SCOUTING WILLIAM & MARY

The William and Mary Tribe are 2-1 this season. In its last game (Sunday), William & Mary rallied from a 23-point first half deficit to defeat Davidson, 74-63 at home. Janine Aldridge scored a game-high 18 points (12 in the second half), along with six steals. Sophomores Katherine DeHenzel and Taysha Pye scored 16 points, while freshman Jaclyn McKenna had 12 points and eight rebounds.

McKenna leads William & Mary with 13.3 points per game. Emily Correal is averaging a double-double, at 10 points and 12.7 rebounds per contest.

Debbie Taylor is in her 11th season as a head coach, and owns a 113-179 record. All of her head coaching experience is at William & Mary.

HAWKEYES RALLY FOR WIN AT NORTHERN IOWA

Iowa used stellar second half shooting to rally past Northern Iowa (Sunday), 81-70 at the McLeod Center. The Hawkeyes shot .556 (15-27) in the second half, including .571 (4-7) from three-point and .938 (15-16) from the free throw line.

Trailing 43-40 with 14:49 left in the game, the Hawkeyes used an 11-0 run to take a 51-44 lead at the 12:22 mark. Northern Iowa fought back to within three (53-50) with 8:33 left, but precise free throw shooting down the stretch gave lowa the win.

The Hawkeyes trailed by as many as seven, but still managed to win. The game saw six ties and two lead changes.

CAREER DAY FOR WAHLIN

Sophomore Kamille Wahlin poured in a career-high 33 points against Northern Iowa. She also notched career-highs in field goals made (11) and attempted (19), three-pointers made (6) and attempted (10) and free throws made (5) and attempted (6). Her five five threepointers were just one shy of the school record.

Wahlin led Iowa's second-half comeback with 21 points on 6-10 shooting, including 4-5 from three point range and all five free throws in the final half.

Wahlin leads the Big Ten in three-pointers made per game (3), ranks second in average minutes played (35.5) and sixth in scoring (17.5).

JOHNSON TIES SCHOOL RECORD

Freshman Morgan Johnson tied a school record with seven blocked shots against Northern Iowa Sunday. Johnson now holds the record with Jerica Watson (vs. Kent State, 12/8/01) and Tangela Smith (at Michigan State, 1/15/95). She currently ranks third in the Big Ten in blocks per game (2.75).

Johnson added 11 points and eight rebounds in the win.

IOWA VS. UNI TIP-INS

• Freshmen Theairra Taylor (fractured eye socket) and Gabby Machado (sprained ankle) both returned to action Sunday after being sidelined with injuries. Taylor finished with 12 points, seven rebounds and two steals in 24 minutes of action. She had eight points in the final two minutes. Machado played three minutes and finished with two points.

• Three of Iowa's four leading scorers were freshmen, including Jaime Printy (12), Theairra Taylor (12) and Morgan Johnson (11).

• Iowa shot a season-high .519 (28-54) from the field, .471 (8-17) from three-point and .810 (17-21) from the free throw line.

• The Hawkeyes had four players log at least 30 minutes. Kamille Wahlin played all 40 minutes, while Kelly Krei and Jaime Printy played 32. Morgan Johnson saw 31 minutes of action.

INJURY UPDATE

Senior JoAnn Hamlin is out indefinitely after having a blood clot removed from her right leg.

Junior Kachine Alexander is expected to miss one month with a stress fracture in her right leg.

Sophomore Hannah Draxten will be sidelined for approximately one more week with a herniated disc in her back.

Sophomore Shante Jones is questionable for Tuesday's game with a foot injury.

ALEXANDER'S NUMBERS WILL BE MISSED

Junior Kachine Alexander had a solid start to the season. Alexander has recorded a double-double in each of Iowa's first three games, and was averaging 21 points and 15.7 rebounds, before suffering a stress fracture in her right leg.

Alexander currently leads the Big Ten in rebounding (15.7) and offensive rebounds (8.3). She also ranks second in scoring (21) and defensive rebounds (7.3), third in minutes played (34.6) and fifth in assists (4.3).

FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET

Freshman Jaime Printy has been everywhere for the Hawkeyes.

Printy has started all four games, and has registered at least five rebounds and three assists in each game.

She grabbed five rebounds and dished out six assists against Santa Clara, and followed with a 16 point, seven rebound and four assist effort against Illinois State.

Printy netted five points, six rebounds, five assists and two steals against Kansas.

Sunday at Northern Iowa, Printy added 12 points, five rebounds and three assists.

Printy leads the team and ranks fourth in Big Ten assists (4.5). She is the team's third-leading rebounder (23) and fourth -leading scorer (8.8).

UNDERCLASSMEN CONTRIBUTING

Iowa's freshmen and sophomore class are putting up big numbers for the Hawkeyes this season.

Hawkeye underclassmen are responsible for 78 percent of the minutes played, 76 percent of the blocks, 73 percent of the points, 72 percent of the steals, 64 percent of the assists and 56 percent of the rebounds.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 10th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 26th season as a college head coach. She is a two-time Big Ten and WBCA Regional Coach of the Year, most recently earning honors a year ago in 2007-08.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 528-252 (.677), including a 172-110 (.610) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark



(1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose. Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to six post-season tournaments (4 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and six upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

Junior Kelsey Cermak earned her first career start at Northern Iowa, and played the small forward position. Cermak has tradionally been a post player.

Freshman Trisha Nesbitt, who has been a point guard during her entire basketball career, saw 19 minutes of action as Iowa's shooting guard.

ALEXANDER NAMED CO-BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week Nov. 16 after earning MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander recorded double-doubles in each of Iowa's first two games. She tied a Hawkeye Challenge tournament record by grabbing 18 rebounds (nine offensive, nine defensive), along with netting 19 points in Iowa's season-opening win over Santa Clara. Both her 19 points and 18 rebounds were game highs.

Alexander followed on Sunday with a 21 point, 12 rebound (nine offensive, three defensive) performance in the championship game against Illinois State. Alexander was clutch down the stretch at the free-throw line, making 13-16 attempts from the charity stripe.

WAHLIN LANDS ON ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Sophomore Kamille Wahlin was named to the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge all-tournament team after two solid performances to open the season.

Against Santa Clara, Wahlin netted 13 points and added three rebounds.

Wahlin was clutch down the stretch in the championship against Illinois State, scoring seven points during lowa's crucial 12-2 run in the final three minutes of the second half to give the Hawkeyes the victory. Wahlin drained a three-pointer with 3:46 left to give lowa a one-point lead at 64-63. She then hit a jumper with 37 second left, extending lowa's lead to five points at 70-65. Wahlin added two free throws on the next trip down the court to seal the win.

PRESEASON RANKINGS

Iowa was picked to finish fifth in the Big Ten by both the league coaches and media. Ohio State was tabbed as the favorite to win the Big Ten, with Michigan State coming in second.

LOOKING AT THE ROSTER

The Hawkeyes return two full-time starters, one part-time starter and a total of seven letterwinners from last year's squad.

lowa returns 43.7% of its scoring and 56.4% of its rebounding from a year ago. The Hawkeyes also return 57% of their assists, 52.5% of their steals and 50.3% of their minutes played from the 2008-09 season.

WELCOME TO IOWA CITY

The Hawkeyes welcome five freshmen to the squad this season, one at each position.

Trisha Nesbitt (Ames, IA), will most likely play point guard for Iowa this season. She was a three-time all-conference and two-time first team all-district and all-state selection.

Jaime Printy (Marion, IA) could play both guard positions. She became the youngest player (15) ever to verbally commit to the Iowa Women's Basketball team. She also played high school basketball at Coach Bluder's alma mater (Linn-Mar). She was a three-time consensus first team all-state, all-district, all-metro and all-conference pick.

Theairra Taylor (St. Paul, MN) is a 5-11 guard. She was a finalist for 2009 Miss Minnesota Basketball award and was the 2009 St. Paul City Conference Player of the Year. Taylor also earned Associated Press and Pioneer Press first team all-state honors.

Gabby Machado (Pontiac, MI) ranked in the Top 10 in the state of Michigan's 2009 recruiting class. She was a Detroit News Class "A" all-state honorable mention selection.

Morgan Johnson (Platte County, MO) was the Miss Show Me Basketball Award winner, given to the top prep senior in the state of Missouri. She was also named the 2009 Direnna Award winner, given to top prep in the Kansas City Area, and the Kansas City Star Scholar Athlete of the Year.

Hawkeyes Ink Talented Recruit

Jade Rogers has signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa next fall.

"We are eager to have Jade Rogers join our team," Bluder said. "Jade is a tremendous kid that loves the game, and has grown up as a Hawkeye fan. Jade will be a versatile player that can play a number of positions. She can post up or she can shoot the long ball. She is also a good rebounder. Jade has had a great career at Cedar Rapids Kennedy, and is looking forward to continuing her career as a Hawkeye."

Rogers, a 5-11 forward, is from nearby Hiawatha, IA, and attends Cedar Rapids Kennedy High School. She led the state in scoring (22.3) and rebounding (13.4) as a sophomore, and was named the Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Year. She also earned first team all-state, all-district, all-metro and all-conference honors.

Rogers suffered an ACL injury during the summer of the 2008, but returned to the court and helped lead Kennedy to the semifinal round of the state tournament. Rogers played in 17 games as a junior and averaged 17.9 points and 10.6 rebounds. She was named first team all-state, alldistrict, all-metro and all-conference, along with being named to the state tournament all-tournament team.

As a freshman, Rogers earned second team all-state honors, along with first team all-district, all-metro and all-conference recognition.

Rogers currently has 1,089 points (18.5 per game average), which is fourth on the all-time scoring list at Kennedy. She also holds school records for single-game rebounds (20), single-season rebounds per game (12.6) and is on pace to become Kennedy's career rebounding leader. Rogers is also a three-time team captain.

Rogers has also lettered in volleyball. She helped lead the Kennedy volleyball team to a state tournament appearance this year.


