Post game comments by Purdue Coach Jim Young:

"In my estimation, this was just a great football game here today. Seldom do you have both teams ready to play like these two did today. It was an outstanding offensive display in the first half and a defensive game in the second half."

"This was as great a win as I've ever been associated with, when you consider we came into the game without our top four backs and were also without our top two leading pass receivers. But McCall (Purdue back Ben McCall) did just a super job at both fullback and tailback today. Herrmann (Purdue Quarterback Mark Herrmann) was super. That last interception he threw was really my fault. It really resulted from a substitution problem."

"McCall has been about the third string player at both fullback and tailback. Today he really came through when we needed him. This is the most banged up team I've ever coached at this point in the season."

"In the second half we tried to do a little more with the blitz, but that's about the only change we made in our defense."

"The part of the game that pleased me the most? Winning!"

"Iowa in my estimation was a very, very fine football team today. They (Iowa) did some things on offense that hurt us and some things on defense that hurt us. That was obvious as they had a chance to win it right down to the wire."

"Yes, I expected Iowa to throw the ball a lot, because I didn't think they could run against us."

"I think Iowa's quarterback (Phil Suess) did a darned good job. He backed out of there and threw those short passes and then when we pulled in a little, he hurt you with those long ones."

Post game comments by Iowa Coach Hayden Fry:

Commenting on Iowa's offensive play, an incomplete pass to Reid in the end zone: "It was a seven-yard stripper. All we were tryin' to do is get a first down, we missed it."

"I personally think we did everything we could. We weren't fast enough to keep up with Herrmann and his receivers. We obviously just aren't that good. Phil Suess has matured into a very fine quarterback. Most of the opportunities we missed were not his fault."

"We really thought we could win today ~~fine~~ (against Purdue) for the first time in 18 years. Our interior line hasn't stopped their draw play yet."

"I'm very proud of our football team, but I am disappointed that we lost. We just ~~don't~~ didn't have the finesse and poise to pull it off. It's very disappointing. Right now, Ohio State has the best football team in the country."

"Give credit to Purdue. Herrmann is a great passer, and they have great receivers, and that number 13 did a great job running the ball."

"I was certainly disturbed with some of the calls today (particularly on an offsides call). If he (Young) was disturbed (in the fourth quarter) I guess things just evened out. I'm real proud of Mosley (for making 1,000 yards. I thought that if we threw enough we could break him, but you're not going to find a much better defense than Purdue." //
