# **HEAD COACH TOM BRANDS**



Two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his fourth season as head wrestling coach at Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time all-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 72-6 overall and 21-3 Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and an 89-26 career mark.

In his third season with the Hawkeyes, Brands led Iowa to its second straight NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning five all-Americans and two Big Ten champions. The 2009 national title was the school's 22nd, and it was only the second time in school history Iowa won the NCAA title without an individual champion. Brands earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors after guiding Iowa to the school's 33rd conference team title. The Hawkeyes ended the 2008-09 season with a 24-0 record, going undefeated for the first time since 1999-2000. The Hawkeyes, who ended the season on a 38-dual match winning streak that dates back to the 2007-08 campaign, clinched the 2009 Big Ten regular season title with a perfect 8-0 mark in conference competition and won the 2008 Midlands team title.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 all-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time all-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

#### HAWKEYES TO HOLD ANNUAL YOUTH CLINIC SATURDAY

The Hawkeyes will hold their annual youth clinic Saturday from 5-6 p.m. in Carver-Hawkeye Arena prior to the lowa vs. Oklahoma State dual. Youth ages 7-13 are invited to participate in the free clinic, which will be conducted by members of the Hawkeye wrestling coaching staff.

The East Carver-Hawkeye Arena doors will open at 4:30 p.m. for participants and their families. Parents will be required to sign a medical release form for their child at the check-in table, or the child must bring the form with them to the arena and present it at the check-in table. Parents can print the release form online at **www.hawkeyesports.com** and fill it out in advance to speed up the process. The child will then be given a complimentary gold lowa wrestling t-shirt for their participation in the clinic.

Participants will receive a free ticket to the Oklahoma State dual. Parents and family members will be required to purchase a ticket at the athletic ticket office window.

#### BORSCHEL NAMED BIG TEN WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

Hawkeye 174-pounder Jay Borschel has been named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week. It is the first time the senior from Marion, IA has earned the honor in his Hawkeye career, and the second-straight week that a Hawkeye wrestler has earned the conference honor. Senior 149-pounder Brent Metcalf was named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week January 5.

Borschel, who is ranked first in the nation by *Amateur Wrestling News* and *W.I.N. Magazine*, and second by Intermat, picked up the honor after being named Division I Outstanding Wrestler at the 2010 NWCA/Cliff Keen National Duals in Cedar Falls, IA, last weekend. Borschel, who went 4-0 at the two-day tournament, helped the Hawkeyes win their third-straight and sixth overall National Duals tournament team title. Iowa joins Oklahoma State (2003-05) as the only schools to win three consecutive team titles in the tournament's 22-year history. He is only the second Hawkeye to earn the Division I Outstanding wrestler honor. Metcalf earned the award in 2008.

Borschel opened the tournament with a 10-7 win over #3 Stephen Dwyer of Nebraska and a 8-2 decision over #16 Nate Lee of Boise State. He posted one of Iowa's two major decisions in the championship semifinals over #13 Scott Glasser of Minnesota (11-3). He then scored the only team bonus points in Iowa's finals match with #2 Iowa State, beating #14 Duke Burk, 10-2. He is now 5-0 against Burk, and is undefeated at 17-0 (13-0 in duals) this season. Borschel has a career record of 79-10 at Iowa and is 17-2 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. He ranks first on the team in collegiate and dual winning percentage (1.000), and dual wins (13); and ranks second in dual meet team points scored (61), pins (7) and major decisions (5) this season.

#### **IOWA WINNING STREAKS**

The Hawkeyes have won their last 51 dual matches, which is a school record. The current streak started with a win over Cornell (32-3) on Jan. 12, 2008, which was the first match after lowa lost to Oklahoma State (19-14) on Jan. 5.

lowa has also won its last 20 duals at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. That streak, which ranks fourth in school history, started with a 27-13 win over Penn State on Jan. 20, 2008, which was also the first home match after the Jan. 5 loss to the Cowboys.

The Hawkeyes have won 36 consecutive duals on the road, which is also a school record. That streak started with a 20-13 win at Iowa State on Dec. 9, 2007.

#### **CONSTRUCTION ZONE**

Construction has officially begun on the Carver-Hawkeye Arena Renovation Project, which will result in some changes regarding parking and entrance to the arena for wrestling matches.

The North entrance will no longer be accessible from the outside of the facility. Fans can enter, and purchase tickets, at the West and South entrances. Arena doors will open 90 minutes before the meet. The East entrance will serve as the event pass gate. Fans can still purchase tickets to future events from the North ticket windows, but will only be able to access that location from inside the arena.

## **IOWA WRESTLING HISTORY**

lowa's overall dual meet record is 867-215-30 (.793) in 100 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 22 national titles and 33 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 49 NCAA champions have won a total of 57 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 14 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 101 Big Ten champions have won a total of 184 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time and 26 two-time lowa winners. Iowa's 138 all-Americans have earned all-America status 278 times, including 17 four-time, 27 three-time and 35 two-time honorees.

Media parking for all meets will be in Lot 40, which is located across Elliott Drive from Carver-Hawkeye Arena, on the building's southeast side. Throughout the season, fans are encouraged to use free parking near the arena at Lot #33 (East Dental Lot), Lot #43 (located west of Kinnick Stadium and the UI Recreating Buildling), and the Finkbine Commuter lot. Other free parking is available at Hancher Auditorium, the Hawkeye Commuter lot (which is located west of the UI Athletics Hall of Fame, Grant Field, UI Soccer Field and the Hawkeye Tennis and Recreation Complex), and the hard surfaced lots at the UI softball and outdoor track complexes. Parking is also available at the regular hourly parking rate in the Clock Tower (#3) and Field House (#4) ramps.

#### **OKLAHOMA STATE COWBOYS**

Oklahoma State is ranked fourth in the nation in the most recent NWCA/USA Today Division I Coaches Poll with a 8-0-1 record. The Cowboys posted wins over Arizona State (21-9), Minnesota (21-8), UC Davis (43-0) and Cal Poly (21-13), and scored a 16-16 tie with intra-state rival Oklahoma. Oklahoma State also won the Virginia Duals title last weekend with wins over Liberty (36-6), Clarion (42-6), Penn State (24-13) and Lehigh (30-6).

Head Coach John Smith is 289-42-5 in 19 years at Oklahoma State. A seventime Big 12 Coach of the Year, Smith is Oklahoma State's winningest wrestling coach. During his tenure, he has coached 23 individual NCAA champions, which leads all active collegiate head coaches. He is assisted by Oklahoma State alums Eric Guerrero (1999) and Tyrone Lewis (2004).

The Cowboys returns all-American Jared Rosholt (Hwt.) from the 2008-09 squad that went 15-7 and placed 16th at the NCAA Championships. Rosholt is ranked first in the nation by *Amateur Wrestling News* and Intermat, and second by *W.I.N. Magzine*. He has a 20-1 record this season, and is currently riding an 18-match winning streak.

Also leading the youthful Oklahoma State squad are sophomores Jamal Parks (141), Mike Benefiel (174) and Alan Gelogaev (197), and redshirt freshman Jordan Oliver (133). Parks is ranked fifth in the nation by *AWN* and Intermat, and seventh by *W.I.N.* with a 20-3 record, while Benefiel is ranked seventh by Intermat, 13th by *AWN* and 14th by *W.I.N.* at 24-1. Gelogaev is ranked sixth by *AWN* and seventh by Intermat and *W.I.N.* at 20-1, while Oliver is ranked sixth by *AWN* and Intermat, and ninth by *W.I.N.* with a 17-2 record. Junior Clayton Foster is ranked 12th by *W.I.N.* and 13th by *AWN* and Intermat at 184 with a 10-1 record, but has not seen much action since the beginning of December due to injury.

#### **THE SERIES**

Oklahoma State leads the series, 25-17-1, but lowa won the last meeting between the two teams - a 20-13 decision in Stillwater on Jan. 18, 2009. The series is tied 9-9 in matches wrestled in lowa City. The Cowboys have been victorious in their last four trips to lowa City (21-15 in 2002, 30-10 in 2004, 18-14 in 2006 and 19-14 in 2008). The last time lowa beat Oklahoma State in Carver-Hawkeye Arena was Feb. 4, 2000 (20-14).

Oklahoma State is one of five teams in Iowa's 108-opponent school history to hold a series edge. The other four are Kansas State (0-1-1), New York AC (0-1), Oklahoma (16-17) and Toledo (0-1).

#### LAST MEETING - IOWA 20, OKLAHOMA STATE 13

University of Iowa Head Wrestling Coach **Tom Brands** made his 50th win at Iowa extra sweet with a 20-13 victory at Oklahoma State Jan. 18, 2009, in Stillwater, OK. The win snapped the Cowboys' nine-match winning streak in the series and was Iowa's first in Stillwater since 1996. It was also Brands' first win over Oklahoma State since he took the Hawkeye helm. Iowa improved to 15-0 on the season, picking up its 29th straight win. Oklahoma State fell to 11-4 with the loss.

The Cowboys put the first points on the board at 125 with senior Obenson Blanc's 6-2 win over Hawkeye redshirt freshman J.J. Krutsinger. Krutsinger was wrestling for injured Hawkeye starter **Charlie Falck**. Iowa rolled off wins at the next three weights to take an 11-3 lead and never looked back. Iowa junior **Daniel Dennis** started the streak at 133 with a 3-2 win over junior Chris Notte. Hawkeye senior **Alex Tsirtsis** posted his 85th career victory with a 4-1 victory over redshirt freshman Jamal Parks. Iowa junior **Brent Metcalf** posted his 52nd straight win with a 23-6 technical fall in 5:47 over Luke Silver at 149.

Oklahoma State won a decision at 157 when sophomore Neil Erisman posted a 4-1 victory over Hawkeye sophomore **Matt Ballweg**, but three lowa juniors followed with decisions to seal the team win. At 165, **Ryan Morningstar** scored nearfall points in the second period to beat Shenandoah, IA, native Brandon Mason, 3-1. **Jay Borschel** fought off a last second takedown attempt by Cowboy senior Newly McSpadden to post a 3-2 win at 174. **Phillip Keddy** posted his fifth straight win with a 12-7 decision over sophomore Cody Hill at 184 to remain undefeated.

The Cowboys won the final two bouts, but it wasn't enough for the team win. Senior Clayton Foster scored a 9-1 major decision over Hawkeye redshirt freshman **Brodie Ambrose**, who was wrestling for injured starter **Chad Beatty**, at 197. Hawkeye heavyweight **Dan Erekson** put up a fight against top-ranked Jared Rosholt in the final match, but lost 9-5.

#### **CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA**

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has been the home of Iowa wrestling since 1983. The Hawkeyes are 175-18 (.907) in the arena, which includes a record 10 victories during the 1986 season. Iowa has recorded 17 undefeated seasons in the arena, with the most recent (7-0) occurring in 2008-09. The dual wrestling attendance record for Carver-Hawkeye Arena is 15,955, set when Iowa defeated Iowa State (20-15) on December 6, 2008. The arena seats 15,500 for a dual wrestling meet.

### **IOWA WINS THIRD STRAIGHT NATIONAL DUALS TITLE**

The Hawkeyes won their third straight NWCA/Cliff Keen National Duals team title Jan. 10 with a 19-12 win over #2 lowa State in the championships. Iowa is only the second school in the tournament's 22-year history to win three straight team titles. Oklahoma State also won three straight from 2003-05. Hawkeye senior 174-pounder Jay Borschel was named Division I Outstanding Wrestler for the tournament. Borschel and Iowa senior 149-pounder Brent Metcalf (2008) are the only two Hawkeyes to earn the Outstanding Wrestler honor.

lowa improved to 13-0 and extended its dual winning streak to 51 matches, while posting a 28-12 record at the two-day tournament. Iowa beat #15 Nebraska (33-3) in the opening round, #9 Boise State (20-12) in quarterfinals and #6 Minnesota (28-12) in the semifinals. The Hawkeyes have won a total of six National Duals titles (1992, 1995, 1996, 2008, 2009, 2010).

Four Hawkeyes went undefeated during the two-day tournament. Metcalf recorded a forfeit, pin, major decision and decision, while Borschel scored two major decisions and two decisions. Senior **Ryan Morningstar** (165) scored a technical fall, major decision and two decisions, while redshirt freshman **Matt McDonough** (125) posted two major decisions and two decisions.
