### NOTES

- Illinois picked up a midweek win over Eastern Illinois on Tuesday after dropping two of three at Nebraska last weekend. The Huskers ended the Fighting Illini's streak of nine straight Big Ten series won with come-from-behind wins on Saturday and Sunday.
- The Illini set a season high with 16 hits in a 9-7 win over Eastern Illinois Tuesday night at Illinois Field. Doran Turchin and Anthony Drago had three hits and Jason Goldstein added three RBIs.
- The Illini could not hold on to its 6-4 lead after four innings Sunday in a 9-7 loss. Nebraska scored four unanswered runs in the fifth and the sixth to take control of the game. Dan Rowbottom and Michael Hurwitz each finished with three hits.
- Illinois surrendered five runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to allow Nebraska to come from behind and beat the Fighting Illini, 9-8, Saturday. Nebraska sent 10 batters to the plate in the eighth and scored its five runs off of three Illini relievers.
- A heads up defensive play helped the Illinois baseball team find a way to win the opener of a three-game series at Nebraska Friday night at Hawks Field. A two-out single in the ninth inning nearly loaded the bases with the tying run at second for Nebraska, but a 7-5-6 putout erased the Husker's Cole Klemke rounding third and the Fighting Illini left with a 6-4 victory. Illinois walked 12 times, including eight base on balls from the top three hitters in the order, as the Illini came back from a 3-2 deficit after six innings to win.
- Illinois had won three of four before falling last Tuesday at Indiana State, 5-4. A dropped third strike allowed Indiana State's winning run to score with two outs in the ninth inning. There was some controversy on whether the pitch hit batter Andy DeJesus during the swing, while catcher Jason Goldstein scrambled to find the ball and make the throw that DeJesus beat. If the ball hit his foot, the third strike would have counted, the ball would be dead and the inning would have ended without the run scoring.
- The Illini's 5-3 loss to Penn State on March 26 snapped a 22-game Big Ten regular season winning streak. Illinois won 20 straight Big Ten regular season games to end the 2015 season and won its first two of 2016.
- Illinois is 19-5 in Big Ten regular season road games since the start of 2014 with four of those losses coming at Nebraska (two in 2014, two in 2016). Illinois is 17-1 on the road against the rest of the Big Ten field since 2014.
- Illinois is 18-1 in its last 19 Big Ten games at Illinois Field dating back to 2014. Penn State won at Illinois Field on March 26.
- Doug Hayes put up one of the best Illinois pitching performances in recent years by throwing only 94 pitches in a one-hitter against Penn State March 26, as the Illini cruised to a 6-1 win. Hayes induced 18 groundouts, while facing one batter over the minimum. It was the Fighting Illini's first one-hitter since since Mike Stankiewicz at Northwestern in 2007. Both Hayes and Stankiewicz were former walk-ons.
- Cody Sedlock matched career highs March 25 with 7.0 innings pitched and 10 strikeouts to lead Illinois to a 5-0 win over Penn State in the Big Ten and home opener.
- Two Illini hitters batted .400 or better during the Nebraska series: Michael Hurwitz .500 (4-8, 3 BB) and Dan Rowbottom .400 (4-10, 5 BB).
- Three Illini hitters batted over .400 during the Penn State series: Anthony Drago .455 (5-11), Jason Goldstein .444 (4-9) and Pat McInerney .417 (5-12). Drago and Goldstein both homered.
- After holding Penn State to a .170 batting average in three games, Nebraska hit .346 against the Illini.
- Freshman Cole Bellair became the first Illinois true freshman to start a Big Ten game since May 24, 2013 when Ryan Castellanos got the ball against Minnesota.
- Cody Sedlock, Doug Hayes and Cole Bellair have averaged nearly seven innings per start and the group has a 3.15 ERA in the Big Ten's first six games, over a full run better than the team's overall ERA.
- Illinois ranks 19th in the nation in double plays per game (1.04). The Illini turned four double plays against FGCU Feb. 26 and four against Villanova March 6.
- Freshman centerfielder Doran Turchin and redshirt-junior shortstop Adam Walton are the only Illini to start every game at their respective positions. Only Walton, the leadoff hitter, has started in the same spot in the batting order.
- Seven of the Illini's 12 wins have come with the opponent scoring two or fewer runs.
- Nearly half of the Illini's hits (49.8%, 111/223) have been by players who never started a game before 2016.
- Last season, Illinois set a program record with 50 wins, including a Big Ten record 27-game winning streak. The Illini won the NCAA Champaign Regional on its way to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. Eventual national runner-up Vanderbilt ended the Illini's season in the NCAA Champaign Super Regional.
