ON THE MAT

The top-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team hosts No. 16 Michigan on Friday at 7 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Mat at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. A win against the Wolverines would give Iowa the outright Big Ten regular season dual championship. The Hawkeyes clinched a share of the title with an 18-12 win against Penn State on Feb. 8.

The Hawkeyes host No. 13 Virginia on Sunday at 1 p.m. in the opening round of the EAS/NWCA National Duals. The winner advances to the championship rounds, hosted by the University of Iowa at Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Feb. 21-22.

SENIOR NIGHT

The Iowa wrestling program will honor eight seniors following the Michigan dual on Friday. That includes student-athletes Josh Dziewa, Mike Evans, Jeremy Fahler, Matt Gurule, Michael Kelly, Nick Moore, and Bobby Telford, and team manager Maddie Schossow.

TICKET INFORMATION

Tickets to the Michigan dual are \$12 for adults and \$8 for youth 18 and younger. Adult tickets are \$15 for the Virginia dual. UI students and kids five-years old and younger are admitted free.

Tickets to the second round of the Cliff Keen National Duals (Feb. 21-22) -- featuring eight teams and three rounds of competition -- are \$10 for Saturday's quarterfinals and semifinals, and \$20 for Sunday's final round.

BIG TEN CHAMPIONS

Iowa won a share of the Big Ten regular season dual title with an 18-12 win at Penn State on Feb. 8. The Hawkeyes are 8-0 in the Big Ten, one dual ahead of Nebraska and Ohio State in the loss column.

A win on Friday would guarantee Iowa the outright Big Ten regular season dual championship.

The Hawkeyes have won or shared seven of the last eight Big Ten dual championships, and have won or shared the regular season title eight times since the conference started recognizing a dual meet champion in 1999. Iowa won the title outright in 2000, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, and 2013, and shared the title in 2003 and 2014.

WIRE TO WIRE

Iowa debuted at the top spot on Nov. 11 when the USA Today/NWCA preseason poll was released 14 weeks ago. The Hawkeyes have maintained the top spot all season and enter the weekend as the unanimous No. 1, claiming all 12 first-place votes.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

The Hawkeyes are 7-0 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena this season and have a 220-21 all-time record at home since Carver started hosting wrestling duals in 1983. The Hawkeyes have recorded 20 undefeated seasons in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, the most recent in 2012-13 (9-0).

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted three Big Ten Championships (1983, 1994, 2005) and four NCAA Championships (1986, 1991, 1995, 2001). The Hawkeyes have won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

On February 21-22, 2015, Carver-Hawkeye Arena will host the National Duals for the third time (1998, 1999).

BATTLE TESTED

The top-ranked Hawkeyes finished their road schedule with a 6-0 record. Iowa traveled 5,226 miles since opening the dual schedule at Rutgers on Jan. 2. That includes 3,370 miles in the air -- Rutgers, Ohio State, Maryland, Penn State -- and 1,856 miles on the road to Stillwater, Okla., and Minneapolis. Five wins were against ranked opponents, and four of those wins were against top 10 opponents.

The Hawkeyes also won the Midlands Championships on Dec. 30, a 460 mile roundtrip trip to Evanston, Illinois.

Iowa defeated Ohio State 18-14 in Columbus, Ohio, on Jan. 4. The Hawkeyes return to St. John Arena March 7-8 for the Big Ten Championships.

Individually, Iowa is 42-18 in six wins at #23 Rutgers (27-9), #7 Ohio State (18-14), #8 Oklahoma State (30-7), #2 Minnesota (23-12), Maryland (33-3), and #5 Penn State (18-12).

THE SERIES -- MICHIGAN

Iowa has won seven straight against Michigan and leads the all-time series 30-25-1. The Hawkeyes are 13-9-1 against the Wolverines in duals wrestled in Iowa City. Michigan's last win at Carver-Hawkeye Arena was a 21-11 victory on Feb. 13, 2005.

Iowa won the last meeting between the teams, 26-6, in Iowa City in 2014.

THE SERIES -- VIRGINIA

Iowa won the only meeting between the schools, 26-12, on the campus of UT-Chattanooga.

Fourth-ranked Mike Evans defeated eighth-ranked Nick Sulzer, 7-4, at 165 pounds, and sixth-ranked Bobby Telford won by forfeit against Patrick Gillen.

TOPS IN THE BIG TEN

Redshirt freshman Brandon Sorensen and sophomore Sammy Brooks are the highest ranked Big Ten wrestlers at their respective weights, according to the latest InterMat poll.

Sorensen is 27-2 and ranked No. 2 at 149 pounds behind Edinboro senior David Habat. Habat defeated Sorensen, 3-2, in the semifinals of the Midlands Championships.

Brooks is 21-2 and ranked No. 8 at 184 pounds. He is one of two Big Ten wrestlers ranked in the top 10 at 184. Ohio State's Kenny Courts is ranked 10th. Brooks defeated Courts 3-2 in Columbus on Jan. 4.

SORENSEN IS 1 OF A KIND

Redshirt freshman Brandon Sorensen is the only Division I wrestler in the country with wins over two reigning NCAA finalists.

Sorensen defeated NCAA 149-pound runner-up Josh Kindig, 6-1, on Jan. 11, and 12 days later he handed defending NCAA champion Jason Tsirtsis is first loss of the season, 3-2, in double overtime.

His 27 wins lead the team, and his only losses have been to teammate Brody Grothus (3-2) at the Luther Open, and current No. 1 David Habat (3-2) at the Midlands Championships.

ALL-AMERICANS BEING ALL-AMERICANS

Iowa's four All-Americans -- Cory Clark (133), Mike Evans (174), Nathan Burak (197), and Bobby Telford (285) -- are a combined 71-8.

Evans is 20-1 with 12 wins by bonus points. Burak is 13-2 with two pins, one major decision, and one technical fall. He has claimed two tournament titles wrestling unattached at the Luther Open and Midlands Championships. He wrestled attached for the first time Jan. 4 at Ohio State and earned a 2-1 win over No. 7 Kyle Snyder.

Cory Clark, an All-American at 125 last year, is 17-4 overall with eight falls, one technical fall, and one major decision. Bobby Telford is 21-1 with nine pins, one major decision, and one win via medical forfeit.

All four returning All-Americans won Midlands individual titles on Dec. 30.

The Hawkeyes have crowned at least one All-American every year since 1972, a span of 43 seasons. Iowa has totaled 261 All-America honors during that stretch. The Hawkeyes crowned six All-Americans in 2014, including four-time All-American Derek St. John (157) and first-timers Clark (125) and Burak (197). Tony Ramos earned his third career All-America honor, winning the 133-pound bracket, and Evans (174) and Telford (285) were both named All-Americans for the second time in their careers.

CHASING MILESTONES

Seniors Mike Evans and Bobby Telford are within striking distance of career win No. 100. Evans leads all active Hawkeyes with 97 career wins, Telford has 96. Forty wrestlers in the program history have accumulated 100 career wins, including coaches Tom Brands (158), Terry Brands (137), and Ryan Morningstar (110).

Tom Brands is one win shy of his 160th dual victory at Iowa, which would tie Dave McCuskey for No. 2 in program history.

BRANDS PASSES BRANDS

Tom Brands earned his 159th coaching victory at the University of Iowa on Feb. 8. He owns a 159-15-1 (.911) dual record since becoming Iowa's head coach in April 2006. He is one win shy of tying Dave McCuskey for No. 2 in program history.

He now has one more victory as coach than he did as student-athlete. Brands was 158-7-2 (.952) from 1989-92. His 158 wins rank second in school history

(Barry Davis, 162).

He won three NCAA Championships as a wrestler (1990, 1991, 1992) and has won three NCAA Championships as head coach (2008, 2009, 2010).

BIG WEEKLY HONORS

University of Iowa senior Bobby Telford has been named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week for the second time this season, the conference office announced Tuesday.

Telford, a native of Hockessin, Del., defeated two ranked opponents on his return to the east coast last weekend. He shutout 13th-ranked Spencer Myers, 4-0, at Maryland on Feb. 6, and blanked sixth-ranked Jimmy Lawson, 3-0, at Penn State on Feb. 8.

The Hawkeyes have received four Big Ten weekly honors this season, more than any other conference school. Redshirt freshman Brandon Sorensen has earned the honor on two occasions, first on Jan. 13 and again on Jan. 27.

HAWKEYES IN THE RANKINGS

Iowa has nine wrestlers ranked in the top 10 of the latest Intermat rankings (Feb. 10), more than any other school.

Four of Iowa's wrestlers are ranked in the top five, including Thomas Gilman (5), Brandon Sorensen (2), Mike Evans (3), and Bobby Telford (2).

Four more Hawkeyes are projected in the top eight, including Cory Clark (6), Josh Dziewa (6), Sammy Brooks (8), and Nathan Burak (6). Nick Moore is ranked No. 9 at 165, and Michael Kelly is ranked No. 14 at 157.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 953-224-31 (.802) in 105 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 53 NCAA Champions have won a total of 81 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 110 Big Ten champions have combined for 191 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 29 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 150 All-Americans have earned All-America status 307 times, including 18 four-time, 32 three-time and 39 two-time honorees.

40 YEARS SINCE NO. 1

Iowa celebrated the 40th anniversary of its first national championship on Jan. 23. Gary Kurdelmeier led Iowa to its first NCAA Championship in 1975, and in the 40 years since, the Hawkeyes have accumulated 23 team titles, more than any other school -- Oklahoma State (7), Penn State (4), Minnesota (3), Iowa State (2), and Arizona State (1).

NCAA EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeyes have seven wrestlers with NCAA Championships experience. Seniors Mike Evans (174) and Bobby Telford (285) are three-time NCAA qualifiers. Telford earned All-America honors in 2012 and 2014, while Evans earned All-America honors in 2013 and 2014. Junior Nathan Burak (197) and sophomore Cory Clark (125) also advanced to the All-America stand in 2014. Burak was making his second NCAA tournament appearance, while Clark was making his first. Senior Nick Moore (165) has competed in two NCAA Championships (2013, 2014), and last year senior Josh Dziewa (141) and junior Brody Grothus (149) made their first career appearances.

NWCA NATIONAL DUALS

The Division I National Duals was founded as part of the Virginia Duals in Hampton, Va., in 1989 as the National Dual Meet Championships. In 1991, the event began to rotate around the country with the oversight of the National Duals handled by the National Wrestling Coaches Association. Since 1989, 10 different cities have hosted the championships entirely or served as a championship finals site. Cedar Falls, Iowa, had the longest consecutive run of hosting championships, with six straight years from 2006-2011. This year's finals host, Iowa City, has hosted the event previously in 1998 and 1999.

Over the past 26 years, the team championship trophy has only been hoisted by six programs – Oklahoma State (8 titles), Minnesota (8), Iowa (6), Penn State (2), Cornell (1) and Iowa State (1). Iowa, Minnesota and Cornell all look to win another dual team championship this season.

NWCA FORMAT

This year's format melds a regional concept born a few seasons ago with a championship weekend site to fully expand the reach of the event. Eight regional sites will host play-in matches on Feb. 14-15, while the winners of those eight duals will go to Iowa City on Feb. 21-22 and then compete in the championship round. The eight teams advancing will be reseeded according to their ranking by the USA Today/NWCA Division I Wrestling Coaches Poll. No draws are pre-determined based on first-round matches. Quarterfinals and semifinals will take place in Carver-Hawkeye Arena in Iowa City, Iowa on February 21 with the finals and third-place dual on February 22. The semifinals and finals will be shown live on the Big Ten Network.

NWCA TEAM RANKINGS

Ten of the 16 teams in the 2015 Division I field are ranked in the Top 15 according to the USA Today/NWCA Division I Wrestling Coaches Poll including five of the top six. Iowa, Missouri, Ohio State, Minnesota and Cornell. Other ranked teams include Lehigh, Illinois, Virginia, Edinboro and North Dakota State. Chattanooga and Oklahoma have all spent time in the Top 25 this season.

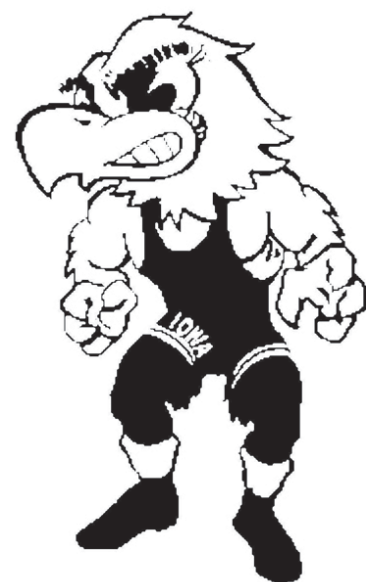

Tom Brands
Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands completed his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 159-15-1 (.911) overall and 66-6 (.917) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 176-35-1 (.826) career mark.

In eight seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning nine NCAA champions, 11 Big Ten champions and 44 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 61 academic all-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 72 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last eight years, sending the entire 10-man line-

up in 2009, 2010, and 2014. Iowa has also won or shared six of the last seven Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, Iowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the then-national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when Iowa defeated Iowa State, 20-15, on Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' eight seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.

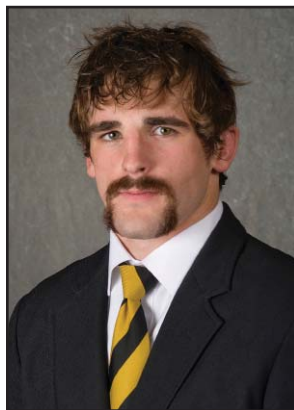
