IOWA VS ILLINOUS COACHES QUOTES

Iowa Coach Frank Lauterbur:

"I've said it before and I'll say it again, There's nothing that can take the place of a victory.

There were so many turning points in the game. Our goal line stand, the missed extra point, the long run by Mix and a number of second and third efforts by everyone on the field.

"You couldn't signal anybody out as a hero today because everyone out there was a hero. They wanted to win this game very badly for the seniors. I felt we'd win it and I glad I was right. It's especially great to win when your picked as three touchdown underdogs.

"Dave Harris was sick in bed the first three days this week. That's why he didn't start. But when Mix was hurt Davey had to gow in and he did a tremendous job.

"I though Butch Caldwell had excellent poise at quarterback today.

"This is the first time I've won a game on a two-point extra point. I've lost three other games because of it.

"The great thing about today's game is that when our defense gave way, our offense took over. I was very pleased that we were for once able to gain some consistency to our offensive attack.

"We Had about 15 pass plays called today but for some reason or another they never got off.

"I thought Dough Nessan did a good job at quarterback when he was in there.
"I was just pleased with everybody and everything today. It sure is going to make the winter shorter.

"The game ball will be given to our trainer Tom Spalj. Tom is in the hospital seriously ill with pneumonia.

Illinois coach Bob Blackman?

"Before I say anything, I want to give full credit to Iowa. They just out-fought us today. They (Hawks) really came out hitting.

"We didn't play well today, certainly part of this has to be to the credit of Iowa.

"When you play that last game of the season away from home it really makes a difference.

"We felt before the game that the burden would be on our defense. We told the defense Before the game that they would have to come up with 12 big plays (pass interceptions, fumble recoveries, etc.). We had seven in the first quarter, but then things kind of trailed off."

"We lost Bruce Beaman with a broken shoulder on that long kick-off return.

"Our offense was off today because of the Iowa defense and also because of a lack of enthusiasm...on our part. Our backs didn't run really hard in the early part of the game and then as we encouraged them, the Iowa defense really got ISENTEEN tougher."

"I want this to sound in no way like an alabi, because Iowa won the game. But the arbi ficial INTEXT turf today was really INT bad for us. A lot of slipping, etc. But this certainly wasn't the reason we lost the game.
