


\$ NCAA Automatic Qualifier ^NCAA Provisional Qualifier !School Record **THIS WEEK** -- The Iowa women's track team will host the 2004 Big Ten Indoor Championships Saturday and Sunday in Iowa City, IA. All events will be held at the University Recreation Building. Tickets are \$7 per day for adults and \$5 per day for youth and students. All seats are general admission.

<u>HAWKEYES CRACK TOP 20</u> -- The Hawkeyes are ranked 13th in the nation in the most recent United States Track Coaches Assocation Team Power Ranking. Teams are assigned a point total and ranked based on quality of athletic performance, team depth and dual meet scoring potential. Iowa has earned a score of 258.89. Nebraska is ranked first with a 300.73 score. Other Big Ten teams ranked in the top 20 are Penn State (3rd-284.31), Ohio State (6th-270.32) and Indiana (10th-263.40).

<u>WILLIAMS LEADS THE PACK</u> -- Hawkeye senior Shellene Williams is on track for another outstanding season at Iowa. In her first full indoor season with the Hawkeyes, Williams has automatically qualified for the NCAA Indoor Championships in the 400 meters, and provisionally qualified in the 200 meters and as part of the distance medley relay. Her qualifying times in the 200 and 400 meters also set school indoor records. Williams also leads the team in the 60 meters. Her season-best time of 7.50 ranks second on Iowa's all-time best performers list.

Williams is looking to carry momentum from her 2003 outdoor accomplishments into 2004 indoor post-season competition. She won the 400 meters and ran the anchor leg of Iowa's winning 1,600-meter relay at the 2003 Big Ten Outdoor meet. She became the fourth female student-athlete in school history to win two events at the same conference meet. The 1,600-meter relay of Aisha Hume, Nicole Charles, Sarah Steffen and Williams went on from winning the school's first conference title in that event to shattering the 15-year-old school record of 3:41.23 by almost five seconds. They ran a blistering 3:36.26 at the NCAA Midwest Regional.

Williams has a chance to make a permanent mark in the Iowa record books. With two conference titles under her belt, and an indoor and outdoor meet left to compete in, she has the chance to catch Iowa's four three-time champions and the Hawkeyes' lone four-time champion, Vivien McKenzie. McKenzie won three consecutive 100-meter titles (1983-85) and the 1985 55-meter title. Williams and the rest of the squad have the chance to end Iowa's drought at the Big Ten meet. Iowa's last Big Ten indoor champion was Yolanda Hobbs, in the 55 meters, in 1995.

2003 INDOOR BIG TEN REVIEW -- Iowa placed ninth with 29.5 points at the 2003 Big Ten Indoor Championships in Bloomington, IN. Michigan won the team title. The Hawkeyes were led by Aisha Hume, who placed sixth in the 500 meters (1:32.90). Hume also ran the third leg on the 1,600 meter relay of Jessica Fouche, Nicole Charles and Sarah Steffen that placed fifth in 3:48.06. Michelle Lahann placed fifth in the mile (4:54.75) and anchored the distance medley relay of Becca Thompson, Shellene Williams and Atalie Barber to a fifth-place finish in 11:51.71. Jessie Strand also placed fifth in the pole vault (11-11 3/4). Tiff Pedersen placed sixth in the pentathlon with 3,451 points, Steffen placed seventh in the 60-meter hurdles (8.59), and Jiselle Providence placed seventh in the 200 meters (24.72) and eighth in the 60 meters (7.66).

HEAD COACH JAMES GRANT



James Grant

Head Coach Eighth Year at Iowa University of Iowa, 1969

James Grant is in his eighth season at the helm of the Iowa women's track and field program. Grant was the former assistant coach at Iowa for 12 years.

Grant and the Hawkeyes had a monumental season in 2003, headlined by their sixth-place finish at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships - Iowa's highest placing at that meet during Grant's tenure. Iowa crowned a school-record six Big Ten Champions at the meet, including two-time winner Shellene Williams, who is the fourth student-athlete in school history to win two events at the same conference meet. The Hawkeyes showed signs of a well-rounded team throughout the season, but this was highlighted at the conference outdoor meet where they recorded 15 top-10 placings in 14 different events and scored their highest team-point total (70) since 1992. Seven Hawkeyes advanced from the NCAA Midwest Regional to compete at the NCAA Outdoor Championships.

Grant also had immense success in his first two seasons at the Hawkeye helm. Wynsome Cole earned all-America status in the 400-meter hurdles in 1997, and won a Big Ten title in that event in 1998. Ellen Grant won 400-meter titles at the 1997 conference indoor and outdoor meets. The 400-meter relay of Tara Underwood, Cole, Grant and Kaydene Wynter also won a Big Ten outdoor title. Erica Broomfield won the 200-meter title, and was runner-up in the 55 meters to earn Big Ten Indoor Freshmen of the Year accolades in 1998.

While improving in the league standings in considered a priority, Iowa's track and field team also concerns itself with performance in the classroom. During Grant's tenure, 31 Hawkeyes have earned 54 academic all-Big Ten honors. This includes a team record 11 honorees in 2001.

As Iowa's assistant coach from 1986-96, Grant coached several Hawkeyes to success. In 1995, Yolanda Hobbs earned all-America status in the 55 and 200 meters after winning the 55-meter Big Ten title. In 1994, Iowa's 400 meter-relay of Tina Floyd, Hobbs, Marlene Poole and Tanja Reid became the first in school history to ever win a Big Ten title in that event, setting a school and meet record. The team set records four times that season and earned all-America honors at the NCAA Championships. Karen Layne won the 1990 600-meter Big Ten title, while Senta Hawkins won the Big Ten 400 meters in 1988. In 1989, the 1,600-meter relay placed second at the conference indoor and outdoor meets.

A former Jamaican track standout, Grant coached at the high school level in Jamaica for 11 years prior to joining the Hawkeye program in 1986. From 1982-85, Grant coached the men's and women's track teams at G.C. Foster College of Physical Education and Sport. There he led the men's team to two national championships and three second-place finishes, and the women's team to three national titles. During that time he coached world outdoor champion quarter-miler Bert Cameron, and world indoor champion quarter-miler Devon Morris.

A graduate of Eastern Michigan University, Grant captained the 1970 and 1971 Huron track teams, earning all-America honors while specializing in the 400 meters, 400-meter hurdles, and the mile relay. During this time, he was the Jamaican 400-meter hurdle national record holder, with a time that was ranked in the top-20 in the world. Grant also represented Jamaica at the Pan American Games and the Commonwealth Games for six years. In 1991, he was inducted into the Eastern Michigan Hall of Fame.

He was the 1965 and 1966 Jamaican national champion in both the 200 and 400-meters as a high school athlete at Jamaica's Kingston College.

Grant received his bachelor's degree in sociology and history from Eastern Michigan, and his master's degree in physical education from the German College of Physical Education in Leipzig, Germany.
