GAME #7 STORYLINES

- Tuesday will be lowa's second game against an ACC opponent in five days. The Hawkeyes played Virginia last Friday at the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Florida.
- lowa is 5-10 in Challenges games, winning its last three ACC/Big Ten Challenge contests, winning home games against Florida State (78-75, OT) in 2015 and Notre Dame (98-93) in 2013, and on the road at North Carolina (60-50) in 2014.
- Peter Jok poured in 42 points against Memphis on Saturday. The 42 points are the most by a Hawkeye in 40 years and tie for the fourth most in a single-game in program history, tying Bruce King's 42 points against Pittsburgh in 1976.
- Senior Dale Jones suffered a fracture in his right wrist and will miss the next 8-9 weeks.
- Peter Jok, who scored his 1,000th career point in lowa's last outing against Memphis on Saturday, has scored double digits in all six games, including netting 27 or more points in four of the contests. Jok leads the Big Ten and players from Power 5 Conferences in scoring, averaging 25.3 points per contest.
- Iowa head coach Fran McCaffery served as an assistant coach at Notre Dame for 11 seasons (1988-99). McCaffery worked on the staffs of Digger Phelps and John MacLeod.
- Nicholas Baer's cousin, Kristin Baer, is a sophomore on the Notre Dame volleyball team.
- Peter Jok (152 points) and Tyler Cook (82 points) account for 45 percent of lowa's offense.
- Peter Jok was named to the preseason 10-player All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists.
- lowa has competed in postseason play the last five years (NCAA 2014-16; NIT 2012-13).
- The Hawkeyes won 22 games, tied for third place in the Big Ten, and won an NCAA Tournament game each of the last two seasons.
- lowa has won 20 or more games in four consecutive seasons -- its longest streak in 15 years.
- Fran McCaffery has guided lowa to upper division finishes in the Big Ten in each of the last four seasons. McCaffery, who is one of just 12 Division I head coaches to take four different programs to the NCAA Tournament, has accumulated 16 first division finishes in 20 years as a head coach. McCaffery has posted 10 seasons of 20 or more wins as a head coach.
- lowa is 53-9 when scoring 80 points or more, the last six seasons. The Hawkeyes are 61-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last six years.


ON THE AIR

Radio: Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin will handle the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of lowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Tuesday's game will be televised nationally on ESPN2 (WATCHESPN). Bob Wischusen and LaPhonso Ellis will call the action.

ALL-TIME SERIES RESULTS

Tuesday will be the 16th meeting between lowa and Notre Dame, with the Irish leading the all-time series 9-6. Tuesday will be the third time the two teams will have played in four years. Iowa beat Notre Dame (98-93) in Iowa City in 2013, while the Irish edged the Hawkeyes (68-62) in Orlando last November at the Advocare Invitational.





MEMPHIS OUTRUNS HAWKEYES IN LAST OUTING

lowa and Memphis combined for 192 points, with the Tigers outlasting the Hawkeyes, 100-92, in the third place game of the Emerald Coast Classic on Saturday in Niceville, Florida.

- Peter Jok was white-hot, posting career highs in points (42) and 3-pointers made (8). The 42 points are a tournament record, and tie for the fourth most scored by a Hawkeye in a single-game in program history. The senior was named to the all-tournament team.
- Peter Jok was a perfect 12-of-12 from the foul line. The 12 makes and attempts was one shy of the school record held by Glenn Vidnovic (13-of-13 vs. Purdue in 1969).
- The game featured 15 lead changes and three ties.
- Freshman forward Tyler Cook also scored in double figures, netting 17 points while also grabbing a team-high seven rebounds.
- Memphis had five players score in double digits and scored 27 of its 40 field goals in the paint.
- lowa shot 54 percent (30-of-55) from the field, while Memphis made 55 percent (40of-72) of its attempts.




HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his seventh season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 20th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four years.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 34th season as a



McCaffery, 57, holds a career mark of 372-266 (.583) and guided his teams to 10 postseason appearances (seven NCAA and three NIT). He is 121-89 (.576) at Iowa. McCaffery has led Iowa to NCAA Tournament victories in each of the past two seasons, the first time Hawkeye teams have won tournament games in consecutive seasons since 1996-97

Since taking over the lowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have earned five postseason tournament berths (3 NCAA, 2 NIT). McCaffery coached lowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided five different Hawkeyes to all-conference honors, including three straight first team honorees. The last time Iowa had three consecutive first-team all-league honorees was 1946-48.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past four seasons at Iowa and 16 of 20 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by more than 50 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes boast a 58-12 home record the last four seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

SCOUTING NOTRE DAME

- Notre Dame has won its first six games of the season, winning four games at home and two on neutral floors. The 6-0 is the third best start in the Mike Brey era.
- Notre Dame returned nine letterwinners, including three starters, from last year's team that advanced to the Elite Eight in the NCAA Tournament.
- The Irish have won its first six contests by an average of 24 points. Notre Dame has made 82.6 percent (95-of-115) of its free throw attempts. Matt Farrell is a perfect 15of-15, while Bonzie Colson is 28-of-32 (.875) from the foul line through six games.
- Four starters average double figures in scoring: Bonzie Colson (17.2), V.J. Beachem (17.0), Steve Vasturia (15.3), and Matt Farrell (11.5). All five of Notre Dame's starters are upperclassmen (three juniors and two seniors).
- In addition to leading the squad in scoring, Bonzie Colson averages a team-best 9.7 rebounds and 1.3 blocks per game.
- Three players have made 11 or more 3-pointers: Matt Ryan (14), V.J. Beachem (13), and Steve Vasturia (11).
- In their last outing against Chicago State on Saturday, the Irish drained 17 3-pointers, seven by Matt Ryan. The sophomore finished with a career-high 23 points. Bonzie Colson finished with his third straight double-double (10 points, 11 rebounds).
- Notre Dame is coached by Mike Brey, who is in his 16th season on the Fighting Irish sidelines. Brey has guided Notre Dame to 15 20-win seasons and 13 NCAA Tournament appearances.

LAST MEETING VERSUS NOTRE DAME

Iowa and Notre Dame met last November in the Advocare Invitational in Orlando, Florida. The Irish outscored the Hawkeyes 14-9 in the last 3:30 of the contest to hold on for a 68-62 win. Iowa's Peter Jok was the only Hawkeye to return this season who scored in that contest (eight points). Notre Dame's V.J. Beachem tallied a team-best 16 points, while Bonzie Colson, Steve Vasturia, and Matt Ryan each contributed 11 points.

PETER JOK SCORCHING THE NETS

After averaging 7.0 points per game as a sophomore, Peter Jok averaged 16.1 points last year as a junior (+9.1), and is averaging a Big Ten-best 25.3 points so far this season as a senior (+9.2). The 9.1 improvement last year was tops among Big Ten players.

Jok was named to the preseason All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists. Jok has scored 27 points or more four times this season, including scorching the nets for 42 points in Iowa's last game against Memphis.

Jok was recognized as the Big Ten Player of the Week on Nov. 21 after averaging 28.5 points, six rebounds, two steals, and two assists against Seton Hall and UTRGV. Jok made all 10 free throw attempts and shot 59 percent (20-of-34) from the field, including 44 percent (7-of-16) from 3-point range in the two-game span.

Jok has made all 24 free throw attempts this season, and has made 25 straight dating back to the last game of last season against Villanova. The 25 consecutive free throws is his second longest streak (27 last season). The school record for consecutive free throws made is 34 set by Chris Street (Jan. 2-Jan. 16, 1993).

Jok, who scored career point No. 1,000 in Iowa's last game against Memphis, has scored double digits 50 times in his career.

Last year, Jok was the first Hawkeye non-senior to average 16 points or more since Chris Kingsbury averaged 16.8 points as a sophomore in 1995.

IOWA HISTORY

lowa has played 2,712 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,596-1,116 (.588). That includes a 1,018-356 (.741) record in home games, a 574-757 (.431) record in contests away from Iowa City, a 752-757 (.498) mark in Big Ten games and a 423-130 (.765) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

- Seven different Hawkeyes have reached double figures in scoring through four games this season.
- After scoring in double figures once in 27 games last year, sophomore Brady Ellingson has netted double digits twice in four games this season.
- lowa surpassed the century mark for the 97th time in program history with a 116-84 win over Savannah State on Nov. 13. The 116 points equal the seventh most points scored in a game in program history.

- lowa posted school records in 3-pointers made (18) and attempted (43) in its victory over Savannah State on Nov. 13.
- Peter Jok scored 27 points in lowa's opener vs. Kennesaw State. The 27 points are the most by a Hawkeye in a season opener since Adam Haluska poured in 29 against The Citadel in 2006.
- Freshman Tyler Cook (10) joined Aaron White as the only two players to grab 10 or more rebounds in their first game as a Hawkeye in the past 20 years.

DALE JONES TO MISS 8-9 WEEKS DUE TO INJURY

Senior Dale Jones suffered a fracture in his right wrist in Iowa's game against Seton Hall (Nov. 17) and is expected to miss approximately 8-9 weeks. After missing the first two games this season, Jones sustained the injury minutes after making his season debut against Seton Hall.

Jones, who transferred to lowa in 2015 after three years at Tyler Junior College in Texas, has played limited minutes in only seven games during his Hawkeye career. Jones suffered a season-ending knee injury in practice on Dec. 1, 2015, after competing in lowa's first six games. The native of Waterloo, lowa, suffered his first knee injury in 2014.

NICHOLAS BAER PLAYED OVERSEAS IN AUGUST

Nicholas Baer averaged 8.5 points, 8.3 rebounds, and two steals in four games (3-1) overseas on the USA East Coast All-Star Team.

This marked the sixth consecutive year that a Hawkeye traveled overseas with the USA East Coast basketball team. In 2011, Matt Gatens and Bryce Cartwright traveled overseas; Zach McCabe went in 2012; Jarrod Uthoff was on the roster in 2013; Mike Gesell and Adam Woodbury competed in 2014; while Dom Uhl traveled with the team in 2015.

IOWA SIGNS 2 PREP STANDOUTS

Luka Garza and Jack Nunge have signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa in 2017.

Garza is a 6-foot-11, 240-pound forward from Maret School in Washington, D.C. Garaza is a two-time first team All-DC, all-conference and second team Washington Post All-Met honoree. He scored more than 1,000 points and grabbed over 600 rebounds his first three years. Garza averaged 25.5 points, 12.6 rebounds, and 2.6 blocks as a junior, and 19.8 points and 9.8 rebounds his sophomore campaign. He helped Maret earn back-to-back conference championships (22-8 in 2014 and 22-5 in 2015). He was recognized as the 2014-15 Washington Post All-Met Most Improved Player. Garza averaged 11.3 points (54% FG, 36% 3-pt FG) and 6.5 rebounds last year in the EYBL.

Nunge is also 6-foot-11 and weighs 220 pounds. He hails from Newburgh, Indiana and attends Castle High School. Nunge earned first-team All-SIAC, IBCA Supreme 15 Underclassmen, and Indiana All Star-Core 6 honors following his junior campaign. He posted a team-best 18 double-doubles, and averaged 19.3 points (FG%: 57%, 3-pt FG%: 43%, FT%: 81%), 11.4 rebounds, and 3.7 blocks per game his junior season. He was named team Most Valuable Player in 2016. A two-time team captain, he tallied 35 points and 25 rebounds against Bosse High School, and 35 points and 22 rebounds versus Harrison High School his junior season. Nunge also excels in the classroom, boasting a 3.97 grade point average, ranks 20th in his class, and earned the Scholastic "C" Award. He is a member of the National Honor Society and Student Council. He played with the Pocket City AAU basketball team.
