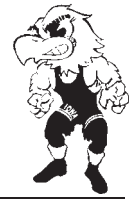

Television - Iowa Public Television, in its 30th season of televising college wrestling, will air a live telecast of Iowa's dual vs. Illinois Friday. Tim Johnson, Jim Gibbons and former Iowa Wrestling Coach Dan Gable will call the action.

HEAD COACH JIM ZALESKY

Jim Zalesky is in his ninth season as head coach at the University of Iowa. He has a school and career record of 125-33 (.803). Named National Coach of the Year in 1998 and 1999, and Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2000 and 2004, he has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA (1998-00) and three Big Ten titles (1998, 2000, 2004). Zalesky has coached 10 NCAA Champions, 20 Big Ten Champions and 40 all-Americans at Iowa. He was inducted into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame in June 2004, the University of Iowa Letterman's Club Hall of Fame and the Iowa High School Athletic Association Wrestling Hall of Fame in 2002, and the Iowa Wrestling Hall of Fame in 1994.

A three-time national champion and one of Iowa's 15 four-time all-Americans, Zalesky was an assistant coach and head recruiter at Iowa under Dan Gable for seven seasons (1991-97). He was named Assistant Coach of the Year by the N.W.C.A. in 1992 and 1997. Undefeated as a junior and senior, Zalesky ended his career on an 89-match winning streak.

ILLINOIS FIGHTING ILLINI

The Illinois Fighting Illini are 8-2 on the season and 3-2 in Big Ten action. They are coming off a rough weekend which saw them drop their first two duals of the season, 18-17 to Michigan and 19-16 to Northwestern.

The Fighting Illini are coached by former Hawkeye assistant Mark Johnson, who is in his 14th year at the helm. Johnson was Dan Gable's top assistant for eight years at Iowa. He has a 135-35-1 record and has guided Illinois to seven top-10 finishes.

Illinois is led by two-time Big Ten Champion Alex Tirapelle, who is 17-1 on the year and ranked No. 1 in the country. Senior 184-pounder and two-time all-American Pete Friedl is 16-2 on the season.

at 16-16 and the day's final match in overtime, Dustin Fox earned an escape with 10 seconds remaining in the second-tiebreaker period to claim the win for Northwestern.

The Wildcats are coached by Tim Cysewski, who is in his 16th season. Under Cysewski's direction, 16 Wildcats have earned All-America honors and 60 wrestlers have qualified for the NCAA Championships.

Northwestern is led by sophomore 174-pounder Jake Herbert, who placed third at last year's NCAA Championships. This season, he is undefeated at 25-0. Fellow sophomore Ryan Lang is 14-2 on the year at 141 pounds.

THE SERIES

Iowa leads the overall series with Northwestern, 60-7-1. In Iowa City, the Hawkeyes have a 26-3 advantage. Last season, the Wildcats defeated the Hawkeyes 22-19 in Evanston, IL.

LAST MEETING

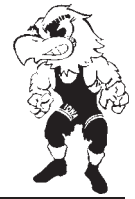
The Wildcats snapped Iowa's 35-match winning streak in the series with a 22-19 win last season in Evanston, IL. Northwestern's last win over Iowa was in 1968.

Iowa won four of the first five weight classes to take a 19-3 team lead. The Hawkeyes got pins from junior Joe Johnston and Mark Perry, a major decision from Ty Eustice and a decision from junior Mario Galanakis (133) in the first five matches. Northwestern responded by winning the last five matches to take the dual. Iowa endured a pin at 174, an upset decision at 184 and a major decision at 197 while still holding on to a 19-16 team lead. Hawkeye freshmen Matt Fields (Hwt.) and Charlie Falck (125) each had a chance to preserve an Iowa dual win, but neither could overcome early deficits in their matches and both lost decisions.

LAST WEEK

The Hawkeyes dropped a pair of Big Ten duals, falling to Penn State 21-12 in Carver-Hawkeye Arena before losing to Michigan State 19-17 in East Lansing, MI.

PERRY OUT

Hawkeye sophomore 174-pounder **Mark Perry** missed the last two dual meets with a neck injury. Perry, who is 12-2 on the season and ranked No. 3, originally injured his neck at the National Duals and missed three of Iowa's five duals there. He is expected to return in time for the Big Ten Championships, March 4-5.

FIELDS OUT

Hawkeye sophomore heavyweight **Matt Fields** will miss the remainder of the season with torn ligaments in his knee sustained during his match with No. 1 Cole Konrad Jan. 22. The Lowden, IA, native tore both the ACL and MCL.

IOWA WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 794-209-30 (.787) in 94 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 20 national titles, including nine of the last 15, and 31 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 47 NCAA Champions have won a total of 73 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 13 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 99 Big Ten Champions have won a total of 180 conference individual titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time and 24 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 127 all-Americans have earned all-America status 258 times, including 16 four-time, 27 three-time and 29 two-time honorees.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has been the home for Iowa wrestling since 1983. The Hawkeyes have a record of 147-14 (.925) in the arena, which includes a record 10 victories during the 1986 season. Iowa has recorded 16 undefeated seasons in the arena, with the most recent (8-0) occurring in 2002-03. The dual wrestling attendance record for Carver-Hawkeye Arena is 15,291, set when Iowa defeated Iowa State on February 22, 1992. The arena seats 15,500 for a dual wrestling meet.

IOWA TICKET INFORMATION

Tickets for Iowa's home duals are on sale at the University of Iowa Athletic Ticket Office at 1-800-424-2957, 319-335-9327 or www.hawkeyesports.com. Tickets for Saturday's dual with Oklahoma State are \$10 per person. Single-match tickets for Iowa's other five duals purchased in advance are \$8 for adults and \$4 for youth. Single-match tickets purchased at the gate are \$10 for adults and \$5 for youth. Groups of 15 or more can purchase tickets for \$4. University of Iowa students will be admitted free of charge for all duals except Oklahoma State.

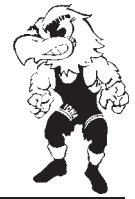

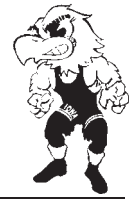
