The University of Iowa men's swimming and diving team opens its Big Ten Conference dual season, facing Michigan State on Thursday and Friday at the Campus Recreation and Wellness Center Natatorium. The dual begins at 7 p.m. (CT) Thursday and 4 p.m. Friday.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

The Hawkeyes debuted in the CollegeSwimming.com poll with a No. 25 national ranking on Oct. 6 based on the results from the team's 155-77 season-opening dual victory over Illinois Chicago. -- a 630 point value. Iowa is currently rated No. 45 in the Oct. 13 poll.

NEWCOMER PACES SPRINTERS

Freshman Jack Smith is pacing Iowa's freestyle sprinters early in the 2015-16 season. The England native won the 50 free in the team's annual intrasquad meet with a time of 20.79 seconds. Smith also won the 100 free, clocking a time of 45.34 seconds.

WAIT, HE'S A DIVER?

Freshman Will Brenner opened his teammates eyes during the annual intrasquad meet when he swam to a victory in a special "diver's 50 free." The Michigan native posted a time of 20.87, which was just .08 behind Jack Smith's winning time in the main 50 free event.

RETURNING NCAA QUALIFIERS

Four of Iowa's five NCAA qualifiers from the 2014-15 season are back in the fold. The Hawkeyes return seniors Roman Trussov and Addison Boschult, junior Jackson Halsmer, and sophomore Jerzy Twarowski in 2015-16.

The Hawkeyes have their top performers returning in 10-of-14 swimming events, all three diving events, and four top performers in relays. Iowa has 25 letterwinners returning in total.

ON THE TOWER

Senior Addison Boschult returns to lead the Iowa divers after earning honorable mention All-America honors on the platform at the 2015 NCAA Championships. Boschult holds the school record on the platform (409.20) and ranks fourth all-time on the 3-meter (368.60) and 10th on the 1-meter (325.13).

TRUSSOV: 2-TIME NCAA QUALIFIER

Senior Roman Trussov returns for his senior season as a two-time NCAA qualifier (2013, 2015). The Kazakhstan native holds the school records in the 100 breast (52.85), 200 breast (1:54.57) and as part of the 200 (1:25.53) and 400 (3:08.56) medley relays. Trussov placed 24th overall in the 100 breast and 28th in the 200 breast at the 2015 NCAA Championships.



TOP FLYER RETURNS

Sophomore Jerzy Twarowski is back for his second season as a Hawkeye and his second season competing in the yards distances. Twarowski became the first Iowa butterfly swimmer to break the 47-second mark during his first collegiate season, posting a school-record time of 46.70. He also broke a 22-year old school record (Rafal Szukala) in the 200 fly, finishing with a time of 1:44.00.

A LONG WAYS FROM HOME

This year's team will feature five Hawkeyes from overseas. Jerzy Twarowski comes to the UI program from Krakow, Poland, Roman Trussov from Ust-Kamenogorsk, Kazakhstan, David Ernstsson from Stockholm, Sweden, Kenneth Mende from Chemnitz, Saxony, Germany, and Jack Smith from Stoke-On-Trent, England.

RECORD BREAKING YEAR

The Hawkeyes broke nine school records in 2015-16. Individually, Grant Betulius (100 backstroke - 45.56) and (200 backstroke - 1:42.19), Roman Trussov (100 breaststroke - 52.85) and (200 breaststroke - 1:54.57), Jerzy Twarowski (100 butterfly - 46.70) and (200 butterfly - 1:44.00) and Addison Boschult (platform diving 409.20) all broke school records in their respective events. The 200- medley relay of Betulius, Trussov, Twarowski, and Jackson Halsmer had a record-

breaking time of 1:25.53 and the 400-medley relay of Betulius, Trussov, Twarowski, and Halsmer had a school-record time of 3:08.56.

CAMPUS RECREATION AND WELLNESS CENTER

Ground was broken for the Campus Recreation and Wellness Center in October 2007. The facility opened in August 2010 and is home for the Hawkeyes. It is located at the corner of Burlington and Madison streets and cost approximately \$69 million. The facility includes a 50-meter competition pool, a separate diving well, a leisure pool with lap lanes and 24,000 square feet of fitness space.

IOWA SWIMMING AND DIVING TRADITION

Iowa was one of the first schools in the nation to compete on a collegiate level and competed at the first NCAA Championship. From 1937 to 1960, Iowa placed in the NCAA top 10 18 times, crowning nine NCAA and 22 Big Ten champions.

ON THE HORIZON

The Hawkeyes return to action Oct. 30, hosting Minnesota at 5 p.m. (CT) at the CRWC Natatorium.
