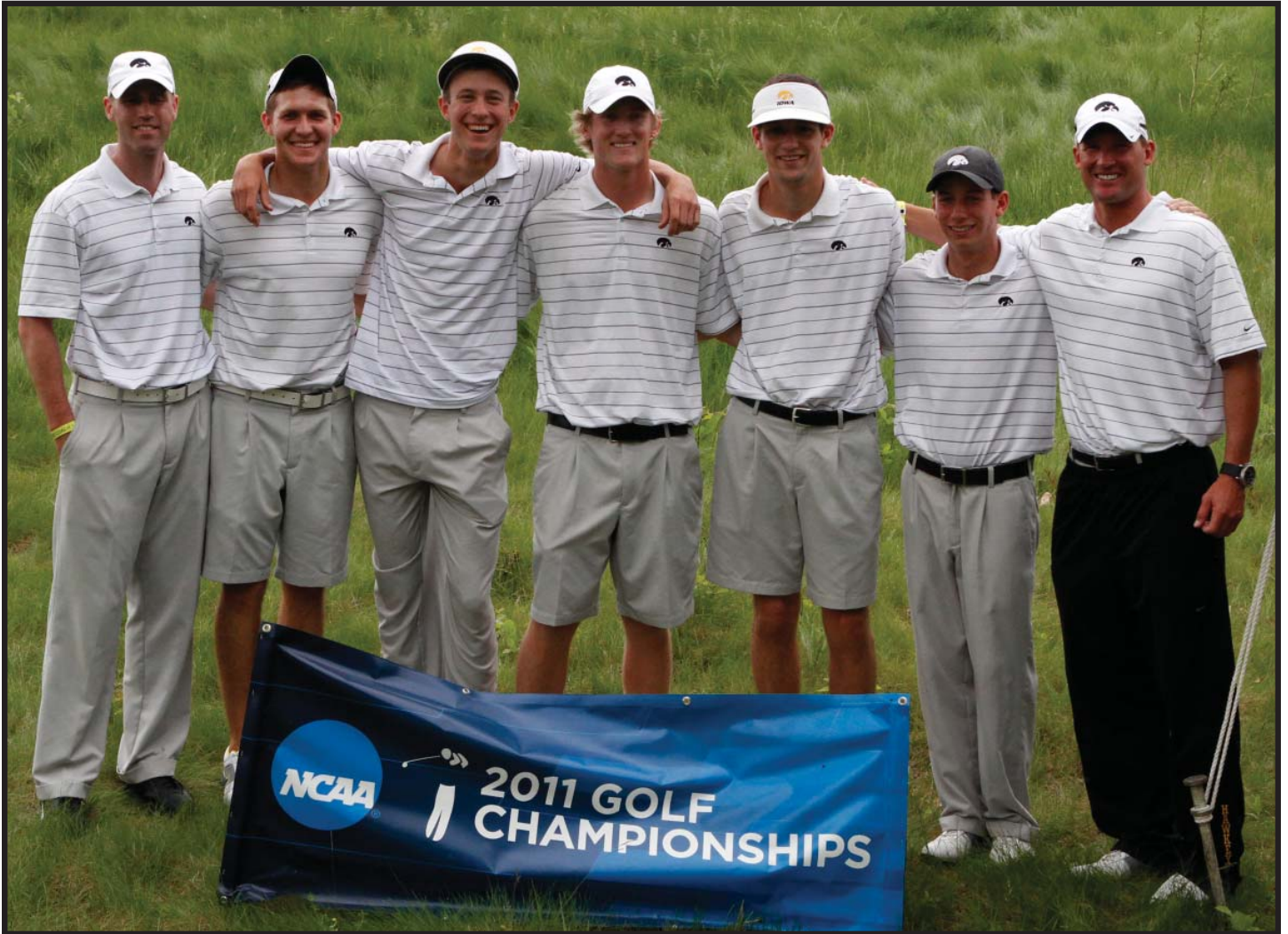

THIS WEEK -- The University of Iowa men's golf team travels to Stillwater, Okla., for the 2011 NCAA Men's Golf Championships May 31-June 5. Action will consist of 54 holes of stroke play competition, followed by three rounds of match play. The Championships will be held on Oklahoma State's Karsten Creek Golf Course. Fans can follow the action live at golfstatresults.com or check out the tournament central page at ncaa.com.

THE COURSE -- Karsten Creek plays to 7,416 yards of bent-grass greens and zoysia fairways cut into aged oak trees and black jacks. The par 72, which opened in 1994, was designed by Tom Fazio as a home course for the OSU Cowboys. It received honors as the Best New Public Course in the Nation soon after its opening and has continued to climb top 100 lists across the country. Most recently, Karsten Creek has been ranked as the best college course in the nation by *Travel & Leisure Golf* magazine.

CHAMPIONSHIP STRUCTURE -- An individual champion will be determined after 54-holes of stroke play. The field will then be cut to the low eight teams for a match play bracket to decide the team champion. Teams will play 18 holes each day in both stroke play and match play action.

THE COMPETITION -- The 13th-seeded Hawkeyes will compete among the top 30 teams left in Division I college golf. Competition begins Tuesday, May 31 at 7 a.m. (CT), but Iowa will wait until 2 p.m. to tee off of the 10th hole with 14th seed Duke and 15th seed Michigan. Teams will be re-paired based on tournament scores for Wednesday and Thursday, with tee times beginning at 7 a.m. both days.

BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS -- Iowa finished third at the 2011 Big Ten Championships. With three individuals in the top 20 (Brant, India and Hopfinger), the Hawkeyes finished with a four-round total of 1181 (+29). Illinois won the championship with an 1160 (+8) while Northwestern took home second with an 1179 (+27). Coupled with Iowa's second place finish at last year's Big Ten Championships, 2011 marks the best back-to-back finishes at the conference championships in school history. Seniors Vince India and Brad Hopfinger were both named first team all-Big Ten, while junior Chris Brant was a second team all-Big Ten selection. The last time Iowa had three players earn all-Big Ten honors was in 1992.

VINCE INDIA -- India, a native of Deerfield, Ill., was named Big Ten Player of the Year for men's golf after putting together the best individual season in Hawkeye history. India became just the second golfer in school history to win the prestigious Les Bolstad Trophy, awarded by the Big Ten Conference at the end of the season to the male golfer who records the lowest stroke average during the season (fall and spring). India's 71.08 stroke average is the ninth-lowest in the trophy's history, dating back to 1974.

India was also named the University of Iowa's Male Athlete of the Year and is in the running for the Big Ten Male Athlete of the Year for all sports. He has been individually ranked as high as third by Golfstat and is currently No. 15 (17th by Golfweek).

2011 NCAA CENTRAL REGIONAL -- The Hawkeyes tied for fourth at the Indiana-hosted NCAA Central Regional in Zionsville, Ind., May 19-21. The Black and Gold never fell out of the top five as it posted a 54-hole total of 865 (+13), the 11th-lowest three round total in program history. In their respective finishes, Michigan, Illinois, Alabama, Iowa and Tennessee advanced out of the Central Regional.

Juniors Chris Brant and Barrett Kelpin led the Hawkeyes with top 20 finishes. Brant tied for seventh with a tournament total of three-under par 210. Kelpin posted a 217 (+4) to tie for 20th.

NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY -- This season marks the third-consecutive year that Iowa has been invited to NCAA Regional competition. The Hawkeyes advanced to the NCAA Championships in 2009, but missed the top five by a single stroke in 2010. After a fifth-place finish in the 2009 NCAA Central Regional, Iowa finished 17th at the NCAA Championships. India, a sophomore at the time, led the way as he tied for 37th with a three round total of 219 (+6). This year's trip to the NCAA Championships marks not only Iowa's second in three years, but the seventh appearance in school history.

“This is what we expect to do. We expect to go to NCAA Regionals. It's always going to be a fight. It was until the last hole this year and our guys came out on top. The NCAA's will be 30 of the best teams in the country and we belong.”

Mark Hankins **Fourth Year at Iowa** **Iowa State** **University (1993)**

Mark Hankins is in his fourth season as head men's golf coach at the University of Iowa. Hankins took over in 2007 after spending seven years as the head coach at Michigan State University.

Under Hankins' direction, the Hawkeyes finished the 2010 season with the highest national ranking in school history. Ranked 36th among all NCAA Division I teams, Iowa earned its best Big Ten finish (second) since 1992 and produced a NCAA Regional berth for the second-consecutive year. Additionally, the Hawkeyes picked up their second tournament title in as many seasons with a win at the 2010 TaylorMade-adidas Hawkeye Invitational.

The Hawkeyes' climb in national rankings began in 2009 under Hankins. Iowa jumped from 155th to 54th during the season as it picked up its first tournament title since 2004 by winning the 2008 Landfall Tradition in Wilmington, NC. Furthermore, Hankins coached the Black and Gold to a fifth place finish at the 2009 Southeast Regionals and a 17th place finish at the NCAA Championships in Toledo, OH; marking the first time the Hawkeyes have qualified for the championships since 1995.

While at Michigan State, Hankins led the Spartans to 10 tournament titles, including two Big Ten Championships (2005 and 2007). In addition, he was voted Big Ten Coach of the Year twice by his peers (2005 and 2007). Hankins also guided Michigan State to five NCAA appearances in his seven years, including a 23rd place finish in the 2007 NCAA Division I National Championship.

Hankins' resume at Michigan State also includes 64 top-10 finishes, national rankings during three different seasons, including the fall 2004 season when his Spartan team was ranked seventh out of 290 Division I men's golf programs, 27 first team academic all-Big Ten selections, two academic All-Americans, two All-Americans, one Big Ten Freshman of the Year, and the first Big Ten Conference medalist in Michigan State men's golf history.

In his first two seasons (1999-2001) at Michigan State, the Green and White posted 19 top-10 finishes out of 22 tournaments. In 2002, Hankins guided the Spartans to its first

trip to the NCAA Regionals since 1994 and established a ranking of 27th in the country. The 2003-04 campaign saw Michigan State post 11 top-10 finishes, including six in the top five, and advance to the NCAA Regionals for the second straight year. The 2004-05 season was an impressive one for the Spartans, as they placed in the top five in nine of 11 tournaments, including capturing the Big Ten championship. Hankins guided the Spartans to 10 top-five finishes his final two seasons at Michigan State (2005-07), including winning three tournament titles (2007 Boilermaker Invitational, 2007 Fossum Invitational and 2007 Big Ten Tournament).

Hankins' coaching resume also includes a two-year stint as head coach at the University of Texas at Arlington. There, Hankins led the Mavericks to a top-25 ranking in 1998 and 1999 and led them to eight Division I collegiate tournament titles in two seasons, the most in Division I golf during that time. In addition, the Mavericks qualified for two-straight NCAA regional berths, one NCAA national qualifier, and captured the Southland Conference Championship in 1999.

Hankins worked a total of three years as an assistant coach for men and women, and associate head coach of the men's golf program at his alma mater, Iowa State University. From 1995-1997 he worked as associate head coach for the Cyclones. During this time, Iowa State advanced to two NCAA regional berths and won three tournament titles. In his final season at Iowa State, the Cyclones broke every existing team record, including individual scoring average, tournament wins and NCAA Regional finish.

His coaching experience also includes serving as head golf coach for the United States team that participated in the 2007 World University Games in Bangkok, Thailand.

In addition to coaching, Hankins has served as a professional at numerous country clubs and camps, including Ames Golf and Country Club, Cyclone Country Golf Camp, Cyclone Golf Academy, Des Moines Golf and Country Club and Iowa PGA Golf Academy. He is currently second vice president of the Golf Coaches Association of America.

During his playing career, Hankins earned all-Big Eight Conference honors his senior season at Iowa State (1993). His personal best round of 66 set a Cyclone individual scoring record. A three-time academic all-Big Eight honoree (1988, 1991 and 1993), Hankins was also named an academic all-American as a senior. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology in 1993 and a master's degree in business administration in 1997 from Iowa State.

In addition to collegiate competition, Hankins has played on the Nike Tour, Golden State Tour, Tommy Armour Tour and participated in PGA Tour Qualifying.

Hankins said his expectations for the student-athletes who will compete for the UI under his direction will be to attain success both on the golf course and in the classroom.

"It's my responsibility to provide the platform for every member of our men's golf program to succeed athletically and academically. I want them to have a first-class experience and to graduate with a sense of pride about themselves and our university," he said.

Hankins is a native of Mt. Pleasant, Iowa.

"I am extremely excited by the support and enthusiasm the administration, alumni, and friends of the golf program have shown throughout my first four years at Iowa. Gary (Barta) has clearly made a commitment to winning championships in every sport, including men's golf, at the University of Iowa."

Tyler Stith is in his third season as assistant men's golf coach at the University of Iowa.

The Hawkeyes have qualified for NCAA Regional action every year since Stith's arrival, with two NCAA Championship berths. Stith was also one of eight finalists for the 2011 Jan Strickland Award presented by TaylorMade-adidas Golf, as selected by the Golf Coaches Association of America. The Strickland Award is presented to the NCAA Division I, II, III, NAIA or NJCAA assistant coach that, among other things, has excelled in working with their student-athletes both on the course and in the classroom.

He was a four-year letterwinner in golf at Iowa from 1999 to 2002. In 2002, Stith tied for 24th at the Big Ten Championships.

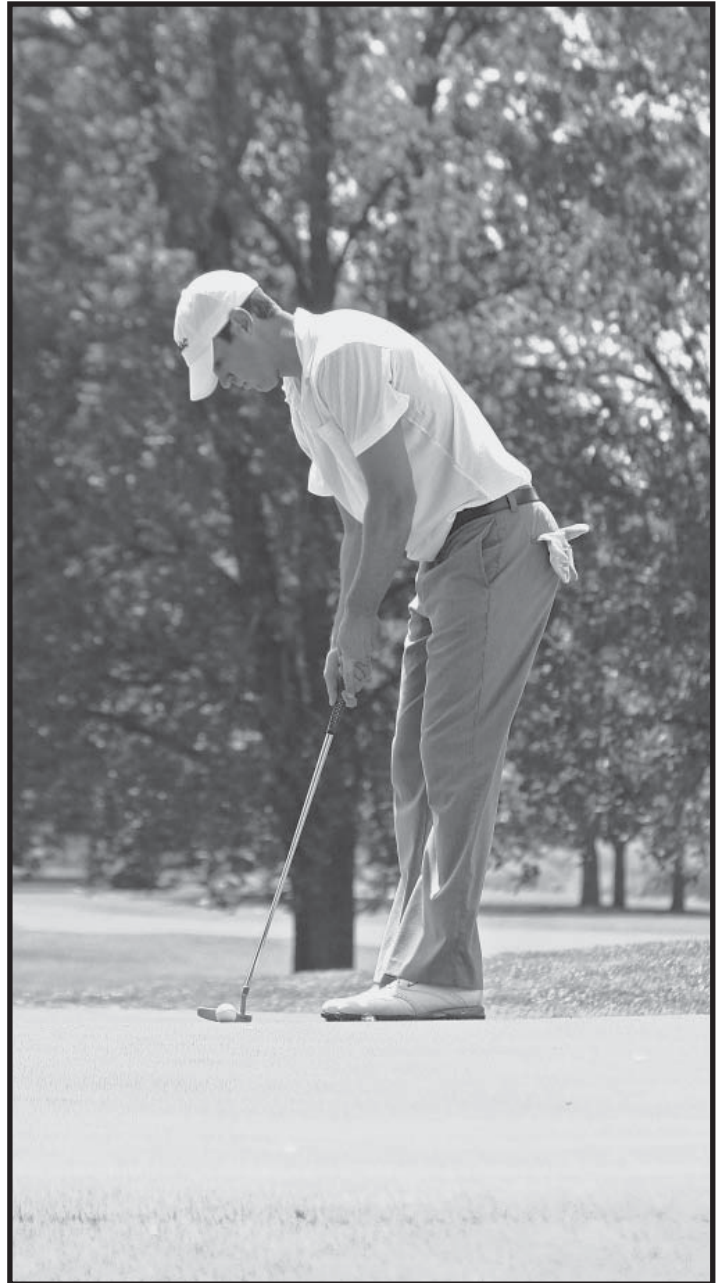
Stith graduated from the University of Iowa in 2002 with a business administration degree. He is a native of Mount Pleasant, IA.

Stith really enjoyed his time as a student-athlete at the University of Iowa.

"I love it here," Stith said. "It was a dream of mine to play Division I golf. Growing up a Hawkeye fan, not far away in Mt. Pleasant, made it awesome playing for Iowa. My experience here was great."

After graduating from Iowa, Stith moved to Florida to pursue professional golf opportunities. He is happy to now be back in Iowa.

"This is a great opportunity," said Stith. "I plan to work on my PGA resume and would like to someday become a head coach or teaching professional. 2011 Spring – Big Ten Player of the Year... University of Iowa Male Athlete of the Year... Winner of Les Bolstad Trophy for lowest combined season stroke average in the Big Ten (71.08)... First team All-Big Ten selection... became third golfer in program history to win three tournaments in a season... co-Big Ten Golfer of the Week after winning the Hawkeye-TaylorMade Invitational with a 142 (-2)... Big Ten Golfer of the Week after second place finish at LSU Collegiate Invitational...

combined season scoring average of 71.38 currently stands as the lowest in school history... currently owns a spring season stroke average of 72.47.

2010 Fall – Finished top-10 in all five events, earning medalist honors twice... won the Baylor Intercollegiate, firing back-to-back 66's for a 132 (-10), the lowest 36-hole total in program history... shared medalist honors at Golfweek Conference Challenge, carding a 206 (-10), tying the lowest 54-hole score in school history... led the Hawkeyes in three of five events... finished season with a team-leading scoring average of 70.21

2010 Summer - Won Illinois State Amateur by 7 strokes... placed second at CDGA Amateur... Qualified for U.S. Amateur at Cantigny Golf Course... finished 44th at Western Amateur.

2010 Spring - One of four Hawkeyes to compete in all seven events... finished match-play competition with a 7-2 record... finished sixth at Hawkeye Invite, posting a total of 217 (+1)... named 2010 All-America Scholar... finished season with scoring average of 73.4... his combined 2009-10 season scoring average of 73.1 is the fourth-lowest average in program history.

2009 Fall - One of four Hawkeyes to compete in all five events... compiled four top-25 finishes, including three top-10 finishes... fired back-to-back rounds of 70, his season-low, at Golden Gopher Invitational where he led the Hawkeyes and tied for fourth... led the Hawkeyes in three tournaments... finished tied for tenth at Fighting Irish Classic (218) and Baylor Intercollegiate (214)... finished season with a scoring average of 72.8.

2009 Spring - Competed in all seven events... three top-25 finishes... led Hawkeyes in three tournaments... fourth at Boilermaker Invite where he fired season-low score of 68... tied for 11th at Kepler Invite... led Hawkeyes at NCAA Championships... academic all-Big Ten selection... finished season with team-leading scoring average of 73.2.

2008 Fall - One of two Hawkeyes to play in every fall event... three top-20 finishes... recorded season low score of 64 at VCU Shootout... tied for second at Landfall Tradition with a score of 219 (+3)... finished fall with a scoring average of 73.1.

2008 Spring - Competed in all four tournaments... was one of four Hawkeyes to play in every spring event... finished sixth at Boilermaker Invitational with a three-round score of 211... posted career-low round of 68 during first round... finished seventh to lead Iowa at the Big Ten Championships with a four-round score of 294... second among Hawkeye golfers with a spring scoring average of 74.4.

2007 Fall - Competed in three events, most of any Hawkeye freshmen... tied for eighth place at Fighting Irish Golf Classic, his first ever collegiate event... carded a 54-hole score of 215 and a season-low round of 69... finished fall season with a scoring average of 74.3.

High School - Four-year MVP and four-time all-conference honoree... owns or shares every school individual golf record... posted three top-three finishes on the International Junior Golf Tour from 2004-05... finished the season 63rd in the AJGA rankings, making him the highest nationally-ranked player to choose Iowa in the last 10 years... was the youngest to ever qualify for the Illinois PGA Open in 2005 at 16 years old and 2 months.

2011 Spring – First team All-Big Ten selection... one of four Hawkeyes to compete in all seven events... tied for 10th at Hawkeye-TaylorMade Invitational with a mark of 148 (+4)... posted a 219 (+6) at Robert Kepler Invitational to tie for 14th... current stroke average of 74.20... current fall and spring combined stroke average of 72.69 stands as

fourth-lowest in program history.

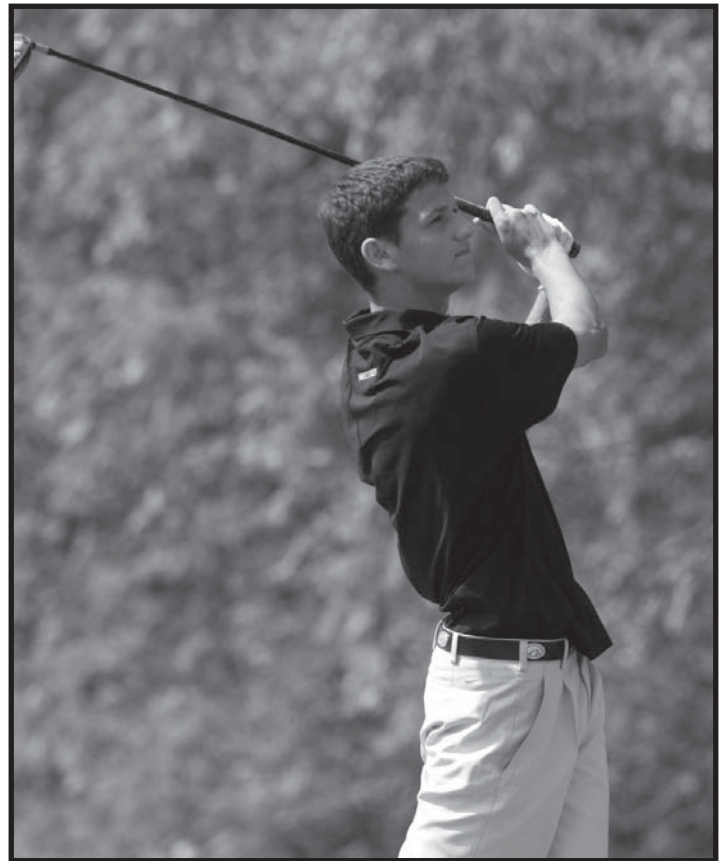

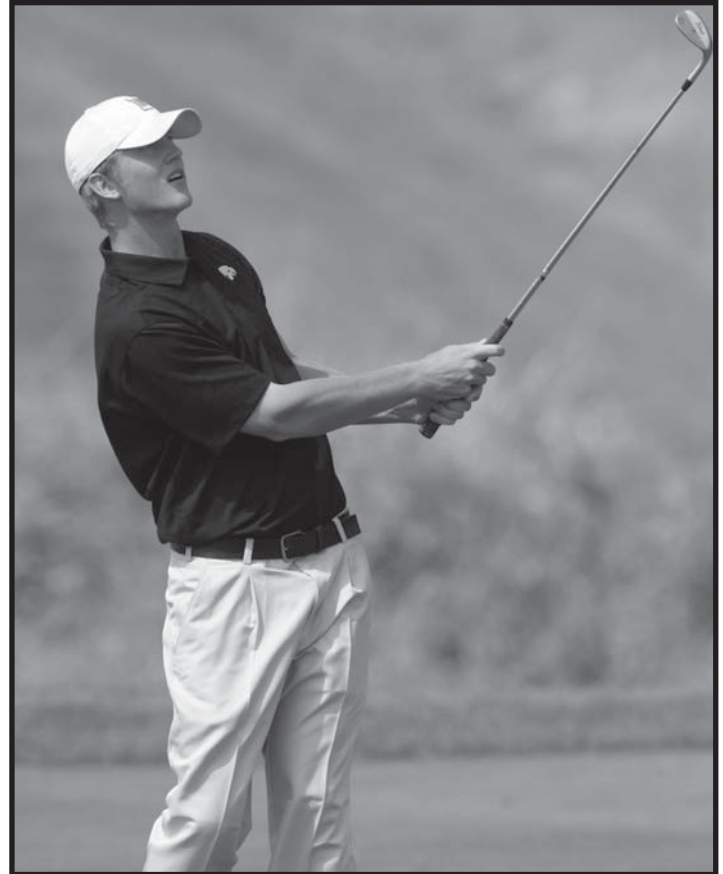

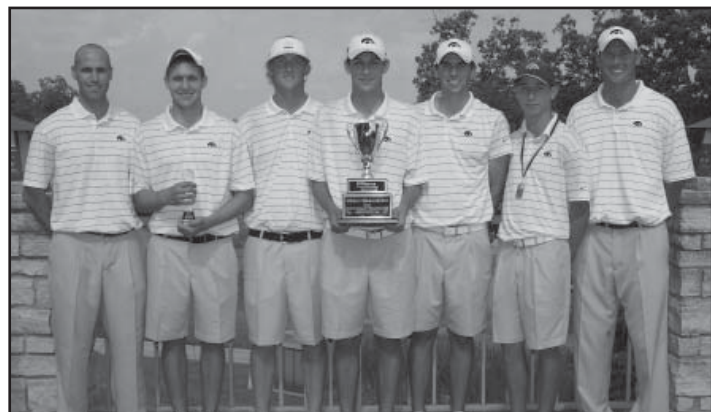
