IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,058 games since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 646-412 (.611). That includes a 323-163 (.665) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 306-88 (.777) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

WIN NO. 300 AT HOME

The UI women's basketball program picked up victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 306-88 (.777) record inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

SCOUTING PENN STATE

The Penn State Lady Lions are 19-5 overall and 8-2 in Big Ten play.

In their last game, the Lady Lions defeated Michigan in Ann Arbor, 81-63. Maggie Lucas scored a game-high 23 points, while Nikki Greene added 14 points and 10 rebounds. Zhaque Gray and Alex Bentley each had 11 points, while Julia Trogele had 10.

Lucas leads the team in scoring with 16.7 points per game. Lucas has played in all 24 games, coming off the bench in each contest. Bentley is next at 14.8 points per game. Gray is scoring 10.4 points per contest. Green is the team's leading rebounder at 8.3 boards per contest.

As a team, the Lady Lions are shooting .453 (706-1,558) from the field, including .449 (173-385) from three-point distance.

PENN STATE VS. IOWA NOTES

- Thursday's contest is the 38th meeting between Iowa and Penn State State, with the Lady Lions leading the all-time series, 21-17. Iowa has won six of the last nine contests, but Penn State has won three of the last four. The Hawkeyes are 11-6 against Penn State in games played in Iowa City.

LAST MEETING

Iowa opened Big Ten play with a 68-59 loss at Penn State Dec. 30.

The two teams were tied at 34 at halftime, but Iowa gained a seven-point lead in the second half. Penn State closed the game with a 20-4 run in the final 6:33 to seal the win. During the run, Iowa went 0-8 from the floor.

Jaime Printy led Iowa with 17 points. Kelly Krei added 14 and Kamille Wahlin chipped in 11.

PRINTY AGAINST THE LADY LIONS

Jaime Printy has put up impressive numbers in four career games against Penn State.

For her career, Printy is averaging 20.3 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.8 assists against the Lady Lions. As a freshman, Printy netted 16 points at Penn State, 26 against the Lady Lions in Iowa City and 22 in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament. She scored 17 in the first meeting this season.

IOWA IN THE RANKINGS

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 20 in the AP poll and No. 22 in the ESPN/USA Today poll.

Three Iowa opponents are also ranked in the AP poll: Michigan State (11th/T-15th), North Carolina (15th/12th) and Iowa State (22nd/20th).

Penn State, Ohio State and Kansas State are receiving votes.

Iowa is also ranked 12th in the latest RPI released by the NCAA, which is the highest mark for a Big Ten school. The Hawkeyes also rank 11th in the nation in attendance, bringing in an average of 6,224 fans to Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

HAWKEYES STUMBLE AT PURDUE

Iowa dropped a 60-41 decision at Purdue Feb. 3.

The Hawkeyes couldn't find their shot, shooting just .218 from the field. Purdue shot .434 from the field, including .444 from three-point range to earn the win.

Iowa held an early 7-6 lead, but a 9:45 field goal drought (from 15:22-5:37 in the first half) saw Purdue open up a 23-11 advantage.

Kachine Alexander was the only Iowa player to score double figures, registering 11 points, eight rebounds and four steals.

POSTGAME NOTES AT PURDUE

- Iowa's .218 shooting percentage, 12 made field goals, two made three-pointers and 17 first half points were all season lows.
- Thursday marked the first time all season that at least two Hawkeyes did not score double figures. The last game when just one player scored double figures was against Stanford in the second round of the NCAA Tournament last season. Kachine Alexander scored 27 points in that contest. Alexander was the only Hawkeye with 10 or more points Thursday at Purdue, netting 11.

WAHLIN CLOSE TO 1,000

Kamille Wahlin needs just 15 more points to become the 28th player in Iowa history to record 1,000 career points. She currently has 985 career points.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT (REBOUNDER)

Kachine Alexander's 9.2 rebounds per game are the most for any guard in the country.

Alexander ranks 48th in the country in rebounding, but the 47 players ranked above her are all listed as forwards or centers.

East Tennessee State's Destiny Mitchel is the only other guard listed among the NCAA's top 50 rebounders. She ranks 49th at 9.1 rebounds per contest.

MORE MILESTONES FOR ALEXANDER

- If Kachine Alexander records one more assist, she would be the first player in Iowa history and just the fifth in Big Ten history, to have 1,000 career points, 800 career rebounds and 300 career assists. The other Big Ten players to hit the milestone were Wisconsin guard Jolene Anderson, Minnesota center Janel McCarville, and Illinois forwards Lacey Simpson and Tajua Catchings.
- With 11 rebounds at Ohio State (Jan. 24), Alexander became just the sixth player in school history, and the first-ever guard, to collect 800 career rebounds.
- Alexander is the sixth player in school history to have 1,000 career points and 800 career rebounds.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 562-271 (.675), including a 206-129 (.615) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

PRINTY AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Iowa has played in six games against opponents ranked in the top 25 this year, and Jaime Printy's numbers in those games have been impressive.

Printy is averaging 15.5 points, 4.7 rebounds and 4.2 assists in Iowa's games against ranked opponents (North Carolina, Iowa State, Ohio State twice and Michigan State twice). Printy is shooting .448 (30-67) from the field, including .458 (11-24) from three-point distance and .917 (22-24) from the free throw line against ranked teams.

NINE IN A ROW FROM DOWNTOWN

Jaime Printy buried nine-straight three-pointers, starting with Iowa's game at Minnesota (Jan. 5). Printy made her last three-point attempt at Minnesota, was a perfect 2-2 against Ohio State (Jan. 8), a perfect 4-4 at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and made her first two attempts vs. Indiana (Jan. 16) before missing a long-distance shot.

SEEING DOUBLE

Kachine Alexander recorded her sixth double-double of the season against Michigan State (Jan. 27), finishing with 23 points and 11 rebounds.

Alexander now has 30 career double-doubles, which is five shy of Lisa Long's school record for double-doubles (35, set from 1983-87).

Last season, Alexander finished with 15 double-doubles, which was one shy of tying Amy Herrig's record for single-season double-doubles.

Alexander tallied nine double-doubles as a sophomore.

KASH GETS A GRAND

With a layup at the 11:54 mark in the first half against Minnesota (Jan. 5), senior Kachine Alexander became the 27th player in school history to record 1,000 career points.

Alexander currently ranks 24th in career scoring at Iowa with 1,114 points.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Morgan Johnson recorded her sixth double-double of the season and the ninth double-double of her career against Illinois (Jan. 30). Johnson finished the game with 17 points and 13 rebounds.

JOHNSON AT .500 OR BETTER

When Morgan Johnson takes eight or more shots in a game, chances are she will make at least half of them.

Johnson has attempted eight or more shots in 17 of Iowa's 23 games this year. In those 17 games, Johnson has shot .500 or better 11 times, including a 7-9 (.778) shooting performance at Illinois (Jan. 30).

Johnson has attempted 10 or more shots eight times, shooting .500 or better in all but two games. Johnson was 8-13 (.615) against Northeastern, 10-16 (.625) against Central Michigan, 8-11 (.727) vs. Iowa State, 9-12 (.750) vs. South Dakota State, 5-10 (.500) vs. Michigan and vs. Ohio State and 7-12 (.583) at Ohio State.

She was 2-12 (.167) vs. James Madison and 4-12 (.333) at Minnesota.

JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET

Morgan Johnson scored double figures over a tough four game-stretch, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 Iowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Iowa is one of only three teams in the Big Ten to have four players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the conference.

Iowa, Ohio State, and Northwestern have four players ranked. Penn State, Wisconsin and Purdue have three ranked, while the remaining five schools have either one or two players ranked.

The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in 19 of the 23 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley and at Illinois. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan, Kansas State, Minnesota and in both games vs. Ohio State.

HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS

Iowa's rebounding numbers are impressive. The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in total rebounding (41.9 per game) and rank second in defensive rebounding (28.0 per game) and third in both offensive rebounding (13.9 per game) and rebounding margin (+5.5).

Kachine Alexander ranks third in overall rebounding (9.2 per game) and offensive rebounding (3.3 per game). Morgan Johnson ranks fourth in offensive rebounding (3.2 per game) and seventh in total rebounding (7.3 per game). Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are the third most for any Big Ten player this season.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (30), sixth in career rebounding (826), 10th in career assists (299) and 23rd in career scoring (1,114). She needs two more rebounds to move past Jennie Lillis for fifth place on the rebounding list and 24 assists to move past Lisa Anderson for ninth on the assists list. She needs six more double-doubles to take over first place (Lisa Long, 35).
- Morgan Johnson ranks fourth in career blocks (134) and needs 12 more to move past Toni Foster into third place.
- Kamille Wahlin ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (149) and 27th in career scoring (985). She needs eight more three-pointers to move past Leah Magner into fourth place.
- Jaime Printy ranks seventh in career three-pointers made (131) and needs eight more to move past Kristi Faulkner for sixth place.

PRINTY HAS A BIG WEEK

Jaime Printy averaged 20.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in Iowa's two games at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and at home vs. Indiana (Jan. 16).

Printy shot a combined .571 (12-21) from the field, including .700 (7-10) from three-point distance, while only missing one free throw (10-11, .909).

Printy started the week with 23 points, seven rebounds, two assists and three steals in Iowa's buzzer-beater loss at Michigan State, scoring 18 of Iowa's 28 first half points.

She followed with a game-high 18 points on 5-10 shooting, including 3-6 from beyond the arc, and eight rebounds in Iowa's 20-point victory over Indiana.

STEALING AWAY AGAINST BRADLEY

Iowa collected 17 steals against Bradley Nov. 16, which was the highest steal total for a Hawkeye team since the 2005-06 season. Iowa recorded 17 steals against UW-Milwaukee in the season opener on Nov. 20, 2005.

RACKING UP THE POINTS

Iowa's 91 points against Bradley Nov. 16 were the most for a regular season, non-overtime game since Feb. 25, 2007, when the Hawkeyes defeated Wisconsin, 103-93. Iowa scored 97 points in a triple-overtime win against Penn State Feb. 1, 2009.

BLUDER REACHES MILESTONE

With a 75-71 win at Drake Dec. 20, Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder became only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 204 wins in her 11 years at Iowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at Iowa, finishing her time in Iowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

ALEXANDER NAMED CO-BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week, Nov. 22, for her efforts against Bradley, Northeastern and Central Michigan. Alexander shared the weekly honor with Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of Iowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander has now been named Big Ten Player of the Week five times in her career. She was a two-time award winner as both a sophomore and junior.

ALEXANDER MAKES FIRST CUT FOR WOODEN AWARD - ON WATCH LISTS FOR OTHERS

Senior Kachine Alexander was one of 20 players to be named to the Wooden Award Top 20 Midseason List Jan 11. She is also on watch lists for the Wade Trophy and the Naismith Trophy. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players and the Naismith Trophy watch list is made up of 50 players.

The Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy are considered the three most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last year marked the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

Iowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.

AWARD WINNERS RETURNING

Several Hawkeyes earned numerous awards during the 2009-10 season.

- Head Coach Lisa Bluder was named Big Ten Coach of the Year for the third time in 10 seasons at Iowa.
- Kachine Alexander was named honorable mention All-America by the Associated Press and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). Alexander was also selected All-Region by the WBCA. She also earned All-America honors by the National Strength and Conditioning Association (NSCA). Alexander was named first team all-Big Ten by the coaches, second team all-Big Ten by the media and was one of five players named to the Big Ten all-Defensive Team. She was also selected to the Big Ten Tournament all-tournament team, named the MVP of the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge and was a two-time Big Ten Player of the Week.
- Jaime Printy was named Big Ten Freshman of the Year and was a unanimous pick for the Big Ten all-Freshmen team. Printy also earned second team all-conference honors from the media and third team all-league honors by the coaches. Printy was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week four times. She was named second team Freshman all-American by Full Court Press.
- Kamille Wahlin was a third team all-Big Ten selection by both the coaches and media. She was also named to the Big Ten Tournament, KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge and Nugget Classic all-tournament teams.
- Kelly Krei was named to the Big Ten Tournament all-tournament team.
- Morgan Johnson earned a Big Ten Freshman of the Week award.
