OHIO STATE TRAVELS TO IOWA THIS WEEKEND

After six days off, the Ohio State baseball team returns to action with its first Big Ten road series at Iowa Saturday-Monday at Duane Banks Field in Iowa City, Iowa. The Buckeyes (19-8, 2-1 B1G) return to the diamond after taking two of three games at home against Nebraska last weekend, while the Hawkeyes (17-9, 3-2 B1G) won a road series at Illinois last weekend in Champaign, Ill. The series was pushed back a day due to frigid temperatures predicted Friday in Iowa City.

LEADING OFF

- Ohio State is 19-8 overall and 2-1 in Big Ten play heading into its second weekend of league play. The Buckeyes hold a 3-1 record in away games.
- Last time out, the Buckeyes won two of three games vs. Nebraska to open Big Ten action. After dropping the opener, 7-3, Ohio State won game two, 7-4, and outthit the Huskers in a 15-14 win in a wild series finale in Columbus.
- The team is hitting .309 as team with 83 extra-base hits and 5-for-29 in stolen bases. The Buckeyes are 11th in the nation and first in the Big Ten in scoring (.79).
- The Scarlet and Gray also rank first in the conference in batting average (.309), on-base percentage (.399), runs scored (212), hits (297) and RBI (196), second in slugging (.452), home runs (24) and third in doubles (53) and walks (132).
- The OSU pitching staff has combined for a 4.12 ERA, which is fifth-best in the league. The group has collected 221 strikeouts, which is third-best in the conference.
- Senior Noah McGowan is leading the team with a .411 average. He is in the Top 10 in nine different batting statistical categories in the Big Ten, including second in batting (.411), slugging (.710), on-base (.480), hits (44), RBI (37), doubles (12) and third in runs scored (30) and total bases (76).
- Sophomore Dominic Canzone is leading the conference with 45 hits and 32 runs scored. He is also fifth in batting (.381) and total bases (64).
- Senior Tyler Cowles is fifth in doubles (9) and seventh in hits (37) and RBI (26). Sophomore Conner Pohl is fifth in RBI (27) and seventh in runs scored (25). Junior Brady Cherry is fifth in doubles (9).
- Junior starting pitcher Connor Curllis is 4-1 with a 3.51 ERA with 45 strikeouts and 10 walks in 41.0 innings pitched. His 45 strikeouts rank second in the league.
- Junior starting pitcher Ryan Feltner has 40 strikeouts, good for fifth in the conference.
- Senior reliever Seth Kinker is 4-1 with a 1.82 ERA in 12 appearances. The Senior CLASS Award Candidate is the only pitcher in the nation with at least four wins and six saves.
- The 2018 Buckeyes return 22 letterwinners this season, including 13 members from the 2016 Big Ten championship team. The team welcomed 10 newcomers in the fall.
- The Scarlet and Gray racked up the frequent flyer miles, opening the 2018 season with 17-straight road games. The Buckeyes were in state of Florida two times and also visited Arizona, South Carolina and North Carolina. The team flew a combine 7,516 miles across the country over the first five weeks of the season.

OHIO STATE VS. IOWA

The Buckeyes lead the all-time series vs. the Hawkeyes, 75-54-1. Ohio State is 33-27 in road games vs. the Hawkeyes. Last year, the Hawkeyes won two of three games over the Scarlet and Gray at Banks Field May 12-14. Dominic Canzone hit .313 (5-for-16) with three runs scored, one home run and four RBI and Conner Pohl batted .625 (5-for-8) with four runs scored, one double, one home run and three RBI. On the mound, Connor Curllis received the win in game two, throwing six innings on four runs, one earned, two walks and four strikeouts.

RPI UPDATE

Ohio State sits at No. 57 in the latest NCAA RPI rankings, which were released on Monday. The Buckeyes are the fifth-highest ranked team in the Big Ten. Ohio State has two wins over RPI Top 50 teams and six against schools in the Top 100.

HOT BATS LAST WEEK

Ohio State hit an impressive .393 as a team with nine doubles and four home runs to go 3-1 last week. Six different Buckeyes hit over the .300 mark guided by Conner Pohl with a .647 average (11-for-18) with six runs scored, one home run and nine RBI.

A LOOK BACK AT NEBRASKA SERIES

The Buckeye bats kept sizzling into the weekend vs. the Huskers after a 19-4 win over Toledo last Wednesday. The squad batted .400 with 44 hits and slugged .536 as a team. Pohl hit .571 (8-for-14) with three RBI and Canzone, Cowles and Barnwell each hit .500. Barnwell had the big three-run homer in the win in game two. McGowan drove in five and homered in the series finale. The Buckeyes recorded 22 hits last Sunday vs. the Husker pitching staff, marking the most hits by a Buckeye team at Bill Davis

Curlis fanned eight over 6.2 innings and allowed three earned runs, Feltner struck six in six innings of work on three earned runs and Niemeyer worked five and allowed three earned runs in game three. Kinker collected two saves, combining to throw 3.2 innings on four hits, two runs, five strikeouts and no walks.

After 27 games in 2018, vs. the first 27 in 2018, several individuals are enjoying significant statistical improvements:

- Noah McGowan is batting 185 points higher (.227 in 2017, .411 in 2018) and his slugging is 246 points higher (.464 in 2017, .710 in 2018). He has 18 more RBI in 27 games than his season RBI total a year ago.
- Tyler Cowles is batting 173 points higher (.190 in 2018, .363 in 2018) and his slugging is 225 points higher (.314 in 2017, .539 in 2018). He has 11 more RBI in 27 games than his season RBI total a year ago.
- Dominic Canzone is just 12 hits shy of his season total in 2017 (57 in 2017, 45 in 2018).
- As a team, Ohio State has collected 88 more hits than it did this time last year (297) and has scored 80 more runs than it did this time a season ago (212).

TO THE BULLPEN

The OSU bullpen has combined for 3.55 ERA with 36 strikeouts in 34.2 innings pitched. The Buckeye relievers have combined for a 2.25 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 2018. The OSU hurlers are holding opponents to a .227 batting average out of the bullpen in 27 games.

NOTING THE OPENING HOMESTAND

- Ohio State hit .341 with 22 doubles, four triples and seven home runs.
- The team is outscored opponents, 83-53, in 10 games at Bill Davis Stadium.
- Canzone batted .488 and scored a team-best 16 runs and driven in a team-best 12 RBI.
- The OSU pitching staff combined for 3.83 ERA with 92 strikeouts in 94.0 IP in Columbus. Kinker was 2-0 with 17 strikeouts and has not walked a batter in 12.1 innings of relief work.

NATIONAL STAT RANKINGS

Ohio State ranks in the Top 50 in the nation in several statistical categories, including 11th in scoring (7.9), 13th in batting average (.309), 19th in runs scored (212), 20th in hits (297), 24th in on-base (.399) and 28th in slugging (.452).

Noah McGowan is eighth in RBI per game (1.37), 10th in RBI (37), 21st in batting (.411) and 25th in doubles (12). Dominic Canzone is 14th in hits (45) and 31st in runs scored (32).

KINKER NAMED SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE

Seth Kinker, a senior pitcher on the Ohio State baseball team, is a candidate for the 2018 Senior CLASS Award, the organization announced Wednesday. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as a Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Kinker, from Huntington, W. Va., has been a key member for the Buckeye pitching staff the last four years. Kinker has made 91 career appearances, which ranks seventh in school history. In his career, he is 13-4 with a 2.31 ERA and 147 strikeouts in 159.2 innings pitched.

SPRING BREAK 2018

Ohio State went 4-2 during its spring break trip in the Carolinas. Highlighting the week was a 7-5 win over No. 21 Coastal Carolina to conclude play at the 2018 Environmental Chanticleer Classic March 11 in Conway, S.C. Ohio State rallied with six runs in the final two innings to earn their second ranked win of the year. Noah McGowan was 2-for-4 with two runs scored, home run and two RBI. Seth Kinker earned his second win of the season, throwing three innings on four hits, two runs, one walk and two strikeouts. Tyler Cowles led the Buckeyes at the plate during the four-game stretch, batting 8-for-16 with five runs scored, three doubles and two home runs.

Dominic Canzone hit .400 during the series with a double and home run.

RANKED WIN IN PENSACOLA

Highlighting the Cox Diamond Invitational on the Gulf Coast was a 9-6 comeback win over No. 15 Southern Miss March 3 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. The bats rallied with seven answered runs to claim the first nationally-ranked win of the season. Conner Pohl went 3-for-5 with a home run and three RBI, while Noah McGowan was 2-for-4 with four runs scored, triple, RBI and two walks. Dominic Canzone also had three hits on the night with a RBI and stolen base. He had the go-ahead RBI single in a four-run eighth inning. On the mound, Curtiss Irving claimed the win to improve to 2-0 and Seth Kinker picked up his third save. In all, the team sprayed 15 hits against the Golden Eagle pitching staff.

BARNWELL NAMED TO JOHNNY BENCH AWARD WATCH LIST

Jacob Barnwell was named to the 2018 Johnny Bench Award Watch List presented by BaseballSavings.com, announced Tuesday by the Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission. Because the award is given annually to the top division one collegiate catcher, the list will be updated to include other candidates until April 30, 2018. Ninety-seven catchers were nominated for the award by their coaches. Barnwell has appeared in 91 games with 78 starts, including 74 starts from behind the dish.

BIG/PAC-12 CHALLENGE REWIND

The Buckeyes went 2-2 Feb. 22-25 at the Big Ten/Pac-12 Challenge in Surprise, Ariz. Ohio State defeated Utah twice and fell to No. 2 Oregon State in both games at Surprise Stadium. Noah McGowan had another big weekend at the plate, hitting .450 (9-for-20) with three doubles, one home run and six RBI.

In game one, the Buckeyes on, 7-2, vs. Utah. Junior left-handed pitcher Connor Curlis had a solid outing in his second start of the season to improve to 1-0. He gave up one run on four hits with five strikeouts and no walks. Conner Pohl went 3-for-4 with a run scored and RBI and Kobie Foppe was 2-for-5 with a run scored and RBI. Dominic Canzone also drove in a pair of runs and had a run scored and walk. Brady Cherry went 1-for-3 with a run scored and two walks and Tyler Cowles and Noah McGowan each had a hit, run scored and RBI.

In game two, Ohio State led by two runs against the second-ranked Beavers heading into the eighth inning, but Oregon State took advantage of two OSU errors in the bottom half to score six unearned runs and win, 10-8. Ohio State starting pitcher Ryan Feltner received a no decision after tossing six innings and scattered four runs on six hits with two walks and six strikeouts. Pohl had a big day at the dish going, 2-for-5 with two runs scored, five RBI and two home runs. He gave the Buckeyes the lead in the top of the third with a three-run homer and hit a majestic, towering two-run shot in the top of the ninth to pull the team within two runs. McGowan had a three-hit day, with two doubles.

In game three, the Buckeyes won, 20-13, over the Utes, posting a season-high 24 hits in the win. McGowan had another huge performance at the plate, going 5-for-7 with a double, home run and four RBI, while fifth-year senior right-handed reliever Curtiss Irving picked up his first career win. The Buckeyes dropped the finale vs. No. 2 Oregon State, 6-1.

20 RUNS SCORED VS. THE UTES

Game three marked the first time Ohio State has scored 20 more runs since March 12, 2016, in a 20-3 at UNLV. The posted 24 hits in the win as six different Buckeyes recorded multi-hit games. It was the second-most runs scored since the 2011 season when NCAA baseball switched to the BBCOR bats.

The Buckeyes went 2-2 behind excellent hitting .329 in Arizona. Ohio State outscored their opponents, 36-31. The opponent pitchers collected a combined 7.71 ERA. Ohio State had seven different hitters post a .300 batting average or better out west.

MCGOWAN NAMED NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Noah McGowan was named a National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball, announced Feb. 19. McGowan powered the Buckeyes to a 3-1 record at the Snowbird Classic in Port Charlotte, Fla. He collected 13 RBI, including 12 RBI with two outs, batting .400 with a double, two home runs, six runs scored and three walks. He had four-consecutive games with at least one RBI, including a career-high six RBI in the 2018 opener against Wisconsin-Milwaukee. McGowan became the first Buckeye to be named National Player of the Week since Jacob Boskiokovic (2016).

SNOWBIRD CLASSIC RECAP

Ohio State went 3-1 during the opening weekend in Port Charlotte, Fla. The Buckeyes won their opener for the fifth straight year after coming from behind to defeat Wisconsin-Milwaukee, 11-7, in game one of a Friday doubleheader. Noah McGowan and Tyler Cowles combined to drive in 10 runs on five hits, while Seth Kinker earned the win with one inning of relief work and allowing one unearned run. In game two, the Buckeyes downed Canisius, 6-4, McGowan launched the first home run by a Buckeye on the early season and drove in four more runs to put his doubleheader total an impressive 10. Ryan Feltner claimed the victory after throwing five innings and allowed four runs on six hits with six strikeouts and three strikeouts. Kinker struck out the side in the ninth to claim his first save of the season. Miscues hurt the Scarlet and Gray last Saturday against the Golden Griffs as the Buckeyes fell short, 6-5. Ohio State had the tying run on second base in the ninth, but Dominic Canzone flew out at the wall in right center to end the game. McGowan also launched a moonshot over the left field fence for his second dinger of the year. In the finale, Yianni Pavlopoulos picked up the win, working five innings and scattering two runs on six hits with two strikeouts and one walk. The OSU bats ignited for 14 hits in the 13-3 win. Ohio State improved to 21-9 all-time at the Snowbird.

TRIO OF BUCKEYES NAMED TO BIG PLAYERS TO WATCH LIST

Senior Seth Kinker, junior Ryan Feltner and sophomore Dominic Canzone were named to the Big Ten Preseason to Watch List, the conference office announced Wednesday afternoon.

Kinker, a native of Huntington, W. Va., collects his second straight league preseason honor and returns for his final season in the Scarlet and Gray. The right-hander was 3-1 with a 2.95 ERA in 24 appearances with 54 strikeouts in 58.0 innings pitched a year ago. Feltner, from Hudson, Ohio, earns his first conference preseason honor. The right-hander has been tabbed as the top prospect in the Big Ten for the 2018 MLB Draft by multiple media outlets, including D1Baseball and Perfect Game. The 6-4, 195-pound right-hander has collected 158 strikeouts in 171.1 innings pitched.

Canzone, from Sagamore Hills, Ohio, was a third team All-Big Ten selection as a true freshman in 2017. The Buckeye right fielder hit .343 with four doubles, three triples, three home runs and 36 RBI. He also had a team-high seven assists and did not make an error in 39 starts.

NIEMEYER & MICHALIK NAMED 2018 CAPTAINS

Redshirt senior pitcher Adam Niemeyer and redshirt senior Kyle Michalik were named captains of the 2018 squad, head coach Greg Beals announced in November. Niemeyer, a two-time Ohio State captain, the most experienced starter on a deep pitching staff, has started a team-high 30 games in career and holds a 10-8 overall record. Michalik, a native of Brunswick, Ohio, has 77 career appearances out of the vaunted Buckeye bullpen, posting a 2.89 ERA.

The Buckeyes also welcomed six freshmen consisting of two position players and four pitchers: Alex Theis (New Riegel, Ohio), Seth Lonsway (Celina, Ohio), Luke Duermit (Fishers, Ind.), Dillon Dingle (Massillon, Ohio), Jake Ruby (Groveport, Ohio) and Griffan Smith (Cincinnati, Ohio).

Ohio State will faced some tough competition to prep the boys for Big Ten play. The team played No. 2 Oregon State twice at the Big Ten/Pac-12 Challenge next week in Surprise, Ariz., before facing No. 15 Southern Mississippi March 3 at the Cox Diamond Club Invitational in Pensacola, Fla. Ohio State split a pair of games against Coastal Carolina, the 2016 NCAA champions, March 10-11. The squad swept a UNCW, a regional team from 2016, to end its spring break trip.
