IOWA WOMEN'S ROWING

HAWKEYES ROW AT 40th HEAD OF THE CHARLES

BOSTON, MA – The University of Iowa women's rowing team competed in the 40th annual Head of the Charles this weekend. The Varsity 8 team rallied to finish sixth in Event 1F on Saturday. The 2nd Varsity 8 finished 20th in event 24F on Sunday. Both events were in the Women's Club Eights Division.

The Varsity 8 team consisted of Lori Rehel, Michelle Trannel, Lydia McGee, Jessie McBride, Katie Ramundt, Emily Wagstrom, Carolyn O'Meara, Emily Vail, and Nikki **Stob.** They recorded a time of 13:35.349. However, due to a misunderstanding on which members of the team where able to compete, the team was disqualified. Members of the team were not able to compete because of a rule that states a top five team cannot field the same members two years in a row. Two members of the Varsity 8 team placed in the top five at last year's race.

The 2nd Varsity 8 team consisted of Vanessa Sheehan, Liz Bauer, Kateri Nelis, Jennifer Stachera, Lesley Weston, Anna Battoe, Sophie Nielsen, Jessie Reid, and Megan **Conner.** They recorded a time of 12:59.002 and placed 20th out of a field of 42.
