IOWA WOMEN'S ROWING VARSITY 4+ BOAT NAMED BIG TEN BOAT OF THE WEEK

IOWA CITY, IA – After finishing the weekend with an undefeated record, the University of Iowa Varsity 4+ crew was rewarded for their efforts and was named Big Ten Boat of the Week. This is the first time the Varsity 4+ has received this honor, while the Varsity 8+ has received the honor five times in the last four years.

On Friday, March 19, the Varsity 4+ crew, comprised of Sheena Williams, Allison Frederick, Sophie Nielsen, Kathleen Lehman and Katie Moe, opened the spring season with a victory over Texas. They posted a time of 8:08.2, defeating Texas by over 30 seconds.

The Varsity 4+ continued their dominance on Saturday, defeating Tulsa by 20 seconds. Iowa timed an 8:07.6, while Tulsa posted a time of 8:27.5. Crew members on Saturday's team included: Vanessa Sheehan, Anna Battoe, Lesley Weston, Stephanie Beeler and Laura Balogh.

The Varsity 4+ wrapped up a successful weekend on Sunday, defeating Duke by nearly 20 seconds. The Hawkeyes posted a time of 7:30.2 to secure the win, with Duke finishing in 7:49.9. Crew members on Sunday's team included: Lori Rehel, Allison Frederick, Sophie
