apiece. The Crusaders have a .270 hitting percentage thus far and average 12.4 kills per set.

### HAWKEYE SCHEDULE SUMMARY

lowa opens the 2013 season on the road with two weekend tournaments, the Chanticleer Invitational in Conway, S.C. and the Valparaiso Tournament in Valparaiso, Ind., before returning home to host the annual Hawkeye Challenge in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, Sept. 13-14. Following a match at Milwaukee and a match against Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk series rival Iowa State at home (Sept. 21), the Hawkeyes open Big Ten Conference play. Iowa will face each member of the Big Ten twice in 2013 with the exception of Ohio State and Penn State. The Hawkeyes will play 32 matches in the regular season with 15 at home on Mediacom Court in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

### YEAGER'S HARDWARE

Senior libero Bethany Yeager earned the first Big Ten weekly honor of her career when she was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week on Monday, Sept. 2. She helped the Hawkeyes accomplish a 3-0 mark and Chanticleer Invitational championship opening weekend. Yeager paced the team in digs in each match tallying 26 against Wofford, 30 against Youngstown State, and 23 against Coastal Carolina. Her 79 digs and 5.64 digs per set average top the Big Ten following week one. Yeager's award marks Iowa's first Defensive Player of the Week honor since Christina Meister received the nod in 2009.

#### **MOST VALUABLE**

Junior middle Alessandra Dietz was the lone Hawkeye named to the all-tournament team at the Chanticleer Invitational. For her efforts on the court, she was named most valuable player of the tournament. Dietz posted a career-high in kills in the first two matches of the 2013 season, including a 14 kill performance against Wofford and a 19 kill effort against Youngstown State. She hit a dominating .500 in the opener and .457 in match two. She wrapped the weekend with an eight kill performance against Coastal Carolina. After week one of play, Dietz owns a .397 attack percentage and 2.93 kills per set.

#### LIVE ACTION ON BTN

Seven Iowa volleyball regular season contests will be available via live coverage during the 2013 season. The Hawkeyes' matches against Wisconsin on Oct. 2 and at Nebraska on Oct. 23 will be shown on the Big Ten Network, while five other contests will be streamed on **BTN.** com.



# **Head Coach Sharon Dingman**



Sharon Dingman was named the eighth coach in the history of University of Iowa volleyball March 21, 2008. In five seasons at the helm of the volleyball program, she has imposed a winning attitude.

The Hawkeyes faced another challenging slate in 2012, facing 16 eventual NCAA tournament teams, after taking on 18 in 2011. Dingman led a young lowa team — with only one senior — to eight non-conference victories. Five Hawkeyes garnered all-tournament honors. She led lowa to conference wins at Indiana on Oct. 5 (3-1) and at 12th-ranked Purdue on Oct. 6 (3-0). The victory in West Lafayette, Ind., marked lowa's first win at Purdue and first sweep of the Boilermakers since Nov. 10, 2000.

It also marked the fourth win over a ranked foe for Dingman, and her first victory over a ranked team on the road. No. 12 Purdue is the highest-ranked team the Hawkeyes have defeated during her tenure and the program's highest since defeating No. 11 Michigan at home in 2007 (Sept. 28). It also marked the first time lowa won two-straight league contests since 2008 and consecutive league road matches since 2005. Purdue was one of seven Big Ten teams selected to the NCAA Tournament. Six league foes advanced to the Sweet 16 and two (Michigan, Penn State) represented the conference in the NCAA Final Four.

Dingman coached sophomore Alex Lovell to Big Ten Player of the Week honors on Oct. 8 for her efforts in the back-to-back league road victories. It marked lowa's first Player of the Week honor since Sept. 18, 2006, when Melanie Meister received the recognition. It was also the Hawkeyes' first weekly honor since Christina Meister was tabbed Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 7, 2009. The Leonard, Mich., native equaled junior Rachael Bedell with a team-best 37 kills in the two wins.

Lovell finished the year with a team-high 382 kills, the most in a single season since Catherine Smale posted 441 in 2005. Junior Bethany Yeager totaled a career-best 533 digs in 2012 — the most in a season since 2006, when Emily Hiza registered 545. Yeager became the 14th Hawkeye in program history to surpass 1,000 career digs in lowa's season-opening sweep of Chicago State. She is fifth in program history with 1,522 career digs, moving up nine spots on the all-time list during the season.

In 2011, the Hawkeyes used their second of consecutive nationally recognized recruiting classes to continue building a program that will, in time, ascend up the Big Ten standings. Four Hawkeye freshmen combined to start 59 matches, and those four freshmen combined with four sophomores to total 62-percent of lowa's starting lineup. The Hawkeyes' youth flourished in the nonconference season, racing to a 10-3 record and a pair of tournament championships.

In 2010, lowa's four freshmen combined for 67 starts. The Hawkeyes started their freshman quartet four times, more than any other Big Ten school. lowa kicked off the season with consecutive tournament championships and made program history by starting the season 3-0 for the second consecutive year. lowa knocked off No. 16 Michigan in Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Nov. 12, marking the third time in as many seasons Dingman and the Hawkeyes defeated a top 25 opponent.

In 2009, Dingman helped lowa match the best start in program history by guiding the Hawkeyes to a 6-0 start. Iowa eventually became the first team in school history to start the season 7-0 on the road. The Hawkeyes captured five conference wins in 2009, raising Dingman's two-year Big Ten win total to 11, the highest two-year stretch for an Iowa volleyball team since 2000-01.

Dingman led the Hawkeyes to their most successful campaign in recent memory in her first season at the helm. lowa's 14 wins in 2008 were tied for the most since 2000, and its six conference victories are the most since 2000. Dingman guided the Hawkeyes to a ninth place finish in the competitive Big Ten Conference, which was the highest finish for a Hawkeye squad since 2000.

Dingman's team set or snapped many streaks in a successful first season. Iowa won seven-straight matches, tying the fourth-longest winning streak in school history. The Hawkeyes also swept every opponent during the winning streak and won 15-straight sets. That was the longest set-winning streak since 1990. Iowa opened the conference season with wins over No. 18 Wisconsin and Northwestern, marking only the fifth time in school history that a Hawkeye team started 2-0 in Big Ten play. The Hawkeyes also had a winning record inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena for the first time since 1998.

The Hawkeyes also snapped conference losing streaks in Dingman's first season. lowa defeated Ohio State for the first time in 39 tries, dating back to 1988. That win also broke an 18-match losing skid on the road in Big Ten play. lowa's upset win over No. 18 Wisconsin snapped a 26-match losing streak against the Badgers, which dated back to 1994.

Dingman set a personal milestone at Northwestern on Nov. 14 when she recorded her 350th career win in Iowa's five-set victory. Her career record stands at 391-316 in 22 seasons as a head coach. Iowa's match at Michigan State on Nov. 2, 2012, marked Dingman's 700th as a head coach.

#### **BIG TEN = NATIONAL POWER**

After week one of regular season action, the Big Ten added a team to the AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Poll released on Sept. 2. Illinois, who was previously not ranked, was the No. 18 team on the list, while Penn State moved from the second spot to its first No. 1 ranking of the season. Remaining in the top 25 included No. 4 Minnesota, No. 7 Michigan, No. 13 Nebraska, No. 20 Michigan State, No. 22 Purdue, and No. 23 Ohio State.

#### **NEW FACES**

A pair of Hawkeye freshmen made an immediate impact on opening weekend. Setter Alyssa Klostermann appeared in every set for lowa, contributing 60 assists (4.29 per set) and notching a team-most four service aces (0.29 per set average). She also posted 33 digs for a 2.36 digs per set average. Outside hitter Lauren Brobst played in 12 sets for the Hawkeyes. Her 23 kill performance in the opening win against Wofford paced the team and she hit .436 in the match.

#### REUNITED

Hawkeye juniors Alessandra Dietz and Alex Lovell were high school teammates (2007-10) at Marian High School in Bloomfield Hills, Mich. The pair led Marian to three division championships from 2008-10 and a pair of state titles in 2009 and 2010. Dietz and Lovell played club volleyball with fellow Hawkeye, junior Erin Leppek. The trio led the 17 team to a national title at the 2010 USA Volleyball National Championships and a fifth place finish at the AAU National Championships.

#### **GIANT SLAYERS**

The Hawkeyes have defeated a ranked team in four of Dingman's five seasons. Iowa will have plenty of opportunities to continue that trend, as eight of its 2013 opponents appear in the AVCA top 25 preseason poll. Iowa's top 25 victories since 2008 include: vs. No. 18 Wisconsin (3-0, 2008); vs. No. 18 Michigan State (3-0, 2009); vs. No. 16 Michigan (3-1, 2010); at No. 12 Purdue (3-0, 2012).
