GAME #9 STORYLINES

- Fans who bring a new toy to donate to the UI Children's Hospital will receive \$5 off Monday's game ticket.
- Monday will be the first ever meeting between Iowa and Stetson.
- Freshmen Cordell Pemsil and Jordan Bohannon have each scored 74 points to tie for third in scoring on the Hawkeyes.
- Iowa has won 40 of its last 43 nonconference home games, dating back to 2012.
- Peter Jok, who scored his 1,000th career point against Memphis, has scored double digits in all eight games, including netting 27 or more points in five of the contests. Jok ranks third in country -- first among players from Power 5 conferences -- in scoring per game (25.0).
- Peter Jok poured in 42 points against Memphis on Nov. 26. The 42 points are the most by a Hawkeye in 40 years and tie for the fourth most in a single-game in program history, tying Bruce King's 42 points against Pittsburgh in 1976.
- In their first career starts, Jordan Bohannon (23) and Cordell Pemsil (18) combined to score 41 of Iowa's 78 points at Notre Dame. Bohannon was 7-of-15 from long distance; the 15 attempts tied Justin Jackson for the second most 3-point attempts in a single-game in Iowa history.
- Cordell Pemsil ranks first in the Big Ten in field goal percentage, making 76 percent of his shot attempts (29-of-38).
- Peter Jok was named to the preseason 10-player All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists.
- Iowa has competed in postseason play the last five years (NCAA 2014-16; NIT 2012-13).
- The Hawkeyes won 22 games, tied for third place in the Big Ten, and won an NCAA Tournament game each of the last two seasons.
- Iowa has won 20 or more games in four consecutive seasons -- its longest streak in 15 years.
- Fran McCaffery has guided Iowa to upper division finishes in the Big Ten in each of the last four seasons. McCaffery, who is one of just 12 Division I head coaches to take four different programs to the NCAA Tournament, has accumulated 16 first division finishes in 20 years as a head coach. McCaffery has posted 10 seasons of 20 or more wins as a head coach.
- Iowa is 53-10 when scoring 80 points or more, the last six seasons. The Hawkeyes are 61-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last six years.

THE SETTING

Iowa (3-5) remains home on Monday to host Stetson (4-5). Tipoff is set for 6:01 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

TICKETS/PROMOTIONS

ON THE AIR

Radio: Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin will handle the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Monday's game will be televised nationally on ESPNU (WATCHESPN). Roy Philpott and Sean Harrington will call the action.

2 HAWKEYES SIDELINED DUE TO INJURIES

Forwards Dale Jones and Tyler Cook are sidelined due to hand injuries suffered during the month of November.

Jones suffered a fracture in his right wrist in Iowa's game against Seton Hall (Nov. 17) and is expected to miss approximately 8-9 weeks. The Hawkeye senior sustained the injury minutes after making his season debut against the Pirates. Jones, who transferred to Iowa in 2015 after three years at Tyler Junior College in Texas, has played limited minutes in only seven games during his Hawkeye career.

Cook fractured his right index finger during a practice on Thanksgiving at the Emerald Coast Classic and is expected to miss approximately three weeks. The Hawkeye freshman had surgery on Nov. 29 in Iowa City. Cook, who started the first six games of his collegiate career, ranks second on the team in scoring (13.7 points per game) and rebounding (5.3 rebounds per game).

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,714 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,596-1,118 (.588). That includes a 1,018-357 (.740) record in home games, a 574-758 (.431) record in contests away from Iowa City, a 752-757 (.498) mark in Big Ten games and a 423-131 (.763) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his seventh season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 20th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four years.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 34th season as a collegiate coach in 2016, which includes 20 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant. McCaffery is one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 57, holds a career mark of 372-268 (.581) and guided his teams to 10 postseason appearances (seven NCAA and three NIT). He is 121-91 (.571) at Iowa. McCaffery has led Iowa to NCAA Tournament victories in each of the past two seasons, the first time Hawkeye teams have won tournament games in consecutive seasons since 1996-97.

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have earned five postseason tournament berths (3 NCAA, 2 NIT). McCaffery coached Iowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided five different Hawkeyes to all-conference honors, including three straight first team honorees. The last time Iowa had three consecutive first-team all-league honorees was 1946-48.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past four seasons at Iowa and 16 of 20 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by more than 50 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes boast a 58-12 home record the last four seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

HAWKEYES FALL TO OMAHA ON SATURDAY

Omaha shot 48 percent from the field en route to a 98-89 win over Iowa on Saturday on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

- Three players accounted for 80 percent of the Hawkeyes' offense: Peter Jok (33), Jordan Bohannon (20), and Cordell PemsI (18).
- In their second straight start of their collegiate careers, Jordan Bohannon and Cordell PemsI scored in double figures.
- The Mavericks owned a 47-39 rebounding edge, with 19 of the 47 rebounds coming on the offensive glass and scoring 20 points on those second chance opportunities.
- In addition to scoring a game-high 33 points, Peter Jok led all rebounders with 10 rebounds for his second career double-double.
- Saturday was the second game played without starting forward Tyler Cook, who is out of action most of this month due to a fractured finger.
- Both teams went 21-of-27 from the free throw line. Iowa's Peter Jok made all 12 free-throw attempts for the second time in three games. After going 10-of-23 from the foul line the first seven games of the season, Cordell PemsI made 6-of-7 attempts from the charity stripe against Omaha.
- The loss was just Iowa's fourth loss in 43 games against current members of The Summit League.

SCOUTING STETSON

- Stetson comes to Iowa City having won two of its last three games, most recently beating Florida College (101-69) on Saturday.
- Five players scored in double figures in its most recent contest against Florida College. Luke Doyle netted a team-best 21 points, while Angel Rivera dished out 13 assists to only one turnover. As a team, Stetson made 15 (15-of-31) 3-pointers.
- Three starters average double figures in scoring: Derick Newton (18.6), Divine Myles (15.6), Luke Doyle (12.0), and Angel Rivera (10.0).
- Two Hatters have made 22 or more 3-pointers this season: Derick Newton (26) and Luke Doyle (22). As a team, Stetson makes 34.6 percent (84-of-243) of its 3-point attempts.
- Monday will be Stetson's fourth true road game of the season, losing its first three at East Carolina (73-60), Air Force (85-72) and Central Florida (81-45).
- Stetson averages 78.2 points per game; the Hatters have scored 100+ points in two home games this year (116-112 loss to Citadel and a 101-69 win over Florida College).
- Monday will be Iowa's second game of the season against a school from the Atlantic Sun Conference.
- The Hatters are coached by Corey Williams, who is in his fourth season as a collegiate head coach, all at Stetson (32-73). Williams played collegiately at Oklahoma State from 1989-92. He finished his career eighth on OSU's career scoring charts with 1,320 points.

PETER JOK SCORCHING THE NETS

After averaging 7.0 points per game as a sophomore, Peter Jok averaged 16.1 points last year as a junior (+9.1), and is averaging a Big Ten-best 25.0 points so far this season as a senior (+8.9). The 9.1 improvement last year was tops among Big Ten players.

Jok was named to the preseason All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists. Jok has scored 27 points or more five times this season, including scorching the nets for 42 points in Iowa's against Memphis and 33 against Omaha this past Saturday.

Jok was recognized as the Big Ten Player of the Week on Nov. 21 after averaging 28.5 points, six rebounds, two steals, and two assists against Seton Hall and UTRGV. Jok made all 10 free throw attempts and shot 59 percent (20-of-34) from the field, including 44 percent (7-of-16) from 3-point range in the two-game span.

Jok, who scored career point No. 1,000 against Memphis, made his first 24 free throw attempts this season before misfiring on his first attempt Tuesday at Notre Dame. Jok has had free throw streaks of 27 and 26 the last two seasons. The school record for consecutive free throws made is 34 set by Chris Street (Jan. 2-Jan. 16, 1993).

Jok ranks third nationally in points per game (25.0) and 3-pointers per game (3.88). His 25.0 scoring average is tops best among players from Power 5 conferences.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA ENHANCEMENTS

The Iowa Athletic Department upgraded Carver-Hawkeye Arena's video boards, sound system, lighting, digital scoretable displays, and playing surface this past summer.

A new four-sided centerhung video system is the centerpiece of the installation. The two main centerhung displays measure approximately 14.5 feet high by 26 feet wide and the other two centerhung displays measure 9.5 feet high by 16.5 feet wide. The project also upgraded the auxiliary displays located near the ceiling at each side of the arena.

HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- Eight different Hawkeyes have reached double figures in scoring through eight games this season.
- After scoring in double figures once in 27 games last year, sophomore Brady Ellingson has netted double digits twice this season.
- Iowa surpassed the century mark for the 97th time in program history with a 116-84 win over Savannah State on Nov. 13. The 116 points equal the seventh most points scored in a game in program history.
- Peter Jok joined Reggie Evans (twice) and Aaron Fuller as the only Hawkeyes to post 30+ points and 10+ rebounds in a single game the last 20 years. Jok totaled 30 points and 11 rebounds against Seton Hall (Nov. 17). His efforts earned the team captain Big Ten Player of the Week honors on Nov. 21.
- Iowa posted school records in 3-pointers made (18) and attempted (43) in its victory over Savannah State on Nov. 13.
- Peter Jok scored 27 points in Iowa's opener vs. Kennesaw State. The 27 points are the most by a Hawkeye in a season opener since Adam Haluska poured in 29 against The Citadel in 2006.
- Freshman Tyler Cook (10) joined Aaron White as the only two players to grab 10 or more rebounds in their first game as a Hawkeye in the past 20 years.

NICHOLAS BAER PLAYED OVERSEAS IN AUGUST

Nicholas Baer averaged 8.5 points, 8.3 rebounds, and two steals in four games (3-1) overseas on the USA East Coast All-Star Team.

This marked the sixth consecutive year that a Hawkeye traveled overseas with the USA East Coast basketball team. In 2011, Matt Gatens and Bryce Cartwright traveled overseas; Zach McCabe went in 2012; Jarrod Uthoff was on the roster in 2013; Mike Gesell and Adam Woodbury competed in 2014; while Dom Uhl traveled with the team in 2015.

Luka Garza and Jack Nunge have signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa in 2017.

Garza is a 6-foot-11, 240-pound forward from Maret School in Washington, D.C. Garza is a two-time first team All-DC, all-conference and second team Washington Post All-Met honoree. He scored more than 1,000 points and grabbed over 600 rebounds his first three years. Garza averaged 25.5 points, 12.6 rebounds, and 2.6 blocks as a junior, and 19.8 points and 9.8 rebounds his sophomore campaign. He helped Maret earn back-to-back conference championships (22-8 in 2014 and 22-5 in 2015). He was recognized as the 2014-15 Washington Post All-Met Most Improved Player. Garza averaged 11.3 points (54% FG, 36% 3-pt FG) and 6.5 rebounds last year in the EYBL.

Nunge is also 6-foot-11 and weighs 220 pounds. He hails from Newburgh, Indiana and attends Castle High School. Nunge earned first-team All-SIAC, IBCA Supreme 15 Underclassmen, and Indiana All Star-Core 6 honors following his junior campaign. He posted a team-best 18 double-doubles, and averaged 19.3 points (FG%: 57%, 3-pt FG%: 43%, FT%: 81%), 11.4 rebounds, and 3.7 blocks per game his junior season. He was named team Most Valuable Player in 2016. A two-time team captain, he tallied 35 points and 25 rebounds against Bosse High School, and 35 points and 22 rebounds versus Harrison High School his junior season. Nunge also excels in the classroom, boasting a 3.97 grade point average, ranks 20th in his class, and earned the Scholastic "C" Award. He is a member of the National Honor Society and Student Council. He played with the Pocket City AAU basketball team.

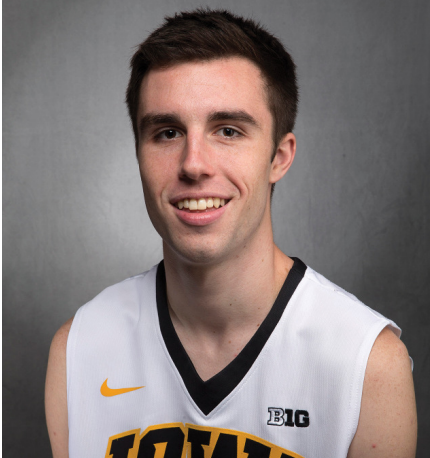
