LEADING OFF

 The University of Toledo begins its 94th baseball season this weekend at the Sunshine State Series in Kissimmee, Fla. with games against lowa, Saint Louis, and Pittsburgh.

• The Rockets return 19 letterwinners and eight position player starters in 2018.

 Under head coach Corv Mee. UT is 0-1 against lowa and 1-6 against Pittsburgh. His teams have never faced St. Louis.

YEAR IN REVIEW

 Toledo finished the 2017 season with a record of 17-41 and a 9-15 mark in Mid-American Conference play. The Rockets played a tough non-conference slate, featuring 10 games against NCAA Tournament gualifiers. They clinched a MAC Tournament berth with a 6-5 win over Eastern Michigan in the final regular-season game of the season.

• In many areas, 2017 saw the best offensive season for Toledo since 2010. The Rockets hit 39 home runs, 19 triples, and 101 doubles, all of which were the most since 2010. UT's slugging percentage was .377, and its 748 total bases were also the most since 2010.

• Toledo hit .248 as a team and scored 278 runs. Riley Campbell led the team with a .284 batting average. Ross Adolph, Dalton Bollinger, and AJ Montoya each hit seven home runs to lead the Rockets, while Bollinger's 28 extra-base hits were a team high. He and Montoya led the Midnight Blue and Gold with 40 RBIs. Matt Hansen, who hit in the top third of the order 51 times last season, led UT with 44 runs scored.

 The Rockets tied a school record with 19 triples last season, matching the 1988 squad. UT led the MAC and was 31st in the country in triples; individually, Ross Adolph led the team with six, tied for second-most in a single season in school history.

• Toledo pitchers posted a 6.20 ERA to go along with 357 strikeouts and 329 walks. The ERA dropped by nearly a full run in MAC games to 5.26.

 Rocket pitchers recorded at least 10 strikeouts nine times, including a season-high 16 at USF on March 3. They punched out at least 10 opposing batters twice in the same series three times: at USF, at Bowling Green, and at Kent State.

• Pitcher Ross Achter (graduated) was named a second-team All-MAC performer and AJ Montoya earned MAC West Player of the Week honors twice.

SAME FACE, NEW PLACE

A couple Rockets will be seeing time at new positions in 2018. Michael Jacob, UT's closer the last two seasons, will move into the weekend rotation with the expectation of being the Friday starter. Riley Campbell, Toledo's primary third baseman in 2017, will make the move across the diamond to be the team's starting second baseman.

ON THE DOCKET

Toledo's 2018 schedule features several notable dates, including 21 home games, eight against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams, and a mid-week contest at Comerica Park, home of the Detroit Tigers.

FROM ONE EXTREME TO THE OTHER

Toledo played 15 one-run ballgames in 2017, earning a record of 7-8, including 2-3 in extra inning affairs. On the other end of the spectrum, the Rockets played 24 games decided by five or more runs.

20/20

Last year, for The first time since 2010, Toledo scored 20 runs in a game two times in one season. The Rockets defeated Bowling Green, 20-4, in the second game of a doubleheader on April 8 and, one week later, beat Buffalo, 21-20, in a slugfest for the ages.

WELCOME BACK

After spending a year at Norfolk State as the team's director of player development, Ryan Chipka is back at Toledo as an assistant coach. He spent 2016 with the Rockets as well.

NEWCOMERS

Toledo has 12 newcomers on its roster this season: freshmen Kyle Bischoff, Alec Bukowski, Andrew Compton, Bryce Davis, Trace Hatfield, David Jeffers, Chris Meyers, Zach Schwartzenberger, John Servello, and Jacob Youngpeter are joined by junior college transfers Axel Bueter and Billy Todorowski.

MAC PRESEASON POLL

Toledo was picked eighth in the Mid-American Conference preseason poll. Kent State was picked to finish first and received eight first-place votes, with Miami (Ohio) and Northern Illinois receiving the other two first-place votes.


