WHERE TO WATCH

Sunday's dual is televised by BTN. Tim Johnson, Jim Gibbons, and Shane Sparks will call the action.

THE SERIES -- MINNESOTA

Sunday's dual is the 104th meeting between Minnesota and Iowa. The schools first met in 1921, a 39-3 Iowa victory in Iowa City.

The Hawkeyes lead the all-time series 74-28-1. lowa has won four straight in the series. Minnesota's last win in the series was 19-15 on Jan. 25, 2014, in Iowa City.

lowa is 32-10-1 all-time at Minnesota and has won its last two trips to Minneapolis, including a 23-12 win in 2015, and a 27-11 win in 2017.

The schools have met 16 times since 2006-07, Tom Brands' first season as lowa's head coach. The Hawkeyes own a 12-4 advantage during that stretch.

MOVING UP THE RANKINGS

Sophomore Kaleb Young and redshirt freshman Jacob Warner continue to ascend the rankings.

Young opened the season ranked 15th in the country by Intermat and has climbed to No. 5 entering Sunday's dual at Minnesota. Young is 11-1 with three pins, three technical falls, and a major decision. He has wins over No. 14 Griffin Parriott (Pin 3:37), No. 15 Josh Humphreys (4-1), and No. 16 Luke Weiland (15-0). He was named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week following his win over Parriott

Warner opened the season ranked No. 13 by Intermat, but is ranked No. 6 heading into this weekend. He is 6-2 this year with a 5-4 decision over No. 5 Willie Miklus.

MARINELLI CLIMBS TO NO. 2

Sophomore Alex Marinelli climbed to No. 2 in the national rankings following his Midlands Championship on Dec. 30. Marenilli defeated Evan Wick, 4-3, in the 165-pound Midlands finals. It was his second straight Midlands title. He was 5-0 in the tournament with wins over Wick, No. 5 Joshua Shields (4-1), and No. 19 Jonathan Viruet (8-6 SV1). The No. 2 ranking matches his career best. He was ranked No. 2 the final two weeks of the 2018 regular season.

NEXT MAN IN

Fourteen Hawkeyes have at least one dual win this season. Iowa opened the season with three projected starters on the bench, including redshirt freshman Jacob Warner (197), and All-Americans Michael Kemerer (174) and Sam Stoll (285).

Starters Spencer Lee (125) and Pat Lugo (149) have missed one dual this season.

In their absence, Carter Happel, Myles Wilson, Connor Corbin, Mitch Bowman, and Aaron Costello have picked up wins for Iowa.

Happel bumped up a weight class and shut out Parker Filius of Purdue, 2-0, at 149.

Bowman, a national qualifier at 184 in 2018, has two wins at 174 and two at 197. He opened the season filling in at 197, earning a 6-2 decision in the season opener, and later a 7-5 win over No. 11 Christian Brunner of Purdue. When Kemerer was ruled out for the season, and Wilson medically forfeited against lowa State, Bowman began a cut to 174. He debuted at 174 at Midlands, going 2-2 overall. Jeremiah Moody has also wrestled at 174 for lowa (0-1).

Costello has posted a 6-4 mark at heavyweight. He has appeared in five of Iowa's six duals (3-2).

Corbin and Wilson also have dual wins. Corbin is 1-1 at 197, and Wilson is 2-3 at 174.

HAWKEYES CROWN 2 MIDLANDS CHAMPIONS

Sophomores Austin DeSanto and Alex Marinelli won individual titles to help Iowa capture the team race at the 56th Ken Kraft Midlands Championships on Dec. 30.

lowa scored 184 points to win its 28th Midlands title, 10 of which have been led by head coach Tom Brands. Northern lowa followed the Hawkeyes with 119.5 points, Northwestern came in third with 110 points and Wisconsin followed in fourth with 97.5 points.

The second-seeded DeSanto grabbed his first Midlands title, winning the 133-pound bracket with a 15-5 major decision over the fourth seed. DeSanto scored 28.5 team points in the tournament, more than any other wrestler in the tournament.

Second-seeded Alex Marinelli earned his second Midlands title in as many seasons, defeating the No. 1 seed Evan Wick, 4-3, in the 165-pound finals.

A LITTLE EXTRA ON TOP

Sophomore Spencer Lee opened the season with nine straight wins before falling to then-No. 2 Sebastian Rivera in the Midlands 125-pound finals. The loss snapped Lee's career long 16 match winning streak.

Lee is 9-1 overall with eight bonus-point victories. He leads the team with six technical falls. He has one major decision and one pin (2:34).

Lee is 10-3 all-time against top 10 opponents. Among those 10 wins, he has three technical falls, two pins, and one major decision.

Minnesota's Sean Russell is ranked No. 6 by Intermat. Lee won by a 15-0 technical fall in his only career meeting with Russell (2017 Midlands).

LAST MEETING -- #7 Iowa 34, #18 Minnesota 7 (Feb. 2, 2018)

IOWA CITY, Iowa -- The University of Iowa wrestling team defeated No. 18 Minnesota, 34-7, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Senior Brandon Sorensen and redshirt freshman Carter Happel, two lowa natives at opposite ends of their careers, each flattened Gophers on opposite sides of the dual.

Sorensen opened the dual with a fall in 3:32 at 149 pounds. Nine matches later, after the Hawkeyes had already built a 28-7 lead, Happel put on the finishing touches with a fall in 6:58.

Somewhere in between, the Hawkeyes won six more bouts, two by major decision and one by technical fall. The Hawkeyes held a 24-8 advantage in takedowns, and recorded three wins over top 10 opponents. It marked their fourth straight win in the series.

TOP OF THE BATTING ORDER

lowa's 1-2-3 punch at the top of the lineup has combined for a 28-4 record with 21 bonus point victories. Sophomore Spencer Lee, the nation's second-ranked 125-pounder, is 9-1 with a team-high six technical falls, one pin, and one major decision.

Sophomore Austin DeSanto is 10-1 with three major decisions, two technical falls, and two falls. DeSanto is ranked 10th nationally at 133, and has three wins over ranked opponents.

Murin is ranked No. 15 at 141. He is 9-2 with three major decisions and three falls.

BEHIND THE SCENES

The Hawkeyes have won nine individual tournament titles in 2018-19. Freshmen Nelson Brands (165) and Tony Cassioppi (285), and sophomore Justin Stickley (141) won titles at the Grand View Open on Nov. 10. Brands, Cassioppi, junior Vince Turk (141), and redshirt freshman Zach Axmear (149) won championships Nov. 17 at the Lindenwood Open. Axmear and freshman Aaron Cashman won titles at the Pat "Flash" Flanagan Open on Jan. 5.

Cassioppi is 13-2 with 11 falls and one major decision. Ten of his 11 pins have been in the first period. Brands is 13-0 with two falls, three major decisions, and two technical falls.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

lowa earned its 1,000th dual win in program history Nov. 9, topping California State Bakersfield, 36-3, in Kent, Ohio. Iowa is one of four NCAA Division I schools with 1,000 program wins (Oklahoma State, Iowa State, Oregon State). The Hawkeyes' overall dual meet record is 1,005-230-31 (.799) in 109 seasons.

The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 35 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 55 NCAA Champions have won a total of 83 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 112 Big Ten champions have combined for 199 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 30 two-time Big Ten champions from Iowa.

lowa's 157 All-Americans have earned All-America status 329 times, including 20 four-time, 36 three-time and 40 two-time honorees.



Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands is in his 13th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa in 2018. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time

national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 210-22-1 (.901) overall and 91-10 (.900) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 227-42-1 (.839) career mark.

In 12 full seasons as lowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning 11 NCAA champions, 15 Big Ten champions and 66 All-Americans. Iowa has had 99 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 109 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 12 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared eight of the last 11 Big Ten regular season titles.

lowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when lowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 11 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at lowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.


