

A LOOK BACK - HAWKEYE CHALLENGE

lowa opened its season last weekend in the annual Hawkeye Challenge presented by Comfort Suites. The Hawkeyes hosted Chicago State, South Dakota State, Southeast Missouri and Valparaiso on Mediacom Court in Carver-Hawkeye Arena in the two-day tournament. The Black and Gold finished 3-1 in the tournament. Iowa defeated Chicago State (3-0) and South Dakota State (3-1) on Friday to improve to 2-0. The Hawkeyes dropped a 3-2 decision to Southeast Missouri on Saturday before concluding the tournament with a 3-1 victory over Valparaiso.

IN GOOD COMPANY

Bethany Yeager became the 14th Hawkeye in program history to surpass 1,000 career digs in Iowa's season-opening sweep of Chicago State. The junior registered a match-high 21 digs in the win. She ranks first in the Big Ten with 86 digs and ranks second in digs per set (5.38). Yeager ranks 13th at Iowa in career digs (1,075).

HAWKEYE CHALLENGE HONORS

Juniors Bethany Yeager and Chante' Thompson were both named to the All-Tournament Team. Yeager registered 86 digs in the four-match tournament and added 12 assists. Thompson notched 38 kills and recorded two career-best matches.

REUNITED

Hawkeye sophomores Alessandra Dietz and Alex Lovell were high school teammates (2007-10) at Marian High School in Bloomfield Hills, Mich., which is 12 miles from the site of this weekend's matches in Rochester. The two led Marian to three division championships from 2008-10 and a pair of state titles in 2009 and 2010. Dietz and Lovell played club volleyball with Hawkeye sophomore Erin Leppek. The trio led the 17 team to a national title at the 2010 USA Volleyball National Championships and a fifth place finish at the AAU National Championships.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Three Hawkeyes notched multiple double-doubles during lowa's opening weekend of competition. Rachael Bedell (16 kills, 12 digs vs. South Dakota State and 16 kills, 17 digs vs. SEMO) and Nikki Dailey (50 assists, 19 digs vs. SEMO and 45 assists, 12 digs vs. Valparaiso) both recorded two. Alex Lovell led the way, recording three double-doubles (16 kills, 10 digs vs. South Dakota State, 17 kills, 16 digs vs. SEMO and 13 kills, 11 digs vs. Valparaiso).

SEASON OPENERS

With the win over Chicago State, head coach Sharon Dingman moved to 5-0 in season openers and 4-1 in home openers since taking over the lowa program in 2008. Since 1977, the Hawkeyes are 24-12 all-time in season openers and 27-9 all-time in home openers. Iowa has not lost a season opener since 2007 (vs. BYU, 3-2). The Hawkeyes are 3-1 under Dingman in their first game away from Iowa City.

HAWKEYE SCHEDULE

The Hawkeyes hosted the Hawkeye Challenge and make three weekend road trips before beginning their 20-match Big Ten schedule. The entire 33-match schedule includes 18 contests against teams that appeared in the 2011 NCAA Tournament. Iowa will play a home-away series with every Big Ten team except Illinois and Northwestern for the second-straight season. The Hawkeyes face the Illini once (at Carver-Hawkeye Arena, Nov. 24) and the Wildcats once (at Northwestern, Oct. 21).

BIG TEN GOES BIG IN POLLS

The Big Ten is represented by six teams in the AVCA top 25 poll, including three in the top 10. Both are equal to the most of any conference. Defending league champion Nebraska moved to No. 1 overall, followed by Penn State at No. 4 and Purdue (No. 7). Minnesota is No. 16 while Illinois, the 2011 national runner-up, sits at 19. Other top 25 residents include Michigan (No. 22). Ohio State and Michigan State are receiving votes.



Head Coach Sharon Dingman



Sharon Dingman was named the eighth coach in the history of the University of Iowa volleyball program on March 21, 2008. In four seasons at the helm of the volleyball program, she has imposed a winning attitude and established a volleyball culture that has Iowa fans excited about the immediate future.

In 2011, the Hawkeyes used their second of consecutive nationally recognized recruiting classes to continue building a program that will in time ascend

up the Big Ten Standings. Four Hawkeye freshmen combined to start 59 matches, and those four freshmen combined with four sophomores to total 62-percent of Iowa's starting lineup. The Hawkeyes' youth flourished in the non-conference season, racing to a 10-3 record and a pair of tournament championships.

In 2010, Iowa's four freshmen combined for 67 starts. The Hawkeyes started their freshman quartet four times, more than any other Big Ten school. Iowa kicked off the season with consecutive tournament championships and made program history by starting the season 3-0 for the second consecutive year. Iowa knocked off No. 16 Michigan in Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Nov. 12 to mark the third time in as many seasons Dingman and the Hawkeyes defeated a top 25 opponent.

In 2009, Dingman helped Iowa match the best start in program history by guiding the Hawkeyes to a 6-0 start. Iowa eventually became the first team in school history to start the season 7-0 on the road. The Hawkeyes captured five conference wins in 2009, raising Dingman's two-year Big Ten win total to 11, the highest two-year stretch for an Iowa volleyball team since 2000-01.

lowa set season attendance records in each of Dingman's first two seasons as head coach, including averaging a school-record 1,632 fans in 2009, the 23rd highest total in the country. Since 2008, the Hawkeyes have experienced nine of the school's top 10 all-time attendance figures, and 17 of the top 20. On November 11, 2009, the Hawkeyes eclipsed the 3,000 mark for the first time in program history when 3,102 fans saw Iowa host top-ranked Penn State. Four of Iowa's top 10 all-time attendance figures came in 2011, as fans continued to pack Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena in year four of the Dingman era.

Dingman led the Hawkeyes to their most successful campaign in recent memory in her first season at the helm. Iowa's 14 wins in 2008 were tied for the most since 2000, and its six conference victories are the most since 2000. Dingman guided the Hawkeyes to a ninth place finish in the competitive Big Ten Conference, which was the highest finish for a Hawkeye squad since 2000.

Dingman and the Hawkeyes set or snapped many streaks in a successful first season. Iowa won seven-straight matches, tying the fourth-longest winning streak in school history. The Hawkeyes also swept every opponent during the winning streak and won 15-straight sets. That was the longest set-winning streak since 1990. Iowa opened the conference season with wins over No. 18 Wisconsin and Northwestern, marking only the fifth time in school history that a Hawkeye team started 2-0 in Big Ten play. The Hawkeyes also had a winning record inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena for the first time since 1998.

The Hawkeyes also snapped conference losing streaks in Dingman's first season. Iowa defeated Ohio State for the first time in 39 tries, dating back to 1988. That win also broke an 18-match losing skid on the road in Big Ten play. Iowa's upset win over No. 18 Wisconsin snapped a 26-match losing streak against the Badgers, which went back to 1994.

Dingman set a personal milestone at Northwestern on Nov. 14 when she recorded her 350th career win in Iowa's five-set victory. Her career record stands at 384-294 in 21 seasons as a head coach.

ROAD WARRIORS

After playing its first four matches at home on Mediacom Court in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, Iowa's match Friday against Eastern Illinois marks the first of 11-straight matches away from Iowa City.

WELCOME

The Hawkeyes have six newcomers on this year's roster. They include sophomore transfers Alessandra Dietz (Loyola-Marymount, 6-1, MB) and Katie Kelley (Maryland, 5-5, DS), and true freshmen Julianne Blomberg (5-11, DS/OH), Kathleen Dailey (5-11, DS/OH), Erin Radke (6-1, RS) and Anne Yanda (5-11, S). Four newcomers -- Dietz, Kelley, Yanda, Radke -- saw action over the weekend.

HAWKEYE IRONWOMEN

Juniors Bethany Yeager and Nikki Dailey started every match last season. Dailey played in all 123 sets in 2011, while Yeager, an Academic All-Big Ten honoree, has only missed one set in her first three seasons at Iowa (244-of-245).

RETURNING LEADERS

In 2011, sophomore Alex Lovell led the team in kills and became lowa's first freshman since 2005 to surpass 300 kills in a single season, recording 312. Junior Nikki Dailey led the team a year ago in assists (1,152) and service aces (33). Junior Bethany Yeager led lowa in digs (527) for the second time in as many years.

YOU FROM AROUND HERE?

Three Hawkeyes on the 2012 roster hail from Iowa City: sophomores Kari Mueller and Katie Kelley, and redshirt freshman Alli O'Deen. Mueller competed at City High School while Kelley and O'Deen led West High School to the 2010 state title.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Senior Allison Straumann and juniors Bethany Yeager and Nikki Dailey have been voted team captains for the 2012 season. Straumann, Iowa's lone senior, has appeared in 44 career matches. Yeager and Dailey both started every match in 2011.

GIANT SLAYERS

The Hawkeyes have defeated a ranked team in three of Dingman's four seasons. Iowa will have plenty of opportunities to continue that trend, as seven of their 2012 opponents appear in the AVCA top 25 poll. Iowa's top 25 victories since 2008 include: vs. No. 18 Wisconsin (3-0, 2008); vs. No. 18 Michigan State (3-0, 2009); vs. No. 16 Michigan (3-1, 2010).

LIVE ACTION ON BTN

Ten Iowa volleyball regular season contests will be available via live coverage during the season. The Hawkeyes' matches against Penn State on Oct. 24 and at Northwestern on Oct. 21 will be shown on BTN, while eight other contests will be streamed on **BTN.com**.

2012 Coaching Staff

Sharon Dingman enters her fifth season as the head Hawkeye. She is joined by assistants **Jason Allen** and **Ben Boldt**.

Allen is in his fifth season as a assistant coach at Iowa. Allen was also promoted to the team's recruiting coordinator following the 2008 season. Allen previously served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Sam Houston State University prior to serving as the 16U head coach for the Texas Tornados club program in 2007.

Boldt enters his fourth season as an assistant coach at Iowa. Before joining the Hawkeyes, Boldt spent two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Alabama. Prior to joining Alabama, Boldt served as a staff assistant for five seasons at the University of Nebraska. In his final season, the Cornhuskers finished 33-1 en route to the NCAA Championship.

Angie Boldt is in her fifth season as the Director of Volleyball Operations. She came to Iowa City in 2008 after serving as the Director of Volleyball Operations at Alabama for two seasons.

Adam Rollman is in his first season as a volunteer assistant coach. Rollman previously served as a student assistant at Nebraska Wesleyan in 2011 and a student manager for Nebraska in the spring of 2012.
