LEADING OFF

- The Hawkeyes are ranked for the eighth straight week, coming in No. 15 by Collegiate Baseball, 18th by Perfect Game, 19th by Baseball America, 21st in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, 21st by the UCBWA, and 22nd by D1Baseball.com.
- Iowa won 19 games in Big Ten play to earn its highest regular season finish in 25 years. The Hawkeyes' 39 overall wins are the most victories since 1990. Iowa has four top-four Big Ten finishes since 1990.
- The Hawkeyes are making their second straight and 10th Big Ten Tournament appearance. Iowa is 9-18 all-time in the event, finishing as the runner-up in 1983 and 2010.
- Iowa has gone 8-1 in neutral site games this season, winning eight straight since dropping their season opener to Kansas State in Port Charlotte, Florida.
- The Hawkeyes had a school-record six student-athletes earn All-Big Ten recognition in Blake Hickman (1st team), Nick Hibbing, Calvin Mathews, and Eric Toole (2nd team) and Nick Roscetti and Tyler Peyton (3rd team).
- Iowa registered its 30th victory of the season in game two of an April 26 doubleheader against Nebraska, giving Iowa back-to-back 30 win seasons for the first time since 1989 and 1990. The team's 39 wins are the most since 1985 when Iowa won 40 games.
- UI head coach Rick Heller is the winningest coach in Iowa history in his first two seasons, winning 69 games.
- Junior Blake Hickman went 7-0 with a 2.45 ERA in Big Ten play, and is 9-1 overall with a 2.75 ERA. The nine victories are the most by a Hawkeye since 2005 and tied for the fourth most in school history and are 18th-best nationally.

Junior Blake Hickman is the first Iowa start-

ing pitcher since 2004 to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. The right-hander led the Big Ten with seven victories and is 9-1 with a 2.75 ERA this season. Hickman has given up 59 hits over 78 2/3 innings and is holding hitters to a .207 batting average.

Rick Heller is entering his second season as head coach of the University of Iowa baseball program. Heller was tabbed as the 20th head coach program history July 12, 2013, after serving as head coach at Indiana State from 2010-13.

Heller, a native of Eldon, Iowa, has been head coach at four institutions -- Iowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99) -- leading his first three schools to NCAA postseason play. He led Indiana State to its first outright Missouri Valley Conference title in 2012. He led Northern Iowa to the 2001 MVC title and into the NCAA Tournament, the first regional appearance for the Panthers since becoming a Division I program in 1981. In 27 seasons as a head coach, Heller holds a career mark of 757-600-4.

In his first season in Iowa City, Heller helped guide the Hawkeyes to a 9-1 start -- the program's best start since 1940 -- a Big Ten Tournament berth and conference tournament win. Iowa finished the year with a 30-23 record for just the third 30-win season since 1993. The 30 victories are the most by a first-year coach in Iowa history.

Heller won his 700th career game in a 13-1 rout of Georgetown on March 15 at the Snowbird Classic in Florida. The Hawkeyes also took 2-of-3 games from Nebraska to open the Big Ten regular season -- Iowa's first conference-opening series win since 1998 and took 2-of-3 games against Minnesota for the first time since 2005.

Under Heller's direction, Iowa became one of the most potent offensive teams in the Big Ten in 2014. The Hawkeyes led the conference in four offensive categories (batting average, hits, runs and on-base percentage) and ranked second in four more (slugging percentage, RBIs, home runs and total bases). Iowa finished with 23 home runs -- a season after the team had two long balls in 49 contests.

Heller coached five student-athletes to All-Big Ten recognition, the most for the program since 2007. Junior shortstop Jake Yacinich garnered first-team All-Big Ten honors after ranking second in the league in batting average and steals. He was the first Iowa first-teamer since 2009.

NEXT UP

The 15th-ranked and second-seeded University of Iowa baseball team faces third-seeded Michigan in a Big Ten Tournament winner's bracket game at 5 p.m. (CT) on Thursday at Target Field in Minneapolis.

GAME COVERAGE

- Thursday's game will be televised live on BTN with Kevin Kugler and former Hawkeye Danan Hughes on the call.
- The game will also be broadcast on AM-800 KXIC and AM-1360 KMJM with Brent Balbinot and Steve Duncan on the call. The game will also be available via the subscription-based service Hawkeye All-Access on hawkeyesports.com.

• LAST GAME

The Hawkeyes won their opening round game, 3-2 over seventh-seeded Ohio State, with a walk-off, two-run home run from senior Nick Day. Day finished 2-for-3 with two RBIs and a run scored in the game.

- Junior Tyler Peyton threw 6 1/3 innings, allowing one run on eight hits with seven strikeouts against zero walks. Senior Nick Hibbing (3-1) picked up the victory, allowing one run in 2 2/3 innings.

QUICK HITTERS

- Senior Kris Goodman has reached safely in a career-best 14 straight games, while junior Tyler Peyton has reached safely in 11 consecutive contests. Peyton also has a six-game hitting streak.
- Eric Toole went 0-for-4 against Ohio State. It was just his third game this season where he hasn't reached safely.
- The Hawkeyes have allowed two earned runs or fewer in 31 games this season, including 15 in Big Ten play.
- The Hawkeyes currently have a 2.89 team ERA over 53 games. Iowa's school record is 3.63, set in 1971.
- Twenty-one games have been decided by two runs or less. Iowa is 16-7 in such contests.
- Iowa is 19-5 when playing error-free baseball and 32-9 when committing one or fewer errors. Iowa is 7-5 when committing two or more errors.
- The Hawkeyes are 29-2 when out-hitting their opponents and 29-5 when scoring first. Conversely, Iowa is 10-9 when the opponent scores first.
- Iowa has out scored opponents 35-12 in the first inning, and 94-47 over the first three innings.

THE SERIES

- The Wolverines own a 110-49 advantage against Iowa in the all-time series. Iowa won the regular season series, taking 2-of-3 games in Ann Arbor from May 1-3. It was the Hawkeyes' first series win over Michigan since 2010.
- Iowa is 2-6 all-time against Michigan in the Big Ten Tournament. The Wolverines eliminated Iowa, 7-1, last season in Omaha.

REGULAR SEASON SERIES

- Iowa took 2-of-3 games from Michigan during the regular season in Ann Arbor. The Hawkeyes won the opening game 13-7, dropped game two, 11-5, before winning the finale, 2-0.
- The Hawkeyes hit .315 and scored 20 runs during the weekend with Nick Roscetti leading the way with a .500 average (6-for-12) with four RBIs and two runs. Dan Potempa hit .333 in the series, which included a 4-for-6, three-RBI performance in the series opener.
- Iowa had a 6.23 ERA in the series -- its highest ERA during a series this season. The Wolverines scored 18 runs on 28 hits in three games and struck out just seven times while drawing 14 walks.
- Junior Blake Hickman lasted just 2 1/3 innings in his May 1 start, allowing four runs on five hits and giving up three doubles.
- Junior Ryan Erickson earned the win in relief May 1, throwing a career-high 5 2/3 innings, allowing two runs on five hits. He had two strikeouts to two walks.
- Junior Calvin Mathews and senior Nick Hibbing combined to limit Michigan to four hits in a 2-0 shutout victory May 3. Mathews allowed three hits over six innings, while Hibbing allowed a single hit over three.

A DAY TO REMEMBER

Senior Nick Day belted a two-out, two-run walk-off home run into the left field bleachers at Target Field to send the Hawkeyes to a 3-2 come-from-behind victory over Ohio State on Wednesday.

Day finished 2-for-3 with two RBIs and a run scored. It was his first multi-hit game since April 3 at Purdue, and his first home run since April 1 at Western Illinois.

The blast was Day's first career home run against a Big Ten opponent and fourth overall. It was Iowa's first walk-off home run since Jason White in 2008 (10-9 win over Illinois).

WIN TOTAL CLIMBING

- Iowa has won 39 games in 2015, reaching the 30-win plateau in two straight seasons for the first time since 1989 and 1990.
- The 39 victories are the most for the program since 1985.
- Iowa hasn't won 40 games since 1985 (40-20), and the program has only three 40-win seasons in its history.

WALK-OFF WINNERS

The Hawkeyes have posted six walk-off wins this season with contributions from six different players. Iowa has overcome deficits in 14 games, going 11-3 in such contests.

GOOD PITCHING... GOOD DEFENSE

The Hawkeyes have relied on their pitching and defense all season. Iowa ranks in the top-10 nationally in both team fielding percentage (.979) and ERA (2.89). The team has committed 43 errors in 53 games -- the fewest in the Big Ten -- and Iowa has 43 double plays.
