LEADING OFF

- Junior Mason McCoy became the first Hawkeye since 2007 to hit for the cycle; he finished 5-for-7 with six RBIs in a 22-2 rout of Air Force on April 13. The five hits tied an lowa single-game school record.
- McCoy is the first Big Ten player since 2013 to hit for the cycle.
- lowa has posted 10 come-from-behind victories in 2016. The Hawkeyes have two walk-off wins -- their seventh and eighth since the start of 2015 -- downing Bradley, 7-6, on March 22 and Illinois, 4-3,
- The Hawkeyes are 10-2 at Duane Banks Field this season, but just 3-12 in true road games.
- Senior Joel Booker is 11-of-12 on the base paths this season. The outfielder has been successful in seven straight attempts; he hasn't been caught stealing since March 12 against Seton Hall.
- Senior Eric Schenck-Joblinske had the gamewinning RBI single in the 10th inning in lowa's come-from-behind, extra-inning victory April 17 at Indiana. Schenck-Joblinske was 1-for-3 with two RBIs -- his second two-RBI game this season.
- lowa is second in the Big Ten Conference and 18th nationally with a .978 team fielding percentage.

MIDWEEK SUCCESS

The Hawkeyes are a perfect 6-0 in midweek contests this season — all coming at Duane Banks Field. lowa is averaging 14.5 runs per game and is hitting .344 as a team midweek and the pitching staff has a 2.77 ERA. Joel Booker (.440) and Daniel Aaron Moriel (.409) are both hitting over .400.

THE SERIES

lowa leads the all-time series over Bradley, 42-40-2. The Hawkeyes won the first meeting this season, 7-6, ending a two-game losing streak in the series.

REMATCH ON MOUND

Wednesday's pitching match-up between a pair of lowa native -- Cole McDonald and Ben Olson -- is a rematch of the March 22 meeting in lowa City.

McDonald allowed two runs on four hits in 1 1/3 innings, while Olson gave up one run on three hits in two innings.

TOP 14 BOOKER

Joel Booker ranks in the top 14 in the Big Ten in six different offensive categories. He is sixth in total bases (74), tied for eighth in steals (11), ninth in runs (31), tied for ninth in doubles (10), 10th in hits (47), and 14th in slugging percentage (.517).

THINGS ARE "ROSEY"

Senior Nick Roscetti has a team-best 16 multi-hit games and seven multi-RBI contests. He had a career-best 15-game hitting streak from Feb. 26-March 22. The shortstop tied a career-high with four hits, going 4-for-5 with three runs scored in the series finale at Indiana. Roscetti scored the gamewinning run in the top of the 10th inning.

• Roscetti ranks 11th in the Big Ten in hits (47) and tied for 15th in runs (28).

PEYTON HEATS UP

Senior Tyler Peyton has posted four multi-hit games in his last five contests, and he's hitting .450 (9-of-20) during the stretch. Peyton had two hits in all three games of the weekend series at Indiana.

STRENGTH IN NUMBERS

lowa's relief corps has been a strength of the 2016 pitching staff. The Hawkeye relievers have posted a 2.96 ERA over 152 innings and have 117 strikeouts to 58 walks. Opponents are hitting .231 against the relievers.

- Redshirt junior Josh Martsching as emerged as a closer. He is 1-0 with a 1.17 ERA in eight appearance, fanning seven in 7 2/3 innings. The Bloomfield, lowa, native has a team-high three saves.
- Sophomore Nick Allgeyer has a 3.54 ERA in 12 appearances tied for a team-high. He has allowed 16 hits in 20 1/3 innings and is holding opposing hitters to a .216 average. The southpaw allowed one run on three hits in 3 2/3 innings last weekend at Indiana.
