HEAD COACH TOM BRANDS



Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his fifth season as head wrestling coach at Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has an 84-6 overall and 29-3 Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 101-26 career mark.

In the past four seasons at lowa, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three straight NCAA and Big Ten team titles (2008-10). During that time the Hawkeyes have crowned six NCAA champions, six Big Ten champions and 23 All-Americans, and qualified 36 wrestlers to the NCAA Championships. The Hawkeyes have also won the last three Big Ten regular season titles with perfect 8-0 records each year. The team is in the midst of the longest dual (61) and longest road dual (41) winning streaks in school history.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at lowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 all-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

THIS WEEK

The Iowa Hawkeyes (2-0, 0-0 Big Ten) will face Chattanooga (3-4) and Cornell College (3-0) in a double dual Friday at Cornell's Small Multi-Sport Center. Iowa will wrestle Chattanooga at 6:30 p.m. and Cornell at 8 p.m. Cornell will face Chattanooga at 5 p.m. Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$6 for youth (ages 5-18). Cornell will provide a live webcast of all three duals at *cornellcollege.edu*.

Steven Grace and two-time Hawkeye NCAA champion and four-time all-American Mark Ironside will call the action live on *hawkeyesports.com*. Action from the Big Ten and NCAA Championships, as well as the finals of the Midlands Championships, will also be aired live. Live audio broadcasts from all competitions will be available online at *hawkeyesports.com*. Broadcasts are available using the All-Access subscription (\$14.95 per month or \$119.95 per year).

CHATTANOOGA MOCS

The Chattanooga Mocs are 3-4 with wins over Liberty (26-16), Cumberland (42-6) and Gardner-Webb (29-9), and losses to Kent State (12-24), North Carolina (18-21), Virginia Tech (12-25) and Wisconsin (16-25). Chattanooga graduate Heath Eslinger is in his second year as head coach at his alma mater. In 2010, the team won the Southern Conference regular season title with a 5-0 record. Eslinger is assisted by Rocco Mansueto (Cleveland State, 2003) and Josh Lambrecht (Oklahoma, 2003).

Sophomore Dean Pavlou (149) and junior Jason McCroskey (184) are Chattanooga's returning NCAA qualifiers. Pavlou is ranked 13th in the nation by *W.I.N. Magazine* with a 6-6 record, while McCroskey is ranked 16th by *W.I.N.*, 17th by Intermat and 18th by *Amateur Wrestling News* with an 8-3 mark.

Hawkeye Associate Head Coach **Terry Brands** served as head coach at Chattanooga from 2002-05. During his tenure, he led the Mocs to the 2005 Southern Conference title, while crowning three conference champions and two All-Americans.

CORNELL COLLEGE RAMS

Cornell is 3-0 with wins over Simpson (42-0), Iowa Central (25-15) and Southern Illinois-Edwardsville (39-6). The Rams will host Augustana Tuesday night. Head Coach Mike Duroe is 68-48-1 in in his sixth year at Cornell. The 2009-10 Iowa Conference Coach of the Year, Duroe has coached 17 national qualifiers and 12 All-Americans. He served as head coach of the Hawkeye Wrestling Club from 2003-05. Duroe is assisted by former Hawkeye Charlie Falck (Iowa, 2009), Shawn Voight (Cornell, 1990), Andrew Knaack (Wartburg, 2005) and Kyle Burkle (Upper Iowa, 2007). Falck was a two-time All-American (2007-08), three-time NCAA qualifier, three-time Big Ten placewinner and four-time letterwinner (2005, 2007-09) for the Hawkeyes at 125 pounds.

The Rams are led by returning NCAA qualifiers Kevin Donahue (141) and Nicholas Loughlin (157). Donahue is undefeated at 5-0, while Loughlin has a 5-2 record. Juniors Tigue Snider (133) and Jacob Schwebke (149) have 9-2 records, while juniors Michael Buhr (133), Joe Hambleton (165) and Andrew Roberts (184) are 8-2.

THE SERIES

Iowa's series with Cornell is tied 3-3, with Iowa winning the last three meetings. This is one of only eight series in Iowa's 112-opponent history that the Hawkeyes do not hold the lead. The other seven series are East Stroudsburg (1-1), Kansas State (0-1-1), New York Athletic Club (0-1-0), Ohio (0-0-1), Oklahoma (16-17-1), Oklahoma State (18-25-1) and Toledo (0-1-0). Iowa is 1-3 at Cornell.

IOWA WINNING STREAKS

The Hawkeyes have won 63 straight dual matches, which is a school record. The current streak started with a win over Cornell (32-3) on Jan. 12, 2008, which was the first match after lowa lost to Oklahoma State (19-14) on Jan. 5.

That 63-match winning streak ranks fourth-best in NCAA wrestling history behind three Oklahoma State streaks. The Cowboys won 76 straight duals from 1937-51, and had two 69-match streaks (1921-32 and 1996-99).

The Hawkeyes have also won 41 consecutive duals on the road, which is also a school record. That streak started with a 20-13 win at lowa State on Dec. 9, 2007.

lowa has also won its last 27 duals at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. That streak, which ranks fourth-best in school history, started with a 27-13 win over Penn State on Jan. 20, 2008, which was also the first home match after the loss to the Cowboys. The school record is 55 (1/9/1977-12/18/1983).

Against Big Ten opponents, the Hawkeyes have won their last 27 duals, including 12 at home and 15 on the road. The 27 league duals rank second in school history, while the 12 home duals rank third and the 15 road duals rank fourth. lowa's school record for consecutive Big Ten wins is 98 (12/13/1975-1/28/1989), while the records for Big Ten home wins is 63 (1/17/1975-1/3/1998) and road wins is 54 (1/19/1974-1/28/1989).

IOWA WRESTLING HISTORY

lowa's overall dual meet record is 879-215-30 (.795) in 101 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 51 NCAA champions have won a total of 78 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 15 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 102 Big Ten champions have won a total of 186 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time and 27 two-time lowa winners. Iowa's 140 all-Americans have earned all-America status 286 times, including 17 four-time, 29 three-time and 37 two-time honorees.

HAWKEYES GO 2-0 AT IOWA CITY DUALS

Hawkeye Head Coach **Tom Brands** picked up his 100th career win and lowa pitched two shutouts Nov. 19 at the third annual lowa City Duals at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. lowa, ranked seventh in the nation in the most recent NWCA/ *USA Today* Coaches Poll, posted wins over lowa Central (45-0) and Coe College (44-0) to open the 2010-11 season. The Hawkeyes extended their dual winning streak to 63 matches overall, and 27 in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, with the wins.

Five Hawkeyes - sophomore Mark Ballweg (141), and redshirt freshmen Nick Trizzino (133), Dylan Carew (149), Derek St. John (157) and Ethen Lofthouse (174) - made their Carver-Hawkeye Arena debuts and Brands' recorded his 100th career victory against Iowa Central. Iowa scored bonus points in nine of the 10 bouts and posted a 33-2 takedown advantage. Ballweg, St. John and senior Jake Kerr (165) pinned their opponents, while sophomore Matt McDonough (125), Trizzino, Carew, Ethen Lofthouse, sophomore Grant Gambrall (184) and senior Luke Lofthouse (197) all scored major decisions. Junior Blake Rasing (Hwt.) picked up his first win at Carver-Hawkeye Arena and his 10th career victory with a 9-4 decision.

lowa had a short break after the lowa Central win before taking the mat against Coe. McDonough, who is the defending NCAA Division I Champion at 125, opened the dual against Coe's Clayton Rush, who is the defending NCAA Division III Champion at 125. McDonough led 4-2 after two periods, but scored a takedown, three nearfall points and a point for riding time in the last 16 seconds for the 10-2 major decision. McDonough remains undefeated (13-0) at Carver-Hawkeye Arena, and has a 39-1 career record. Trizzino, Ballweg and Ethen Lofthouse pinned their Kohawk opponents, while Luke Lofthouse collected his 30th career win with a 19-3 match-ending technical fall in 5:47 over Stuart Maddox. St. John and Gambrall posted major decisions, while Kerr collected his 25th career win with a 6-4 decision over former Hawkeye Nick LeClere. Carew and Rasing also posted wins for the Hawkeyes.

Hawkeye freshmen **Michael Kelly** (157) and **Mike Evans** (174) each won amateur titles at the 2010 Ryan Kaufman/Glen Brand Open Saturday in Omaha, NE. Kelly and Evans, who both competed unattached, were two of lowa's 18 wrestlers at the tournament, with nine going in the elite division and nine in the amateur bracket.

The 157 and 174-pound amateur finals were all-lowa match-ups as Kelly faced teammate **Nick Moore** and Evans wrestled fellow Hawkeye **Jeremy Fahler**. Kelly posted six wins en route to his title, including an 8-7 victory in the third tiebreak period in the semifinals over Indiana's RaVaughn Perkins. Kelly defeated Moore in the finals, 6-4. was the 149-pound amateur division runner-up, while freshmen **Matt Gurule** (125) and **Ethan Owens** (141) placed sixth.

Sophomore **Nate Moore** (133) and senior **Aaron Janssen** (165) led the Hawkeyes in the elite division, both placing third. Moore was pinned by Minnesota's Bart Reiter near the end of his first match, but won six straight consolation bouts - including a 12-5 decision over Reiter - to earn third place. Janssen lost a close 8-7 decision to Oklahoma's Dallas Bailey in the semifinals, but posted two wins in the wrestlebacks to place third. Junior **Vinnie Wagner** also placed fourth at 184.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

On the 2010-11 Hawkeye wrestling team, there are three sets of brothers, two wrestlers whose fathers wrestled at Iowa and two uncle-nephew combinations.

Senior Matt Ballweg (157), sophomore Mark Ballweg (133/141) and freshman Jacob Ballweg (141) are brothers who hail from Waverly. They are the fifth set of three brothers to wrestle at lowa, and the third set to be on the roster at the same time. The other sets of three brothers to compete for the Hawkeyes are Ed Banach, Lou Banach and Steve Banach; Marty Kistler, Harlan Kistler and Lindley Kistler; Mike Uker, Ben Uker and Joe Uker; and Lenny Zalesky, Larry Zalesky and Jim Zalesky. Junior Stew Gillmor (149/157) and freshman Walt Gillmor (165) are brothers from Donahue, while sophomore Nate Moore (133) and freshman Nick Moore (157/165) are brothers from lowa City.

Sophomore **Matt McDonough** (125/133) and redshirt freshman **Nick Trizzino** have fathers who wrestled for the Hawkeyes. **Mike McDonough** wrestled at lowa from 1974-76, while **Mark Trizzino** was an all-American (1984) and four-year letterwinner (1981-84) for the Hawkeyes.

Senior Luke Lofthouse (197) is the uncle of Hawkeye redshirt freshman Ethen Lofthouse (174). Nick Trizzino's uncle, Scott Trizzino, was a three-time all-American (1978-79-81) and four-time letterwinner (1977-79, 1981) for the Hawkeyes.
