ON THE MAT

The University of Iowa wrestling team travels to Bradley, Ill., to face Purdue on Friday at 6:30 p.m. (CT). Bradley-Bourbannais High School will host the dual. Admission is \$7.

The Hawkeye return to Carver-Hawkeye Arena to host Michigan State on Saturday at 7 p.m. Admission is \$12 for adults, \$8 for youth, and free for UI students and children five years old and younger.

BIG TEN OPENERS

Head Coach Tom Brands owns a 51-5 Big Ten record in seven seasons, including 7-0 in conference openers. He is 27-1 all-time at home in Big Ten duals.

THE SERIES -- PURDUE

The Hawkeyes lead the all-time series 38-4-3 and have won the last 26 meetings between the two schools.

Iowa owns an 18-3-1 advantage at Purdue. The Boilermakers are hosting this year's dual at Bradley-Bourbonnais High School in Bradley, Ill.

Iowa won the last meeting between the schools, 29-9 last year in Iowa City. Iowa hasn't lost to Purdue on the road since Feb. 27, 1954 (L, 16-10).

THE SERIES -- MICHIGAN STATE

The Hawkeyes have won five straight meetings with the Spartans and hold a 35-15-2 lead in the all-time series.

Iowa hasn't lost to Michigan State at home since Feb. 5, 2006 (L, 19-17).

Iowa won the most recent meeting, 27-12, last season at Michigan State.

GILMAN NAMED BIG WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

University of Iowa freshman Thomas Gilman was named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week on Dec. 31. The conference honor was the first of his career.

Gilman defeated defending NCAA Champion Jesse Delgado and defending Midlands champion Jarrod Garnett to win the 125-pound title at the 2013 Midlands Championship. He topped Delgado, 3-1, in the semis before defeating Garnett, 6-1, in the finals. He also registered a major decision in the opening round and a 6-3 win over No. 7

Dylan Peters in the quarterfinals.

Gilman is 10-2 this season with three wins over ranked opponents, two major decisions, two falls, and one technical fall. He is ranked No. 3 in the most recent InterMat rankings.

HAWKEYES DOMINATE

The Hawkeyes won three individual titles and scored a tournament-record 187.5 points to win the 51st annual Midlands Championships on Dec. 30.

Thomas Gilman (125), Derek St. John (157), and Mike Evans (174) each won their first career Midlands titles as the Hawkeyes won their record 23rd Midlands team championship. Iowa placed 14 wrestlers in the top eight, including 10 inside the top three.

Tony Ramos (133), Nick Moore (165), Ethen Lofthouse (174), and Bobby Telford (285) each finished runner-up at their respective weight class.

Josh Dzewa won a 3-1 decision in the 141-pound third-place match, and Brandon Sorensen topped Brody Grothus, 4-2, for third place at 149. Nathan Burak placed third at 197, and Sammy Brooks (184) and Cory Clark (125) each placed sixth.

24 AND COUNTING FOR ST. JOHN

Senior Derek St. John has won a team-best 24 straight matches dating back to last season. His last defeat was a 5-4 loss to Nebraska's James Green in the semifinals of the Big Ten Championships. He won two matches in the consolation bracket to place third, and then won five straight at the national tournament to win the 157-pound NCAA title. He has opened the 2013-14 season with 17 straight wins. The 24-match win streak is the longest of St. John's career.

UNDEFEATED HAWKEYES

Cory Clark (12-0) and Derek St. John (17-0) enter the weekend with undefeated records. Clark lost to Jarrod Garnett in the semifinals of the Midlands Championships, but Garnett was wrestling as a member of the Bison Wrestling Club and the match does not count toward Clark's college record.

In the history of Iowa wrestling, 15 wrestlers have finished the season with a perfect record (minimum 20 matches). Four of those wrestlers were able to perform the feat

twice. They include Mark Ironside, Lincoln McClravy, T.J. Williams and Jim Zalesky. Iowa coaches Tom Brands and Terry Brands are among the 15 wrestlers. Tom went 45-0 in 1990-91 and Terry went 35-0 in 1991-92.

RAMOS HITS 100-WIN PLATEAU

All-American Tony Ramos won four matches en route to the Midlands finals, picking up career win No. 100 along the way. Ramos is 101-14 all-time. He is the 19th wrestler in program history to reach 100 career wins. His 101 wins rank No. 37 all-time.

Ramos has a perfect 27-0 record inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Ramos owns a 57-2 all-time record in duals, including a 23-2 all-time record in Big Ten duals.

Ranked No. 4 at 133 pounds, Ramos has recorded seven falls this season. He entered the season with 24 career pins, and has since raised his career total to 31. He recorded two falls as a redshirt freshman, eight falls as a sophomore, and 14 falls last season as a junior. Ramos needs 44 career falls to tie Chuck Yagla for 10th all-time in career pins.

Brent Metcalf, who scored 47 pins from 2008-10, was the last Hawkeye to crack the top 10 list. Prior to Metcalf, the list had not changed since Terry Brands (48), Tom Brands (46), and Mark Reiland (45) ended their careers in 1992.

SWEET 16 FOR EVANS

Junior Mike Evans has scored bonus points in 16-of-17 wins this year. Evans has a recorded seven falls, and leads the team with four major decisions and five technical falls.

Evans racked up three pins and two majors en route to his first Midlands title Dec. 30. He is 17-1 this season and has a career record of 66-16, including a 20-1 all-time mark inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

GROTHUS BREAKS INTO RANKINGS

Brody is ranked No. 15 at 149 pounds in the most recent Intermat rankings.

Grothus went 6-2 en route to a third-place finish at the Midlands Championships. He avenged an earlier season loss to No. 8 Dave Habat, pinning Habat in 1:38. He also topped No. 2 Jason Tsirtsis of Northwestern, 3-2. Grothus is 15-5 overall with four falls.

NCAA EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeyes have seven wrestlers with NCAA Championship experience in the lineup. Senior Derek St. John (157) is the defending national champion at 157 pounds and a three-time All-American. Seniors Ethen Lofthouse (184) and Tony Ramos (133) are three-time NCAA qualifiers and two-time All-Americans. Juniors Mike Evans (174) and Bobby Telford (285) are two-time NCAA qualifiers. Telford earned All-America honors in 2012, while Evans earned All-America honors in 2013. Junior Nick Moore (165) and sophomore Nathan Burak (197) both qualified for their first NCAA Championships in 2013.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 932-223-31 (.799) in 104 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 52 NCAA Champions have won a total of 80 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 105 Big Ten champions have won a total of 190 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 28 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 148 All-Americans have earned All-America status 301 times, including 17 four-time, 32 three-time and 38 two-time honorees.

ALL-AMERICAN STREAK

The Hawkeyes have crowned at least one All-American every year since 1972, a span of 42 seasons. Iowa has totaled 255 All-America honors during that stretch. The Hawkeyes return five All-Americans to this year's squad. Tony Ramos (2nd-133), Derek St. John (1st-157), Mike Evans (6th-174) and Ethen Lofthouse (5th-184) join 2012 All-American Bobby Telford (5th-285) in the 2013-14 lineup.

40 YEARS OF DOMINANCE

Since 1974, only seven schools have captured the NCAA Championship. During that 40-year span, the Hawkeyes have won 23 team titles, including nine straight from 1978-86. The other schools include Oklahoma State (7), Minnesota (3), Penn State (3), Iowa State (2), Arizona State (1) and Oklahoma (1).

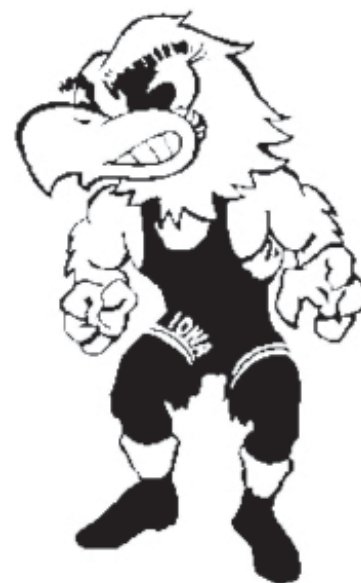

Tom Brands
Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 137-14-1 (.905) overall and 51-5 (.911) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 154-33-1 (.822) career mark.

In seven seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning eight NCAA champions, 10 Big Ten champions and 38 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 53 academic all-Big Ten honorees, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 62 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last seven years, sending the entire 10-man

lineup in 2009-10. Iowa has also won five of the last six Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, Iowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when it hosted Iowa State Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The previous record of 15,646 was set Feb. 1, 2002, when Minnesota hosted Iowa at the Target Center in Minneapolis. The Hawkeyes won the Iowa State dual, 20-15. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' six seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
