Program Quick Hits

- Iowa is one of 10 teams in the country, and the only Big Ten team, to have appeared in the last eight NCAA Tournaments. There are 349 Division I teams.
- The Hawkeyes made their first Sweet Sixteen appearance since 1996, and their sixth overall, last season.
- Iowa is 1-of-21 teams to advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in each of the last two seasons.
- Iowa ended the season with a No. 11 national ranking in the *USA Today* Top 25 Coaches' Poll -- the highest for the program since 1995-96 (No. 7 in AP, No. 9 in *USA Today*). The Hawkeyes appeared in the rankings in all 20 weeks of the season.
- The Hawkeyes finished undefeated at home for the first time since 1995-96 last season, setting a program record with 18 wins. Iowa was one of 13 teams nationally to finish undefeated at home during the regular season and one of four to finish undefeated at home when playing at least 16 home games (Baylor, Tennessee, and Wichita State).
- The Hawkeyes ended the 2014-15 year ranked sixth nationally in scoring offense (79.5), setting a new school record for the second consecutive season. In 2013-14, Iowa finished the season with an average of 78.2 points per game.
- Iowa returns two starters in junior Ally Disterhoft and sophomore Whitney Jennings. The 2015-16 roster is comprised of four freshman, four sophomores, three juniors, and three seniors.
- The 2015-16 squad gained valuable experience this August. The Hawkeyes spent 11 days together on the Italian Tour, which included three games, and benefitted from 10 practice days leading up to the trip.
- Iowa's 2015 recruiting class of Tania Davis (Michigan Miss Basketball), Hannah Stewart (North Dakota Miss Basketball), Megan Gustafson (all-time leading scorer in Wisconsin high school basketball history), and Tagyn Larson (four-time all-state, all-city, and all-conference player) came in with a No. 17 national ranking by ESPN HoopGurlz.
- Junior Ally Disterhoft was named a preseason All-Big Ten player by the coaches in October. As a sophomore, she earned second team All-Big Ten honors from both the coaches and the media. As a freshman, she was named honorable mention All-Big Ten by the coaches and media and to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team.
- Sixteenth-year UI head coach Lisa Bluder has led Iowa to three consecutive 20-win seasons and eight overall. She was the recipient of the WBCA's Carol Eckman Award in 2015.

THE SETTING

The University of Iowa women's basketball team will face Michigan inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Thursday, Jan. 28 at 7 p.m. It is the second matchup between the programs this season, as the Wolverines topped the Hawkeyes, 82-75, on Jan. 7 in Ann Arbor, Michigan.

GAME COVERAGE

- Fans can watch Thursday's game live online on BTN Plus, available at btn2go.com.
- Live audio of the game can be heard on select Hawkeye Radio Network affiliate stations and on Hawkeye All-Access available at hawkeyesports.com. Brent Balbinot and Kathryn Reynolds will call the action.
- Balbinot is in his 12th season as Iowa's play-by-play voice.
- Reynolds, a member of the infamous Core Four and team captain for the Hawkeyes in 2014-15, is pursuing a law degree at the University of Iowa.

SERIES HISTORY

- Iowa leads Michigan, 46-16, in the all-time series.
- In games played in Iowa City, the Hawkeyes lead the series, 23-7. Iowa has not lost to the Wolverines on its home court since 2012-13.
- The Wolverines won the first matchup of the season, 82-73, in the Crisler Center on Jan. 7, ending the Hawkeyes' three-game win streak against Michigan. It was Iowa's first loss to Michigan on the road since 2009-10 (63-64).

SCOUTING THE WOLVERINES

- Michigan is 11-8 overall and 3-5 in conference play heading into Thursday night.
- The Wolverines have posted Big Ten wins against Iowa, 82-75, at Minnesota, 93-86, and at Penn State, 91-87.
- As a team, Michigan averages 81.5 points per game. Katelynn Flaherty (21.7) and Hallie Thome (13.4) average double figures in scoring.
- Michigan is outscoring (+12.7) and outrebounding (+6.4) its opponents so far this season.
- The Wolverines, comprised of four freshmen, four sophomores, two juniors, and here seniors, are led by fourth-year head coach Kim Barnes Arico.

SEASON REWIND

- The Wolverines scored 30 points in the fourth quarter to earn a comeback win over the Hawkeyes, 82-75, on Jan. 7 in Ann Arbor, Michigan.
- Sophomore Chase Coley had her highest scoring effort in conference play, leading the team with 18 points, followed by junior Ally Disterhoft and freshman Megan Gustafson, who each compiled 14 points.
- The inside game was very successful for the Hawkeyes, as Gustafson made 5-of-6 field goals and 4-of-4 free throws and Coley sunk 7-of-10 field goals and 4-of-4 free throws. Both also added two blocks and three rebounds apiece.
- Iowa's bench contributed 24 points in the game.

QUICK HITS

- Iowa, a team that has played the 28th most difficult schedule in the country so far this season, is No. 48 in the latest RPI release. Michigan is No. 78 in the RPI rankings.
- Iowa is the only team this season to outrebound Maryland, edging the Terrapins 38-37 in the category.
- The Hawkeyes have outrebounded 12 of 20 opponents this season, averaging 39.1 rebounds per game for a +1.6 margin.
- Iowa averages 73.0 points per game and owns a +3.6 scoring margin. Ally Disterhoft (16.6), Alexa Kastanek (10.8), and Chase Coley (10.2) average double figures in scoring.
- Thursday's game against Michigan is the ninth game of the conference slate, signaling the halfway point of Big Ten regular season play.
- Iowa debuted a new starting lineup at Purdue in guard Tania Davis, guard Whitney Jennings, forward Ally Disterhoft, forward Chase Coley, and center Megan Gustafson. It marked the first career start for Gustafson and the third for Davis.

BUTTENHAM BREAKS OUT

- Sophomore Christina Buttenham came off the bench at Purdue for her best collegiate performance yet.
- The forward had a near perfect outing, sinking 5-of-6 field goals including a perfect 3-for-3 mark from three-point land, to set new career high with 14 points.
- She also posted three rebounds, one steal, and one assist in her career high 27 minutes.
- At 6-0, Buttenham leads the Hawkeyes in offensive rebounds in conference play (16) and is third in total rebounds (32).

CALL ON ME

- Junior Ally Disterhoft, a preseason All-Big Ten selection by league coaches, has been a consistent force for the Hawkeyes all season.
- The 6-0 forward paces Iowa in points (16.6) and rebounds (5.6) per game. She is also second in assists, averaging 2.9 per contest.
- She has scored double figures in every game of the season and in 65 of 71 career starts.
- The Iowa City, Iowa, native has led Iowa in scoring in 10 of 20 games this season, scoring 20 points or more in five contests.
- Disterhoft owns a .523 field goal percentage, .357 three-point field goal percentage, and .750 free throw percentage.
- She currently ranks 19th on Iowa's all-time scoring list with 1,309 career points and 21st all-time with 541 career rebounds. Disterhoft is the 34th player in program history to surpass the 1,000 career point threshold.

BREAKOUT PERFORMANCE

- Freshman Tania Davis, Miss Michigan Basketball in 2014-15, made a statement in her return to the Breslin Center in East Lansing, Michigan, on Jan. 16, where she won state titles with Goodrich High School in 2012 and 2013.
- Davis led the Hawkeyes with a career-high 16 points and a career-high matching five assists at Michigan State. She matched another career-high with six rebounds in the contest.
- In the first half, Davis was 3-for-3, sinking all three of her three-point field goal attempts.
- The Grand Blanc, Michigan, native closed the game with a .417 field goal percentage (5-12), and an .800 three-point field goal percentage (4-5).
- Davis used her performance against the Spartans as a springboard in to the Penn State game on Jan. 20 in Iowa City, Iowa. She tallied career-highs with a team-leading six assists and four steals, and posted nine points and three rebounds to provide a spark off the bench for Iowa.
- On Jan. 24 at Purdue, Davis earned her way back in the starting lineup. She posted 14 points and dished out a career-high seven assists in her third career start.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir), the all-time winningest coach in program history, is in her 16th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 32nd season as a college head coach.

Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 14 postseason appearances (12 NCAA and two WNIT) in 15 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in each of the last eight seasons. Iowa is the only team in the Big Ten, and one of 10 in NCAA Division I women's basketball, to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the last eight years. There are 349 Division I teams.

Bluder, the 2015 Carol Eckman Award winner, has posted a 317-181 (.637) record at Iowa and her career record stands at 673-323 (.676). Bluder surpassed Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as the all-time winningest coach in program history on Feb. 10, 2014, as the Hawkeyes defeated Northwestern, 90-84.

Bluder, 1-of-10 active major college coaches with 600 or more wins, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010) and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year (2001 and 2008). She has guided Iowa to a winning record in 14 of her 15 years at Iowa, including 11 upper-division finishes in the challenging Big Ten Conference. Bluder, who ranks fourth among Big Ten coaches all-time in league victories (152), has led Iowa to nine 20-win seasons in her 15 years, including seven of the last eight years.

Bluder has coached numerous players to different awards in her 15 years in Iowa City. She has mentored 19 players to 46 All-Big Ten honors, including 12 first team picks, 16 second, 11 third and eight honorable mention selections. She has also had two Big Ten Freshman of the Year award winners, two Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year recipients, six members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team and three players named to the Big Ten All-Defensive team, with Kachine Alexander earning the honor twice.

Five players during Bluder's tenure have earned a total of seven Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) all-region team accolades and six players have earned a total of 11 honorable mention All-America honors. Bluder coached her first consensus All-American in Samantha Logic, who earned the honor after being named a WBCA Division I Coaches All-American, USBWA All-American, ESPN Second Team All-American, and Third Team Associated Press All-American.

With Bluder on the Iowa sidelines, student-athletes have been named Academic All-Big Ten 75 times, including a program-best eight honorees in 2011 and 2012. The 75 honorees equal the third-highest total in the Big Ten during the last 15 years.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five postseason appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

REBOUNDING EDGE

- The Hawkeyes have outrebounded 12 of 20 opponents this season, averaging 39.1 rebounds per game for a +1.6 rebounding margin.
- Iowa is the only team to rebound Maryland this year, edging the Terrapins, 38-37, in the category.
- Eight of 13 active players have pulled down 51 or more rebounds through 20 games. Junior Ally Disterhoft (112) and senior Kali Peschel (101) lead the team with 5.6 and 5.3 rebounds per game, respectively.
- In 2014-15, Iowa averaged 36.4 rebounds per game and owned a -4.6 rebounding margin. Only six players on the roster posted 50 or more rebounds in the 34-game season.

COMING ON STRONG

- Sophomore point guard Whitney Jennings has hit her stride, improving significantly in conference play.
- In five of eight league games, Jennings has scored in double figures (10 vs. Rutgers; 10 vs. Maryland; 11 at Wisconsin; 15 at Michigan State; 11 vs. Penn State).
- The Logansport, Indiana, native is second on the team with 24 assists, and owns a .400 field goal percentage and a .346 three-point field goal percentage in conference contests. She averages 9.8 points per game in conference games.
- In all 20 games, she averages 8.7 points per game, and is shooting .339 from field goal range and .296 from beyond the arc.

MOVING UP THE CHARTS

- Junior Ally Disterhoft is 19th on Iowa's all-time scoring list with 1,309 career points and 21st all-time with 541 career rebounds.
- She has played in every game of her Hawkeye career with 71 consecutive starts.
- Disterhoft has scored in double figures in every game this season, and in 65 of her 71 career starts.
- The co-captain leads Iowa in points (16.6) and rebounds per game (5.6).
- Freshman Megan Gustafson has compiled 31 blocks through 20 games played this season, which is fourth on the all-time freshman list at Iowa. The record at Iowa in a freshman season is 79 blocks, set by Morgan Johnson in 2009-10.

DISTERHOFT MAKES HISTORY

Junior Ally Disterhoft became the 34th player in Iowa women's basketball history to reach the 1,000 career points mark. The Iowa City, Iowa, native scored 20 points in season-opening action against North Dakota and surpassed the 1,000-point threshold with 11 points against UT Martin on Nov. 15.

HAWKEYES HOLD OFF BADGERS

- The Hawkeyes held off of a fourth quarter surge to record a road win at Wisconsin, 57-54, on Jan. 13.
- Ally Disterhoft led the team in scoring with 18 points, hitting 8-of-9 field goals. Whitney Jennings joined her in double figures with 11 points.
- Christina Buttenham came off the bench to match her career-high and pace the Hawkeyes in rebounds with six, four offensive and two defensive.
- Iowa outrebounded the Badgers, 36-28.
- Depth made a difference for the Hawkeyes, as their bench outscored the Badger reserves, 12-2.

HOT SHOOTING HAWKS TOP RUTGERS

- Iowa shot a season-high 54.5 percent to earn its second consecutive conference win over Rutgers on Jan. 4.
- Four Hawkeyes scored in double figures, including Alexa Kastanek (20), Ally Disterhoft (15), Chase Coley (10) and Whitney Jennings (10).
- Kastanek sunk five three-pointers, one from tying her career-high, to lead the Hawkeyes offensively.
- Megan Gustafson came off the bench for three blocks, six points, and a team-high six rebounds in her 20 minutes. She has blocked three or more shots in five of 20 games of her freshman season.
- Iowa outrebounded the Scarlet Knights, 34-31, in the contest.

BIG OPENER, BIG SUCCESS

- Iowa opened its Big Ten Conference slate on the road with a win at Nebraska, 74-68, on Dec. 31. It is the lone matchup against the Huskers this season.
- The Hawkeyes have won four consecutive games against the Huskers, dating back the 2014-15 season when Iowa topped Nebraska three times.
- Iowa dominated the boards in the contest, outrebounding Nebraska, 51-29.
- Iowa shot 45.6% from field goal range, 35% from three-point land, and 78.9% from the charity stripe in the win.
- Three Hawkeyes scored in double figures, led by junior Ally Disterhoft who netted 17 points. She added 11 rebounds for her first double-double of the year.
- Sophomore Chase Coley and Lincoln, Nebraska, native junior Alexa Kastanek scored 16 and 13 points, respectively.



A QUALITY NONCONFERENCE START

- Iowa compiled a 10-2 record in nonconference action, facing challenging opponents at home and on the road to prepare for Big Ten play.
- The Hawkeyes won seven of 12 nonconference games by 10 or more points.
- In the first 12 games, Iowa outscored, outrebounded, outassisted, and outblocked its opponents.
- The Hawkeyes own a .440 field goal percentage, .771 free throw percentage, and .309 three-point field goal percentage in nonconference action.
- Iowa had four or more players score in double figures in seven of the 12 nonconference games played. A season-high six scored in double figures for the Hawkeyes against Drake on Dec. 22, including Ally Disterhoft (20), Megan Gustafson (16), Whitney Jennings (15), Alexa Kastanek (15), Chase Coley (11), and Tania Davis (10).

DISTERHOFT EARNS BIG HONOR ROLL RECOGNITION... AGAIN

- Junior Ally Disterhoft was named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll on Dec. 28, after helping Iowa defeat intrastate rival Drake, 89-76.
- The 6-0 forward scored a team-high 20 points, tied for the team lead with seven rebounds, and dished out four assists against the Bulldogs. It was her fourth time scoring 20 points or more in a game this season.
- The Iowa City, Iowa native, hit 6-of-9 field goals, including a 3-of-6 performance from beyond the arc in the game.
- She has scored in double figures in all 20 games this season and in 65 of 71 career starts.
- Disterhoft was also named to the Big Ten Honor Roll on Dec. 7, after guiding the Hawkeyes to a pair of wins at Virginia and against Robert Morris.

DISTERHOFT NAMED TO WBCA ALL STATE GOOD WORKS TEAM

- Junior Ally Disterhoft was named to the 2016 WBCA Allstate Good Works Team on Dec. 2.
- Student-athletes are recognized for making outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement, and for their leadership on and off the court.
- Disterhoft was nominated for raising helmet awareness for moped riders in the Iowa City area and has a close connection to Live Like Line (#LLL) cause.

DISTERHOFT EARNS PRESEASON HONOR

Junior forward Ally Disterhoft was named a preseason All-Big Ten honoree by league coaches. The two-year starter and team-elected co-captain, was a second team All-Big Ten selection in 2015, and an honorable mention All-Big Ten honoree, Big Ten All-Freshman Team member, and Big Ten All-Tournament Team selection in 2014.

The Iowa City, Iowa, native entered the season 34th all-time in scoring at Iowa with 977 career points. Disterhoft -- the only sophomore to be named a CoSIDA Capital One Academic All-American in 2014-15 -- led the Hawkeyes in points (503) and points per game (14.8) last season.

HAWKEYES IN BIG TEN PLAY

Iowa head coach Lisa Bluder is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010). She has guided Iowa to 11 upper-division finishes in the Big Ten in 15 seasons. Iowa won a share of the Big Ten regular season championship in 2008 and finished in a three-way tie for second in 2009. The Hawkeyes clinched a share of the title in 2008 with a win at Wisconsin in the regular season finale (March 2, 2008). In conference games alone, Bluder owns a 155-101 (.605) record at Iowa.

Since the 2008 season, Iowa has finished first once, second three times, third twice, fourth once, and seventh once. Iowa finished second in the inaugural 14-team league in 2015.

DISTERHOFT RECOGNIZED AS STUDENT-ATHLETE OF THE MONTH

- UI Student-Athlete Academic Services recognized junior Ally Disterhoft as the November female Student-Athlete of the Month on Dec. 7.
- The co-captain and three-year starter for the Hawkeyes became the 34th player in program history to score 1,000 career points in the second game of the season.
- Through 20 games played, Disterhoft leads the team in points (16.6) and rebounds per game (5.6), and is second in assists (5.7).
- The 6-0 forward was named to the Big Ten Honor Roll on Dec. 7 and again on Dec. 28.

2016 Recruiting Class

Bre Cera (Mukwonago, Wisconsin), Makenzie Meyer (Mason City, Iowa), Amanda Ollinger (Cedar Rapids, Iowa), and Alexis Sevillian (Goodrich, Michigan) have inked National Letters of Intent to play basketball at the University of Iowa. UI head coach Lisa Bluder announced on Nov. 11. The class of four is ranked 18th nationally by Blue Star Basketball.

"We are excited about our 2016 recruiting class," Bluder said. "We have signed four tremendous athletes that also succeed academically and are all-around great young women. They will be wonderful additions to our Hawkeye family."

Cera, a 5-10 guard from Mukwonago High School in Mukwonago, Wisconsin, is a Blue Star Basketball Top 300 recruit, ranking as the 83rd-best prospect nationally.

The two-time first team all-state honoree has helped Mukwonago to a trio of top three conference finishes in her high school career, including a conference championship in the 2012-13 season. Cera guided her team to a state runner-up finish that year as a freshman, a semifinal appearance at state as a sophomore, and a regional berth as a junior. The two-time team captain has been named first team all-conference, first team all-area, and first team all-county in consecutive seasons.

Cera became Mukwonago's all-time leading scorer in February of her junior season. She averaged 17 points, five rebounds, three assists, and two steals per game that year. As a sophomore, Cera surpassed the 1,000 career points mark, was named Milwaukee Journal-Sentinel prep athlete of the week, and averaged 14 points, four rebounds, three assists, and two steals per game. She also owns the school record for points in a game with 37.

"Bre is a terrific defensive player, a hard worker, and unbelievable competitor," Bluder said. "She makes her presence known on both ends of the court. Bre is a great athlete who has the versatility to play a variety of positions on the floor."

Meyer, a 5-10 guard from Mason City High School in Mason City, Iowa, is an ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruit, ranking as the 83rd-best prospect nationally and the 23rd-best point guard.

The two-year captain, only the fifth player in Mason City history to join the 1,000 career point club, helped her team to state quarterfinals in 2015 and semifinals in 2013 at the 5A level, and a trio of conference co-championships. As a junior, Meyer averaged 20.5 points, 6.8 rebounds, 3.2 assists, and 2.3 steals per game. She was named first team all-conference, first team all-district, first team all-state, and to the Sports Spotlight Iowa High School Girls Basketball All State Team.

Meyer, the school record holder for points scored in a game with 36, garnered first team all-district, first team all-state, and Mason City Globe Gazette Player of the Year honors as a sophomore. The National Honors Society member also excels academically, earning Principle List and academic all-conference recognition.

"Makenzie has the opportunity to play the point or the off guard for us," Bluder said. "She controls the tempo, but also has a scorer's mentality. Makenzie was our first commitment from this class and got the ball rolling for us. She is a great player who has consistently competed at the highest level, not only within the state of Iowa, but nationally. We are excited to have another native Iowan in Makenzie."

Ollinger, a 6-1 forward from Linn-Mar High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, is an ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruit, ranking as the 90th-best player overall and 18th-best forward.

The two-time second team all-state and three-time all-metro and all-conference honoree most recently helped Linn-Mar to a runner-up conference finish, averaging 12.3 points, 4.8 rebounds, and 1.1 blocks per game as a junior. She also earned the team's top free throw percentage award, and is only the second player in program history to net six three-pointers in a game (joining Linn-Mar and Hawkeye women's basketball alum Jaime Printy).

As a sophomore, Ollinger averaged 18.6 points, 7.2 rebounds, and 2.3 blocks per game. She is also a standout volleyball player, who led the state in kills, kills per set, and kills in a season at the 5A level. The two-time team captain is a two-time all-state volleyball honoree.

"She is an all-around athlete that can play either forward position for us," Bluder said. "Amanda is an excellent rebounder, but can also nail the open three. She runs the floor so well for a player her size and will beat people guarding her down the court or off the bounce. It's great to have another Iowa player on our roster, especially one from so close to Iowa City."

Sevillian, a 5-6 guard from Goodrich High School in Goodrich, Michigan, is a Blue Star Basketball Top 300 recruit, ranking as the 91st-best prospect nationally. She has a familiar face on the Hawkeye roster in freshman Tania Davis, also a Goodrich graduate.

The two-time all-state, all-area, and all-conference honoree has guided Goodrich to three consecutive conference championships, two district and regional championships, and a state championship in 2013. As a junior, Sevillian started every game, registered 422 points, 94 rebounds, 62 steals, and 60 assists, and led her team to state semifinals and a 23-2 final record. She tallied 304 points in her sophomore season, helping Goodrich to a 22-3 mark.

Sevillian, a preseason all-state and Miss Michigan Basketball candidate, is a National Honor Society member. She also excels in track and field and was named an All-American in the shot put after placing third nationally in the event.

"Alexis is a great defensive player, who can also shoot the three. She has a tremendous work ethic and competes all the time. Her older sister, Keke, currently plays basketball at Penn State, so she knows Big Ten basketball."

2 TOURNAMENTS, 2 TEAM TROPHIES

- The Hawkeyes have taken home the hardware in every tournament so far this season, beginning with the Hawkeye Challenge, Nov. 13-15, and continuing at the Lone Star Showcase, Nov. 26-28.
- Iowa topped North Dakota and UT Martin at its annual tournament in Iowa City opening weekend to secure its first team championship with a 2-0 record.
- Ally Disterhoft (MVP), Kali Peschel, and Megan Gustafson earned Hawkeye Challenge All-Tournament team accolades.
- The Hawkeyes edged out the competition in their bracket at the Lone Star Showcase over Thanksgiving break. The squad recorded wins over Wright State and Houston, but fell to No. 23 George Washington in double overtime.
- Iowa and George Washington both posted 2-1 records, but the Hawkeyes earned the team title by the margin of victory tie breaker.

ACADEMIC PROWESS

- Iowa was the only program to have two Capital One Academic All-Americans, Ally Disterhoft and Samantha Logic, in 2014-15. There were 15 total honorees.
- Disterhoft was the only sophomore in the country to earn Capital One Academic All-American honors.
- Seven Hawkeyes, Disterhoft, Bethany Doolittle, Alexa Kastanek, Samantha Logic, Kali Peschel, Kathryn Reynolds, and Hailey Schneden, earned Academic All-Big Ten recognition following the 2014-15 season.
- To be eligible for Academic All-Big Ten, student-athletes must be letterwinners and be in at least their second academic year at the institution. They must also carry a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better.

TOP 15 IN ATTENDANCE

In 2014-15, the University of Iowa ranked 11th in total attendance nationally after drawing 95,417 fans to Carver-Hawkeye Arena. With an average of 5,301 fans per game, the Hawkeyes were 14th in national attendance among Division I teams. It is the sixth-straight season Iowa has ranked inside the top 25 in attendance.

The Hawkeyes were 15th in average attendance (5,213) and 13th in total attendance (83,406) in 2013-14, 22nd in attendance (4,395) in 2012-13, 19th in both 2011-12 and 2010-11, and 13th in 2009-10.

#REDWHITENBLUDER

Sixteenth-year UI head coach Lisa Bluder took her talents to the international stage as head coach of the U.S. Pan American Women's Basketball Team in 2015. She guided the Red, White, and Blue to four consecutive wins in four days to reach the gold medal contest, where Team USA ultimately fell to the Pan American Games host in Canada in day five of competition. It marked the 14th medal all-time (seven gold, five silver, two bronze) for the U.S. and the second for Bluder, who earned a gold medal with the team as an assistant coach at the World University Games in 2001.

BUTTENHAM REPRESENTS CANADA

Sophomore forward Christina Buttenham was one of 12 named to the Canadian Junior Women's National Team for the second consecutive year in 2015. The Hamilton, Ontario, Canada, native was unable to compete with the team, which finished eighth in the competition held in Chekhov, Russia, due to injury. Buttenham was one of just 12 women's basketball players in the Big Ten selected to represent the conference in international competition.

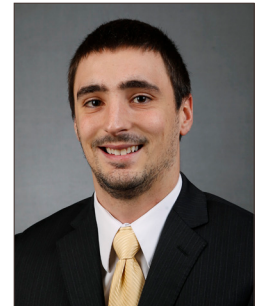
