Notables

Junior Courtney Moses is 14 points away from becoming the 27th member of Purdue's 1,000 point club.

The Boilermakers are 9-0 when Sam Ostarello gets 10 or more rebounds.

Purdue is tied for first place in the Big Ten with Michigan State and Penn State with 4-0 conference marks.

At 15-2, Purdue is off to its best start since going 17-2 in 2005-06.

Ostarello is averaging a double-double with 10.8 points and 10.4 rebounds per game. In Big Ten games, Ostarello is averaging 16.2 points and 16.0 rebounds per contest.

Ostarello has recorded a double-double in three straight games, tying for third most consecutive games in school history.

KK Houser has dished out a career-high 10 assists in back-to-back games.

Moses has hit three or more three-pointers in the last three games and is averaging 18.8 ppg, 4.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists in Big Ten games.

Purdue is 15-0 when scoring 60 or more points and the Boilermakers are 14-0 when leading at the half.

As of Jan. 18, Purdue was ranked in the top 15 nationally in four categories: 3FG% (9th; .379), free throw percentage (10th; 77.7), FG% (14th; .456) and won-loss percentage (11th; .882). The Boilermakers are 25th in assists per game (16.6).

Purdue leads the Big Ten in free throw percentage, shooting 77.7 percent this season, even with the school record mark set in 2010-11.

Purdue tied a season low with 14 turnovers against Minnesota.

The Boilermakers are 7-0 at home this season and 6-1 on the road.

The Opponent

Iowa (13-5, 2-2) is coming off a 65-54 loss at Michigan State on Thursday. The Hawkeyes have wins over Ohio State and Wisconsin and lost to Michigan on Jan. 6. Head coach Lisa Bluder is one win away from her 600th career victory and this season has her Hawkeyes averaging 70.4 ppg and 40.0 rpg, while holding opponents to an average of 61.1 ppg. Senior center Morgan Johnson, a Preseason All-Big Ten Team selection by the coaches, leads the Hawkeyes at 17.4 points, 7.8 rebounds and 2.1 blocks per game. Senior guard Jaime Printy contributes 13.4 points and sophomore Samantha Logic averages 9.1 points and a conference-best 7.0 assists per game.

The Series

This is the 62nd meeting between Purdue and Iowa in women's basketball, with the Boilermakers holding a 35-26 series edge. Purdue is 16-4 in the last 20 meetings, including 7-3 in the last 10 games, but is 10-16 all time in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, losing the last two contests at Iowa. Last year, the Boilermakers brought an 8-0 Big Ten record to Iowa City, but shot just 23.3 percent from the field and were beaten 59-42. Purdue had defeated the Hawkeyes 57-55 in Mackey Arena on Jan. 15, 2012.

Last Time vs. Iowa

Kamille Wahlin scored all 13 of her points in the second half and Iowa upset No. 13 Purdue 59-42, snapping the Boilermakers' 11-game winning streak. Center Morgan Johnson added 17 points and 11 rebounds for the Hawkeyes. Brittany Rayburn hit a three-pointer to cut Iowa's lead to 40-37 with 11 minutes left, but the Hawkeyes answered with a 16-2 run over an eight-minute stretch to pull away. It was a tough and sloppy game from the start. Iowa led just 23-21 at halftime. The teams combined for 43 fouls and 29 turnovers.

Purdue vs. The Big Ten Conference

The Boilermakers are 399-218 all time against teams in the Big Ten Conference. Purdue has a winning record against every conference opponent except Ohio State (27-40, .403). The Boilermakers have the highest winning percentage vs. Michigan (49-15, .766), followed by Illinois (49-16, .753) and Wisconsin (44-17, .721). Purdue is 40-17 (.702) versus the Gophers, 43-19 (.694) against Northwestern, 2-1 (.667) when playing Nebraska, 49-25 (.662) when taking on in-state rival Indiana and 26-16 (.619) against Penn State. Purdue is 36-26 (.581) versus Michigan State and holds a 35-26 (.574) record versus Iowa.

Next Up

Purdue returns home Jan. 24 for the only matchup of the season against Northwestern. The tip is set for 8:30 p.m. ET live on BTN.

Last Time Out

Sam Ostarello had 19 points and 14 rebounds as Purdue defeated Minnesota 75-67. Courtney Moses added 18 points and six assists, Drey Mingo scored 14 points and KK Houser had 10 assists for the Boilermakers. Rachel Banham and Leah Cotton led Minnesota with 17 points apiece, and Shayne Mullaney had 12. Purdue never trailed in the game, scoring the first six points of the game en route to a 38-33 halftime advantage. The Boilermakers led by as many as 14 points in the second half. Minnesota tied the game once, at 20-20 with 7:21 left in the first half, but Purdue scored the next eight points on a three-point play by Mingo, a three-pointer from Moses and a layup from Ostarello.

Notables from Minnesota

- The Boilermakers recorded 22 assists on 25 made field-goals. Purdue had the same assist to field-goal ratio against Minnesota in the last meeting on Jan. 12, 2012, a game Purdue won 72-55.

- Purdue turned the ball over just 14 times, tying the season low for turnovers (Bowling Green, 11/19/12).

- Courtney Moses was 4-of-7 from the three point line, her straight game third with three or more three-point field goals.

- Sam Ostarello's team-high 19 points and 14 rebounds gave her a double-double for the third consecutive game, tying for third at Purdue for most consecutive double-doubles. The school record is four straight, which was last accomplished by Lindsay Wisdom-Hylton between Feb. 12 and Feb. 26, 2009.

- Ostarello has pulled down 12 or more rebounds in her last four games.

- With her sixth double-double of the season, Ostarello has 11 for her career, tying for ninth in Purdue history for career double-doubles.

- KK Houser had 10 assists, tying her career high for the second consecutive game, the third time this year and the fourth time in her career.

One Plays

With 12 conference schools and a 16-game Big Ten regular-season schedule, Purdue will face six teams just once in the regular season. In addition to playing host to Ohio State, Purdue also faces Michigan and Northwestern in Mackey Arena only, while traveling to Nebraska, Penn State and Wisconsin.

Ostarello Named Big Ten Player of the Week

Sam Ostarello earned Big Ten Player of the Week after helping the Boilermakers to an 82-75 triple overtime win against Ohio State on Monday. Ostarello recorded 22 points, tied her career high with 19 rebounds and set a career high with eight blocked shots against the Buckeyes. It was the most blocks by a Boilermaker since Danielle Campbell set the school record with 11 against Butler on Nov. 17, 2007. The Fort Pierre, S.D., native played a career-high 51 of 55 minutes and added three steals and three assists, while converting a career-best 10-of-12 free throws in Purdue's third-straight overtime contest. It is the first conference weekly honor for Ostarello and Purdue's second of the season. KK Houser was named Big Ten Player of the Week on Dec. 3.

Strong Start

At 15-2, the 14th-ranked Boilermakers are off to their best start since 2005-06, when Purdue started 17-2. The best record in school history was the national championship season in 1998-99 when Purdue went 34-1, including a 32-game win streak.

Balanced Attack

Four Boilermakers are averaging double-digit points. Courtney Moses who tied her season high with 24 points against Ohio State, leads the team at 14.3 ppg. Drey Mingo is averaging 12.2 ppg, while KK Houser has an 11.4 average and Sam Ostarello averages a double-double with 10.8 points and 10.4 rebounds. In conference play, Moses' average is up to 18.8 ppg, Ostarello's is 16.3 ppg, Mingo's is 14.8 ppg and Houser is below her season average but still in double-figures at 10.3 ppg.

Hitting the Boards

Senior Sam Ostarello is second in the Big Ten behind Illinois' Karisma Penn for rebound average at 10.4 rpg. Her conference average of 16.0 rpg is by far the highest. Ostarello had a career-high 19 rebounds at Nebraska and again against Ohio State. It was the first time in school history, a Boilermaker pulled down 19 or more rebounds in two straight games. The 6-foot-2 forward has grabbed double-digit rebounds in nine games this season and 28 times in her career and has 12 or more rebounds in each of her last four outings.

Doubling Up

The Boilermakers have recorded 10 double-doubles this season. Leading the way is Sam Ostarello with six this season and 11 in her career, which is ninth all-time at Purdue for career double-doubles. Ostarello's 19 points and 14 rebounds was her third consecutive double-double, tying for third at Purdue for consecutive double-doubles. The school record is four which was last accomplished by Lindsay Wisdom-Hylton in 2009. Drey Mingo has recorded three double-doubles this year and KK Houser tallied a double-double, the second of her career with 19 points and 10 assists against Georgia Tech.

Double Trouble

Twice this year, seniors Drey Mingo and Sam Ostarello have recorded double-doubles in the same game: vs. Bowling Green and at UT Martin.

No Extra Charge

Purdue's first three conference games went into overtime, including the triple overtime victory against Ohio State. Before this season, Purdue had never had back-to-back overtime games and the three OT contest tied the school record for extra sessions. It was just the second triple overtime game in school history (93-89 3OT loss to Nebraska; 2/2/12). With three straight, Purdue is tied for second in the NCAA record books for consecutive overtime games. Wisconsin set the record with four in 1999.

1,000 Point Club

Junior guard Courtney Moses is 14 points away from becoming the 27th member of Purdue's 1,000 point club. If Moses scores 14 or more against the Hawkeyes, The Sweetser, Ind., native will have accomplished the feat in 84 career games, tying Joy Holmes for ninth fastest in school history.

Free Throws

Purdue leads the Big Ten in free throw percentage. The Boilermakers are averaging 77.7 percent from the charity stripe, tying the school record set in 2010-11. Courtney Moses ranks third in the league at 90.2 percent. Drey Mingo is sixth at 85.7 percent and KK Houser is 10th, shooting 81.0 percent.

Long-Range Bombers

As of Jan. 18, Purdue's three-point field goal average of 37.9 percent was ninth best in the nation and third in the Big Ten behind Penn State and Michigan. On Nov. 24, the Boilermakers hit a season-high 13-of-22 threes against No. 2 UConn, tying for third most in school history. At Notre Dame, Purdue went 0-for-11 from long range. It was the first time Purdue failed to make a three-pointer since March 1, 2009, at Michigan State and just the 52nd time in school history.

Conversely

Purdue's three-point field goal defense has been impressive. The Boilermakers are holding opponents to 27.0 percent from beyond the arc, tied with Ohio State for second best in the conference behind Michigan State. IUPUI was limited to a season-low 7.1 percent (1-of-14), while Wake Forest had the season high with 38.5 percent (5-of-13).

Statistically Speaking

Based on statistics through Jan. 18, Purdue is ranked in the top 50 among Div. I institutions in several categories. In addition to holding the No. 9 spot for three-point field goal percentage (.379), the Boilermakers are No. 10 for free throw percentage (.777), No. 11 for win/loss percentage (.882), No. 14 for field goal percentage (.456), No. 25 for assists per game (16.6) and No. 41 for scoring offense (70.9).

Stacking Up in the Big Ten

Several Boilermakers are among the conference leaders in multiple categories. Courtney Moses is 12th in scoring with an average of 14.3 ppg, while Drey Mingo is 20th, averaging 12.2 ppg. Sam Ostarello is second in rebounding (10.4), first in defensive rebounds (7.9), ninth in blocked shots (1.3), eighth in field goal percentage (.490) and 26th in scoring (10.8). Mingo is tied for 17th in rebounding (6.2), 13th for FG% (.468), tied for 11th for blocked shots (1.1) and sixth for free throw percentage (.857). Houser is 10th in the league for free throw percentage (.810), 12th (.355) for three-point field goal percentage, 13th for threes per game (1.6), seventh for assists at 5.1 apg, tied for 13th for steals (1.9) and 12th for assist to turnover ratio (1.2). Moses is third in free throw shooting (.902), sixth for 3FG% (.395), eighth for threes per game (2.0) and tied for 15th for steals (1.8).

Houser Shares the Rock

Redshirt junior KK Houser's steal average is down this season, but her overall productivity is up. Houser is third on the team in scoring at 11.4 ppg, while averaging a team- and career-high 5.1 apg. Against Georgia Tech, Ohio State and Minnesota, Houser tied her career high with 10 assists. Houser was named Big Ten Player of the Week on Dec. 3 after consecutive 19 point games.

Want to C-Mo?

Junior Courtney Moses, whose nickname is "C-Mo", has scored in double-figures in 49 of 83 career games, including a team-high tying 14 times this season. She has started in 81 contests for the Boilermakers. The Sweetser, Ind., native leads Purdue in scoring at 14.3 ppg and has been the team's leading scorer a team-best seven times this year. Moses was selected by the Big Ten coaches as a first team Preseason All-Big Ten team member. Her defense has improved along with her offense, and she is second on the team with 31 steals, and has seven games of three or more takeaways.

Speaking of Moses

Head coach Sharon Versyp challenged her players to get in at least 30,000 shots this summer. Moses attempted 42,000 shots and it is paying off. She is shooting 46.5 percent from the field, including 39.5 percent from three-point range and has hit six threes twice this season (UConn and Ohio State). The junior guard has hit 131 three-pointers in her career, 11th most in school history.

Rebounding Prowess

Sam Ostarello is leading Purdue and is second in the Big Ten in rebounding with an average of 10.4 boards per game. The Fort Pierre, S.D., native has 28 career games, including nine games this season with double-figure rebounds. Ostarello set a career high with 19 rebounds along with a team-high tying 17 points at Nebraska and followed that up with 22 points, 19 rebounds and a career-high eight blocks against Ohio State. She has recorded six double-doubles this year and 11 in her career. Her three-straight double-doubles ties for third most in school history.

Mingo Returning to Form

Drey Mingo's scoring is up in Big Ten play/ She is averaging 14.8 points per game on .537 shooting from the field in the last four contests. The Atlanta, Ga., native sat out last season after tearing her ACL in late Oct.

Poston Returns to Action

Redshirt senior guard Chantel Poston underwent knee surgery on Nov. 30 for a torn lateral meniscus and a chipped bone, an injury she suffered Nov. 24 against UConn. Poston missed seven games and was shooting a sizzling 65.0 percent (13-of-20) from the floor before her injury. In her first game back (at Illinois), Poston played 25 minutes, recording four points, six rebounds, two assists, a blocked shot and a steal.

Shooting Percentages Up

The Boilermakers have shot over 50.0 percent from the field on five occasions this season, shooting a season-high 56.3 percent at Oakland. Against IUPUI, Purdue shot 55.6 percent (30-of-54) from the field. At IPFW, the Boilermakers went 23-of-44 for 52.3 percent, against Georgia Tech, Purdue shot 52.4 percent (33-of-63) and 54.3 percent (25-of-46) against Marist. Purdue also has shot .500 or better from three-point range four times this year, hitting a season-high 13-of-33 against UConn for 59.1 percent.

Purdue vs. Ranked Opponents

The Boilermakers are 97-136 all time against ranked opponents, 81-81 against ranked opponents when also ranked and 52-26 when ranked higher than the ranked opponent.

Balanced Attack

Through 12 games, the Boilermakers had five different leading scorers and at Notre Dame was the first time the same player (Moses) led the team in points in back-to-back games. Purdue has had at least three players in double-figures in every game except against the Irish. In the 67-53 win against Wake Forest, all five starters reached double-digits.

Win No. 150

With Purdue's 82-75 triple overtime victory against Ohio State, head coach Sharon Versyp earned her 150th win as the Boilermaker head coach.

Mingo Returns

Drey Mingo is looking to complete her first full season with the Boilermakers after being granted a clock extension by the NCAA for a sixth year. The 6-foot-2 forward transferred from Maryland and sat out the 2009-10 season due to NCAA transfer rules. She missed four games the next year after contracting a life-threatening case of bacterial meningitis before Thanksgiving. The illness left her with permanent hearing loss, with only 10 percent hearing in her left ear and 80 percent in her right. Fully recovered from the illness for the 2011-12 season, Mingo tore the ACL in her right knee on Oct. 29 in a closed scrimmage at Indiana State, setting up the waiver by the NCAA to return for this season. The Atlanta, Ga., native is a three-time captain, pursuing a graduate degree in occupational and environmental health sciences. Mingo led the Boilermakers in rebounding in 2010-11 with an average of 5.8 rebounds per game, was second on the team in scoring at 12.0 ppg and set a school single-season record for three-point field

goal percentage at 48.1 percent. This season, Mingo is Purdue's second leading scorer and has been named one of 30 candidates for the Senior CLASS Award.

Giving Back

Mingo, who plans to become a pediatrician, decided to turn her experience with bacterial meningitis into a positive for others. The sixth-year senior has started a nonprofit organization, the Sounds of Serenity to help raise awareness about hearing loss in children and young adults, as well as raise funds to provide hearing aids to children in need. Mingo has partnered with the Indiana School for the Deaf in Indianapolis and the Purdue Audiology Clinic. For more information, please visit teamsounds.net.

Turnovers

Purdue's 34 turnovers against Illinois did not crack the top 10 for most in school history, but it was the most since committing 34 miscues against Arkansas on Nov. 25, 2004, a game No. 15 Purdue won 55-51. It was only the third time in head coach Sharon Versyp's seven-season tenure that Purdue turned the ball over 30 or more times and is the first time the Boilermakers have done so since 2006-07 and still won. The previous high under Versyp was 32 turnovers at Minnesota on Jan. 14, 2010, a game Purdue lost 74-47. Purdue committed 30 turnovers in a loss at Washington on Dec. 21, 2007.

Kix Battling Cancer

Purdue's supervisor of basketball operations, Terry Kix, has been diagnosed with stage 3 stomach cancer N1 (cancer cells in one lymph node near the stomach) and is currently undergoing chemotherapy treatment. Kix was diagnosed Nov. 14 and started chemo on Nov. 26. She will not travel with the team but will be on the bench at home games as her health allows.

Watching The Charts

- Courtney Moses is 131-of-355 from three-point range for a career percentage of .369, eighth all time at Purdue. The 131 threes puts her in 11th place for career threes and needs three to pass Jannon Roland for 10th.
- KK Houser is tied for 15th at Purdue for career three-point field goals with 85 and needs one to pass Nicole Erikson for sole possession of 15th.
- Drey Mingo holds the school record for season three-point field goal percentage. She connected on 27-of-56 for 48.2 percent in 2010-11.
- Mingo is 11th at Purdue for career field goal percentage, having made 189-of-382 shots for 49.5 percent.
- With 986 career points, Moses is 14 points from becoming the 27th member of Purdue's 1,000 point club.
- Moses is atop the school chart for career free throw percentage, having made 177-of-199 free throws for a career mark of 88.9 percent. Katie Gearlds moves to the No. 2 spot with a career percentage of .863 (314-364). Mingo is fifth at 81.8 percent and Houser is 11th with a career mark of 77.5 percent.
- Last season, Moses set the school record for season free throw percentage at 90.7 percent (78-of-86). She set a school record with 47-consecutive makes, the most in NCAA Div. I last year.
- Sam Ostarello is ninth all time at Purdue in rebounding with 737, and needs eight rebounds to pass Joy Holmes for eighth.
- Ostarello is eighth all time at Purdue with a career-rebound average of 6.4 boards per game.

- Ostarello is 10th at Purdue with 110 career blocks. She picked up her 100th at Nebraska and needs two blocks to move past Kay Tucker for ninth place.

Head Coach Sharon Versyp

Former Boilermaker point guard, Sharon Versyp is in her seventh season as head coach at Purdue. She has a 151-72 record, the third most wins in school history. The Mishawaka, Ind., native has a career mark of 268-137 in her 13th year as a collegiate head coach. At Purdue, Versyp is averaging nearly 23 wins per season, while leading the Boilermakers to three Big Ten Tournament championships (2007, 2008, 2012) and to the NCAA Tournament Elite Eight twice (2007 and 2009). A 2010 inductee into the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame, Versyp and her staff have signed a top 25 recruiting class each of the seven years at Purdue.

Road Warriors

In Dec. and early Jan., the Boilermakers played a stretch of six of seven games on the road. The Boilermakers went 6-1, 5-1 in road games.

Rebounding

Purdue continued its strong rebounding with a season-high 53 rebounding effort at Nebraska. The Boilermakers outrebounded the Huskers 53-44 after earning a 49-29 rebound advantage at Illinois. At Nebraska, Sam Ostarello led Purdue with a career-high 19 rebounds. The 6-foot-2 senior's 19 rebounds were the most since Joy Holmes pulled down 20 boards in 1991. Point guard KK Houser had a career-high nine rebounds against the Huskers.

Speaking of Strong Starts

In seven games this year, Purdue has never trailed - at SIU Edwardsville, Bowling Green, Wake Forest, Central Michigan, at IPFW, versus IUPUI and Minnesota. Additionally, Purdue is 13-0 this season when leading at halftime.

Manuel Named Big Ten Freshman of the Week

Taylor Manuel earned Big Ten co-Freshman of the Week on Dec. 10 by averaging a team-high 14.0 points, while shooting 71.4 percent from the field in the two wins. Manuel was leading the Big Ten in field goal percentage, but does not currently have enough attempts to qualify for the category. She is the first Boilermaker to earn Big Ten Freshman of the Week since Courtney Moses won it Feb. 21, 2011.

Thornton Out

Sophomore Torrie Thornton will not play this season after undergoing patella tendon debridement surgery in May to correct severe tendonitis in both knees. Thornton plans to use a medical redshirt this season.

Career Day for Dee Dee

Oakland's game plan was to sag off Dee Dee Williams and make her be the one to beat the Grizzlies, and that's exactly what she did. The junior guard scored a career-high 14 points on 5-of-6 shooting, including 4-of-4 from three-point range. Coming into the contest, Williams had hit only two three-pointers in her career (2-of-19; .105) and was averaging just 1.9 points per game.

Now That's Good Defense

Purdue's five fouls at Oakland were the second fewest in school history.

Preseason Honors

The Big Ten coaches picked Purdue No. 3 in the preseason and honored junior guard Courtney Moses with Preseason All-Big Ten team accolades.

2012 Big Ten Tournament Champions

Last March, the Purdue women's basketball program extended its conference record for Big Ten Tournament championships to eight, with a 74-70 double-overtime win against No. 24 Nebraska. It was the third conference tournament championship for head coach Sharon Versyp and her fourth title game appearance in six years. The Boilermakers have double the tournament titles as the next winningest team in the league. Ohio State has four tournament championships.

Miss Basketball

The Boilermakers have six former Miss Basketball honorees on their bench, including head coach Sharon Versyp who was the first Indiana Miss Basketball to play at Purdue and Courtney Moses who is the eighth. KK Houser was Nebraska's Miss Basketball as a senior, Sam Ostarello earned the Miss Basketball title for South Dakota as a senior, Taylor Manuel was Miss Show-Me Basketball in Missouri last year and Hayden Hamby was named Miss Basketball in Alabama as a junior.

It Is About Academics Too

Head coach Sharon Versyp stresses academic achievement. Two former players are in medical school. Lauren Mioton, a Rhodes Scholar finalist, is in her fourth year of medical school at Vanderbilt, while Chelsea Jones is a first year med student at Arkansas. Brittany Rayburn is in her first year in Purdue's School of Veterinary Medicine. While Natasha Bogdanova is in the MBA program at Purdue's Krannert School of Management.

RPI

Purdue is ranked No. 13 in the NCAA Women's Basketball RPI.

Among Nation's Best In Attendance

Purdue fans' loyal support makes Mackey Arena a tough place to play and has put the Boilermakers in the top 10 in national attendance for 17-straight seasons. Purdue finished seventh in attendance last year. The Boilermakers have won at least 12 home games each of the last seven seasons.

Welcome To The Family

Purdue's two-woman signing class is ranked No. 23 nationally by the Collegiate Girls Basketball Report. Guards Ashley Morrisette (Twinsburg (Ohio) H.S.) and Bridget Perry (Roncalli (Ind.) H.S.) signed NLI's on Nov. 14 and will join the Boilermakers next fall.

Sharon Versyp, a former Boilermaker point guard, has led Purdue to three Big Ten Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament Elite Eight appearances in her six seasons as the head coach at her alma mater. At Purdue, she has averaged nearly 23 wins per season, including a 22-9 record in the postseason. Versyp signed a contract extension that will secure her presence on the Boilermaker sidelines through the 2016-17 season.

Versyp's impact on basketball in the Hoosier state was recognized on April 24, 2010, when she was inducted into the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame in her first year of eligibility, an honor that includes Larry Bird and John Wooden.

The Mishawaka, Ind., native is known for her prowess in team defense, game preparation, individual player development and team building. Recruiting is a key to success and Versyp and her staff have proven that they can attract elite players to Purdue. Versyp's first six signing classes were ranked in the top 15, and the most recent class of student-athletes earned a No. 23 ranking.

Equally impressive to the on-court accolades are the team's academic achievements under Versyp's guidance. For three-straight years, the Boilermakers earned a team GPA of 3.10 or better and last season, Brittany Rayburn earned Academic All-America accolades. Two players in the Versyp era are in medical school - Lauren Mioton is at Vanderbilt and Chelsea Jones is at Arkansas, while Rayburn is in her first year in Purdue's School of Veterinary Medicine.

Purdue returned to its championship ways in 2011-12, with the third Big Ten Tournament championship in Versyp's six years and a conference-best eighth title overall. The Boilermakers' veteran squad tied for second in the Big Ten in the regular season and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament to finish with a 25-9 mark. Three Boilermakers earned Big Ten postseason honors with Rayburn a second team selection and KK Houser and Sam Ostarello honorable mention All-Big Ten. Rayburn also picked up Big Ten Tournament Most Outstanding Player honors, was named to the Naismith Player of the Year midseason 32 list and was selected to participate in the State Farm

Women's 3-point Championship at the men's Final Four.

Versyp returned to her alma mater as Purdue's eighth head coach on April 10, 2006. As a player Versyp, a former Boilermaker point guard, led her teams to three consecutive winning seasons when the program had enjoyed only one winning campaign in the previous 10 years.

In her first year as head coach at Purdue, Versyp compiled a 31-6 record that included a second-place finish in the Big Ten regular season, a Big Ten Tournament title and an appearance in the NCAA Elite Eight. Versyp was named the 2007 WBCA Region VI Coach of the Year.

Versyp's win percentage in 2006-07 of 83.8 percent (31-6) was tops for a first-year coach. The 31 wins equals the second-most in school history and Versyp is the only first-year head coach to achieve a 30-win record.

Versyp was the head coach at Indiana prior to Purdue, where she led her team to a 19-14 season, 9-7 in the Big Ten and the quarterfinals of the post-season WNIT. The nine-game improvement was the second largest turn-around in school history for a first-year head coach.

Prior to her stint with the Hoosiers, Versyp was the head coach at Maine for five seasons where she amassed a 98-51 record, including a 67-19 America East Conference record. Versyp's teams won three straight America East regular season championships (2003, 2004, 2005) and in 2004 also won the America East Tournament title earning an NCAA Tournament berth.
