

THIS WEEK -- The Hawkeye men and women's track teams will compete in the 96th running of the Drake Relays, Wednesday thru Saturday, in Des Moines, IA. Events will be held on Jim Duncan Track in Drake Stadium. The school is hoping for its 40th consecutive sellout in the 18,000 seat Drake Stadium, which is the longest streak in U.S. track history. 2004 DRAKE RELAYS REVIEW -- The Hawkeyes crowned two champions at the 95th annual Drake Relays. Hawkeye senior **Shellene Williams** won the women's special invitation 400 meters, and junior **Ken Kemeny** won the University men's shot put.

Williams became the Hawkeye women's seventh individual event champion at Drake and Iowa's first 400-meter champion with her winning time of 52.95. Kemeny was the Hawkeye men's 26th individual Drake champion and Iowa's second shot put champion with his winning throw of 59-11 1/4. He beat runner-up Bradford Williams of Georgia by over a foot.

Several other Hawkeyes posted strong finishes at Drake. Sophomore **Adam Hamilton** placed second in the hammer throw (206-7) and senior **Eric Rothwell** placed third in the discus (177-2). The women's 3,200-meter relay of seniors **Michelle Lahann** and **Atalie Barber**, junior **Aisha Hume** and freshman **Shannon Stanley** placed second (8:48.87). **Lahann** placed third in the 800 meters (2:06.79), and the distance medley relay of **Barber, Williams, Hume** and senior **Sarah Arens** placed third in 11:34.56. Junior **Tiff Pedersen** placed fourth in the heptathlon with 4,864 points.

BREAKIN' RECORDS -- Two Hawkeyes have set school records during the outdoor season. Sophomore **Tiffany Johnson** broke the triple jump record of 40-7 1/2 set in 1988 by Becki Borg with her collegiate-best leap of 40-9 1/2 at the Mt. SAC Relays. Sophomore **Becca Franklin** now holds the hammer throw record with the 181-11 she threw at the Iowa Musco Twilight VII last weekend. Franklin originally broke the record of 161-10 set by Kerri Blackstone in 1999 with her winning mark of 163-1 at the Jim Duncan Invitational two weeks ago.

LAST WEEK -- The Hawkeyes hosted Drake, Missouri and Minnesota at a cold, windy Musco Twilight VII Saturday at Francis X. Cretzmeyer Track in Iowa City. Despite the weather, 24 athletes from all four schools qualified for the NCAA Regional meet.

Iowa did especially well in the throwing events, qualifying several athletes. The Hawkeye men went 1-2 in the discus and shot put. Senior **Tim Brodersen** won the discus (186-0) and **Ken Kemeny** won the shot put (60-5 1/4). Senior **Andy Banse** placed second in both events (180-0, 58-2 1/4). Sophomore **Becca Franklin** smashed her own hammer throw school record set last week with a winning throw of 181-11. Senior **Chris Voller** won the hammer throw with a personal best 200-0. Senior **Kamesha Marshall** took third in the women's shot put with a qualifying throw of 48-0 3/4.

Another highlight of the meet was **Meghan Armstrong's** performance in the 3,000 meter run. The freshman set a new Musco Twilight record with a time of 9:49.70.

MEN'S TEAM CAPTAINS CHOSEN -- Seniors **Ken Kemeny**, **Juan Coleman** and **Bill Neumann** are tri-captains for the 2005 season. **Kemeny** is a five-time NCAA qualifier in the shot put, the 2004 Drake Relays champion in that event and has led the team in the shot put each of the last three years. **Coleman** is a four-time NCAA qualifier in the 1,600-meter relay, and ran the lead leg on the 2001 Big Ten Outdoor Champion 400-meter relay. **Neumann** is a two-time all-American and Big Ten Champion in the javelin. He won that event in five of six meets in 2003, and is the school record holder.

NEXT COMPETITION -- The men and women's teams will compete at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships, May 13-15, in Columbus, OH. All events will be held at Jesse Owens Memorial Stadium. Tickets are available from the Ohio State University Athletic Ticket Office. All-session tickets are \$15 for adults and \$10 for students. Single session tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 for students.



20th SEASON AT IOWA
EASTERN MICHIGAN, 1971

James Grant is in his ninth season at the helm of the Iowa women's track and field program. Grant was the former assistant coach at Iowa for 11 years (1986-96).

The past three seasons have been outstanding ones for Grant and the Hawkeyes. Iowa placed third at the 2004 Big Ten Indoor Championships in Iowa City and sixth at the 2003 conference outdoor meet. Both were Iowa's highest placings during Grant's tenure, and the third-place indoor finish tied the team's highest conference finish in school history. In the last three seasons, the Hawkeyes have crowned 11 Big Ten Champions, 37 regional qualifiers, 13 all-region selections, 22 NCAA qualifiers and three all-Americans, and set 15 school records.

In 2004, Shellene Williams became the second student-athlete in program history to win four Big Ten titles, winning three titles in the 400 meters and one as part of the 1,600-meter relay. Despite the fact that she only competed for the Hawkeyes for two seasons (2003-04), she holds school records in three individual events and two relays. Peaches Roach gave Iowa its first Big Ten high jump titles, winning that event at the indoor and outdoor conference meets to earn outdoor Freshman of the Year honors.

In 2005, Roach and freshman Kineke Alexander became Grant's first indoor all-Americans during his tenure as head coach. Roach defended her Big Ten indoor high jump title to become the second Hawkeye to win two consecutive Big Ten titles in the same event in school history. She also set the indoor school record in that event, breaking the 6-0 mark for the first time of her collegiate career. Sophomore Tiffany Johnson set the school triple jump records, both indoors and outdoors, while sophomore Becca Franklin broke the hammer throw record.

Grant also had immense success in his first two seasons at the Hawkeye helm. Wynsome Cole was an all-American in the 400-meter hurdles at the 1997 NCAA Championships. Iowa won six Big Ten event titles in those two seasons, and Erica Broomfield was named 1998 Big Ten Indoor Freshman of the Year.

While improving in the league standings is considered a priority, Iowa's track and field team also concerns itself with performance in the classroom. During Grant's tenure, 34 Hawkeyes have earned 63 academic all-Big Ten honors.

As Iowa's assistant coach from 1986-96, Grant coached several Hawkeyes to success. In 1995, Yolanda Hobbs was an all-American in the 55 and 200 meters after winning the 55-meter Big Ten title. In 1994, Iowa's 400 meter-relay of Tina Floyd, Hobbs, Marlene Poole and Tanja Reid earned a spot in the Hawkeye record books it won Iowa's first Big Ten title in that event, earned all-America honors and set meet and school records. Karen Layne won the 1990 600-meter Big Ten title, while Senta Hawkins won the Big Ten 400 meters in 1988. In 1989, Iowa's 1,600-meter relay placed second at the Big Ten Indoor and Outdoor Championships.

A former Jamaican track standout, Grant coached at the high school level in Jamaica for 11 years prior to joining the Hawkeye program. From 1982-86, Grant coached men's and women's track at G.C. Foster College of Physical Education and Sport. There he led the men's team to two national championships and two second-place finishes, and the women's team to three national titles. During that time he coached world outdoor champion quarter-miler Bert Cameron, and world indoor champion quarter-miler Devon Morris.

A graduate of Eastern Michigan University, Grant captained the 1970 and 1971 Huron track teams, earning all-America honors while specializing in the 400 meters, 400-meter hurdles, and the mile relay. During this time, he was the Jamaican 400-meter hurdle national record holder, with a time that was ranked in the top-20 in the world. Grant also represented Jamaica at the Pan American Games and the Commonwealth Games for six years. In 1991, he was inducted into the Eastern Michigan Hall of Fame.

He was the 1965 and 1966 Jamaican national champion in both the 200 and 400 meters as a high school athlete at Jamaica's Kingston College.

Grant received his bachelor's degree in sociology and history from Eastern Michigan, and his master's degree in physical education from the German College of Physical Education in Leipzig, Germany.

Larry Wiecek is in his ninth season as head men's track and field coach at Iowa, and recently completed his 18th season as head men's cross country coach. He served as an assistant track and field coach for 12 years before taking the helm in 1997.

A six-time Big Ten champion and four-time all-American at Iowa, Wiecek once held conference marks in the one, two, three, four and five-mile runs. A member of Iowa's last Big Ten track championship team in 1967, he still owns Iowa records in the outdoor 5,000-meters and the indoor two miles, as well as third-fastest mark in the cross country 8,000 meters. He was inducted into Iowa's National Varsity Club Athletics Hall of Fame in 1998.

Under Wiecek, the cross country team has placed sixth or higher eight times at the NCAA Regional Championships, posted 22 all-region selections and qualified for the NCAA Championships three times. In 2002, Wiecek was named Midwest Regional Coach of the Year honors by the United States Cross Country Association after the Hawkeyes won the NCAA Regional for the first time in school history and advancing to the NCAA Championships for the second time in five years. Iowa also tied a school record with five NCAA all-Region selections. In 2004, the Hawkeyes recorded their highest placing at the Big Ten Championships (3rd) and NCAA Championships (13th) under Wiecek. Hawkeye sophomore Micah VanDenend earned second team all-Big Ten honors with his 14th place finish at the conference meet, which was hosted by Iowa on Ashton Cross Country Course. Iowa also crowned four all-region selections in seniors Matt Esche and Tony Rakaric, and juniors Dan Haut and Adam Roche.

Since Wiecek was named head men's track and field coach in 1997, his plan to build a strong sprint program around a national power 1,600-meter relay, and strong throws program is being realized. In his nine years at the helm, Wiecek has coached NCAA Champion long jumper Bashir Yamini, 23 all-Americans, 73 national qualifiers, 40 regional qualifiers and 33 Big Ten Champions. Iowa's 1,600-meter relay won the 1999 Big Ten outdoor title and has earned all-America honors twice during Wiecek's tenure. The Hawkeyes recorded their highest conference indoor placing (fourth) in 1997, and their highest

team finish at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships (second) in 33 years at the 1999 Big Ten outdoor meet.

Another of Wiecek's goals as head coach was to create an annual outdoor home event for the Hawkeyes that would be entertaining for the community and feature outstanding competition for participating student-athletes. Now in its seventh year of existence, the annual Iowa Musco Twilight Meet is just that. Named for Musco Lighting of Oskaloosa, IA, who supplies mobile lighting equipment, the co-ed meet which features five teams in 2005, starts in the late afternoon and extends into the night. In its first four years, the meet had produced 43 NCAA provisional qualifiers. Since the creation of the regional qualifying system in 2003, 130 competitors have reached qualifying standards.

While improving in the league standings is considered a priority, the Hawkeyes also concern themselves with performance in the classroom. Under Wiecek, former cross country runners Kevin Herd, Chad Schwitters and Stetson Steele earned academic all-America honors. Iowa has had an academic all-Big Ten selection each year during his tenure, totaling 53 honorees in cross country and 47 in track.

Wiecek came to Iowa after 11 seasons as head track coach at Proviso (IL) West High School. He also served as an assistant there for three years. His prep teams were consistent placers on the state level and several of his athletes won state titles. He served on the Illinois track advisory board and founded the prestigious Proviso Indoor Track Classic. Wiecek was inducted into the Illinois High School Track and Cross Country Coaches Hall of Fame in 2000.

Wiecek was born on September 11, 1946, in Chicago, IL. He received his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1969 and his M.S. degree in physical education from Northern Illinois University in 1973. His wife's name is Jackie.
