THIS WEEK -- The Iowa Women's tennis team will compete in the 2008 Big Ten Conference Championships at West Lafayette, IN beginning Thursday. The Hawkeyes concluded regular season play with a 12-9 mark, 3-7 Big Ten record and are seeded seventh in the Big Ten. Iowa will begin tournament play against tenth-seeded Penn State at 2 p.m. (CT) Thursday. All matches will be played at the Schwartz Tennis Center on the Purdue University campus.

THE HAWKEYES -- Iowa is currently ranked 56th in the FILA Collegiate Tennis Rankings. Competing for the Hawkeyes this week will be Jennifer Barnes, Merel Beelen, Kayla Berry, Kelcie Klockenga, Jacqueline Lee, Mili Veselinovic, Jessica Young, Lynne Poggensee-Wei, and Alexis Dorr. Veselinovic, ranked 82nd nationally, leads the Hawkeyes with a 25-6 overall singles record. The duo of Lee/Dorr is currently Iowa's top doubles team, with a 19-12 record.

THIS SEASON -- Iowa opened its 2008 spring season by dominating the Hawkeye Invitational against Drake, Iowa State, and Northern Iowa, ending the tournament with a 27-2 record. Lee was named co-Big Ten Athlete of the Week Jan. 20 after an outstanding performance at the Hawkeye Invitational. Iowa has since gone 12-9 in match play, and 3-7 in the conference. Senior Mili Veselinovic started the season off with a 13-match winning streak and broke the Iowa school record for career singles wins. The 82nd-ranked Veselinovic currently boasts 112 career singles wins and is on track to break the school record for most singles wins as a senior.

THE COMPETITION -- Penn State is currently unranked and posted an 8-13 overall mark and a 2-8 (Big Ten) record this season. Iowa defeated the Nittany Lions (5-2) earlier this season and boasts a 19-2 overall series record against Penn State.

LAST WEEK -- Iowa concluded regular season play on the road last weekend. The Hawkeyes traveled to West Lafayette, IN Saturday and snapped a four match losing streak by defeating Purdue 5-2. Making the trip to Champaign, IL Sunday, Iowa concluded its dual match season against 54th-ranked Illinois. Earning the doubles point to gain a 1-0 lead, the Hawkeyes were unable to win a match and lost 6-1.

LAST TIME AT BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS -- Iowa entered the 2006-07 Big Ten Championships as the fourth seed and received a bye into quarterfinal competition. The Hawkeyes found success in their first match of the tournament, defeating No. 5 Ohio State (4-2) and advancing to the semifinals. Iowa then lost to top-ranked Northwestern, 4-1.

HEAD COACH DARYL GREENAN -- Coach Daryl Greenan is in his fourth season as head coach of the Hawkeyes. Greenan led the Hawkeyes to a 12-10 overall record in 2007, going 7-3 in Big Ten competition for a fourth place league finish. Greenan was named 2006 Big Ten Coach of the Year. Greenan has a 44-26 overall record in three seasons at Iowa. Toni Neykova is the assistant coach and is in her sixth season with the Hawkeyes. She is a former member of the Hawkeye tennis team (1999-2002).

Fourth Season**

2006 Big Ten Coach of the Year Daryl Greenan is in his fourth season as head coach of the University of Iowa women's tennis team.

In just four seasons at Iowa, Greenan and the Hawkeyes have compiled a 56-35 (.620) overall record and a 26-14 (.650) mark in Big Ten play. Iowa has

finished in the top four of the conference each year, qualified for the NCAA tournament twice and crowned six academic all-Big Ten honorees.

In 2006-07, the team finished fourth in the conference and advanced to the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament for the third-straight season. Junior Jacqueline Lee was a unanimous all-Big Ten selection, going 8-5 in conference play. Junior Milica Veselinovic and sophomore Merel Beelen posted winning percentages over .700, with Veselinovic going 27-9 (.750) overall and 8-3 in Big Ten play, and Beelen going 25-7 (.780) overall and 9-2 in the conference. Despite a slower start to the season, the team picked up the pace in the spring and ended the year ranked sixth in the Midwest region and 51st in the nation.

The 2005-06 Iowa squad went 9-1 in the Big Ten and established a school-record second place finish in the conference. The team's overall record of 18-6 gave the Hawkeyes their best winning percentage (.750) in school history. Iowa qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the third consecutive year and sixth time overall. The results led to a No. 33 final national ranking. Several individuals recorded career-best seasons. Three Hawkeyes finished 9-1 in Big Ten play. Meg Racette, Milica Veselinovic and Jacqueline Lee posted league-leading 9-1 records at the number one, number three and number four positions, respectively. It's the first time three Hawkeyes earned Big Ten leading records for their position in one season. Racette was awarded all-Big Ten honors and finished 2006 ranked 35th in the nation. She became only the second Hawkeye to qualify for the NCAA singles tournament and the first to win a match in the draw. Veselinovic finished the season ranked 80th in the nation. Racette and Lee were ranked 48th nationally in doubles play. Freshman Krissy Dowlin was a Division I ITA Scholar-Athlete.

In 2004-05, Greenan led Iowa to a 14-10 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance. The Hawkeyes also recorded a 7-3 mark in the Big Ten, finishing a then school-best fourth in the league. The team ended the season ranked 45th by the Intercollegiate Tennis Association.

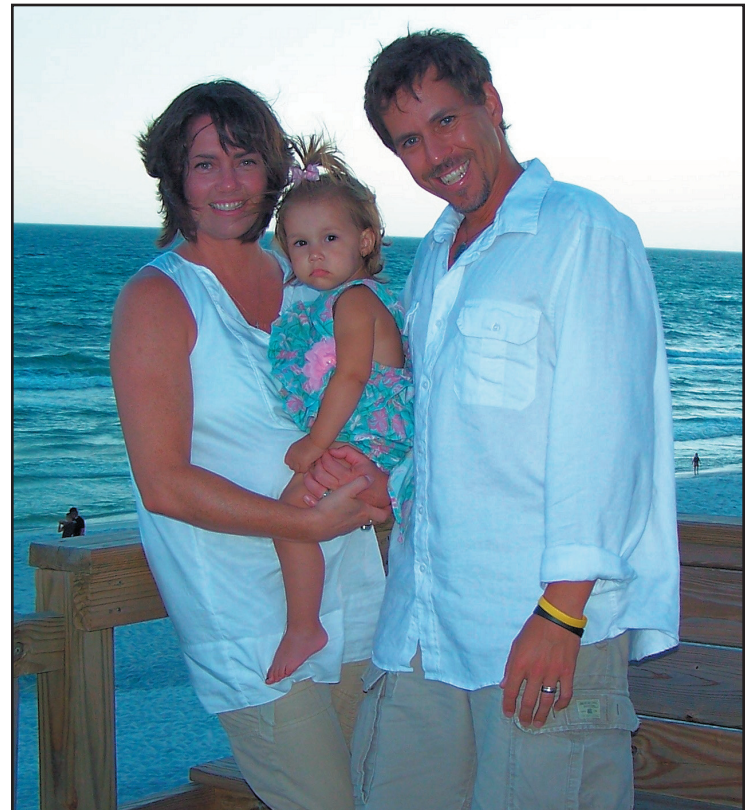
tion. Racette earned all-Big Ten honors for the second consecutive season, ending the year ranked 124th. Veselinovic set the school record for most wins by a freshman (30) in her first season at Iowa. Sophomore Hillary Mintz earned a career-high ITA individual ranking of 78th. Sophomore Hilary Tyler was a Division I ITA Scholar-Athlete. Racette was ranked 88th in the nation by ITA in singles, and the doubles team of Racette and Mintz was ranked 44th in the 2005-06 preseason.

Prior to becoming a Hawkeye, Greenan was an assistant women's tennis coach at the University of Alabama for three years. He worked under Head Coach Jenny Mainz, the Iowa women's tennis coach from 1995-1997. While at Alabama, Greenan was named the 2004 ITA South Region Assistant Coach of the Year. He helped coach the Crimson Tide to two top 30 national rankings, one top 40 national ranking and three consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament.

Greenan served as the head coach at Mississippi University for Women, in Columbus, MS, from 1998-2001. Greenan compiled a 41-25 record with the Blues. He was also an assistant men's and women's coach at Valdosta State (GA) for two years (1996-1998).

Greenan was part of the men's tennis team at Valdosta State from 1986-1988 and from 1994-1996. He was the No. 1 singles player for two seasons, and was part of the No. 1 doubles team for three seasons. Greenan was ranked in the top 20 in singles and achieved his highest doubles ranking in 1995, when he finished second in the nation. He was honored as part of the 2005 all-American team and earned All-Gulf South Conference honors three seasons. Greenan was inducted into the Valdosta State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.

Born in Ontario, Canada, Greenan currently resides in Coralville, IA, with his wife, Shannon, their two year old daughter, Willa. Greenan earned his B.S. degree in health and fitness from Valdosta State in 1997.
