HEAD COACH JIM ZALESKY

Jim Zalesky is in his eighth season as head coach at the University of Iowa. He has a school and career record of 111-23 (.828). Named National Coach of the Year in 1998 and 1999, and Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2000, he has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA (1998-00) and three Big Ten titles (1998, 2000, 2004). Zalesky has coached 10 NCAA Champions, 20 Big Ten Champions and 36 all-Americans at Iowa. He was inducted into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame in June 2004, the University of Iowa Letterman's Club Hall of Fame and the Iowa High School Athletic Association Wrestling Hall of Fame in 2002, and the Iowa Wrestling Hall of Fame in 1994.

A three-time national champion and one of Iowa's 15 four-time all-Americans, Zalesky was an assistant coach and head recruiter at Iowa under Dan Gable for seven seasons (1991-97). He was named Assistant Coach of the Year by the N.W.C.A. in 1992 and 1997. Undeclared as a junior and senior, Zalesky ended his career on an 89-match winning streak.

OKLAHOMA STATE COWBOYS

Oklahoma State is 6-0 on the season with wins over Tennessee-Chattanooga (37-6), Boise State (38-0), Minnesota (28-10), Oklahoma (21-16), Cal Poly (32-9) and Fresno State (34-6). The Cowboys will host Michigan State Thursday at 7 p.m. That match was rescheduled from last week due to bad weather.

Cowboy Head Coach John Smith is 205-25-3 in 13 seasons at Oklahoma State. The Cowboys return four all-Americans from the 2003-04 squad that went 17-2 and won Big 12 and NCAA team titles. Oklahoma State is led by four undefeated competitors in freshman Nathan Morgan (17-0 at 133), junior Zack Esposito (15-0 at 149), junior Jake Rosholt (15-0 at 197) and junior Steve Mocco (15-0 at heavyweight). Senior Chris Pendleton (174) and sophomore Johny Hendricks (165) are both 14-1 this season.

THE SERIES

Oklahoma State leads the series with Iowa, 20-16-1. The Cowboys have won the last four meetings and hold a 10-5-1 advantage in Stillwater.

LAST MEETING

Iowa lost a 30-10 decision to top-ranked Oklahoma State January 11, 2004, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena in Iowa City. The Cowboys snapped Iowa's 10-match winning streak in Carver-Hawkeye and handed the Hawkeyes their 10th and worst arena loss.

Bright spots for the Hawkeyes were wins by sophomore Joe Johnston (157) and seniors Luke Eustice (125) and Cliff Moore (133). Johnston scored a 5-3 decision over Oklahoma State's Johnny Hendricks at 157 pounds. Luke Eustice picked up Iowa's second win of the day with his 10-4 win over Cowboy Cody Stites at 125. Moore closed out the dual with an 18-7 major decision over Oklahoma State's Ronnie Delk at 141. Here are the match-by-match results:

FAMILY TIES

Hawkeye redshirt freshman **Mark Perry** (165) is the nephew of Oklahoma State Head Coach John Smith. Perry's mother, Cathy, and Smith are brother and sister. Perry's father, Mark, was a two-time Big 12 Conference champion (1984-85) at 118 pounds and a three-year letterwinner (1983-85) for the Cowboys. He also served as an assistant coach on the Cowboy coaching staff for eight seasons (1992-99).

MEETING UP WITH MOCCO

Sunday will be the first dual meeting between Oklahoma State heavyweight Steven Mocco and his former Hawkeye teammates. Mocco was a two-time all-American at Iowa, winning Big Ten and NCAA titles in 2003 as a sophomore. He took an Olympic redshirt in 2003-04, and transferred to Oklahoma State for the 2004-05 school year. His career record at Iowa was 71-3 with 24 pins. The top-ranked junior has already faced one Hawkeye this season, defeating freshman Matt Fields, 5-0, at the 2004 Kaufman-Brand Open.

LAST WEEK

Iowa went 3-0 last weekend, defeating Virginia Tech (38-0) Friday in Iowa City, and then beating Fresno State (30-7) Sunday afternoon in Fresno, CA, and Cal Davis (26-9) Sunday night in Davis, CA.

Against Virginia Tech, Iowa scored its highest dual meet point total (38), recorded its first shut-out of the season, and improved to 3-1 with the win. Virginia Tech, coached by former Iowa assistant coach and NCAA Champion Tom Brands, fell to 8-3 with the loss.

Iowa scored team bonus points in three matches, en route to a 30-7 win over Fresno State. A crowd of 6,863, which is the second-highest dual meet attendance figure in Fresno State wrestling history, attended the dual.

The Hawkeyes picked up their second dual victory of the day with a 26-9 victory over Cal Davis. The crowd of 5,150 set a Cal Davis dual wrestling meet attendance record, and is the largest Pavilion crowd so far this season. The facility also hosts Aggie basketball, volleyball and gymnastics competitions. It was a Zalesky vs. Zalesky match-up as Hawkeye Head Coach **Jim Zalesky** faced Cal Davis Head Coach Lennie Zalesky, who is his older brother and was a three-time all-American and Big Ten Champion at Iowa. **Jim Zalesky** is now 2-0 in the brother series, picking up his first win in Iowa City in 2002-03 (36-3).

Going 3-0 for Iowa on the weekend were juniors **Mario Galanakis** (133), **Ty Eustice** (149) and **Joe Johnston** (157), redshirt freshman **Mark Perry** (165) and freshmen **Charlie Falck** (125), **Alex Tsirtsis** (141) and **Matt Fields** (Hwt.). **Galanakis** recorded two upsets, defeating sixth-ranked David Hoffman of Virginia Tech, 8-4, and beating top 20-ranked Derek Moore of Cal Davis, 5-4. **Tsirtsis** recorded a pin and two major decisions, **Perry** scored three major decisions, and **Fields** scored a major decision and two wins in sudden victory.

IOWA WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 779-198-30 (.788) in 93 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 20 national titles, including nine of the last 14, and 31 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 47 NCAA Champions have won a total of 73 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 13 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 99 Big Ten Champions have won a total of 180 conference individual titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time and 24 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 124 all-Americans have earned all-America status 254 times, including 16 four-time, 27 three-time and 28 two-time honorees.
