THE INDIANA HOOSIERS

OVERALL...

- · · · Indiana has won 13 of its last 14 games and is 16-5 overall with four wins over 2014 NCAA Super Regional teams and six vs. ranked opponents. Comparatively, Indiana was 13-8 through 21 games in 2014.
- ••• IU's 12-game win streak (2/28-3/22) was tied for the fifth-longest in IU history, is the 11th time that IU has had a streak of 10 or more games all-time and was the nation's longest current winning streak at the time.
- · · · In the Big Ten, IU ranks first in walks allowed (42), tied for first with nine triples, third in team ERA (2.48) and strikeouts (184), tied for third in home runs (14) and fourth in batting average (.284), and RBI (115) and tied for fourth in total bases (299).
- · · · Fifteen of Indiana's 21 games have been decided by three runs or less, including seven by one run. IU is 6-2 in one-run games and has won five straight. In three-run games, IU is 11-4 and winners of its last eight such con-
- · · · Indiana has recorded 10 or more hits in 13 of its last 17 games and has struck out 10+ batters in five of the last six.
- ••• The Hoosiers moved up to No. 19 in D1Baseball's poll this week, the highest IU has been ranked nationally this season.

BACK TO BIG TEN PLAY

INDIANA VS. IOWA...

- · · · Indiana and Iowa will meet for the 145th time since opening the all-time series on April 18, 1913.
- ••• Iowa leads the all-time series, 74-70.
- · · · The Hoosiers have defeated lowa eight consecutive times and swept the season series in 2014 and 2013 -- both in Iowa City. During the streak, Indiana has outscored lowa, 71-31, for an average margin of victory of five runs.

INDIANA VS. THE BIG TEN...

- ••• IU is 1-1 in Big Ten play in 2015 -- splitting a doubleheader at Penn State on 3/22 after snow cancelled the opener on 3/20 and postponed the series.
- · · · Indiana has won back-to-back Big Ten regular season and tournament championships. Only nine times in B1G history has a team won three consecutive Big Ten titles.
- ••• Indiana is 37-10 in conference action since 2013, including a 21-3 mark in 2014. IU is 19-7 on the road in that span (11-1 in 2014).

ANOTHER WIN...

- ••• Indiana topped No. 7 Louisville, 3-0, at home on Tuesday to improve to 16-5 overall and 7-0 at home, matching its best start in the three years of Bart Kaufman Field's existence.
- ••• Isaiah Pasteur hit the first two home runs of his career, accounting for three RBI in the win.
- · · · IU owns three shutouts in the last six games.
- ••• Indiana is 44-7 in the month of March since 2013 and 12-1 in 2015.

BACK IN THE RANKINGS...

- ••• Four of the five polls recognized by the NCAA have the Hoosiers ranked, while IU is also receiving votes in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
- ••• Here's how the rankings shake out for IU: D1Baseball (19), Collegiate Baseball (24), Baseball America (24), USA Today Coaches Poll (29) and NCBWA (30).
- ••• Since 2013, Indiana has been ranked in at least one poll in 35 of 45 possible weeks. IU has been a Top 25 team on 35 occasions, a Top 20 team in 29 weeks, a Top 15 team 16 times and has reached the Top 10 nine times.

BIG TEN WEEKLY HONORS...

- ••• IU players have been honored five times this season by the Big Ten, the most selections in the league, with Nick Ramos (Feb. 16) and Austin Cangelosi (March 16) earning Big Ten Player of the Week and Logan Sowers (March 2 and 9) and Brian Hobbie (March 16) picking up Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors.
- ••• A Hoosier was honored by the Big Ten in four of the first five weeks of the season. Indiana has 22 weekly conference honors since 2013 and five this season. The Hoosiers earned 11 such accolades in 2014 and six in 2013.

LEADING THE HOOSIERS

IN THE BIG TEN...

- ••• Casey Rodrigue leads Indiana with 4 total bases and 17 RBI. Craig Dedelow leads IU with a .341 batting average and 28 hits. Three Hoosiers have at least seven extra-base hits, led by 10 from Austin Cangelosi.
- ••• Thomas Belcher leads IU with 23 strikeouts and a 0.57 ERA (min. 15 inn.). Ryan Halstead has a team-high five saves and his IU career record 28 rank sixth among NCAA active career leaders.

THE LAST TWO YEARS

A HISTORIC RUN...

- ••• Indiana is coming off arguably the best twoyear run for any Big Ten team in the last 30 years with its first College World Series appearance in 2013 and the first national seed by any Big Ten program ever.
- •••2013-14: 93-31 overall record (.750), consecutive Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles, seven All-Americans, 12 All-Big Ten First Team members, eight MLB draft picks, including four in the first five rounds.
- •••2014: 44-15 overall record (.746), earned No. 4 overall national seed and hosted NCAA Regional at Bart Kaufman Field, B1G regular-season and tournament champions, claimed eight of 13 spots on First Team All-Big Ten list, tying conference record for most first team honorees in one season, four All-Americans, five MLB draft picks, including Kyle Schwarber, the highest pick in IU baseball history (fourth overall by Chicago Cubs).
- •••2013: Won program-record 49 games (49-16; .754), first Big Ten team to make College World Series in 29 years, finished No. 6 in Collegiate Baseball final poll and No. 7 in Baseball America and USA Torday Baseball Weekly/ESPN/ABCA final polls, B1G regular-season and tournament champions -- IU's first regular-season crown since 1949 and first outright since 1932, three All-Americans and three MLB draft picks, four All-Big Ten first teamers.

LEMONIS HIRED AS INDIANA'S 24TH BASEBALL HEAD COACH

Indiana University Vice President and Director of Athletics Fred Glass announced the hiring of Louisville assistant coach Chris Lemonis, The 2013 ABCA/Baseball America Assistant Coach of the Year, as the 24th head coach of the Hoosier baseball program on July 2, 2014.

"We are extremely pleased with the extensive interest in this position, from head coaches to assistant coaches and others associated with collegiate and professional baseball," Glass said. "From those outstanding candidates, we are confident we have selected the right one to lead Indiana Baseball.'

Indiana, the No. 4 overall seed in the 2014 NCAA Tournament, conducted a comprehensive, nationwide search and consulted some of the most recognized names in baseball, including Major League Baseball All-Star and Indiana native Scott Rolen.

"I'd like to personally thank all involved in the process of helping us land this outstanding head coach, especially our student-athletes and Scott Rolen, who served as a special advisor in our search," Glass said.

Lemonis' imprint in elevating the Louisville program to new heights has been evident. The former Cardinals' recruiting coordinator aided Louisville to three College World Series appearances (2008, 2013, 2014) and a 359-159 (.693) record during the past eight seasons, including back-toback 50-win seasons in 2013 and 2014.

Working under Louisville head coach Dan McDonnell, Lemonis has helped the Cardinals produce 15 All-Americans, 54 all-conference selections and a pair of conference Player of the Year winners. Entering his 21st season in coaching and first as a head coach, Lemonis takes over an IU program that has gone 93-31 during the past two seasons, including its first-ever College World Series appearance in 2013 and the No. 4 overall seed in the 2014 NCAA Baseball Championship.

"I am really excited for the opportunity to join one of college baseball's hottest programs at Indiana," Lemonis said. "I am thankful Fred Glass and the administration have faith in me to keep the momentum rolling and keep the Hoosiers at the top of the Big Ten.

"Our staff will do everything we can to recruit the state of Indiana and the entire Midwest to bring the best baseball players to Bloomington. We will play an exciting brand of baseball and are confident we can continue the championship tradition that has been established at IU.

Known as one of the premiere hitting coaches and recruiters in college baseball, Lemonis built a pristine track record in 20 years as an assistant that included continuous Top 25 recruiting classes and 12 visits to the NCAA Tournament.

Lemonis mentored 33 players that signed professional contracts after being selected in the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft during the last eight years, including a school-record 10 selections in the 2010 MLB Draft.

Lemonis helped Louisville win four BIG EAST championships in the school's final five years in the conference and he saw U of L set the school record for wins in a season three different times, including 2013, when the Cardinals won a current-best 51 games.

Prior to his time at Louisville, Lemonis spent 12 seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater. The Citadel, including the final four as associate head coach. While at The Citadel, the Bulldogs recorded five NCAA Regional appearances and finished first or second in the Southern Conference seven times.

Lemonis, who worked primarily with hitters and outfielders at The Citadel, oversaw 35 new offensive records. The Bulldogs boasted seven All-Americans, two Freshman All-Americans, 17 first team All-Southern Conference honorees, a Southern Conference Player of the Year and a Freshman of the Year.

Part of nearly 800 wins as an assistant coach, Lemonis' teams have averaged 39.2 victories per year during his career, bolstered by a 44.9 winsper-season average at Louisville.

Lemonis graduated from The Citadel in 1992, twice earning All-Southern Conference honors as a player and leading the team in home runs three times. He led the Bulldogs with a .367 average, 19 doubles, 52 runs, 10 home runs and 66 RBI as senior. He was also named to the 1993 All-Southern Conference Tournament team. He ranks in the top 15 all-time at The Citadel in RBI (152), 11th in home runs (23) and 10th in slugging percentage (.538).

A native of Myrtle Beach, S.C., Lemonis and his wife, Jill, have two daughters, Marissa and Mackenzie.
