This Week: The lowa women's volleyball team (2-1) will travel to Ames, IA, to compete in the Cyclone Challenge Friday and Saturday. Iowa will face host Iowa State (3-0) on Friday at 7 p.m. The Hawkeyes will then face Kentucky (2-1) at 9 a.m. and Western Illinois (0-3) at 2 p.m. on Saturday. All matches will take place at Hilton Coliseum. Admission is \$6 for adults and \$4 for students.

The Cyclones: Iowa State is coming off a tournament title, winning its own Heritage Inn Classic. The Cyclones defeated Creighton (3-1), McNeese State (3-1) and Auburn (3-0). Junior Brittany Dalager leads the Cyclone offense, averaging 4.27 digs per game. She also leads the team in blocks (4.45). Senior setter Lindsey Chapman is averaging 11.82 assists and 3.45 digs. Sophomores Ashlie McWee and Katie Kruenegel are both averaging one block per game. The Cyclone Challenge will mark the second tournament hosted by Iowa State this season.

lowa-lowa State Series: lowa leads the series over lowa State, 21-15. In meetings at Ames, the series is tied, 5-5. lowa won the last meeting between the two teams, 3-0, in Ames (9/6/97).

The Wildcats: Kentucky won two-of-three matches last weekend at the Wake Forest Deamon Deacon Invitational. The Wildcats lost to Wake Forest (3-0) and defeated Southern Methodist (3-2) and Tennessee Tech (3-1). Seniors Sissy Canfield and Liz McCaslin each earned all-tournament honors. Canfield is averaging 3.33 kills and leads the team with .75 blocks per game. McCaslin is averaging 2.08 kills and two digs per game. Junior Sarah Spinner leads the team with 3.5 kills and .83 service aces per game. Freshman Kirby Newhouse is averaging four digs. Sophomore setter Leigh Marcum is averaging 10.92 assists.

Iowa-Kentucky Series: Iowa leads the series over Kentucky, 2-0. Both matches

took place in Iowa City. In their last meeting, the Hawkeyes defeated the Wildcats, 3-0 (9/6/97).

The Westerwinds: Western Illinois is 0-3 after losing to Eastern Illinois (1-3), Evansville (2-3) and Drake (2-3) at the Eastern Illinois Tournament. Junior Kali Landis leads the team with four kills per game. Sophomore Jenna Yurs is averaging 1.07 blocks. Freshman Jennifer Alexander is averaging 3.79 digs. Freshman setter Lisa Suellentrop is averaging nine assists.

Iowa-Western Illinois Series: Iowa leads the series over Western Illinois, 17-2. In matches played at neutral sites, the Hawkeyes lead, 3-1. In its last meeting, Iowa defeated Western Illinois, 3-0, at the Western Illinois Tournament in Macomb (9/14/02).

Hawkeyes Take Two of Three at Saluki/ Best Inns Invite: lowa began its 2003 campaign with a loss to Denver (2-3) and wins over Austin Peay (3-1) and host Southern Illinois at the Saluki/Best Inns Invite. Against Denver, Iowa took the first game, 31-29. Denver rallied winning games two (30-25) and three (30-26). The Hawkeyes fought back with a 31-29 victory in game four, but their efforts came up short. Iowa could only muster six points in the 15-6 game five loss, giving the Pioneers the victory. The Hawkeyes rallied back with a win over Austin Peay. After losing the first game (31-29), lowa bounced back to win the final three games (30-23, 30-25, 32-30) to claim victory. Iowa had its back against the wall against host Southern Illinois. The Hawkeyes fell behind 2-0 after losses in the first two games (30-27, 30-14). After intermission, lowa rallied back with wins in the third and fourth games (30-28, 30-24) to force a fifth game. The Hawkeyes went on to take the game (15-9) and the match.

All-TourneyTeam:Senior Jitka Stehnova and freshman Tiana Costanzo received all-tournament team honors at the Saluki/Best Inns Invite. The honor marks the third all-tournament selection for Stehnova and

the first of Costanzo's collegiate career. Last season Stehnova received all-tournament honors are the UIC Invitational and the Western Illinois Tournament.

Stehnova Leads the Pack: Jitka Stehnova posted three double-doubles in lowa's first three matches. Against Austin Peay, Stehnova tied a career high with seven kills and recorded a career-high 23 digs. She currently leads the team with a .385 hitting percentage (19-4-39) and 11.5 assists.

Simpson Steps Up: Junior Laura Simpson recorded double figures in kills in Iowa's first three contests. Simpson posted a career-best 21 kills in Iowa's win over Austin Peay. She currently leads the team with 3.79 kills per game.

Freshmen Flourish: Freshmen Tiana Costanzo and April Mech made an immediate impact for the Hawkeyes at the Saluki/Best Inns Invite. Costanzo recorded double figures in digs in all three matches and recorded 12 kills and three service aces against Austin Peay, helping earn her all-tournament team honors. Mech recorded a double-double in her first collegiate match against Denver with 12 kills and 12 digs.

Agba Records Double-Doubles: Sophomore Echaka Agba recorded her first career double-double with 14 kills and 12 digs against Denver. She registered 11 kills and 11 digs against Southern Illinois for her second career double-double.

Kavadas Climbs Into Rankings: With 46 digs at the Saluki/Best Inns Invite, junior **Pam Kavadas** has climbed to 22nd in Iowa's all-time digs with 623. Kavadas needs only 24 digs to move to 20th.

Marathon Matches: The Hawkeyes played two five-game matches at the Saluki/Best Inns Invite. Iowa only played one five-game match last season (at Purdue 11/1/02). Iowa is 1-1 in five-game matches this season.

In Big Ten Rankings: The Hawkeyes lead the conference with 19.43 digs per game. Iowa is second in the Big Ten with a 2.46 blocks per game average. Tiana Costanzo ranks fourth, averaging 3.79 digs. Jitka Stehnova is fifth, averaging 3.71 digs. Senior Abby Tjaden is averaging one block, ranking ninth.

In Iowa Rankings: Jitka Stehnova is currently fifth in Iowa's all-time assists with

1,287. **Carolyn Giese** is 24th in all-time attack percentage at .187 (293-140-817).

International Experience: Assistant Coach Chris Gonzalez served as an assistant coach for the USA women's national team that won the bronze medal match of the Pan American Games. Tiana Costanzo competed for the USA youth squad that spent the summer competing in Montreal. Laura Simpson competed for the Australian national team against Japan and participated in the Thang Long championship against Vietnam, Malaysia, Singapore, Kazakhstan and Thailand.

Home Grown Hawkeyes: The lowa roster features five Hawkeyes from the state of lowa. Abby Tjaden is from Eldora, Carolyn Giese Dubuque, Lastascia Granger Waterloo and April Mech and Betsy Cordt Davenport.

The Long Beach State Connection: Head Coach Rita Buck-Crockett and assistant coaches Chris Gonzalez and Melissa Ohta all have ties to the Long Beach State program. Buck-Crockett served as an assistant coach from 1986-88. Gonzalez served as the 49ers' assistant coach from 1997-2002 and was part of three final four teams, including the 1998 national champion squad that went undefeated (36-0). Ohta was a competitor on each of the final four teams as one of the nation's top defensive specialists from 1997-2000.



Head Coach Rita Buck-Crockett

Buck-Crockett is in her sixth season as head coach. She has compiled an overall record of 46-100 (.315) and a Big Ten record of 24-76

(.240). Buck-Crockett has spent the past four summers as a member of the USA Volleyball High Performance staff. She was a member of the 1980 and 1984 USA Olympic teams. Buck-Crockett has played and coached at the international level in Japan, Italy and Switzerland. In the spring of 1999, she was inducted into the San Antonio Sports Hall of Fame.
