THIS WEEK

Top seed Iowa (10-0) will face unseeded Wyoming (3-0) in the first round of the NWCA/Cliff Keen National Duals Saturday at 9 a.m. at the UNI-Dome in Cedar Falls. The two-day annual tournament features 16 teams from NCAA Division I, 12 from Division II, 15 from Division III and NAIA, eight NJCAA teams, seven NCWA teams and five women's wrestling teams.

The Division I field includes seven of the top 10_ranked teams in the most recent USA Today/Intermat/NWCA coaches poll. Boise State, Buffalo, Cornell, Indiana, Iowa State, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, Northern Iowa, Northwestern, Ohio State, Penn State, Wisconsin and Wyoming will battle the Hawkeyes for the title. Results will be available at www.unipanthers.com throughout the tournament.

Depending on the outcome of the Iowa-Wyoming dual, the Hawkeyes will face either the winner or loser of the #8 Minnesota-Buffalo dual Saturday at 1 p.m.

WYOMING COWBOYS

Wyoming is 3-0 on the season with wins over Stanford (34-10), Cal State Fullerton (20-15) and Columbia (21-18). The Cowboys, who are making their first appearance at the Cliff Keen/NWCA National Duals, have competed in six tournaments this season.

Head Coach Mark Branch is in his first season at Wyoming. A four-time NCAA finalist for Oklahoma State, Branch served as an associate head coach at his alma mater for six seasons. He is assisted by Ben VomBaur and Travis Shufelt.

The Cowboys are led by a trio of redshirt freshmen who have all posted over 20 wins this season. Michael Martinez is 21-7 at 125, Shane Onufer is 28-5 at 174 and Joe LeBlanc is 26-4 at 184.

Iowa won the only previous meeting between the two schools - 21-6 in 1958.

HEAD COACH TOM BRANDS



The 2008 NWCA, *W.I.N. Magazine* and Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his third season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time all-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 45-6 overall and 19-3

Big Ten record at Iowa, and a 62-26 career mark.

In his second season at Iowa, Brands guided the squad to NCAA and Big Ten titles, as well the Big Ten regular season title with an undefeated 8-0 league mark. It was Iowa's 21st NCAA team title - the first since 2000 - and the Hawkeyes' 32nd Big Ten championship - the first since 2004. Iowa also won the 2007 Midlands title and the Division I trophy at the NWCA/Cliff Keen National Duals in January. The Hawkeyes posted a 21-1 dual mark, ending the season on a 14-match winning streak. Senior Mark Perry and junior Brent Metcalf each won NCAA titles, and Iowa crowned a total of seven all-Americans, which was the most for Iowa since 2001.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 all-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001. Brands was a four-time all-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

LAST TIME AT THE DUALS

Iowa won its fourth NWCA/Cliff Keen National Duals title, defeating all four opponents at the 2008 tournament in Cedar Falls. The second-seeded Hawkeyes opened the tournament with a 32-3 win over Cornell, defeated seventh-seeded Missouri (27-9) in the quarterfinals, sixth-seeded Michigan (23-13) in the semifinals and unseeded Nebraska (24-6) in the finals. Iowa posted a 32-8 mark over the four duals, and sophomore 149-pounder **Brent Metcalf** was named Division I Outstanding Wrestler of the tournament.

HAWKEYE HISTORY AT THE DUALS

lowa has wrestled in 16 National Duals and has a 58-10-3 all time record in the tournament. Iowa has won the title four times (1992, 1995, 1996, 2008), placed second three times (1994, 1997, 1998), third six times (1990, 1991, 1993, 2001, 2002, 2003), fifth once (2007) and sixth once (2006).

HAWKEYES WIN 20TH MIDLANDS TITLE

The University of Iowa wrestling team won its 20th Midlands title in school history and crowned three individual champions at the 2008 tournament in Evanston, IL, Dec. 30. The Hawkeyes tallied 156.5 points in the two-day tournament, edging out runner-up Iowa State by three points for the team title. Hawkeye juniors **Daniel Dennis** (133), **Brent Metcalf** (149) and **Ryan Morningstar** (165) each won individual titles. Iowa went 7-2 during the fourth and final session. Metcalf received the tournament's Highest Point Total Award for scoring 27 team points during the competition.

Senior **Alex Tsirtsis** (141) and junior **Phillip Keddy** (184) were both the second seeds at their respective weight classes, and both lost their first matches of the season in the finals.

The Hawkeyes went 4-0 in the fourth session's consolation bracket. Top-seeded junior **Jay Borschel** placed third at 174 with a 4-1 win over #2 Raymond Jordan of Missouri. Junior **Dan Erekson** (Hwt.), sophomore **Jake Kerr** (165) and redshirt freshman **Montell Marion** (133) each placed fifth for Iowa. Kerr, who was unseeded, scored a 7-3 upset over #2 seed Nick Marable of Missouri. Eighthseeded Erekson also upset #6 Rashawn Goff of Cleveland State, 7-3, in the fifth place match.

HAWKEYES LOOK TO EXTEND WINNING STREAKS

Iowa has won its last 24 duals, and its last 20 duals away from Iowa City. The school record for overall consecutive dual wins is 42 (1994-97), and for consecutive away dual wins is 31 (1994-97). The 20 straight away duals rank second in school history. Hawkeye junior **Brent Metcalf** (149) also has a winning streak of his own, winning his last 47 bouts.

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 838-215-30 (.787) in 97 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 21 national titles and 32 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 49 NCAA champions have won a total of 76 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 14 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 101 Big Ten champions have won a total of 182 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-

time and 24 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 135 all-Americans have earned all-America status 273 times, including 17 four-time, 27 three-time and 33 twotime honorees.

HAWKEYES SET ATTENDANCE RECORD

Iowa set the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when it hosted #2 Iowa State Dec. 6 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The previous record of 15,646 was set Feb. 1, 2002, when Minnesota hosted Iowa at the Target Center in Minneapolis. The Hawkeyes won the dual, 20-15.

THREE HAWKEYES WON TITLES AT FLASH FLANAGAN OPEN

Hawkeye junior **Joe Slaton** (133), and sophomores **Matt Ballweg** (157) and **Colby Covington** (165) all won titles at the Flash Flanagan Open Jan. 3 at Loras College in Dubuque. Slaton picked up his 35th collegiate win with a 16-1 technical fall over NIACC's Cody Hogan in the semifinals, and defeated Iowa true freshman **Nate Moore** (7-3) in the finals. Ballweg posted a 3-2 win over Minnesota true freshman Marion Mason in the finals, while Covington scored a technical fall and two major decisions in his Hawkeye debut. Also placing for Iowa were redshirt freshman **Ethan Sebert** (149-4th) and **Stew Gillmor** (157-5th).

Against Minnesota, tickets purchased in advance are \$13 for adults, \$7 for youth and \$2 for children ages five and under. Tickets purchased at the meet are \$15 for adults, \$8 for youth and \$2 for children ages five and under. Due to the possibility of a sellout crowd, the first 1,000 general admission University of lowa students will be admitted free of charge after they log-in to their student account at **www.hawkeyesports.com** to reserve a seat and download a free paper ticket. After that allotment is sold out, students may purchase reserved seats at the youth price.

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeye wrestling staff of **Tom Brands**, **Terry Brands**, **Doug Schwab**, **Mike Zadick** and **Jared Frayer** earned a total of one Olympic gold medal, one Olympic bronze medal, six NCAA titles, 11 conference titles and 15 all-America honors. Their combined college career wrestling record is 487-83-2 (.858).

UP NEXT

The top-ranked Hawkeyes will travel to Stillwater, OK, to face Oklahoma State (8-2) Jan. 18 at 2 p.m. The match will be held at Gallagher-Iba Arena. The Cowboys have won the last nine meetings between the two teams, and hold a 12-5-1 advantage in Stillwater.
