#### **SCOUTING IOWA CUBS:**

The Hawkeyes will take on the AAA affiliate of the Chicago Cubs for the third time since Head Coach **Jack Dahm** took the helm.

The game will be the first of a tengame home stand for the I-Cubs and marks the organization's first game of the year. The Iowa Cubs will take on Round Rock and Albuquerque in a four-game series, each.

The last time the Black and Gold took on the minor league team, they competed against active MLB players: Ryan Theriot, Rich Hill, Mike Fontenot, Felix Pie and Geovany Soto.

lowa is currently 0-2 in the series. In 2004, they lost 4-2 and in 2006 they lost, 20-0.

#### SCOUTING ILLINOIS STATE:

The Redbirds are currently 9-13 and 0-6 in the MVC. They are currently on an eight game losing streak after being swept in a four-game series to No. 16 Witchita State and last weekend against Creighton.

Illinois State is led offensively by Kevin Dubler, who has a .353 batting average with eight doubles, two triples and three home runs.

Leading the Redbirds on the mound is Ryan Copeland with a 3-3 record and 2.43 ERA. Copeland is a strike throwing southpaw, who has 30 strikeouts on the year and only a mere three walks.

The Redbirds lead the series between the two schools, 8-7.

#### **SLUGGING WITH WOOD:**

In Tuesday's exhibition game, the Hawkeyes will swing the major league way: with wood.

The Hawkeyes will put away their trusty aluminum bats and sport the traditional wooden bats that their opponents use regularly.

lowa will be bringing the heavy lumber, having used wooden bats in their fall series and also in practice.

#### **MICHIGAN SUMMARY:**

The Hawkeyes were swept in their Big Ten opening series against No. 25 Michigan last weekend in Ann Arbor, MI.

**Kevin Hoef** led the Black and Gold offensively, going 4-for-14 (.286) with a double, triple, two-RBIs and scoring three Iowa runs. **Justin Brauer** was 3-for-8 (.375) and scored a run. **Kody McManis** was 1-for-4 (.250) and was hit by two pitches.

lowa lost 3-2 Sunday in the nightcap of a doubleheader against Michigan. Despite the rainy and cold Ann Arbor weather, lowa scattered five hits and fell to 7-12 and 0-4 in the Big Ten. Michigan got its first Big Ten sweep of the year, improving to 13-6 and 4-0 in the conference.

**Tony Manville** started on the hill for lowa and held the Michigan offense off balance for three scoreless innings in his second start as a Hawkeye. He allowed two runs, one of them earned, on six hits in four innings.

The Hawkeyes dropped their third game Sunday, 6-3 in seven innings. In the loss lowa scattered nine hits, including three doubles, and utilized the sacrifice.


**Nick Erdman** started on the mound for Iowa and received the Ioss. He went five innings, allowing five earned runs on 11 hits.

The Black and Gold lost the second game of a doubleheader against No. 25 Michigan Saturday, 5-3. In the loss, lowa utilized the sacrifice and scored the first three runs.

**Brock Alberts** received the loss and pitched six innings allowing two earned runs on five Wolverine hits. Alberts kept the Michigan offense scoreless for the first four innings.

The Hawkeyes fell to Michigan in their Big Ten season opener in ten innings, 4-3. In the loss, Iowa capitalized on three Wolverine errors in the seventh and manufactured runs against Zach Putman.

In the Hawkeye loss, the lowa pitching staff threw consistently throughout the ten innings. **Michael Jacobs** went seven and one-third innings allowing two earned runs on seven hits and walking no one. The Black and Gold bullpen included **Andrew Porter**. Porter got the loss, dropping his record to 1-1.

HAWKEYE SIGN EIGHT FOR 2009: The Iowa Baseball program has signed eight recruits for next year. Nick Brown, Sean Flanagan, Cory Glieden, Jarred Hippen, Mike McQuillan, Zach Robertson, Phil Schreiber and Chett Zeise all signed national letters of intent to attend the University of Iowa.

## Head Coach Jack Dahm



Jack Dahm is in his fifth season as head coach of the University of Iowa baseball team. He has compiled an 392-409-2 overall record and is 109-133 at Iowa.

Last season, lowa took another step forward by recording its best record in 14 years with a 31-23 mark. The Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13. Iowa earned its second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

In Dahm's 14 years as a head coach, he has produced 23 first team allconference performers, seven freshmen All-Americans and two All-Americans. In his four years at Iowa, Dahm has coached 19 all-Big Ten selections, including seven first teamers.

Before coming to Iowa City, Dahm spent 18 years as a member of the Creighton Bluejay baseball program. He left the Bluejays as the winningest coach in school history, having compiled 283 wins against 276 losses in 10 seasons as a head coach.

Twenty-seven of Dahm's players have been selected in the MLB Draft, while four have gone on to play in the major leagues. In the past three years, nine Hawkeyes have inked contracts with professional teams, including three this past spring.

In the classroom, Iowa is in the 90th-percentile in the NCAAs Academic Progress Report, placing them in the top 30 baseball programs, academically. During his Iowa tenure, Dahm has seen 33 players named academic all-Big Ten, including a team-record ten players in 2006. That is the best four-year total in the history of the program.

The 41-year old Dahm and his wife, Lynn, have been married 14 years. The couple has three children - sons Casey and Tyler and daughter Lyndsey.

Jim coached Ryan at Evansville and later gave him a position as assistant coach, under him, at Evansville for a few years.

The Illinois State head coach is in his 29th career season with the Redbirds. With his 820 victories as head coach, Jim ranks in the top-40 among all NCAA Division I coaches.

#### McMANIS BATTLES:

Junior **Kody McManis** showed off his versatility this past weekend as he battled from behind the plate.

The infielder turned catcher got sufficient playing time in Ann Arbor due to a nagging thumb injury sustained by **Tyson Blaser** and from a re-sprained ankle by **Ben Geelan** in game one.

McManis was 1-for-4 on the weekend and is hitting .357 on the year.

#### SUCCESSFUL WITH RUNNERS :

The Iowa offense took advantage of base runners in its Big Ten season opener against Michigan. The Hawkeyes hit 8-for-8 (1.000) with runners on third and less then two outs.


The Black and Gold also hit .558 when there were runners to advance and .500 with the bases loaded.

#### **DIAMOND THIEVES:**

This season the Hawkeyes have out-run their opponents, going 44for-56. Leading lowa in steals is **Caleb Curry** with 13. **Kevin Hoef** with seven, and **Justin Toole** and **Kyle Riffel** have six.

#### UTILIZING RUNNERS ON THIRD:

The Hawkeyes are hitting .635 with runners on third as a team. The Black and Gold are led by **Kurtis Muller** who is hitting .833 in the situation and **Caleb Curry** who is hitting .818.

#### **PITCHING HIGHLIGHTS:**

In their opening weekend in the Big Ten, the lowa pitching staff posted a mere 3.41 ERA.

The Black and Gold were led by starter **Tony Manville** and relievers **Andrew Porter** and **Kyle Heim**, allowing no earned runs in 10 innings.

A quality start by **Michael Jacobs** was also a weekend highlight. Jacobs allowed no walks in seven and one-third innings pitched.

On the season, Porter (1.08) and Heim (1.84) lead the pitching staff in ERA. **Jason Belk** leads the team with a 3.0 strikeout to walk ratio.

An astounding 13 lowa pitchers have seen action so far this year, throwing 166 and two-thirds innings.

BY THE NUMBERS IN THE BIG TEN:

**Caleb Curry** has taken the Big Ten by storm, when compared with the league's players he ranks in the top ten in: batting average (.403), on base percentage (.477), runs batted in (22) and stolen bases (13).

Other Hawkeyes who rank well in the conference include: **Justin Toole** is second in runs batted in (23) and second in sac bunts (4), **Kevin Hoef** leads the league in hit-by-pitches (9), is tied for third in runs scored (22) and is tied for eighth in stolen bases (7). **Kyle Riffel** is second in the league in hit-by-pitches (6) and **Matt Mossey** is tied for fourth in doubles (7). **Kurtis Muller** leads the league in sac bunts (5). **Andrew Porter** is tied for first in appearances (11).

#### CURRY RECEIVES HONOR:

Senior **Caleb Curry** received *CollegeBaseballHub.com*'s Heartland Hitter of the Week honor for his performance against Rutgers.

Curry went 8-for-13 with seven RBI, two walks and three runs scored in the series.

#### **BIG TEN PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:**

Wes Freie was named Big Ten Player of the Week on March 4. In addition, **Brock Alberts** earned co-Pitcher of the Week accolades, sharing the honor with Phil Isaksson.

Freie had a stellar weekend helping lead lowa to a 2-1 record, including a 6-3 upset win over fifth-ranked Vanderbilt, at the Music City Classic in Nashville, TN. The first baseman, who was named tournament MVP, was 9-for-12 with a double, home run, two RBI and two walks. The junior led the Black and Gold against No. 5 Vanderbilt, going a perfect 4-for-4 with an RBI.

Alberts had a great season debut in lowa's come-from-behind win over Xavier Feb. 29. The senior right hander threw five and one-third innings in relief for the win. He allowed no runs, scattered five hits with no walks and struck out a career-high 10 of the 21 batters he faced.

# 2008 MUSIC CITY CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM:

After going 2-1 at the tournament and upsetting Vanderbilt, the Hawkeyes received six of the 12 spots on the all-tournament team, including the MVP.

Hawkeyes honored were: Justin Toole at second, Kevin Hoef at shortstop, Kyle Riffel in the outfield, Caleb Curry in the outfield and Wes Freie as utility and MVP.

#### SCHEDULE STRENGTH:

Iowa will play one of its toughest schedules in 2008 as it will face nine teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament last season. The Hawkeyes will welcome NCAA Tournament teams Minnesota, Nebraska and Ohio State to Iowa City and will take on Albany, Creighton, Michigan, Rutgers, Stetson and Vanderbilt on the road. Iowa will face three teams in conference action that advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

#### LAST SEASON:

lowa posted a 31-23 record in 2007, the Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13, and earned their second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

During the season, Iowa defeated five teams (Nebraska, Fresno State, Ohio State, Minnesota and Michigan) that reached the NCAA Tournament. The Hawkeyes also posted a 12-game winning streak, which is the second-longest in school history. Included in the streak was a schoolrecord 10-game Big Ten winning streak.

#### SAME FACES, NEW PLACES:

When you look around the diamond this season, your eyes don't deceive you. There are several familiar faces in the lineup playing different positions. Junior **Kevin Hoef** moved from third base to shortstop, while senior **Caleb Curry** moved to center field from left field.

#### HAWKEYES HIT THE CLASSROOM:

In October, the Iowa baseball team was awarded the 2007 NCAA Public Recognition Award for being in the 90% percentile of Academic Progress Report (APR) for baseball.

#### THE ASSISTANT COACHES:

Head Coach Jack Dahm is assisted by coach Ryan Brownlee and coach Nick Zumsande, along with volunteer coach Kris Welker and Director of Baseball Matt Haddy.

**Ryan Brownlee** enters his fifth season as lowa's hitting, infield instructor and recruiting coordinator.

As hitting coach, Brownlee saw the team's batting average vault 55 points from 2005 to 2007 (.269 to .324). Additionally, the team also scored more runs (273 to 401) had more RBIs (249 to 345) and walks (152 to 245) during that time span. **Nick Zumsande** enters his fifth year as the lowa pitching coach.

Under Zumsande's guidance, the Hawkeye pitching has had a pitcher named first team all-Big Ten three of the last four years, and a pitcher named allconference in each of his four years.

**Kris Welker** is in his second year as the team's volunteer assistant. Welker works with the lowa catchers and outfielders, prepares scouting reports and coaches first base.

As a senior, Welker earned third team all-Big Ten honors, helping lowa to a third-place finish in the Big Ten and a trip to the conference tournament. He led the team with a .354 batting average, 46 RBIs and 16 doubles. Welker also received the Bob Oldis, Jr MVP Award

**Matt Haddy** is in his third season as the Director of Baseball Operations for the University of Iowa.

He assists the coaching staff with the day-to-day operations and administrative areas of the program. Haddy also serves as the travel coordinator and director of Hawkeye Baseball Camps.

#### **KEEPING IT IN THE FAMILY :**

Hawkeye baseball ties run deep, and it shows in the support staff. Baseball administrator **Fred Mims**, academic advisor **Troy Wulf** and volunteer assistant coach **Kris Welker** are all former lowa baseball players.


