ON THE MAT

The University of Iowa hosts the final rounds of the EAS/NWCA National Duals this weekend at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Top-ranked Iowa (15-0) face eighth-seeded Chattanooga (12-5) on Saturday at 12 p.m. (CT) in the quarterfinal round.

Minnesota and Cornell will meet in the 4/5 dual and face the winner of Iowa/UT-Chattanooga in the semifinals.

On the other side of the bracket, Missouri earned the No. 2 seed and will face seventh-seeded Illinois (13-4). Ohio State is the three-seed and will face sixth-seeded Lehigh (13-4).

The four quarterfinals are Saturday at 12 p.m., with the semifinals to follow at 3 p.m. The championship and third-place duals are Sunday at 11:30 a.m. BTN will televise the semifinals and the finals.

IOWA AT THE NATIONAL DUALS

The Hawkeyes have competed at the NWCA National Duals tournament 19 times and own a 70-13-3 all-time record. Iowa has won the title six times (1992, 1995, 1996, 2008, 2009, 2010), placed second three times (1994, 1997, 1998), third seven times (1990, 1993, 1999, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2012), fourth one time (2013), fifth once (2007) and sixth once (2006).

HAWKEYES VS. THE FIELD

Iowa owns a 191-59-1 all-time record against the tournament field. The Hawkeyes have met three of the seven competing schools already once this season. Iowa won at Ohio State (18-14) and at Minnesota (23-12), and defeated Illinois (25-12) at home.

DUALS TOURNAMENT IS A STACKED DECK

Fifty-seven wrestlers from eight participating schools are rated in this week's InterMat rankings, including six of the nation's top-rated wrestlers -- Jesse Delgado, 125; Chris Dardanes, 133; Logan Stieber, 141; Dylan Ness, 149; Gabe Dean, 184; J'den Cox, 197.

Of the 10 weight classes, none have more ranked competitors than 133 and 157. Both weight classes feature seven ranked wrestlers. There are six ranked wrestlers at 125 (including four of the top five), 141, 174, 184, and 197. Five ranked wrestlers are in the field at 165, and four of the heavyweights are ranked, none higher than Iowa's Bobby Telford (4).

BIG TEN CHAMPIONS

Iowa won the Big Ten regular season dual title with a 22-9 win over Michigan on Feb. 13. The Hawkeyes finished the Big Ten season 9-0, one dual ahead of Nebraska (8-1) and Ohio State (8-1).

The Hawkeyes have won or shared seven of the last eight Big Ten dual championships, and have won or shared the regular season title eight times since the conference started recognizing a dual meet champion in 1999. Iowa won the title outright in 2000, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, and 2015, and shared the title in 2003 and 2014.

THOMAS GILMAN, 125 POUNDS

- Gilman is 23-1 overall and 14-0 in duals.
- The only Hawkeye to go 9-0 in conference duals.
- Leads Iowa with five technical falls and eight major decisions.
- Led Iowa with 59 points in dual meets.
- He has won nine straight.
- 4-1 record against ranked opponents.
- 2013 Midlands Champion.

CORY CLARK, 133 POUNDS

- Clark is 19-4 overall and 10-4 in duals.
- 5-4 record against ranked opponents.
- Three of his four losses have been to tournament participants, including then-No. 9 Johnny DiJulius (OSU), then-No. 5 Zain Richards (ILL), and then-No. 1 Chris Dardanes (MINN). He lost those matches by a combined five points.
- Ranks second on the team with eight falls.
- 2014 Midlands Champion

JOSH DZIEWA, 141 POUNDS

- Dzewa is 22-5 overall and 11-3 in duals.
- 6-3 record against ranked opponents.
- Won four of his last five against ranked opponents.

- Scored 45 dual points, the fifth most on the team.
- Has 77 career dual wins, third among active Hawkeyes.

BRANDON SORENSEN, 149 POUNDS

- Sorensen is 29-2 overall and 11-0 in duals.
- 7-2 record against ranked opponents, including seven straight wins.
- 29 wins are a team high.
- 12 match winning streak is longest active win streak among Hawkeyes.
- 8-0 in Big Ten duals.
- Tied for third on the team with six falls, ranks second with seven major decisions.
- Only wrestler in the country with wins over two reigning NCAA finalists.
- Named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week on Jan. 13 and Jan. 27.
- Only losses have been to teammate Brody Grothus (3-2) at the Luther Open, and current No. 1 David Habat (3-2) at the Midlands Championships.

MICHAEL KELLY, 157 POUNDS

- Kelly is 19-6 overall and 9-5 in duals.
- 2-5 record against ranked opponents.
- 24-8 career record wrestling attached at 157 pounds.
- Has started 14 of 15 duals, including the last 10.
- 54 career wins tie for fifth, and 46 career duals starts rank fourth among active Hawkeyes.

NICK MOORE, 165 POUNDS

- Moore is 18-6 overall and 9-5 in duals.
- 2-5 record against ranked opponents.
- 23-6 all-time record at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- Six falls ranks third on the team.
- 57 career dual starts rank third, and 71 career dual points rank fourth among active Hawkeyes.

MIKE EVANS, 174 POUNDS

- Evans is 21-1 and 12-1 in duals.
- 6-1 record against ranked opponents.
- 30-2 all-time record at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- Won his first 20 matches of the season before a 2-0 loss to then-No. 3 Matt Brown.
- Has 98 career dual wins, and 66 career dual starts, more than any active Hawkeye.
- Three wins this year against tournament field (Illinois, Ohio State, Minnesota).
- 2014 Midlands champion.

SAMMY BROOKS, 184 POUNDS

WIRE TO WIRE

Iowa debuted at the top spot on Nov. 11 when the USA Today/NWCA preseason poll was released 15 weeks ago. The Hawkeyes have maintained the top spot all season and enter the weekend as the unanimous No. 1, claiming all 12 first-place votes.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

The Hawkeyes are 9-0 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena this season and have a 222-21 all-time record at home since Carver started hosting wrestling duals in 1983. The Hawkeyes have recorded 20 undefeated seasons in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, the most recent in 2012-13 (9-0).

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted three Big Ten Championships (1983, 1994, 2005) and four NCAA Championships (1986, 1991, 1995, 2001). The Hawkeyes have won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

Carver-Hawkeye Arena is hosting the National Duals for the third time (1998, 1999).

BATTLE TESTED

The top-ranked Hawkeyes finished their road schedule with a 6-0 record, including five wins against ranked opponents and four wins against top 10 opponents.

Iowa traveled 5,226 miles since opening the dual schedule at Rutgers on Jan. 2. That includes 3,370 miles in the air -- Rutgers, Ohio State, Maryland, Penn State -- and 1,856 miles on the road to Stillwater, Okla., and Minneapolis.

The Hawkeyes also won the Midlands Championships on Dec. 30, a 460 mile roundtrip trip to Evanston, Illinois.

Iowa defeated Ohio State 18-14 in Columbus, Ohio, on Jan. 4. The Hawkeyes return to St. John Arena March 7-8 for the Big Ten Championships.

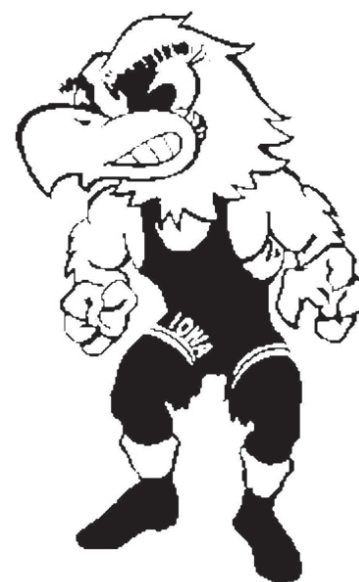

Tom Brands
Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands completed his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 161-15-1 (.912) overall and 67-6 (.918) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 178-35-1 (.826) career mark.

In eight-plus seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning nine NCAA champions, 11 Big Ten champions and 44 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 61 academic all-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 72 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last eight years, sending the entire

10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, and 2014. Iowa has also won or shared seven of the last eight Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, Iowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the then-national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when Iowa defeated Iowa State, 20-15, on Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' eight seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.

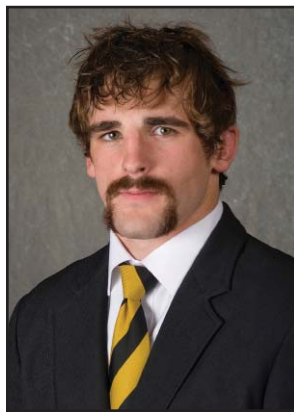
