Alexis Dorr pulled through in singles action with an important 6-3, 6-2 win at the sixth spot. Beelen also posted a straight-set singles win, and Molnar sealed the exciting win by downing Redesci, 6-4, 7-6 (7-5), in the final match of the day to earn Iowa's fourth point.
