Gayle Blevins—Head Coach. Entering her 22nd season, Blevins has lead her teams to 7 Women's College World Series appearances (4 at Iowa), won 8 Big Ten titles (5 at Iowa) and has been inducted into the Indiana

University and NFCA Hall of Fame.



Shane Bouman—Pitching Coach. Bouman enters his 2nd year as the Hawkeye pitching coach. He was formerly the head coach at South Dakota State for 6 years. As a pitcher, Bou-

man was a 4-time ASA All American. He led 5 teams to ASA national championships.



Diane Stephenson—Assistant Coach. Stephenson begins her 1st season as an assistant coach for the Iowa Softball team in charge of hitting and catchers. She was formerly head coach

at Indiana University for 15 years, taking the Hoosiers to the NCAA Tournament 2 times. Stephenson was an All American and All Big Ten catcher for the Hoosiers.
