IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,054 games since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 644-411 (.612). That includes a 321-162 (.665) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 305-88 (.776) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE

The Michigan State Spartans are 18-2 overall and 6-1 in Big Ten play. Michigan State's only losses came at the hands of Baylor, who is currently ranked No. 1 in the country, and Ohio State.

In their last game, the Spartans defeated Minnesota, 66-54, in East Lansing. LyKendra Johnson recorded 20 points, 17 rebounds, five blocks and four steals to lead Michigan State. Kalisha Keane had 14 points and five steals, while Cetera Washington had 10 points and eight rebounds.

Keane leads the team with 15.9 points per game, followed by Johnson at 11 points per contest. Johnson also leads the team with 8.6 rebounds per game.

As a team, the Spartans are shooting .425 (512-1,205) from the field, including .335 (140-418) from three-point distance.

MICHIGAN STATE VS. IOWA NOTES

- Thursday's contest is the 57th meeting between Iowa and Michigan State, with the Hawkeyes leading the all-time series, 32-24. Iowa has won three of the last five meetings, but Michigan State has won 10 of the previous 14 contests. The Hawkeyes are 18-8 in games played in Iowa City.

- Iowa won both meetings last year, including a 77-66 win in Iowa City and a 59-54 victory in the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament.

- Two of the top rebounding teams in the Big Ten will match up Thursday night. Iowa leads the conference in rebounding (42.3 per game), while Michigan State ranks fourth (41.3 per game). Michigan State and Iowa rank first and second, respectively, in rebounding margin and offensive rebounding.

LAST MEETING

Michigan State's Kalisha Keane hit a three-pointer with 0.5 seconds remaining to give the ninth-ranked Spartans a 63-60 win over Iowa in East Lansing (Jan. 13).

Iowa trailed 60-52 with 2:01 left in the game before scoring eight-straight points, capped by a three-pointer by Kamille Wahlin, to tie the game at 60 with 10 seconds remaining. Michigan State ended Iowa's comeback with the buzzer-beating three-pointer.

Jaime Printy led Iowa with 23 points on 7-11 shooting from the field, including a perfect 4-4 from beyond the arc, and also had seven rebounds. Printy had 18 of Iowa's 28 first half points. Kamille Wahlin added 17 points, three rebounds and three assists.

JOHNSON'S BLOCK PARTY AGAINST MICHIGAN STATE

With three blocks against Michigan State in the Big Ten Tournament last season, Morgan Johnson set both the school and freshman record for single-season blocks. Three previous record of 73 was held by Tangela Smith (1994-95). Johnson finished last season with 79 blocks.

IOWA IN THE RANKINGS

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 18 in the AP poll and No. 21 in the ESPN/USA Today poll.

Four Iowa opponents are also ranked in the AP and the ESPN/USA Today polls: Michigan State (10/11), North Carolina (15th/14th), Iowa State (23rd/20th) and Ohio State (24th/23rd).

Northwestern is receiving votes.

HAWKEYES DROP GAME AT OHIO STATE

Iowa dropped an 81-67 decision at Ohio State (Jan. 24).

The Hawkeyes led, 33-32, heading into halftime, but the Buckeyes shot lights-out in the second half to seal the win. Ohio State was 13-17 (.765) from the field in the second half, including 5-7 (.714) from three-point distance and 5-7 (.714) from the charity stripe.

Four Hawkeyes scored double figures, led by Kelly Krei's 15 points. Morgan Johnson added 14, Kamille Wahlin chipped in 13 and Jaime Printy had 12. Kachine Alexander finished with nine points, 11 rebounds, seven assists and three steals.

MORE MILESTONES FOR ALEXANDER

- With 11 rebounds at Ohio State (Jan. 24), Kachine Alexander became just the sixth player in school history, and the first-ever guard, to collect 800 career rebounds.
- Alexander is the sixth player in school history to have 1,000 career points and 800 career rebounds.
- If Alexander records seven more assists, she would be the only player in Iowa history to have 1,000 career points, 800 career rebounds and 300 career assists.

PRINTY AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Iowa has played in five games against opponents ranked in the top 25 this year, and Jaime Printy's numbers in those games have been impressive.

Printy is averaging 16.4 points, 4.4 rebounds and 4.2 assists in Iowa's games against ranked opponents (North Carolina, Iowa State, Ohio State twice and Michigan State). Printy is shooting .439 (25-57) from the field, including .435 (10-23) from three-point distance and .917 (22-24) from the free throw line against ranked foes.

PRINTY HAS A BIG WEEK

Jaime Printy averaged 20.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in Iowa's two games at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and at home vs. Indiana (Jan. 16).

Printy shot a combined .571 (12-21) from the field, including .700 (7-10) from three-point distance, while only missing one free throw (10-11, .909).

Printy started the week with 23 points, seven rebounds, two assists and three steals in Iowa's buzzer-beater loss at Michigan State, scoring 18 of Iowa's 28 first half points.

She followed with a game-high 18 points on 5-10 shooting, including 3-6 from beyond the arc, and eight rebounds in Iowa's 20-point victory over Indiana.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 560-270 (.675), including a 204-128 (.614) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

NINE IN A ROW FROM DOWNTOWN

Jaime Printy buried nine-straight three-pointers, starting with Iowa's game at Minnesota (Jan. 5). Printy made her last three-point attempt at Minnesota, was a perfect 2-2 against Ohio State (Jan. 8), a perfect 4-4 at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and made her first two attempts vs. Indiana (Jan. 16) before missing a long-distance shot.

SEEING DOUBLE

Kachine Alexander recorded her fifth double-double of the season against Indiana (Jan. 16), finishing with 14 points and 10 rebounds.

Alexander now has 29 career double-doubles, which is six shy of Lisa Long's school record for double-doubles (35, set from 1983-87).

Last season, Alexander finished with 15 double-doubles, which was one shy of tying Amy Herrig's record for single-season double-doubles.

Alexander tallied nine double-doubles as a sophomore.

KASH GETS A GRAND

With a layup at the 11:54 mark in the first half against Minnesota (Jan. 5), senior Kachine Alexander became the 27th player in school history to record 1,000 career points.

Alexander currently ranks 24th in career scoring at Iowa with 1,061 points.

JOHNSON BRINGING THE WINDEX

Morgan Johnson tallied 10 or more rebounds for the fourth time this season against Indiana (Jan. 16). Johnson finished the game one-point shy of a double-double, scoring nine points and grabbing 10 boards.

Johnson has recorded double digit rebounds in 10 career games.

JOHNSON AT .500 OR BETTER

When Morgan Johnson takes eight or more shots in a game, chances are she will make at least half of them.

Johnson has attempted eight or more shots in 15 of Iowa's 20 games this year. In those 15 games, Johnson has shot .500 or better 10 times, including two 6-9 (.667) shooting performances against North Carolina and Kansas State.

Johnson has attempted 10 or more shots eight times, shooting .500 or better in all but two games. Johnson was 8-13 (.615) against Northeastern, 10-16 (.625) against Central Michigan, 8-11 (.727) vs. Iowa State, 9-12 (.750) vs. South Dakota State, 5-10 (.500) vs. Michigan and vs. Ohio State and 7-12 (.583) at Ohio State.

She was 2-12 (.167) vs. James Madison and 4-12 (.333) at Minnesota.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Morgan Johnson recorded her fifth double-double of the season and the eighth double-double of her career against Minnesota (Jan. 5). Johnson finished the game with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET

Morgan Johnson scored double figures over a tough four game-stretch, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 Iowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Iowa is one of only four teams in the Big Ten to have four players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the conference.

Iowa, Ohio State, Northwestern and Penn State each have four players ranked. Wisconsin, has three ranked, while the remaining six school have either one or two players ranked.

The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in 17 of the 20 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan, Kansas State, Minnesota and in both games vs. Ohio State.

HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS

Iowa's rebounding numbers through its first 20 games are impressive. The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in total rebounding (42.3 per game) and rank second in rebounding margin (+5.8), offensive rebounds (14.5 per game) and defensive rebounds (27.9 per game).

Kachine Alexander ranks second in offensive rebounding (3.6 per game) and third in overall rebounding (9.4 per game). Johnson ranks third in offensive rebounding (3.5 per game) Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are the third most for any Big Ten player this season.

REBOUNDING NUMBERS IMPROVED FROM A YEAR AGO

Iowa's rebounding has improved greatly from a year ago.

Through 20 games last year, Iowa had a -0.1 rebound margin. The Hawkeyes were being outrebounded, 756-759, including a 241-253 deficit on the offensive glass.

This year through 20 games, Iowa holds a +5.9 rebounding margin and is outrebounding opponents 847-730. That includes a 290-243 advantage on the offensive glass.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (29), sixth in career rebounding (803), 11th in career assists (293) and 24th in career scoring (1,061). - Kamille Wahlin ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (145) and 27th in career scoring (943). She needs 12 more three-pointers to move past Leah Wagner into fourth place.

BLUDER REACHES MILESTONE

With a 75-71 win at Drake Dec. 20, Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder became only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 204 wins in her 11 years at Iowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at Iowa, finishing her time in Iowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

ALEXANDER NAMED CO-BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week, Nov. 22, for her efforts against Bradley, Northeastern and Central Michigan. Alexander shared the weekly honor with Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of Iowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander has now been named Big Ten Player of the Week five times in her career. She was a two-time award winner as both a sophomore and junior.

ALEXANDER MAKES FIRST CUT FOR WOODEN AWARD - ON WATCH LISTS FOR OTHERS

Senior Kachine Alexander was one of 20 players to be named to the Wooden Award Top 20 Midseason List Jan 11. She is also on watch lists for the Wade Trophy and the Naismith Trophy. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players and the Naismith Trophy watch list is made up of 50 players.

The Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy are considered the three most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

Alexander is also one of 30 Division I women's basketball players nationally to be selected as a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible, the candidates must show excellence in four categories: community, classroom, character and competition.

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last year marked the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

Iowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.
