Scouting Minnesota • The Minnesota Golden Gophers are 12-10 overall and one of six teams tied for fifth in the Big Ten with a 5-7 record.

Jessy Jones ranks fourth in the Big Ten in blocks with 1.57 per game (107 total). Christine Tan is averaging 4.62 digs per game, which ranks fifth in the conference. Rachel Hartmann's 11.9 blocks per game (928 total) is seventh-best in the conference.

The Golden Gophers are coached by Mike Hebert. Iowa trails in the all-time series, 50-12.

Last Meeting • Sophomore **Megan Schipper's** return from an injury wasn't enough as Minnesota defeated lowa, 3-0 September 26.

Schipper led the team with 11 kills while junior Laura Kremer had 10 kills along with three total blocks. Freshman Katie Kennedy also had three total blocks while junior Kiley Fister added a teamhigh 32 assists.

Kremer Impressive Against Penn State • Junior Laura Kremer had a team-high seven kills along with a solid .400 hitting percentage against then-ranked No. 2 Penn State Saturday night.

The match marked the third time this season Kremer has hit .400 or better (.722 vs. Saint Francis, .417 vs. Northern Colorado).

Schipper on the Road • Sophomore **Megan Schipper** doesn't mind being away from Carver-Hawkeye Arena. In 21 road matches, Schipper leads the team with 73 kills (3.48 kills per game) along with a .305 hitting percentage.

The Aplington, IA, native also has recorded 19 of her 52 blocks on the road.

Attacking Story • The Hawkeyes are 4-0 this season when they record more kills than their opponent. In contrast, lowa is 0-13 when their opponents tally a higher hitting percentage and 5-14 if the opposition has more kills.

Iron Women • Juniors Laura Kremerland Emily Hiza have each started and played in all 23 matches and 84 games this season.

Freshman **Aimee Huffman** has started all 23 matches while playing in 82 of the 84 games. Freshman **Megan Eskew** has also played in all 23 matches and 83 of the 84 games this season. Junior **Kiley Fister** and sophomore **Christina Meister** have also played in all 23 matches.

Hawkeyes on the Block • lowa has out-blocked 14 of its 23 opponents this season, including five of the last nine teams. Five of the 14 opponents were also ranked (BYU, LSU, Michigan, Penn State and Wisconsin).

Junior Laura Kremer leads the blocking attack with 113 total blocks (22 solo, 91 assists, 1.35 blocks per game). Freshman Aimee Huffman has 77 total blocks while sophomore Megan Schipper has 52.

Hawkeyes In Big Ten Stats • Juniors Laura Kremer, Emily Hiza and Kiley Fister each rank in the top 10 of different Big Ten statistical categories.

Kremer is averaging 1.35 blocks per game (113 total), which is sixth-best in the conference. Hiza is seventh in the Big Ten in digs with 4.54 per game (381 total).

In Big Ten games only, Hiza ranks fifth in digs with 4.86 per game (204 total). Kremer is eighth in blocks with 1.33 per game (56 total), while Fister is ninth in assists with 9.57 per game (402 total).

Climbing the Records Ladder • Juniors **Emily Hiza** and **Kiley Fister** are making their mark on the lowa volleyball records books.

Fister ranks fifth in career assists (3,145). She needs only eight more assists to move past Barb Zvonek, who is currently fourth (3,153).

Hiza started the season ranked 12th in career digs, but has tallied 381 so far in 2007 to move her into fourth place (1,398). She needs 138 more digs to pass Pam Kavadas, who is in third place (1,536).

Reunion in Minneapolis • lowa junior **Catherine Smale** and Minnesota junior Rachel Hartmann are both from St. Charles, IL and attended Rosary High School. They helped Rosary win its first ever conference championship as seniors en route to a No. 42 national ranking. Smale holds three school records while Hartmann holds one.



Head Coach Cindy Fredrick



Cindy Fredrick is in her fourth season as head coach of the lowa volleyball team.

The Hawkeyes have improved in every facet of the game since Fredrick arrived in 2004. In the first year of the Fredrick Era, the Hawkeyes began laying the foundation of a successful program. The team not only improved both their overall and Big Ten Conference record, but became more competitive in every aspect in the game. The coaching staff

worked hard to instill a new winning attitude in the team, which helped the Hawkeyes to an 8-3 start.

The Hawkeyes continued to make strides in 2005 recording more wins (14), Big Ten wins (4), kills (1,709), assists (1,527), service aces (161) and blocks (252) than Fredrick's first year. There were plenty of highlights on the year, including an 11-4 start and the team's first win over in-state rival Northern Iowa in 16 years.

Individually, Fredrick guided Catherine Smale to a spot on the Big Ten all-Freshman team in 2005 – the first Hawkeye to earn that honor. The coaching staff also made great strides in recruiting, pulling in the 30th-ranked class in the nation according to prepvolleyball.com.

The Hawkeyes broke two school attendance records during the 2006 season. Iowa averaged 1,008 fans, which broke the single-season average attendance record. Fredrick and her Hawkeyes also drew 1,690 fans to the Iowa State match, which shattered the single-match attendance school record. Fredrick and the Hawkeyes won 11 of their first 12 matches, including nine in a row.

Turning mediocre volleyball programs into winning programs has been a big part of Fredrick's past, most recently as head coach at Washington State University. During her 15 year tenure at Washington State, Fredrick earned more wins than any coach of a women's sport with a 278-192 record and in seven seasons she had 20 or more wins. In 1995, after guiding her squad to a national ranking of fifth, the highest rank of any men's or women's team in school history, she was named Pac-10 and AVCA District VIII Coach of the Year. Fredrick also led the Cougars to ten NCAA tournament appearances, including two Elite Eight finishes and one Sweet 16 berth. In 1992 her squad was the NIVC Champions. In the 2002 NCAA tournament, the Cougars posted a 3-0 victory over Northern lowa to advance to the Elight Eight.

Prior to coaching at Washington State, Fredrick coached at Weber State (Ogden, UT). When Fredrick first took over the Wildcat program in 1985, she led her team to a sixth place finish in the Mountain West Conference. By the time she left after the 1988 season, her team had finished first in the Big Sky Conference, earned an NCAA tournament birth and Fredrick was named Big Sky Coach of the Year. Fredrick also guided Mt. Vernon, IA, native Kim Benesh to Big Sky Player of the Year honors. She left Weber State with a benchmark 86-60 record in four seasons.

Fredrick's volleyball ties to the state of lowa run deeper than just the University of lowa. Fredrick began her coaching career as the head coach at Davenport Central High School from 1974-82. In 1981, she led her squad to a 33-0 season record and a state championship. From 1983-1985 she was head coach of the USVA Junior Development team in eastern lowa that won four state Midwest championships. In the summer of 1985, Fredrick was named head coach for the United States Volleyball Association team for the state of lowa that competed throughout Canada.

It's Been a While • lowa's win over No. 11 Michigan was the program's first win over a ranked opponent since 2000. The Hawkeyes defeated No. 20 Michigan State, 3-2 on October 21, 2000. Iowa came back from a two-game deficit to defeat Michigan State, 3-2 as well.

Record Setting Night • lowa shattered the single-game attendance record with 2,191 fans against Wisconsin October 13. The previous record of 1,690 fans was set last season against lowa State.

Filling the Seats at North-Carver • The Hawkeyes have had three record crowds this season at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Below is the list of the top 10 crowds in lowa volleyball history.

lowa Ranks High in Attendance • lowa's average home attendance of 1,099 fans is the 34th-highest average attendance in the nation. In addition, lowa's record crowd of 2,191 fans against Wisconsin is the 105th-largest crowd in the country so far in 2007.

Walters Undergoes Surgery • Redshirt freshman **Becky Walters** underwent successful surgery to repair her injured knee, October 4.

Walters will miss the rest of the 2007 season after suffering a serious knee injury in Iowa's match against Indiana, September 21.

Walters was leading the team with a .265 hitting percentage and also had 113 kills along with 52 total blocks (10 solo, 42 assists).

Prep All-Americans • Two of lowa's freshmen were named PrepVolleyball.com high school all-Americans. **Katie Kennedy** and **Aimee Huffman** both were named all-Americans before coming to lowa.

Ohio State Tops Iowa • The Buckeyes defeated Iowa, 3-0 (15-30, 28-30, 29-31) Friday night in Iowa City.

Sophomore **Megan Schipper** finished with 13 kills to lead the Hawkeye attack. Junior **Laura Kremer** added 10 kills while both players tallied three total blocks.

Ohio State out-blocked the Hawkeyes, 7.5-1 in game one to gain an early advantage. The Buckeyes never trailed in the first game, jumping out to a 10-3 lead. Ohio State stretched its lead to 19-10 and finished the game on an 11-5 run for the win.

The Hawkeyes recorded 16 kills to Ohio State's 15 in game two, but couldn't push ahead for the win. Schipper recorded six kills while Kremer added five in game two.

The Buckeyes led for the majority of game three, but lowa fought to make things interesting. Freshman **Megan Eskew** recorded one of her two kills to even the game at nine, but Ohio State answered with a 7-0 run for a 16-9 advantage. Iowa chipped away at the Buckeye lead, using another Fister ace for a 27-26 score. The Buckeyes then took a two-point lead before a **Stacy Vitali** kill made the count 28-27. A Buckeye kill brought up match point at 29-27, but two Ohio State hitting errors tied the game again, this time at 29. Ohio State replied with two-straight kills to end the match.

Penn State Downs Hawkeyes • Then No. 2 Penn State handed Iowa a 3-0 loss (15-30, 28-30, 29-31) Saturday night in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Junior Catherine Smale led lowa with nine kills. Junior Laura Kremer added seven kills with an impressive .400 hitting percentage. Junior Kiley Fister chipped in 23 assists and three block assists while freshman Aimee Huffman had seven kills and three block assists.

Penn State set the tone in game one, hitting at a .500 clip en route to a 30-15 win. Iowa took its only lead of the game off a Penn State service error at 3-2, but the Nittany Lions forced ties at four, five and six before taking the lead for good at 8-7. Penn State followed with a 13-4 run to put the game out of reach.

The Nittany Lions followed with a 30-23 win in game two. The Hawkeyes forced a tie at one point each, but couldn't get any closer. Penn State stretched its lead to 17-10 later, but a 10-6 Hawkeye run brought the lowa within three at 23-20. Penn State responded with 7-3 surge to close out the game.

lowa fought back from an early 3-1 deficit in the third game to force a tie at five off a Penn State error. A Kremer kill knotted the score at six, and two-straight Nittany Lion errors gave the Hawkeyes an 8-6 lead. Another Kremer kill later in the game gave lowa a 10-8 advantage, but Penn State forced ties at 10, 12, 15 and 18 before taking a 19-18 lead they never relinquished. Penn State held on for a 30-25 win to seal the match.
