#### IOWA IN THE ATTENDANCE GAME

The Hawkeyes rank 30th in national attendance, averaging 1,373 fans in 11 home contests. Since Head Coach **Sharon Dingman**'s arrival prior to 2008 season, Hawkeye fans have been flocking to Carver-Hawkeye Arena in record numbers. Four of the top-five all-time attendance figures have been set during the Dingman era. The Hawkeyes set a school attendance record Nov. 7 vs. Penn State when 2,802 fans witnessed the Hawkeyes host the nation's top-ranked team. The record announced crowd broke the old mark of 2,191 set against Wisconsin on Oct. 13, 2007.

Head Coach Sharon Dingman on Hawkeye fans: "The support we continue to have is greatly appreciated. Hawkeye fans appreciate hard work and disciplined effort and it is our goal to give that to them every time we take the court."

#### **HAWKEYE PROMOTIONS**

The Hawkeyes are hosting Little Spikers Night Friday at 7 p.m. when the Purdue Boilermakers visit Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa seniors **Christina Meister** and **Megan Schipper** will sign autographs following the match. Iowa will then host Fan Appreciation Night and Senior Night Saturday at 7 p.m. when the Hawkeyes battle Indiana.

#### **HAWKEYE SENIORS**

The Hawkeyes will honor seniors **Christina Meister** and **Megan Schipper** following Saturday night's contest vs. Indiana. The senior duo ranks one-two in digs and service aces this season. Meister ranks second in the conference in digs per set while Schipper recently picked up her 300th kill for the third consecutive season.

#### SCHIPPER CONTINUES HER CLIMB

Senior **Megan Schipper** currently ranks 12th on lowa's all-time list with 1,147 career kills. She needs seven kills to pass Dee Ann Davidson (1,153) for 11th all-time. On October 23rd, the Hawkeye captain was honored for becoming the 16th player in program history to record 1,000 career kills. The Aplington, IA, native passed the elusive number in lowa's 3-1 win at Wisconsin (9/23). Schipper picked up her 300th kill of the season at Illinois (11/20), marking the third time in her career she has surpassed the 300-kill plateau. In 2007, she led the Hawkeyes with 309 kills as a sophomore. She tallied a career-high 345 kills in 2008, the second-highest total on the team (Catherine Smale, 380). This season, Schipper leads lowa with 304 kills (2.95 kills per set).

#### HAWKEYES DIG DEFENSE

lowa ranks third in the Big Ten, averaging 14.80 digs per set. Senior libero **Christina Meister** ranks second in the Big Ten with 4.31 digs per set. Since 1990, only three Hawkeyes have averaged more than four digs per set through an entire season: Pam Kavadas, 5.22 ('04); Emily Hiza, 4.74 ('06) and 4.52 ('07); and Janet Moylan, 4.63 ('90). Meister has set a new bar for total digs in a season under the current 25-point rally scoring format. She has 447 total digs in 2009. Emily Hiza established the record with 419 digs in 2008, the first year of the current scoring format.

#### **SCHIPPER AMONG ALL-TIME LEADERS**

Senior **Megan Schipper** is one of only nine players in program history to rank among the top 20 career leaders in kills, blocks and service aces. The Hawkeye captain currently ranks 12th in career kills (1,147), 16th in career blocks (220) and 20th in career service aces (77).

#### **HUSZ THAT GIRL**

Sophomore **Mallory Husz** slapped a career-high 12 kills in lowa's five-set win over Wisconsin on the Big Ten Network, Nov. 11. The native of Council Bluffs, IA, also stuffed a career-best seven blocks against the Badgers to help the Hawkeyes sweep the season series from Wisconsin for the first time in 15 years (1994). Husz bounced back against Minnesota (11/13) with a team-leading 10 kills. She picked up three more blocks and tied a career high with three digs vs. the Golden Gophers. She then picked up her first two career aces at Northwestern (11/21). Husz has started eight of lowa's last nine contests and totaled a team leading 27 kills in the Hawkeyes' four contests against nationally ranked Illinois (2), Penn State and Minnesota.

#### NEXT WOMAN IN

Sophomore **Paige Stevens** made her first career start against Wisconsin (Nov. 11) and finished with a career-best 52 assists in lowa's five-set win over the Badgers. The 52 assists marked a season high for any Hawkeye individual this season. Stevens backed up her effort against Wisconsin with a career-high 11 digs vs. Minnesota, Nov. 13.

#### BIG EFFORT ON THE BIG TEN NETWORK

Sophomore **Tiffany Nilges** shined on prime time television in Iowa's 3-2 win over Wisconsin, Nov. 11, on the Big Ten Network. The Tripoli, IA, native picked up career highs in kills (9) and digs (8) as Iowa swept the season series from the Badgers for the first time since 1994.



# **Head Coach Sharon Dingman**



Sharon Dingman was hired as the eighth coach in Iowa volleyball history March 21, 2008.

The second-year head Hawkeye owns a career record of 361-248 (18 years) after leading lowa to its most successful campaign in eight seasons in 2008. The Hawkeyes' 14 overall victories and six conference wins were the most by an lowa Volleyball team

since 2000.

Dingman also reached a personal milestone in her inagural Hawkeye season, recording career victory No. 350 November 14 in a five-set victory over Northwestern.

Iowa re-established a home-court advantage in Dingman's first season, posting its first winning season at North Carver since 1998 and setting a program attendance record.

Dingman came to lowa after serving as head coach at Illinois State from 2000-07, where she compiled a 147-98 record. In 2007, Dingman led the Redbirds to their first at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament since 1997. Illinois State reached the championship match of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and finished with a 21-12 overall record.

Illinois State produced winning seasons in seven of the eight seasons under Dingman and never finished lower than fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. Dingman produced 21 all-Missouri Valley Conference selections, including Player of the Year, Libero of the Year and two Freshman of the Year honorees.

Redbird teams under Dingman were also strong in the classroom. Eleven players were named to the league's scholar-athlete squad in her eight seasons. In 2004, four volleyball student-athletes earned perfect 4.00 grade-point-averages and the team recorded a 3.32 GPA.

Dingman started her head coaching career in 1991 at Auburn, where she led the Tigers to a 22-13 record in her only season at the helm. Her 1991 squad become the first Auburn volleyball tem to receive votes in the national poll and Auburn's fourth place finish in the SEC that season marked the highest finish ever for Auburn at the time.

She then moved to Butler in 1992, where she served as head coach for eight seasons. Dingman led the Bulldogs to four 20 win seasons and three postseason tournaments, including an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 1997 after capturing the Midwestern Collegiate Conference title. She was named MCC Coach of the Year in 1997 after compiling a 28-7 record.

Prior to becoming a head coach, Dingman spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at three Division I programs. After one season at Northern Michigan (1984), she assisted at Texas Tech for three seasons (1985-87). Dingman then spent three seasons at Kentucky (1988-90) and helped the Wildcats to an SEC Championship in 1988 along with three-straight regional finals appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

#### **PURDUE**

The Boilermakers are led by seventh-year head coach Dave Shondell and MH **Tiffany Fischer**. The sophomore ranks 10th in the Big Ten with a .311 attack percentage. Purdue leads the all-time series, 43-18. The Boilermakers topped the Hawkeyes 3-0 in West Lafayette earlier this season (Oct. 17) and have won the past 11 meetings. Iowa last defeated the Boilermakers, 3-2, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena in 2003.

#### **INDIANA**

The Hoosiers are led by third-year head coach Sherry Dunbar and players **Ashley Benson** and **Jordan Haverly**. The front row duo is among the Big Ten leaders in kills per set, ranking ninth and 10th, respectively. Benson, a junior MB, leads the Hoosiers with 3.29 kills per set. Haverly, a freshman OH, ranks 10th in the conference with 3.24 kills per set. The Hoosiers lead the all-time series, 33-25. Indiana topped lowa in three sets at Assembly Hall earlier this season (Oct. 16). The two teams split the season series a year ago, with each team defending its own home court. Iowa rallied from a 2-1 deficit to defeat Indiana in five sets last season at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

#### HIT IT AND WIN IT

The Hawkeyes are 12-0 when attacking at a higher percentage than their opponent this season. Conversely, lowa's opponent has hit a higher percentage in each of the Hawkeyes' 18 losses.

#### **BIG TEN AMONG THE NATION'S BEST**

Penn State clinched its seventh consecutive and 13th overall Big Ten title last weekend and now looks to secure its third consecutive perfect Big Ten season. The Nittany Lions remain the No. 1 team in the nation and are joined in the rankings by No. 5 Illinois, No. 12 Michigan, No. 13 Minnesota and Ohio State, who is receiving votes.

#### SECOND GENERATION

Mara Hilgenberg's father Jay and Emma Krieger Kittle's father Bruce played football together at lowa from 1977-1980. Jay was a four-time letterwinner and went on to win Super Bowl XX with the 1985 Chicago Bears. Bruce used a redshirt in 1980 and came back as a team captain for Hayden Fry's 1981 Big Ten Championship team.

#### **HAWKEYE CAPTAINS**

Senior outside hitter **Megan Schipper** and junior setter **Mara Hilgenberg** are lowa's team captains for the 2009 season. Schipper leads the Hawkeyes in kills (304) and service aces (28) and ranks second in digs (286). Hilgenberg leads the Hawkeyes with 891 assists and is a third generation Hawkeye captain. Her great-uncle Wally and her uncle Jim were football team captains in 1963 and 1977, respectively.

**Sharon Dingman** is in her second season as the head Hawkeye. She is joined by second-year assistant **Jason Allen** and newcomers **Ben Boldt** and **Curt Sivertsen**.

Allen is in his second season as a assistant coach at lowa. Allen was also promoted to the team's recruiting coordinator following the 2008 season. Allen previously served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Sam Houston State University prior to serving as the 16U head coach for the Texas Tornados club program in 2007.

Boldt is in his first season as an assistant coach at lowa. Boldt spent the last two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Alabama. Prior to joining Alabama, Boldt served as a staff assistant for five seasons at the University of Nebraska. In his final season, the Cornhuskers finished 33-1 en route to the 2006 NCAA Championship.

Sivertsen is in his first season at lowa after having served the last two years as head coach of the men's and women's programs at Missouri Valley College.
