The University of Iowa women's gymnastics team gears up for two meets in four days. The GymHawks hit the road for a Big Ten Conference matchup at Michigan State on Jan. 15 at 6 p.m. (CT) inside the Jenison Field House, before returning home to host Denver on Jan. 18 at 2 p.m. inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

LAST TIME OUT:

Nine season bests led the GymHawks past Northern Illinois, 194.500-192.825, in home opening action on Jan. 9. Leading the pack was junior Mollie Drenth with a pair of bests on floor (9.825) and beam (9.875). Registering her own pair of career bests was junior Angel Metcalf, posting scores of 9.800 and 9.850 on floor and beam, respectively. Rounding out the season best list were senior Alie Glover, sophomores Ashley Fischer, Lanie Snyder, Melissa Zurawski and freshman Rose Piorkowski.

SCOUTING THE SPARTANS:

- Michigan State dropped its 2016 season opener 195.700-193.775 at No. 18 Arizona on Jan. 8.
- •The Spartans finished the 2015 season with a 12-10 overall record and went 4-5 in Big Ten competition.
- MSU ranked seventh in the Big Ten and No. 26 in the nation in 2015.
- The Spartans return senior Lisa Burt and junior Elena Lagoski, who were both named First Team All- Big Ten in 2015.
- Burt led the Spartans in all-around competition last season, finishing 23rd in the nation. Lagoski earned eight floor crowns and placed among the top three in 10 regular season meets.
- Michigan State is led by head coach Kathie Klages, who is in her 25th season.

SCOUTING THE PIONEERS:

- The Pioneers finished the 2015 season at the NCAA Ames Regional, where they posted a 195.950 to finish third.
- Denver went 19-8-1 during the 2015 season.
- The Pioneers return senior Nina McGee -- a two-time All-American -- who finished tied for second on floor and No. 11 in the all-around at the 2015 NCAA National Championships. She also finished the season ranked No. 3 in the nation on floor and tied for No. 16 in the all-around.
- Denver is led by head coach Melissa Kutcher-Rinehart, who is in her 18th season.

HAWKEYE NEWCOMERS:

This season, the Hawkeyes welcome eight newcomers -- junior transfer Savannah Borman and freshmen Misty-Jade Carlson, Nicole Chow, Sydney Hogan, Maria Ortiz, Rose Piorkowski, Lexy Wadsworth and Tessa Walsh -- to the 2016 squad.

IOWA SELECTED TO HOST 2016 NCAA REGIONAL:

lowa and Carver-Hawkeye Arena have been selected to host 2016 NCAA Regional competition, beginning April 2 at 4 p.m. (CT). The Hawkeyes last hosted an NCAA Regional in 2009. lowa has been selected to compete in NCAA Regional competition in seven of the last eight seasons.

Fans can also visit their website at hexts.com/tickets or at NCAA.com/tickets or the day of the meet at the north, west and south entrances of Carver-Hawkeye Arena beginning at 3:00 p.m.

METCALF, DRENTH NAMED TO BIG WATCH LIST:

Angel Metcalf and Mollie Drenth were recognized on the 2016 Big Ten Gymnasts to Watch List on Dec. 10. Metcalf, who was featured on the 2014 Big Ten Watch List, registered lowa's individual season bests on beam (9.900 at No. 20 Ohio State, Jan. 24) and in the all-around (39.400 vs. No. 15 Illinois, Feb. 14) last season. She earned fourth on floor (9.900), 19th in the all-around (38.575) and 26th place on bars (9.825) at the Big Ten Championships on March 21, and was named to the All-Championship Team for her efforts. She ended the season at the NCAA Auburn Regional on April 4 with a fifth place finish in the all-around (39.175) and 12th place result on bars (9.800).

Drenth, a 2015 Big Ten All-Championship Team member, competed in every meet last season and owns lowa's individual season best on uneven bars (9.925). Drenth earned the first Big Ten Event Specialist of the Week accolade of her career on March 16 after capturing an event title on bars (9.925) at the Big Five meet. Last season, the junior earned a second place finish on beam (9.900) and a ninth place finish on bars (9.775) at the Big Ten Championships on March 21. Drenth ended the season at the NCAA Auburn Regional where she earned ninth on bars (9.825) and eighth in the all-around (39.050).

SEASON TICKETS:

Fans that are interested in attending home meets at Carver-Hawkeye Arena should visit hawkeyesports.com or contact the UI Athletics Ticket Office at 1-800 IA-HAWKS. Season tickets are currently on sale for \$27 for adults. The season ticket package includes premium seating options and a sweatshirt. Fans purchasing season tickets will gain admission to five home competitions inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena, including two against Big Ten opponents (Ohio State, Nebraska) and a home finale against Towson. All youth, 18 and younger, and UI students are admitted free to all home matches.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The majority of GymHawks are underclassmen, with seven freshmen, six sophomores, six juniors, and three seniors on the roster.

HOLDING STEADY IN THE RANKINGS:

lowa was ranked in the top 25 for six consecutive weeks during the 2015 season. The GymHawks ended the season ranked No. 23 nationally, marking the program's first Top 25 ranking since 2012. There are 80 women's gymnastics teams in the nation. The GymHawks closed the season ranked 16th as a team on the uneven bars (49.175 average score) and 21st on beam (49.010).

FIVE GYMHAWKS NAMED TO ALL-CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM:

Five GymHawks received individual conference awards following the Big Ten Championship. Mollie Drenth, Alie Glover, Sydney Hoerr, and Angel Metcalf were all named to the All-Championship Team, while Opua Calucag collected the Sportsmanship Award. Iowa has only had one other gymnast named to the All-Championship Team (Emma Stevenson, 2012) in program history.

HEAD COACH LARISSA LIBBY:

Larissa Libby enters her 12th year as head coach, and 16th year overall, at the University of Iowa in 2015-16. In 2015, the GymHawks were selected for NCAA Regional competition, marking the program's seventh postseason berth in the last eight years. Five GymHawks placed in the top 15 for individual events, leading Iowa to a fifth place regional finish and a score of 194.475. Libby coached the GymHawks to a season high score of 196.500 at the Big Ten Championships — the team's best championship team result since 2010. Iowa's performance also marked the highest team score for the program at the Big Ten Championships since March 20, 2004.

Under Libby, Iowa was ranked in the top 25 for six consecutive weeks during the 2015 season. The GymHawks ended the season ranked No. 23 nationally, marking the program's first Top 25 ranking since 2012. Libby led sophomores Mollie Drenth and Angel Metcalf, junior Alie Glover, and senior Sydney Hoerr, to earn spots on the All-Championship Team. Libby is also responsible for the only other gymnast named to the All-Championship Team (Emma Stevenson, 2012) in program history.
