ON THE MAT

The University of Iowa (3-0) wrestling team faces Iowa State (5-0) on Sunday in the annual Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series. The dual begins at 2 p.m. (CT) inside Hilton Coliseum (7,914).

Admission is \$20 for adults and \$10 for youth (high school age and younger).

DAN GABLE TRAVELING TROPHY

The Iowa-Iowa State wrestling rivalry introduced the Dan Gable Traveling Trophy in 2010.

In a joint collaboration, the schools announced the annual dual would be wrestled for a trophy representing Iowa State's former two-time NCAA Champion and Iowa's 15-time NCAA championship coach.

Iowa has won each meetings since the trophy's inception, including a 22-13 win in 2010, a 27-9 win in Ames in 2011, and winning in Iowa City, 32-3, in 2012.

THE SERIES

Iowa leads the all-time series 61-16-2, and has won the last nine meetings. The Hawkeyes own a 24-11-1 advantage in Ames.

Iowa State's last win in the series was 19-16 on Dec. 5, 2004. Iowa has won the last four meetings in Ames, and has not lost to Iowa State on the road since Dec. 7, 2003 (21-13). Prior to that Iowa State win, the Hawkeyes had won 30 in a row in the series.

The Hawkeyes have won 10 straight in the series on two occasions. Iowa won 30 in a row from 1987-2002, and 10 straight from 1981-86. A win on Sunday would run Iowa's active win streak to 10.

HAWKEYES VS. CYCLONES ONE-ON-ONE

Iowa's probable lineup owns a 17-9 individual record against Iowa State. Tony Ramos (3-0), Derek St. John (3-0) and Bobby Telford (2-0) are all perfect against the Cyclones.

Michael Kelly and Nick Moore are both 2-1 all-time against Iowa State, and Mike Evans is 1-1.

Ethen Lofthouse started 0-3 against Iowa State, but has since won three in a row to even his record. Tomas Lira is 1-3 all-time against the Cyclones. Cory Clark, Josh Dziewa, Kris Klapprodt and Terrance Jean-Jacques are making their first appearances against Iowa State.

IOWA CORN CY-HAWK SERIES

The Cy-Hawk Series is in its 10th season in 2013-14, being sponsored for the third time by Iowa Corn.

Iowa State currently leads the series, 6-5, after finishing ahead of Iowa in both men's and women's cross country at NCAA Regionals last week. The Cyclones also registered a 3-1 win in volleyball earlier this fall. Iowa has posted victories in women's soccer (3-0) and football (27-21). The Hawkeyes' win in women's soccer was worth two points, while Iowa was rewarded with three points for its win in football.

Iowa owns an 8-1 lead in the Cy-Hawk Series duals. The Cyclones won the first meeting in 2004, while Iowa has won the last eight. (Iowa has won nine straight overall, including a meeting at the National Duals.)

CLARK DEBUTS WITH TITLE

Redshirt freshman Cory Clark made his varsity debut at the Luther Open on Nov. 16. Clark pinned his first three opponents before earning a 4-0 decision against Iowa teammate Thomas Gilman in the 125-pound finals.

Clark made his Carver-Hawkeye Arena debut at the Iowa City Duals on Nov. 22, pinning each of his opponents in the opening period. He is 7-0 overall and tied for the team lead with six falls (Tony Ramos).

Clark owned a 20-2 record competing unattached last season. He won four tournament titles and placed fourth at 125 pounds at the 2012 Midlands Championships. He was a four-time Iowa high school state champion at South East Polk in Des Moines from 2009-12.

RAMOS ADDS TO PIN TOTAL

Senior Tony Ramos recorded three pins at the Luther Open on Nov. 16 and three more at the Iowa City Duals on Nov. 22. His six falls ties Cory Clark for the team lead.

Ramos entered the season with 24 career pins, and has since raised his career total to 30. He recorded two falls as a redshirt freshman, eight falls as a sophomore, and 14 falls last season as a junior. Ramos needs 44 career falls to tie Chuck Yagla for 10th all-time in career pins.

Brent Metcalf, who scored 47 pins from 2008-10, was the last Hawkeye to crack the top 10 list. Prior to Metcalf, the list had not changed since Terry Brands (48), Tom Brands (46), and Mark Reiland (45) ended their careers in 1992.

DZIEWA EMERGES AT 141

Junior Josh Dzewa has started the season 8-0 with four falls and a pair of major decisions.

Dzewa is expected to make just his sixth career dual start. He is 5-0 all-time in duals after recorded three pins at the Iowa City Duals on Nov. 22. His career dual record including a 1-0 mark as a redshirt freshman (149 pounds), and a 1-0 in record last season as a sophomore. Both wins were major decisions.

Dzewa earned the 141-pound starting spot after running through the Luther Open on Nov. 16. He recorded two major decisions, one pin, and a pair of decisions over teammates Ethan Owens (2-0) and Topher Carton (4-0). His win at the Luther Open was his fourth career tournament title.

KELLY EARNS NOD AT 149

Junior Michael Kelly put together five straight wins at the Luther Open to earn the starting nod at 149 pounds. Kelly defeated teammate Connor Ryan in the semifinals, 6-1, before topping Upper Iowa's Edwin Cooper, 6-5, in the finals.

Kelly is 8-0 to start the season for the second time in his career. He raced to a 12-0 as a true freshman before suffering his first loss. He has three pins and two major decisions among his eight wins. The three pins are one more than he recorded all of last season.

ST. JOHN EYES HISTORY

Senior Derek St. John enters 2013-14 as a three-time All-American and a chance to become the 18th four-time All-American in school history.

St. John finished fourth as a freshman and runner-up as a sophomore before winning the NCAA title in 2013. He put together five-straight wins to climb to the top of the 157-pound bracket and become the 52nd national champion in program history. His title is the 80th individual NCAA wrestling championship in school history.

Mark Perry was the last Hawkeye four-time All-American. He is also the last Iowa wrestler to win back-to-back NCAA championships. Perry won titles in 2007 and 2008.

TO FALL OR TO TECH FALL

Junior Mike Evans earned a team-high four technical falls to complement four pin this season.

The four pins surpass his season total from

a year ago, when he recorded two falls, and the four falls are one more than Derek St. John led the team with a year ago.

Evans opened the season in the starting lineup for the third straight year, but for the first time at 174 pounds. He recorded a 26-8 record at 165 as a freshman, and was 2-0 at 165 his sophomore season before bumping up a weight class. He was 21-7 at 174 in 2013, earning a Big Ten runner-up finish and his first All-America honor.

NO. 1 AT 184

Senior Ethen Lofthouse emerged from an all-Iowa final four to win the 184-pound bracket at the Luther Open on Nov. 16. Lofthouse defeated Jeremy Fahler, 4-0, in the semis and Sammy Brooks, 3-2, in the finals. Alex Meyer placed fourth.

Lofthouse is ranked No. 1 at 184 pounds by AWN. He reached the All-America stand for the second straight year last season, racing through seven ranked opponents en route to a fifth-place finish.

Lofthouse pinned each of his three opponents at the Iowa City Duals on Nov. 22 to raise his season total to five falls, one more than he had all of last season.

TELFORD RISES THROUGH FALLS

Junior Bobby Telford returned to action with a tournament title at the Luther Open on Nov. 16. Telford pinned all five opponents in his first appearance since leaving the 2013 NCAA Championships with a knee injury. He navigated the 285-pound bracket in a combined time of 7:32. He pinned his first four opponents in the opening minute before winning the championship finals with a second period fall (4:42).

Telford's five falls match his season total from a year ago. He now has 19 career pins.

LESS WAS MOORE AT IOWA CITY DUALS

Junior Nick Moore made his season debut at the Iowa City Duals on Nov. 22. Moore opened the season with a pair of first period falls.

Moore was 18-10 overall last season at 165, placing fourth at the Big Ten Championships and earning his first NCAA berth. He is currently ranked No. 8 at 165 pounds.

GILMAN GETS GOLD AT JOE PARISI OPEN

Thomas Gilman defeated Oklahoma State's Edward Klimara, 5-2, to win the 125-pound Gold Division title at the Joe Parisi Open on Saturday.

Gilman, a redshirt freshman, earned a spot in the finals by defeating another Cowboy, Austin Miller, 7-5, in the quarterfinals, and topping Missouri's Barlow McGhee, 3-1, in the semifinals. The tournament championship is Gilman's first this season, and the third of his career.

Redshirt freshman Sammy Brooks earned a pair of falls and an overtime victory before dropping a 2-1 decision in the 184-pound finals.

Redshirt freshman Topher Carton and sophomore Brody Grothus rebounded from a pair of quarterfinal defeats to win the consolation bracket of their respective weights. Carton recorded a pair of falls and a 5-1 mark to place third at 141 pounds. Grothus recorded three pins and a 6-1 mark to place third at 149.

Redshirt freshman Phillip Laux won the 125-pound title in the Black Division (freshmen/sophomores). Laux went 5-0 with three pins to improve to 9-0 this year.

48 FALLS AT LUTHER OPEN

Twenty-six Hawkeyes combined for 48 falls at the season-opening Luther Open on Nov. 16.

Bobby Telford led all Hawkeyes, pinning each of his five opponents en route to the 285-pound title.

Iowa swept 10 weight classes in the Elite Division and earned a pair of titles in the Freshman Division.

Iowa Elite champions included Cory Clark (125), Tony Ramos (133), Josh Dziejwa (141), Michael Kelly (149), Derek St. John (157), Walt Gillmor (165), Mike Evans (174), Ethen Lofthouse (184), Kris Klapprodt (197) and Telford.

Phillip Laux (125) and Broc Berge (197) both won titles in the Freshman Division.

NCAA EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeyes return seven wrestlers with NCAA Championships experience. Senior Derek St. John (157) is the defending national champion at 157 pounds and a three-time All-American. Seniors Ethen Lofthouse (184) and Tony Ramos (133) are three-time

NCAA qualifiers and two-time All-Americans. Juniors Mike Evans (174) and Bobby Telford (285) are two-time NCAA qualifiers. Telford earned All-America honors in 2012, while Evans earned All-America honors in 2013. Junior Nick Moore (165), and sophomore Nathan Burak (197) both qualified for their first NCAA Championships in 2013.

ATTENDANCE LEADERS AT IT AGAIN

The seventh-largest dual crowd in NCAA history saw Iowa defeat top-ranked Penn State on Friday, Feb. 1, 2013. The Hawkeyes drew a sellout crowd of 15,077, the sixth-largest wrestling crowd in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history.

In seven home dates last season, Iowa averaged 8,764 fans per dual. It marked the fifth straight year Iowa averaged over 8,000 fans, and the seventh straight season the Hawkeyes led the nation in attendance. The dual wrestling attendance record for Carver-Hawkeye Arena is 15,955, set when Iowa defeated Iowa State (20-15) on Dec. 6, 2008.

2013-14 SCHEDULE

Beginning with No. 15 Iowa State, 10 of Iowa's 17 dual opponents are ranked in the top 25 of the preseason NWCA/USA Today/AWN Division I Coaches Poll. They include Penn State (1), Minnesota (2), Oklahoma State (3), Edinboro (14), Nebraska (10), Iowa State (15), Northwestern (17), Purdue (20), Michigan (22), and Wisconsin (24). Iowa's schedule includes two regular season tournaments, 17 duals, eight home dates and two postseason events -- Big Ten Championships (Mar. 8-9), and NCAA Championships (Mar. 20-22).

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 929-222-31 (.799) in 103 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 52 NCAA Champions have won a total of 80 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 105 Big Ten champions have won a total of 190 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time and 28 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 148 All-Americans have earned All-America status 301 times, including 17 four-time, 32 three-time and 38 two-time honorees.

LAST TIME OUT (DEC. 1, 2012 -- IOWA CITY)

The Hawkeyes won nine of 10 matches to top Iowa State, 32-3, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa scored bonus points in five matches and won all four contests against ranked opponents.

The 29-point victory was the largest margin of victory in the series since Iowa won 33-4 in 1996. The Hawkeyes (6-0) scored 33 takedowns to Iowa State's three.

ALL-AMERICAN STREAK

The Hawkeyes have crowned at least one All-American every year since 1972, a span of 42 seasons. Iowa has totaled 255 All-America honors during that stretch. The Hawkeyes return five All-Americans to this year's squad. Tony Ramos (2nd-133), Derek St. John (1st-157), Mike Evans (6th-174) and Ethen Lofthouse (5th-184) join 2012 All-American Bobby Telford (5th-285) in the 2013-14 lineup.

40 YEARS OF DOMINANCE

Since 1974, only seven schools have captured the NCAA Championship. During that 40-year span, the Hawkeyes have won 23 team titles, including nine straight from 1978-86. The other schools include Oklahoma State (7), Minnesota (3), Penn State (3), Iowa State (2), Arizona State (1) and Oklahoma (1).

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

Iowa finished the 2012-13 home schedule with a 9-0 record inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,077). The perfect record marked Iowa's 20th undefeated season at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since moving from the UI Fieldhouse in 1983. Iowa has a 205-19 (.915) all-time record in the arena. The Hawkeyes have also won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

TICKET INFORMATION

Season and single-meet tickets are now available for purchase on hawkeyesports.com. Season tickets for Iowa's remaining home duals (not including the Penn State dual) are available for \$85. Single-meet tickets for Buffalo (12/12), Michigan State (1/4), Indiana (1/12) and Michigan (2/9) are \$12 for adults and \$8 for youth. Single-meet tickets to Penn State (12/21), Oklahoma State (1/10) and Minnesota (1/25) are \$15 for adults and \$8 for youth. Kids five-years old and younger are admitted free to all wrestling events, but everyone entering the arena must have a ticket.

HAWKEYES EARN 2012-13 BIG DUAL TITLE

Iowa captured its fifth Big Ten regular season title in the last six years when it defeated Nebraska, 31-7, Feb. 10 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The perfect conference record marked the fifth time in six seasons the Hawkeyes finished the Big Ten regular season with an undefeated mark.



The Cy-Hawk Series is in its tenth season in 2013-14, being sponsored for the third time by Iowa Corn.

Iowa State currently leads the series, 6-5, after finishing ahead of Iowa in both men's and women's cross country at NCAA Regionals last week. The Cyclones also registered a 3-1 win in volleyball earlier this fall. Iowa has posted victories in women's soccer (3-0) and football (27-21). The Hawkeyes' win in women's soccer was worth two points, while Iowa was rewarded with three points for its win in football.

Iowa leads the all-time series, 5-4, after capturing the Cy-Hawk Series a year ago by a 17-9 margin. Iowa also captured the inaugural Cy-Hawk Series in 2004-05 (13-8), and won again in 2006-07 (13-8), 2008-09 (21-4) and 2010-11 (15-11). Iowa State won the competition in 2005-06 (13-8), 2007-08 (18-9), 2009-10 (16-11), and 2011-12 (18-12).

The 12-event series awards two points (except football, which is worth three) to the winning school in each head-to-head match-up between the two institutions. Additionally, one point is awarded to an institution if the graduation rate of its student-athletes is greater than the national average as reported each fall by the NCAA.

A commemorative Cy-Hawk Series Cup, which stands 31 inches tall and weighs 19 pounds, is displayed on the winning team's campus for an entire year after a victory. Replica cups are also presented as "traveling trophies" for individual victorious teams in the head-to-head competition.

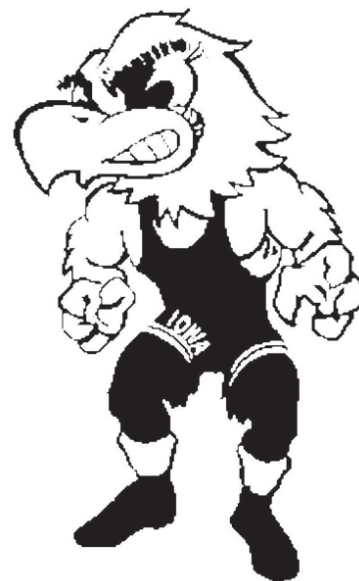

Tom Brands
Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 134-13-1 (.909) overall and 51-5 (.911) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 151-32-1 (.820) career mark.

In seven seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning eight NCAA champions, 10 Big Ten champions and 38 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 53 academic all-Big Ten honorees, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 62 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last seven years, sending the entire 10-man

lineup in 2009-10. Iowa has also won five of the last six Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, Iowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when it hosted Iowa State Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The previous record of 15,646 was set Feb. 1, 2002, when Minnesota hosted Iowa at the Target Center in Minneapolis. The Hawkeyes won the Iowa State dual, 20-15. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' six seasons, setting a NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
