# **HEAD COACH TOM BRANDS**



Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his fifth season as head wrestling coach at Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has an 89-6 overall and 30-3 Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 106-26 career mark.

In the past four seasons at Iowa, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three straight NCAA and Big Ten team titles (2008-10). During that time the Hawkeyes have crowned six NCAA champions, six Big Ten champions and 23 All-Americans, and qualified 36 wrestlers to the NCAA Championships. The Hawkeyes have also won the last three Big Ten regular season titles with perfect 8-0 records each year. The team is in the midst of the longest dual (61) and longest road dual (41) winning streaks in school history.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at lowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 all-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

**Television** - The dual will be aired live on Mediacom Connections (MC22). Tim Johnson and former Iowa State Head Coach Jim Gibbons will provide commentary.

**Radio** - Steven Grace and two-time Hawkeye NCAA champion and four-time All-American Mark Ironside will call the action live on AM-800, KXIC and *hawkeyesports.com* using the All-Access subscription (\$14.95 per month or \$119.95 per year).

Internet - The dual will be streamed live on bigtennetwork. com. Broadcasts are available using a conference pass (\$99.95 annually or \$12.95 monthly) or a school pass (\$64.95 annually or \$7.95 monthly). The 2010-11 lowa wrestling media guide, press releases, meet results, and audio broadcasts are available at hawkeyesports.com. Current wrestling staff and studentathlete head shots are available at pics.hawkeyesports.com.

### SOUTHERN ILLINOIS EDWARDSVILLE COUGARS

The Southern Illinois Edwardsville Cougars are 1-6 with an 18-12 win over South Dakota State, and losses to Coe (6-37), Cornell College (6-39), Iowa Central (15-23), Northern State (18-21), Findlay (18-26) and Northwestern (0-51). It will be the second time this season that the Cougars have wrestled at Carver-Hawkeye Arena, going 0-3 at the Iowa City Duals Nov. 19.

Head Coach David Ray, who lettered for the lowa wrestling team in 1984, has a 6-27-1 record in three years at SIUE. He has a 147-72-5 record in 15 years as a collegiate head coach. Ray is assisted by Cougar alum Alan Grammer.

### LAST MEETING - IOWA 51, SIUE 0

The Hawkeyes closed the 2009 Iowa City Duals with a 51-0 victory over Southern Illinois Edwardsville at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa went 5-0 on the day, posting a 49-1 match record with wins over Coe College (39-3), Cornell College (57-0), Iowa Lakes Community College (52-0) and University of North Carolina Pembroke (47-0) and SIUE. The Hawkeyes recorded team bonus points at eight weights against SIUE, including six pins, one technical fall and one major decision.

### **THE SERIES**

Iowa leads the series with SIUE, 5-0, winning the last meeting (51-0) at the 2009 Iowa City Duals. The Hawkeyes hold a 4-0 edge over the Cougars in Iowa City.

#### **CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA**

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has been the home of Iowa wrestling since 1983. The Hawkeyes are 184-18 (.911) in the arena, which includes a record 11 victories during the 2010 season. Iowa has recorded 18 undefeated seasons in the arena, with the most recent (11-0) occurring in 2009-10. The dual wrestling attendance record for Carver-Hawkeye Arena is 15,955, set when Iowa defeated Iowa State (20-15) on December 6, 2008. The arena normally seats 15,500 for a dual wrestling meet.

### **PARDON OUR PROGRESS!**

As friends of the UI and fans of the Hawkeyes know, the UI Athletics Department is well into a multi-million dollar revitalization of Carver-Hawkeye Arena. This important and exciting project has reduced the number of ticket windows that are operational on game nights. Fans attending lowa's home wrestling meets are invited to avoid delays by purchasing their event tickets online or in advance. If your schedule doesn't allow for an advance purchase, we recommend you consider arriving at the arena a little earlier than originally planned. The North entrance is no longer accessible from the outside of the facility. Fans can enter and purchase tickets at the West and South entrances. Arena doors will open 90 minutes before an event. The East entrance will serve as the event pass gate.

## **IOWA WINNING STREAKS**

lowa has won 68 straight dual matches, which is a school record. The current streak started with a win over Cornell (32-3) on Jan. 12, 2008, which was the first match after lowa lost to Oklahoma State (19-14) on Jan. 5. The 68-match winning streak ranks fourth-best in NCAA wrestling history behind three Oklahoma State streaks. The Cowboys won 76 straight duals from 1937-51, and had two 69-match streaks (1921-32 and 1996-99).

The Hawkeyes have won 44 consecutive duals on the road, which is also a school record. That streak started with a 20-13 win at Iowa State on Dec. 9, 2007.

lowa has won its last 29 duals at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. That streak, which ranks fourth-best in school history, started with a 27-13 win over Penn State on Jan. 20, 2008, which was also the first home match after the loss to the Cowboys. The school record is 55 (1/9/1977-12/18/1983).

Against Big Ten foes, the Hawkeyes have won their last 28 duals, including 13 at home and 15 on the road. The 28 league duals rank second in school history, while the 13 home duals rank third and the 15 road duals rank fourth. Iowa's school record for consecutive Big Ten wins is 98 (12/13/1975-1/28/1989), while the records for Big Ten home wins is 63 (1/17/1975-1/3/1998) and road wins is 54 (1/19/1974-1/28/1989).

### WRESTLERS PLACE FOURTH AT MIDLANDS

lowa crowned eight placewinners Dec. 30 at the 2010 Midlands Championships to place fourth with 91 points. Missouri won its first Midlands team title with 103.5, while Wisconsin placed second (95.5) and Lehigh placed third (93) at the 48th annual event in Evanston, IL. Portions of the event will be broadcast Saturday at 3 p.m. (CT) and Jan. 14 at 6 p.m. (CT) on the Big Ten Network.

Hawkeye sophomore **Matt McDonough** was lowa's top finisher, placing second at 125 pounds. The tournament's top seed and the defending Midlands champion at 125, McDonough lost a 3-1 decision to #2 seed Brandon Precin of Northwestern in the championship finals. Precin scored a first-period takedown and added an escape in the second period to take a 3-0 lead in the match. McDonough scored an escape in the third period, but could not get the takedown to force overtime. The loss was McDonough's first of the season, and only the second of his career.

Also placing for the Hawkeyes were junior **Tyler Clark** (133-5th), seniors **Aaron Janssen** (165-5th) and **Luke Lofthouse** (197-7th), redshirt freshmen **Ethen Lofthouse** (174-5th) and **Tony Ramos** (133-6th), and sophomores **Mark Ballweg** (141-6th) and **Grant Gambrall** (184-6th). Clark (#11 seed), Janssen (unseeded) and Ethen Lofthouse (#9 seed) all wrestled above their seeds with their fifthplace finishes. Clark and Ramos met twice during the two-day tournament, with each posting one victory. Ramos scored a 3-1 decision in the championships quarterfinals, while Clark scored a 2-1 decision in the first tiebreak period in the fifth-place match.

## YOUTH CLINIC INFORMATION ANNOUNCED

The annual Iowa Elite Chevy Youth Wrestling Clinic will be held Jan. 22 in Carver-Hawkeye Arena prior to the Iowa vs. Ohio State dual. Doors will open at noon for the clinic, which will run from 1-2 p.m. Former Hawkeye All-Americans **Phillip Keddy** and **Ryan Morningstar** will be the featured clinicians. Youth, ages 7-13, are eligible to participate in the clinic.

The Iowa vs. Ohio State dual, which will be a "Gold Rush" dual where fans are encouraged to wear gold, is set for 3 p.m. Participants will receive one free admission ticket to the Iowa vs. Ohio State dual in the online pre-registration process. Additional tickets for friends and family members will be available for purchase online at the \$7 group rate. It is recommended that all tickets be purchased at this time in order to receive the group discount and seating together. Everyone must have a ticket prior to entry.

Participants must pre-register for the clinic at <a href="http://www.hawkeyesports.com/ot/chevy-wrestl-clinic-2010.html">http://www.hawkeyesports.com/ot/chevy-wrestl-clinic-2010.html</a>. Registrations will be accepted until January 17th, or until clinic capacity is reached. Clinic participation is only guaranteed to the first 250 youth who pre-register. Check-in will take place at a table at the Carver-Hawkeye Arena South Entrance with sports marketing staff. A signed medical release form (available during the pre-registration process) must be turned in at the check-in table. The child will then be given a complimentary gold lowa Wrestling t-shirt. Re-entry will not be allowed. Once you are in for the clinic, you are in for the meet.

## **USA WRESTLING ANNOUNCES 2012 OLYMPIC TEAM TRIALS BID FINALISTS**

Three cities and their local organizing committees have been named as finalists to host the 2012 U.S. Olympic Team Trials for Wrestling. The date for the event will be the weekend of April 20-21, 2012. Alphabetically, the final cities are: **Columbus, Ohio; Council Bluffs, Iowa**; and **Iowa City, Iowa.** 

The finalists have been invited to make an in-person presentation on behalf of their bid on either January 12 or January 13 at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo.

Seven cities submitted bids to host the event. Greensboro, N.C., Hampton, Va., Oklahoma City, Okla. and Pontiac, Mich. are not finalists at this time. Due to the dates of international Olympic qualification tournaments in wrestling, it has been determined that the event must be held on the weekend of April 20-21.

Three of the bids proposed different dates for the event. The number of finalist cities could be increased if one or more of those cities are able to secure the weekend of April 20-21 for the event. If the date change occurs in a prompt fashion, the cities could be invited to make an in-person presentation either January 12 or 13.

A selection committee will review the finalist bid presentations. The committee will include USA Wrestling staff and athletes, as well as representatives from the U.S. Olympic Committee. An announcement on the bid selected to host the 2012 U.S. Olympic Team Trials for Wrestling is targeted for Jan. 17, 2011.

Each bid proposal includes hosting the 2012 U.S. Olympic Team Trials for Wrestling, which will feature competition in the three Olympic styles of the sport – men's freestyle, Greco-Roman and women's freestyle. The competition will determine the U.S. athletes in both sports who will qualify to represent the United States at the 2012 Olympic Games in London, England.

## **ALL IN THE FAMILY**

On the 2010-11 Hawkeye wrestling team, there are three sets of brothers, two wrestlers whose fathers wrestled at lowa and two uncle-nephew combinations.

Senior Matt Ballweg (157), sophomore Mark Ballweg (141) and freshman Jacob Ballweg (141) are brothers who hail from Waverly. They are the fifth set of three brothers to wrestle at lowa, and the third set to be on the roster at the same time. The other sets of three brothers to compete for the Hawkeyes are Ed Banach, Lou Banach and Steve Banach; Marty Kistler, Harlan Kistler and Lindley Kistler; Mike Uker, Ben Uker and Joe Uker; and Lenny Zalesky, Larry Zalesky and Jim Zalesky.

Junior **Stew Gillmor** (149/157) and freshman **Walt Gillmor** (165) are brothers from Donahue, while sophomore **Nate Moore** (133) and freshman **Nick Moore** (157/165) are brothers from Iowa City.
