SCOUTING CREIGHTON:

The Bluejays are 23-10 on the season and 7-5 in the MVC.

Creighton has swept its 16 consecutive doubleheaders this season. But this past weekend, only pulled out one win in a three-game series against Wichita State.

To lead Creighton, offensively, are Steve Winkelmann and Darin Ruf. Together they account for 11 home runs, 70 RBI and 39 walks. Winkelmann leads the team in slugging percentage (.572) while Ruf leads the team in hits (39).

Creighton's pitching is solid with a 3.67 team ERA. Their relief pitching is strong. Pat Venditte leads the bullpen with 21 appearances, 2.73 ERA and five saves.

Iowa leads the all-time series between the two schools, 10-9.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING:

Head Coach **Jack Dahm** will take on his alma mater and the program he coached for 10 years for the first time ever since taking the reigns at Iowa.

The last time the Hawkeyes took on Creighton was in 1998 in Omaha, NE, under coach Scott Broghamer. Iowa fell 14-6.

IOWA OFFENSE IS STREAKING:

Caleb Curry is currently on a team-high 11-game hitting streak. **Wes Freie** has been swinging the bat well, having gone the last six games with a hit.

Justin Toole and Curry lead the team in multi-RBI games with nine, followed by **Kurtis Muller** who has eight. **Kevin Hoef** and Curry have had 13 multi-hit games this season to lead Iowa, followed by Toole with 11 and Muller and **Wes Freie** with 10.

UTILIZING THE SAC BUNT:

The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in sacrifice bunts this season in the conference with 12. Leading the Black and Gold is **Kurtis Muller** with six, and **Justin Toole** with four.

DIAMOND THIEVES:

This season the Hawkeyes have out-run their opponents, going 72-for-90. Leading Iowa in steals is **Caleb Curry** (23), followed by **Justin Toole** and **Kyle Riffel** with 11.

Iowa ranks first in the Big Ten and fifth nationally in thefts per game.

SUCCESSFUL WITH RUNNERS :

Several Hawkeyes have taken advantage of baserunners this season.

Caleb Curry is hitting .484 with runners on to lead the Black and Gold. **Justin Toole** is hitting .824 when runners are on third, while **Kurtis Muller** is 37-for-58 in advancing runners. **Kevin Hoef** is hitting .500 with the bases loaded.

WEARING PITCHES:

Iowa has no problem taking one for the team. The Hawkeyes have 49 hit-by-pitches on the year which is more than any other team in the Big Ten and enough to rank them 37th in the country in the category.

To lead the Black and Gold is **Kevin Hoef** with 13, followed by **Caleb Curry** with seven and **Kyle Riffel** with six.

THE I-CLUB RECEPTION:

The I-Club will host a pre-game reception from 4:30-6 in the Hall of Fame Room in Rosenblatt Stadium on April 16. Head Coach **Jack Dahm** will speak briefly at 5 p.m.

All Hawkeye fans are welcome. Snacks, cash refreshments and Hawk Shop prizes will be available.

Individuals must have a game ticket to attend the pre-game reception.

A MILESTONE APPROACHES:

Head Coach **Jack Dahm** is three wins from getting his 400th career victory. Dahm had 283 wins at Creighton and is currently at 114 W's at Iowa.

Dahm started in 1994 with his alma mater, Creighton University, and moved on to coach the Hawkeyes in 2003.

The Wildcats are 9-15 on the season and 4-6 in the Big Ten.

Northwestern's team ERA is 5.91 and they are led by Eric Jokisch, who has 3.82 ERA with six starts and a 2-2 record.

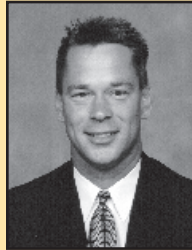

HAWKEYE SIGN EIGHT FOR 2009:

The Iowa Baseball program has signed eight recruits for next year. **Nick Brown**, **Sean Flanagan**, **Cory Glieden**, **Jarred Hippen**, **Mike McQuillan**, **Zach Robertson**, **Phil Schreiber** and **Chett Zeise** all signed national letters of intent to attend the University of Iowa.

Head Coach Jack Dahm



Jack Dahm is in his fifth season as head coach of the University of Iowa baseball team. He has compiled an 397-414-2 overall record and is 114-138 at Iowa. Dahm coached in his 800th career game on March 30th this year at Michigan.

Last season, Iowa took another step forward by recording its best record in 14 years with a 31-23 mark. The Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13. Iowa earned its second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

In Dahm's 14 years as a head coach, he has produced 23 first team all-conference performers, seven freshmen All-Americans and two All-Americans. In his four years at Iowa, Dahm has coached 19 all-Big Ten selections, including seven first teamers.

Before coming to Iowa City, Dahm spent 18 years as a member of the Creighton Bluejays baseball program. He left the Bluejays as the winningest coach in school history, having compiled 283 wins against 276 losses in 10 seasons as a head coach.

Twenty-seven of Dahm's players have been selected in the MLB Draft, while four have gone on to play in the major leagues. In the past three years, nine Hawkeyes have inked contracts with professional teams, including three last spring.

In the classroom, Iowa is in the 90th-percentile in the NCAA's Academic Progress Report, placing them in the top 30 baseball programs, academically. During his Iowa tenure, Dahm has seen 33 players named academic all-Big Ten, including a team-record ten players in 2006. That is the best four-year total in the history of the program.

The 41-year old Dahm and his wife, Lynn, have been married 14 years. The couple has three children - sons Casey and Tyler and daughter Lyndsey.

BY THE NUMBERS IN THE BIG TEN: **Caleb Curry** has taken the Big Ten by storm, when compared with the league's players he ranks in the top ten in: batting average (.398), on base percentage (.469), hits (43), runs batted in (31), hit-by-pitches (7) and stolen bases (23).

Other Hawkeyes who rank well in the conference include: **Justin Toole** is in the top ten in runs batted in (29) and runs scored (30). **Kevin Hoef** leads the league in hit-by-pitches (13), is fifth in runs scored (31), is second in total plate appearances (142) and is fourth in triples (3). **Kyle Riffel** is sixth in the league in hit-by-pitches (6) and **Kurtis Muller** is second in the league in sac bunts (6). **Andrew Porter** is tied for first in appearances (19) and **Kyle Heim** is tied for second (16).

INDIANA SUMMARY:

Iowa won its first Big Ten series against Indiana at Sembower Field. The Hawkeyes took 3-of-4 games from the Hoosiers and scored 47 runs on the weekend, advancing to 4-8 in the conference.

The hot-hitting Hawkeyes had 10 doubles, two triples, five homers, 13 walks, 44 RBI and an astounding .601 slugging percentage.

In the series, seven batters hit over .400 and four hit over .500. As a team, the Hawkeyes hit .399 in the four-game series.

To lead Iowa, offensively, was **Kurtis Muller** who was 7-for-13 (.538) with two doubles, a triple, a two-run homer, seven RBI and a killer 1.077 slugging percentage. **Wes Freie** also swung the bat well, going 8-for-16 (.500). **Ryan Gryzwa** picked up his second hit of the season with two RBI. **Justin Brauer** and **Kody McManis** were consistent, hitting 5-for-11. **Caleb Curry** had a solid weekend going 7-for-18 and scoring eight runs. **Kevin Hoef** hit the ball hard, going 6-for-15 with a .800 slugging percentage. He had a team high eight RBI, with a double, triple and homer.

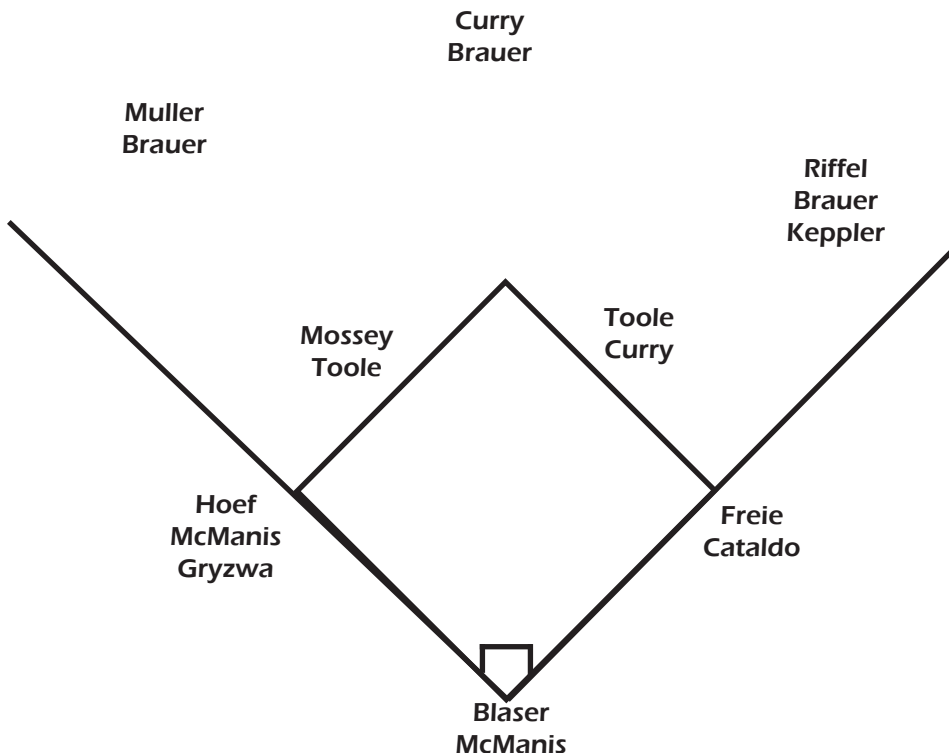

FRESHMAN STEPS UP:

Freshman **Kurtis Muller** has had a stellar season as hitting a solid .313. He has nine stolen bases, five doubles, one triple and two homers on the year. On top of that, he leads the league in sac bunts (6).

This past weekend, Muller was red-hot, going 7-for-13 with seven RBI.

McMANIS TAKES ON CATCHER:

Because **Tyson Blaser** is not 100% with a thumb injury and **Ben Geelan** sidelined with a boot-- utility infielder **Kody McManis** has had to take on the role of starting catcher.

McManis has improved behind the plate and also from the batters box, as well. On the season, McManis is hitting a solid .406 with a double and five RBI. Coming into the season, McManis had a career .186 batting average.

HAWKEYES GO YARD:

The Hawkeyes doubled their home run production last weekend hitting five long balls in four games to bring their grand total to 10 on the year.

Kevin Hoef hit his second career homer to lead off game one, **Wes Freie** followed suit and hit a dinger in the later innings of game one, **Kyle Riffel** hit the lone Iowa bomb in game two, **T.J. Cataldo** added an insurance run with a long ball in game three, and **Kurtis Muller** helped Iowa take the lead in game four with his shot to left.

Eight of Iowa's 10 homers this season have been in Big Ten play (Five at Indiana and three vs. Purdue).

CURRY RECEIVES HONOR:

Senior **Caleb Curry** received *CollegeBaseballHub.com's* Heartland Hitter of the Week honor for his performance against Rutgers.

Curry went 8-for-13 with seven RBI, two walks and three runs scored in the series.

THE ASSISTANT COACHES:

Head Coach **Jack Dahm** is assisted by coach **Ryan Brownlee** and coach **Nick Zumsande**, along with volunteer coach **Kris Welker** and Director of Baseball **Matt Haddy**.

Ryan Brownlee enters his fifth season as Iowa's hitting, infield instructor and recruiting coordinator.

As hitting coach, Brownlee saw the team's batting average vault 55 points from 2005 to 2007 (.269 to .324). Additionally, the team also scored more runs (273 to 401) had more RBIs (249 to 345) and walks (152 to 245) during that time span. **Nick Zumsande** enters his fifth year as the Iowa pitching coach.

Under Zumsande's guidance, the Hawkeye pitching has had a pitcher named first team all-Big Ten three of the last four years, and a pitcher named all-conference in each of his four years.

Kris Welker is in his second year as the team's volunteer assistant. Welker works with the Iowa catchers and outfielders, prepares scouting reports and coaches first base.

As a senior, Welker earned third team all-Big Ten honors, helping Iowa to a third-place finish in the Big Ten and a trip to the conference tournament. He led the team with a .354 batting average, 46 RBIs and 16 doubles. Welker also received the Bob Oldis, Jr MVP Award

Matt Haddy is in his third season as the Director of Baseball Operations for the University of Iowa.

He assists the coaching staff with the day-to-day operations and administrative areas of the program. Haddy also serves as the travel coordinator and director of Hawkeye Baseball Camps.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACES:

When you look around the diamond this season, your eyes don't deceive you. There are several familiar faces in the lineup playing different positions. Senior **Caleb Curry** moved to center field from left field and also has taken on shortstop and second base. Junior **Justin Toole** also will move from second to shortstop on occasion.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH:

Iowa will play one of its toughest schedules in 2008 as it will face nine teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament last season. The Hawkeyes will welcome NCAA Tournament teams Minnesota, Nebraska and Ohio State to Iowa City and will take on Albany, Creighton, Michigan, Rutgers, Stetson and Vanderbilt on the road. Iowa will face three teams in conference action that advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

BIG TEN PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

Wes Freie was named Big Ten Player of the Week on March 4. In addition, **Brock Alberts** earned co-Pitcher of the Week accolades, sharing the honor with Phil Isaksson.

Freie had a stellar weekend helping lead Iowa to a 2-1 record, including a 6-3 upset win over fifth-ranked Vanderbilt, at the Music City Classic in Nashville, TN. The first baseman, who was named tournament MVP, was 9-for-12 with a double, home run, two RBI and two walks. The junior led the Black and Gold against No. 5 Vanderbilt, going a perfect 4-for-4 with an RBI.

Alberts had a great season debut in Iowa's come-from-behind win over Xavier Feb. 29. The senior right hander threw five and one-third innings in relief for the win. He allowed no runs, scattered five hits with no walks and struck out a career-high 10 of the 21 batters he faced.

2008 MUSIC CITY CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM:

After going 2-1 at the tournament and upsetting Vanderbilt, the Hawkeyes received six of the 12 spots on the all-tournament team, including the MVP.

Hawkeyes honored were: **Justin Toole** at second, **Kevin Hoef** at shortstop, **Kyle Riffel** in the outfield, **Caleb Curry** in the outfield and **Wes Freie** as utility and MVP.

BIG TEN NETWORK SCHEDULE:

Three Hawkeye games will be televised on the Big Ten Network (HD) this season. Iowa's doubleheader at Indiana last Saturday was televised on the network. Only one game remains to be televised.

LAST SEASON:

Iowa posted a 31-23 record in 2007, the Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13, and earned their second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

During the season, Iowa defeated five teams (Nebraska, Fresno State, Ohio State, Minnesota and Michigan) that reached the NCAA Tournament. The Hawkeyes also posted a 12-game winning streak, which is the second-longest in school history. Included in the streak was a school-record 10-game Big Ten winning streak.

HAWKEYES HIT THE CLASSROOM:

In October, the Iowa baseball team was awarded the 2007 NCAA Public Recognition Award for being in the 90% percentile of Academic Progress Report (APR) for baseball.

THE 30-WIN CLUB:

The Hawkeyes' 31 wins in 2007 were the most under Coach Jack Dahm, in his career at Iowa, and the most at Iowa since 1993. The 1993 squad posted a 32-20 record under Duane Banks.

2008 UNITY COUNCIL:

The Unity Council is a group elected by their teammates to communicate internally with the coaches on behalf of their teammates. This year's council includes: senior **Ben Geelan**, junior **Kevin Hoef**, junior **Justin Toole**, sophomore **Tyson Blaser**, sophomore **Michael Jacobs** and freshman **Kurtis Mueller**.
