Post game comments by Minnesota Coach Joe Salem:

"The key factor in the game was turnovers. We didn't give them up the way Iowa has been getting them in the past. But then, we worked quite a bit on that part of the game -- not fumbling -- this past week."

"Early in the second half, just after we had scored to make it 17-7, we got the turnover (intercepted pass by Mike Robb) and then bombed 'em (57-yard touchdown pass from Mark Carlson to Elmer Bailey). The game was over at that point."

"Have we passed better than we did today? Yes, I think we got considerable more yardage last week, but it took us 51 passes to do it. I'm not sure what our percentage was today? 14 of 17? We were that hot? Yes, you're right, that's pretty effective passing."

"I felt our defense showed well today, but there again they were not taxed a great deal because we usually had fairly good field position and didn't have them (Minnesota defenders) out on the field for extended periods of time."

Post game comments by Iowa Coach Hayden Fry:

"It's certainly apparent that we didn't play well enough today to win. The team was poorly coached, and we'll take the blame for that. We didn't tackle well in the second half, and we didn't defend well against the pass. I wish I was a genius. I wish I could figure out what we did wrong, but the better team won and won convincingly."

"We just didn't do a smooth job of executing. We did a terrible job of coaching. Bohannon was very inconsistent. He did some thing very well, and he made some mistakes. We tried everything. We just played a real poor ball game."

"The offense aimed at John Harty's position. They didn't make any big, sustained drives on us. We had some fine moments, but overall I thought it was a terrible ball game on our part. We lost by our biggest margin. I don't know whether we'll roll over and play dead or what. We've had three more key injuries." (Bohannon injured his arm and shoulder and was dizzy. McKillip has a hip pointer and a deep thigh bruise. Fry would not say name the third player who was injured.)

"The kids did the best they could, but they just weren't that sharp. We didn't do a good job of coaching. I don't think our club will quit. We have to be careful not to be discouraged. I really thought we'd win the ball game. We'll have to do a little soul-searching this week, I'll guarantee you."
