Post game comments by Minnesota Coach Joe Salem:

"Yes, the wind was really a factor. It was tough on the kicking game and tough on the passing game. I think it made it especially tough for (Iowa's Reggie) Roby.

"They (Iowa) are an especially good defensive team. We got down there several times and didn't get in. Luckily, we got the field goals."

"Our defense today? Wow, they were just unreal! I don't even know how many plays Iowa had in that first half. But it must not ~~have~~ have been many. I think that 4th and 1 situation deep in our territory when Iowa didn't make it was a real key play. Our defense was super there."

"I want to ~~thank~~ thank all the Iowa writers. They were all writing about Iowa and the Rose Bowl this past week and not many were even mentioning Minnesota. We just sat quietly by and by Thursday we knew our guys were ready to play."

"This game today shows, I think, the character of our players. We just came off a very hard loss last week and then played so very well here today."

"You want to talk with our players. By all means, go on up. It was them who won this game. Not me!"

Post game comments by Iowa Coach Hayden Fry:

"It's pretty hard for 18, 19, 20-year-old youngsters to understand that the game of football is not a life-or-death matter, and there's a nother game next weekend. We made a lot of mental mistakes. At times, we played super--super offense and super defense. But we just blew it. We worked hard all week. We tried to take care of everything we could think of. I take all the responsibility as the coach. We've got to things back together first thing next week and get back on top of the mountain and win our sixth game."

"Our objective right now is to win one more game so we can have a winning season."

"Minnesota did a good job blocking up front. . . . But we didn't do that well on offense in attacking their defense. We knew it was complex. We prepared well, but we just didn't execute."

"Gordy (Bohannon) was off and on. When he was on, he was good. When he was off, he was just a blank. We mentally just didn't have our heads in the game."

"The game came close to getting out of hand. . . . The officials could have thrown the flag a jillion times today."

"We wanted to get off against those people and score points right off the bat, but our offense just wasn't worth a flip."

"It just wasn't our day. The defense at times was poor, but then we can't count on our ~~defense~~ defense to ~~win~~ always win our games for us."

"We worked our tails off preparing for this game, but we didn't deserve to win because we didn't execute." I don't have any sour grapes or alibis or anything. We just didn't play that well."

"I would have bet anything amount of money that they (our players) were ready to play ~~ready~~ at kickoff. We haven't had a winning season in 20 years. This is a great rivalry. They are great young men, very intelligent, and they'll just have to be ready to play next week."
