IOWA MEN'S SWIMMING

IOWA IS IN TENTH AFTER DAY TWO OF BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

MINNEAPOLIS, MN – The University of Iowa men's swimming team finished the second day of competition at the 2005 Big Ten Championships in 10th place with a score of 82. The host team Minnesota leads the competition with a score of 469.

11 Hawkeyes advanced to the finals in the second day of competition. Iowa was led by freshman **Dragos Agache** who finished 10th in the 200 breaststroke. Agache's time of 54.54 in the finals was a new career best. Senior **Cal Shelangoski** recorded a 13th place finish for the Hawkeyes in the 100 breaststroke. Shelangoski's time of 55.24 in the preliminaries set a new career and Hawkeye season mark. Freshman **Nate Keeling** set a new personal best as well as a season best time for the Hawkeyes in the 100 butterfly. Keeling recorded a time of 49.47 in the preliminaries which led him to a 14th place finish in the finals. Junior **Cameron Dye** swam a season best time for the Hawkeyes and a new personal best time in the 200 freestyle. Dye's time of 1:40.08 in the finals was good enough for a 17th place finish. Junior **Trevor Haley** recorded a pair of 19th place finishes in the finals of the 400 individual medley and the 100 butterfly. Haley recorded a time of 4:00.83 in the 400 individual medley and 49.94 in the 100 butterfly.
