

THIS WEEK -- The Iowa men and women's track teams will compete at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships, May 13-15, in Columbus, OH. All events will be held at Jesse Owens Memorial Stadium. Tickets are available from the Ohio State University Athletic Ticket Office at 800/462-8259 or www.ohiostatebuckeyes.com. All-session tickets are \$15 for adults and \$10 for students. Single-session tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 for students.

ROACH ATTEMPTS TO JOIN HAWKEYE ELITE -- This weekend sophomore **Peaches Roach** will try to become the third female student-athlete in school history to win four Big Ten titles during her career. She won high jump titles at the 2004 indoor and outdoor Big Ten meets and at the 2005 indoor meet. **Roach** has several opportunities to win her fourth title. The Kingston, Jamaica, native is part of the 400-meter relay that currently leads the conference and is ranked second in the high jump and 100 meters. **Roach** could also make her mark in the Iowa record books as no female track student-athlete has ever totaled more than four conference titles or won more than three in one event.

The other two Hawkeyes to earn four Big Ten titles are **Vivien McKenzie** and **Shellene Williams**. **McKenzie** won three titles in the 100 meters and one in the 55 meters from 1983-85. **Williams** won three titles in the 400 meters and one as part of the 1,600-meter relay from 2003-04.

NEUMANN PLANS RETURN -- Senior Bill Neumann looks to add another Big Ten javelin title to his collection this weekend. The Comox, British Columbia, native redshirted the entire 2004 season to heal an elbow injury. Neumann won the javelin (193-8) at the Iowa Musco Twilight VII at the end of April in his 2005 debut and only competition to date. The two-time Big Ten javelin champion and two-time all-American currently holds the conference javelin record of 238-2. If he wins a third conference javelin title, he would be the only Hawkeye in school history to do so. The three other Iowa Big Ten champion javelin throwers have each won two titles. They are L.D. Weldon (1930-31), Mark Panther (1934-35) and Bushnell Lamb (1936-38).

BREAKIN' RECORDS -- Iowa has set three new school records during the outdoor season. Sophomore Tiffany Johnson broke the triple jump record of 40-7 1/2 set in 1988 by Becki Borg with her leap of 40-9 1/2 at the Mt. SAC Relays. Sophomore Becca Franklin shattered the hammer throw record of 161-10 set in 1999 by Kerri Blackstone with the 181-11 she threw at the Iowa Musco Twilight VII. The 6,400-meter relay of sophomores Nikki Chapple and Jordan Laney, and seniors Katie Donlon and Michelle Sokol also set a school record (20:39.12) at Drake Relays. The previous record was 20:40.89 set in 2001 by Sarah Arens, Atalie Barber, Katie Butler and Ericka Roberts.

NCAA REGIONAL QUALIFIERS -- Iowa has qualified 17 student-athletes in 13 individual events and two relays for the NCAA Midwest Regional Championships, which will be held May 27-28 in Norman, OK. The top five student-athletes in each event, from each of the four regions, will then advance to the NCAA Championships, scheduled for June 8-11 in Sacramento, CA. 2004 BIG TEN OUTDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS REVIEW -- The Hawkeye men and women's track teams placed 10th at the Big Ten Championships in West Lafayette, IN. The men's team scored 31 points, while the women scored 42.

The Hawkeye women crowned two event champions as senior **Shellene Williams** won the 400 meters (52.97) and freshman **Peaches Roach** won the high jump (5-11 1/4). **Williams**, who set a Rankin Track record with the win, became the second female student-athlete in school history to win four conference titles, as she won the 400 meters at the 2004 indoor and 2003 outdoor conference meets and ran on the champion 1,600-meter relay at the 2003 outdoor meet. **Roach** was named Big Ten Outdoor Freshman of the Year. Iowa's other top-three finishers were senior **Brad Daufeldt** (Hammer Throw - 2nd), junior **Tiff Pedersen** (Hepathlon - 3rd), senior **Eric Rothwell** (Discus - 3rd) and senior **Russell Peterson** (400-meter hurdles - 3rd).

HAWKEYES IN BIG TEN HISTORY -- The Iowa men's team has won two Big Ten outdoor team championships (1963, 1967) and 105 event titles since the first meet was held in 1901. Two former Hawkeyes hold a spot in the conference record books. In 1997, Bashir Yamini tied the long jump record of 26-8 1/4 set in 1935 by Ohio State's Jesse Owens. Jon Reimer holds the retired 330-yard hurdles record of 36.1, set in 1965. The Hawkeye men's team has had four student-athletes earn conference individual outdoor track honors. Current Iowa assistant coach Pat McGhee is the lone Hawkeye to earn two awards in the same season, being Male Athlete of the Year and Athlete of the Championships in 1989. Other outdoor honorees were Anthuan Maybank (1993 Athlete of the Year), Jeremy Allen (1998 Freshman of the Year) and Tim Dwight (1999 Athlete of the Championships).

The Iowa women's squad has yet to win a Big Ten outdoor team title, but has crowned 27 event champions in 17 individual running events, five field events and two relays since the first meet was held in 1982. The two Hawkeyes have earned Big Ten Outdoor Freshman of the Year honors are **Erica Broomfield** (1998) and **Peaches Roach** (2004).

LAST MEET -- The Hawkeyes competed at the 96th annual Drake Relays in Des Moines. Senior **Ken Kemeny** was unable to defend his shot put title, placing second with a throw of 59-0 3/4 in that event. The Hawkeyes also snagged four third-place finishes at the meet. Senior **Chris Voller** placed third in the hammer with a collegiate-best 203-1, sophomore **Peaches Roach**

placed third in the special invitation high jump (5-9 3/4), junior **Tim Brodersen** placed third in the discus (177-0) and the women's 1,600-meter relay of senior **Aisha Hume**, sophomores **Lindsey McCalla** and **Erin Sheeley** and freshman **Kineke Alexander** placed third in 3:44.24.

MEN'S TEAM CAPTAINS CHOSEN -- Seniors Ken Kemeny, Juan Coleman and Bill Neumann are tri-captains for the 2005 season. Kemeny is a five-time NCAA qualifier in the shot put, the 2004 Drake Relays champion in that event and has led the team in the shot put each of the last three years. Coleman is a four-time NCAA qualifier in the 1,600-meter relay, and ran the lead leg on the 2001 Big Ten Outdoor Champion 400-meter relay. Neumann is a two-time all-American and Big Ten Champion in the javelin. He won that event in five of six meets in 2003, and is the school record holder.

NEXT COMPETITION -- The Hawkeyes will send athletes who meet the qualifying standards to the 2004 NCAA Midwest Regional, May 27-28 in Norman, OK. All events will be held at John Jacobs Track on the University of Oklahoma campus. All-session tickets are \$15 for adults and \$10 for youth. Single day tickets are \$10 for adults and \$7 for youth. Tickets can be ordered from the University of Oklahoma Athletic ticket office at 800/456-4668 or www.soonersports.com. Events will start each day at noon.

The Midwest region will feature 39 schools from Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas and Wyoming. The top five finishers in each individual event and the top three relays from each of the four regionals will automatically advance to the NCAA Championships, to be held June 8-11 in Sacramento, CA. The other three regions are the West (40 men's teams, 42 women's teams), the Mideast (78 men's teams, 81 women's teams) and the East (110 men's teams, 112 women's teams).

HEAD COACH

20th Season at Iowa Eastern Michigan, 1971

James Grant is in his ninth season at the helm of the Iowa women's track and field program. Grant was the former assistant coach at Iowa for 11 years (1986-96).

The past three seasons have been outstanding ones for Grant and the Hawkeyes. Iowa placed third at the 2004 Big Ten Indoor Championships in Iowa City and sixth at the 2003 conference outdoor meet. Both were Iowa's highest placings during Grant's tenure, and the third-place indoor finish tied the team's highest conference finish in school history. In the last three seasons, the Hawkeyes have crowned 11 Big Ten Champions, 37 regional qualifiers, 13 all-region selections, 22 NCAA qualifiers and three all-Americans, and set 15 school records.

In 2004, Shellene Williams became the second student-athlete in program history to win four Big Ten titles, winning three titles in the 400 meters and one as part of the 1,600-meter relay. Despite the fact that she only competed for the Hawkeyes for two seasons (2003-04), she holds school records in three individual events and two relays. Peaches Roach gave Iowa its first Big Ten high jump titles, winning that event at the indoor and outdoor conference meets to earn outdoor Freshman of the Year honors.

In 2005, Roach and freshman Kineke Alexander became Grant's first indoor all-Americans during his tenure as head coach. Roach defended her Big Ten indoor high jump title to become the second Hawkeye to win two consecutive Big Ten titles in the same event in school history. She also set the indoor school record in that event, breaking the 6-0 mark for the first time of her collegiate career. Sophomore Tiffany Johnson set the school triple jump records, both indoors and outdoors, while sophomore Becca Franklin broke the hammer throw record.

Grant also had immense success in his first two seasons at the Hawkeye helm. Wynsome Cole was an all-American in the 400-meter hurdles at the 1997 NCAA Championships. Iowa won six Big Ten event titles in those two seasons, and Erica Broomfield was named 1998 Big Ten Indoor Freshman of the Year.

While improving in the league standings in considered a priority, Iowa's track and field team also concerns itself with performance in the classroom. During Grant's tenure, 34 Hawkeyes have earned 63 academic all-Big Ten honors.

As Iowa's assistant coach from 1986-96, Grant coached several Hawkeyes to success. In 1995, Yolanda Hobbs was an all-American in the 55 and 200 meters after winning the 55-meter Big Ten title. In 1994, Iowa's 400 meter-relay of Tina Floyd, Hobbs, Marlene Poole and Tanja Reid earned a spot in the Hawkeye record books it won Iowa's first Big Ten title in that event, earned all-America honors and set meet and school records. Karen Layne won the 1990 600-meter Big Ten title, while Senta Hawkins won the Big Ten 400 meters in 1988. In 1989, Iowa's 1,600-meter relay placed second at the Big Ten Indoor and Outdoor Championships.

A former Jamaican track standout, Grant coached at the high school level in Jamaica for 11 years prior to joining the Hawkeye program. From 1982-86, Grant coached men's and women's track at G.C. Foster College of Physical Education and Sport. There he led the men's team to two national championships and two second-place finishes, and the women's team to three national titles. During that time he coached world outdoor champion quarter-miler Bert Cameron, and world indoor champion quarter-miler Devon Morris.

A graduate of Eastern Michigan University, Grant captained the 1970 and 1971 Huron track teams, earning all-America honors while specializing in the 400 meters, 400-meter hurdles, and the mile relay. During this time, he was the Jamaican 400-meter hurdle national record holder, with a time that was ranked in the top-20 in the world. Grant also represented Jamaica at the Pan American Games and the Commonwealth Games for six years. In 1991, he was inducted into the Eastern Michigan Hall of Fame.

He was the 1965 and 1966 Jamaican national champion in both the 200 and 400 meters as a high school athlete at Jamaica's Kingston College.

Grant received his bachelor's degree in sociology and history from Eastern Michigan, and his master's degree in physical education from the German College of Physical Education in Leipzig, Germany.

University of Iowa Men's Head Coach



LARRY WIECZOREK HEAD COACH

21st Season at Iowa University of Iowa, 1969

Larry Wieczorek is in his ninth season as head men's track and field coach at Iowa, and recently completed his 18th season as head men's cross country coach. He served as an assistant track and field coach for 12 years before taking the helm in 1997.

A six-time Big Ten champion and four-time all-American at Iowa, Wieczorek once held conference marks in the one, two, three, four and five-mile runs. A member of Iowa's last Big Ten track championship team in 1967, he still owns Iowa records in the outdoor 5,000-meters and the indoor two miles, as well as third-fastest mark in the cross country 8,000 meters. He was inducted into Iowa's National Varsity Club Athletics Hall of Fame in 1998.

Under Wieczorek, the cross country team has placed sixth or higher eight times at the NCAA Regional Championships, posted 22 all-region selections and qualified for the NCAA Championships three times. In 2002, Wieczorek was named Midwest Regional Coach of the Year honors by the United States Cross Country Association after the Hawkeyes won the NCAA Regional for the first time in school history and advancing to the NCAA Championships for the second time in five years. Iowa also tied a school record with five NCAA all-Region selections. In 2004, the Hawkeyes recorded their highest placing at the Big Ten Championships (3rd) and NCAA Championships (13th) under Wieczorek. Hawkeye sophomore Micah VanDenend earned second team all-Big Ten honors with his 14th place finish at the conference meet, which was hosted by Iowa on Ashton Cross Country Course. Iowa also crowned four all-region selections in seniors Matt Esche and Tony Rakaric, and juniors Dan Haut and Adam Roche.

Since Wieczorek was named head men's track and field coach in 1997, his plan to build a strong sprint program around a national power 1,600-meter relay, and strong throws program is being realized. In his nine years at the helm, Wieczorek has coached NCAA Champion long jumper Bashir Yamini, 23 all-Americans, 73 national qualifiers, 40 regional qualifiers and 33 Big Ten Champions. Iowa's 1,600-meter relay won the 1999 Big Ten outdoor title and has earned all-America honors twice during Wieczorek's tenure. The Hawkeyes recorded their highest conference indoor placing (fourth) in 1997, and their highest

team finish at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships (second) in 33 years at the 1999 Big Ten outdoor meet.

Another of Wieczorek's goals as head coach was to create an annual outdoor home event for the Hawkeyes that would be entertaining for the community and feature outstanding competition for participating student-athletes. Now in it's seventh year of existence, the annual Iowa Musco Twilight Meet is just that. Named for Musco Lighting of Oskaloosa, IA, who supplies mobile lighting equipment, the co-ed meet which features five teams in 2005, starts in the late afternoon and extends into the night. In its first four years, the meet had produced 43 NCAA provisional qualifiers. Since the creation of the regional qualifying system in 2003, 130 competitors have reached qualifying standards.

While improving in the league standings is considered a priority, the Hawkeyes also concern themselves with performance in the classroom. Under Wieczorek, former cross country runners Kevin Herd, Chad Schwitters and Stetson Steele earned academic all-America honors. Iowa has had an academic all-Big Ten selection each year during his tenure, totaling 53 honorees in cross country and 47 in track.

Wieczorek came to Iowa after 11 seasons as head track coach at Proviso (IL) West High School. He also served as an assistant there for three years. His prep teams were consistent placers on the state level and several of his athletes won state titles. He served on the Illinois track advisory board and founded the prestigious Proviso Indoor Track Classic. Wieczorek was inducted into the Illinois High School Track and Cross Country Coaches Hall of Fame in 2000.

Wieczorek was born on September 11, 1946, in Chicago, IL. He received his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1969 and his M.S. degree in physical education from Northern Illinois University in 1973. His wife's name is Jackie.
